Illegal connections also put the lives of community members in danger of being electrocuted due to the live wires and lines." Eskom said.

Further to that, we note that the MEC has been tagged in various social media posts calling for the city's 'shutdown'," spokesperson for the municipality, David Magae said.

"The calls for chaos follows hot on the heels of an ongoing disinformation campaign led by Lesiba Moraka, who is employed in the office of the MEC and Thabang Ngwenya. They falsely claim that the Executive Mayor- Cllr Mpho Khunou has knowledge and is responsible for the disappearance of a municipal owned BMW X5, which was never delivered," said Mr Magae added.

He said that the municipality will take action to defend all the municipal assets. including pursuing various legal avenues available against any individual(s), who is intend to cause disruptions in the city, while residents will become inconvenienced as a result of interruptions in service delivery.

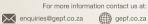

It was not an easy decision to take, but one which is necessary under the circumstances. We need to work hard to deal with the human factor in the examinations system. It is clear that the people responsible for leaking the

question papers are adults," said the Minister. Meanwhile teacher union Sadtu has vowed to challenge the decision by the department. The union is set to file an urgent court application to

interdict the department's decision stating that the decision was unfair and premature as investigations into the leaked question papers had not been concluded.

According to RLM spokesperson, David Maggae, an individual, using the following contact numbers 076 790 9997/014 547 0601, is posing as a recruiter on behalf of the municipality. The following "vacancies" are being advertised: General Workers; Assistant Manager; Call Centre; Agents; Pay Roll Administrators; Cleaners; Drivers with Code 10 & 14 with PrDP; Security Guards; Administration staff. "These job vacancies have not been advertised by RLM and therefore these vacancies are not available," Mr Maggae said. He added that it has also emerged that the name of the Rustenburg Rapid Transport is being used to lure unsuspecting members of the public.

"Apparently the conmen ask for the documents of job seekers, and request a R5000 payment from the candidates to 'confirm' their place in the shortlist," Maggae said. He added that the RRT is not yet at a phase of recruiting personnel and once the employment opportunities become available, the public will be notified accordingly by way of placing advertisements in national and local newspapers, the municipal website and all its social media platforms. "This remains the RLM's standard of personnel recruitment, which has not changed. The municipality does not make use of any employment agencies and/or Human Resources agents for purposes of recruitment," he assured. SARS warns about scam

RUSTENBURG HERALD -RUSTENBURG - The South African Revenue Service (SARS) issued a warning to taxpayers to be wary of persons posing as tax practitioners or tax experts who promise them that they could secure a refund from SARS.

Businesses and other organisations must also beware of third parties such as unknown payroll companies who offer to assist them with their PAYE submissions.

"SARS is being inundated with desperate calls from honest taxpayers who fall victim to these criminals and scammers who pocket the refunds for themselves and their accomplices as they often operate as syndicates." a statement from SARS said.

In some cases, these fraudulent submissions are the cause of delays that are experienced by law-abiding taxpayers when SARS has no other option but to verify the information that was submitted by scammers to SARS.

SARS warned that taxpayers who willing participate in such fraudulent activity in expectation of an illegal refund will be prosecuted along with the scammers.

Beware of Cut-off date for rejected R350 claims announced

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - Those recipients who have applied for the Covid-19 Social Relief of Distress R350 grant and have been rejected, and would like to launch an appeal have until the end of February 2021 to do so.

This was according to a statement recently released from the South African Social Security Agency (SASSA).

SASSA has also revealed that these applications are the ones that were made during the extension period, between November 2020 and January 2021. Meanwhile, the agency has reminded citizens that the R350 grants will only be paid until the end of January 2021. "SASSA has determined a cut-off date for lodging appeals in respect of declined COVID-19 Social Relief Distress Grants. The purpose is to strengthen administrative controls in the management of this grant and to give effect to a conducive environment for accounting," the agency explained. The recipients can send their grievances through https://srd.sassa.gov.za or by sending an email to the covid19appeals@sassa.gov.za on or before 28 February 2021.

Driving licenses grace period extended

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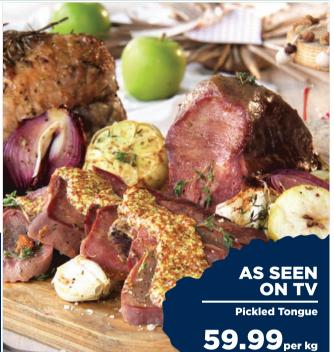

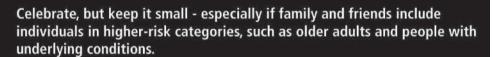

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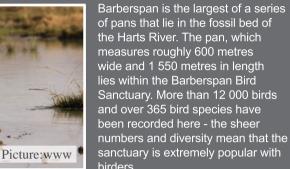

Places to visit in the "platinum province"

The Pilanesberg (formerly Pilandsberg) is a mountain in the North West Province, South Africa. The mountain is an ancient volcanic structure, circular in shape, that rises from flat surrounding plains. It is formed by three concentric ridges or rings of hills, of which the outermost has a diameter of about 24 km. The Pilanesberg is located 100 km to the North-West of Pretoria and is for the greater part enclosed in a protected area known as Pilanesberg Game Reserve. The Elands River flows South of the Pilanesberg in an Easterly direction. There are a number of platinum mines right at the perimeter of the crater formation. The name "Pilanes" comes from a historic Tswana chief named Pilane. Although geographically located within the Witwatersrand range, the mountain is geologically part of a feature known as the Pilanesberg Alkaline Ring Complex. It is a vast ring dike of a very ancient extinct volcano that last erupted some 1,200 million years ago. The Pilanesberg is one of the largest volcanic complexes of its type, there are few similar alkaline volcanic structures in the world. Different types of syenites, including a number of rare minerals, occur in the crater area. The formation of the Pilanesberg occurred 2 billion years ago. As its zenith, the volcano towered to 7,000 metres in height. Over the time, a series of volcanic eruptions occurred. There were further outpourings of lava, craters collapsed, ring fracturing took place around the volcano and magma was squeezed into these fractures. The end result is several "onion rings" of rocks of different ages. Erosion over many millions of years has stripped away the mountain and the highest peak. What we see today is not so much a volcanic crater, but a cross section through the magma pipes that were located at great depth below the mountain's summit.



Madikwe Game Reserve is a conservation area in South Africa's North West Province, bordering Botswana. The reserve's grassland, forest and rocky Tshwene Tshwene hills are home to a variety of wildlife such as elephants, lions, leopards and rhinos, plus endangered wild dogs. Hundreds of bird species include ostrich, vultures and the large kori bustard. Animals often gather at the Madikwe Dam to drink at sunset





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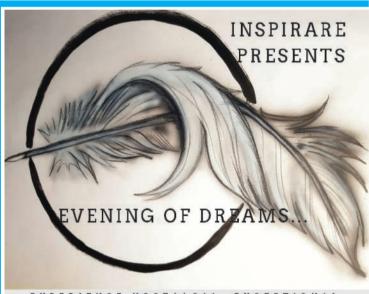


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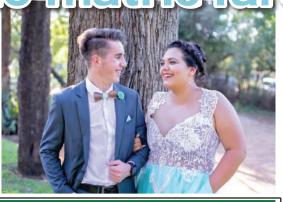

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future for oral history

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - The Digital Age has drastically changed how oral histories are assessed, recorded and received.

With the worldwide pandemic the focus has shifted to technology, using laptops and the Internet, and face-toface interviews are now done by remote. These points were raised by Dr Tshepho Mosweu, of the University of Botswana, who was speaking at the virtual National Oral History

Colloquium held here on 18,19 November. Dr Mosweu was talking on the subject of international and regional experiences on the future of oral traditions/histories in times of Technical Revolution and Pandemics in Society. She quoted from Jan Vansisa, regarded as the father of oral traditions/history, who stated that in the past the written word gained prominence over the spoken word among the educated.

It was only in the early 20th Century that the significance of oral history was recognized.

She added that today she saw an increase in the number of communities

and academic groups undertaking the collection of oral history, though in some countries, like Botswana and Zimbabwe, they are not collecting oral history at present and projects are on hold. Challenges being faced at present, she said, were a state of dwindling funding, technology capabilities and legal issues on data and software use, all of which would have to be addressed. Dr Mosweu formed part of a number of distinguished guest speakers at the Colloquium, including Prof Sekibakiba Legoati, of the University of the Witwatersrand. speaking on decolonising the South African School Curriculum: the role of oral history. Prof NP Saurombe and Dr II Shellneck-Kelly of UNISA spoke on surveying History as a compulsory component of South Africa's Basic Education programme. Dr Kogie Archary of MANCOSA and Regent Business School gave their perspective and insights. In his talk, Prof. Sekibakiba Legoati outlined the duties of the Ministerial Task Team (MTT) on decolonising the South African School Curriculum. In 2015 MTT was launched, he explained, as it was felt there was a lack of social and historical consciousness, especially amongst the youth. It had to advise the Minister of Basic Education on the possibility of offering History as a compulsory subject in Further Education and Training, as well as to strengthen curriculum

content from Grades 4-9. The team conducted a basic international comparative study to inform their work on South Africa and find out what role history played in countries like Russia, Brazil, Uganda, China and India and what its value was. Views and feedback were also obtained from public

presentations in nine provinces to inform the drafting of the report which was then submitted in May 2018. Phase Two involves developing a new History curriculum, having public input and comments on the proposed new curriculum. screening new textbooks and History teacher development. The Minister has not yet made a pronouncement on whether History will be made compulsory. The President of the Oral History Association of South Africa (OHASA), Prof Makgoatsana, outlined the impressive work undertaken by OHASA and their task was to "protect the narratives of our people and promote them because South Africa is one nation but it's incomplete because it tells a separate story. The majority of the South African population is silently represented in the archives and museums. "We have to make sure these stories are told and reclaimed and restored for the South African population. The Oral History Association of South Africa will become a platform to tell stories of the majority of the South African population which have never been

told before. Our duty is that we need to embrace technology even in the face of this pandemic." Nocawe Mafu, Deputy Minister of Sport, Arts and Culture, addressing "The pandemic

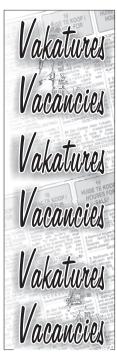

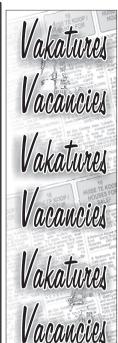

Sensational Mushrooms

For the deep fried mushrooms you will need:

- punnet Oyster mushrooms
- tsp Onion powder
- 2 tsp Garlic powder
- 2 tsp Paprika tsp dried Parsley
- tsp Sea salt
- 2 cups Flour
- 1 cup Water Oil for frying

Method:

Heat oil.

Mix half of the onion powder, garlic powder, paprika, parsley, salt and flour with all the water.

Now mix the other half of the ingredients, but keep it dry.

Dip the mushrooms in the wet mixture and then in the dry mixture. Fry in the hot oil until golden brown.

Serve with a barbeque and/or sweet chilli sauce or any sauce of your choice.

For the oyster mushroom lasagna you will need:

250g cake flour

2 eggs

Salt and Pepper to taste

Mix together

Add 10ml ice cold water to make a workable dough. Add more water if required in very small quantities Cover dough with cling wrap and leave to rest for 30 minutes in

After 30 minutes, remove from fridge and feed through pasta

Pace in boiling water for 1 minute and remove.

Pan Fried Oyster Mushrooms: Olive oil for frying

4 cloves garlic, crushed

2 onions, thinly sliced

15 ml sesame oil

250 g fresh oyster mushrooms, sliced

2 slices finely chopped oak smoked bacon

1 slice parma ham per serving Salt and Pepper to taste

Parmesan cheese shavings

Sautee garlic and onion in olive oil. Add bacon and fry for 3 minutes. Add oyster mushrooms, salt and pepper and sesame oil. Fry for 5 minutes and remove from heat.

To assemble:

Layer lasagna and oyster mushrooms, starting with the pasta and ending with the mushrooms. Top with a slice of parma ham and a few shavings parmesan cheese.

For the oyster mushroom meringues with mint ricotta and oyster mushroom dust you will need:

MERINGUES:

100 gram Egg Whites

200 grams Castor Sugar

5 ml White wine Vinegar

5 ml Corn Flour

30 grams Oyster Mushroom Biltong (New Earth) made into

Mix egg whites till foamy, add vinegar and corn flour. Mix until ribbons start to form. Add the caster sugar gradually mix until all sugar is used and it is fluffy and shiny. Fold in the Oyster Mushroom Powder. Pipe in desired shapes and bake at-100 C for an hour.

MINT RICOTTA:

100 grams Ricotta 5ml Mint leaves Salt & Pepper to Taste Combine all ingredients TO ASSEMBLE:

Place mint ricotta mix between two oyster mushroom meringues. Place three sets of meringues on a plate. Garnish with some fresh herbs and sprinkle with mushroom biltong powder



Serve the fried oyster mushrooms with a dipping sauce or two

DA rejects Bojanala District Municipality's illegal extension of leave

RUSTENBURG HERALD-RUSTENBURG The Democratic Alliance (DA) in the Bojanala Platinum District Municipality rejects with contempt the Council's adoption of a resolution to extend an ex-gratia leave period to municipal employees from 11 December 2020 until 11 January 2021. It is completely unjustifiable to extend additional leave with full pay to municipal employees on top of the legislated and regulated annual leave they are entitled to. Council is not empowered under the Constitution, the Municipal Systems Act or the Municipal Finance Management Act to take such a decision, says Martin Coetzee, DA Councillor in Rustenburg. The decision is therefore illegal and the DA's objection to the motion was duly noted. Council's decision basically means that double leave pay will be facilitated for double the duration of non-existent performance and non-existent service delivery.

In fact, municipal officials and employees would actually enjoy three extended leave periods on full pay this year should we consider the ridiculous level 5 lockdown period earlier this year. Last year the municipality could not pay salaries for several months and borrowed R50 million purely for this purpose. The municipality also, through what appears to be some sort of collusion with the North West Department of Cooperative Governance, Human Settlements and Traditional Affairs (COGHSTA), received R134 million intended for Rustenburg Local Municipality, but promptly spent it on things like travel, catering and maintenance which, incidentally, nobody can confirm ever took place. The DA lodged a case with the Hawks and it is under investigation. According to Coetzee "the Bojanala Platinum District Municipality is bankrupt and under Section 139 administration. We will request the DA's

provincial spokesperson, Freddy Sonakile MPL, to escalate this matter to Premier Job Mokgoro and the MEC for COGHSTA.

Mmoloki Cwaile, to intervene and reverse the illegal decision taken by Council", Coetzee concluded.

It is no news that Mkwebane's term in office was marred by the one pitiful defeat after another and yet another opportunity to clear her name and to set the record straight was lost when the Pretoria High Court rejected her notorious report on the so-called rogue unit in SA Revenue Services - allegedly led by the Minister of Public Enterprises -Pravin Gordhan himself. Mkwebane had to cover for her wickets time after time during the course of the past four years in which she was dealt one blow after another and rarely ever was a Mkwebane report found to be satisfactory. The truth is that quality of Mkwebane's reports were not only repeatedly rejected, but labeled laughable with serious obvious shortcomings and lack of any credibility.

To those who have remained steadfastly by her side, one needs to ask. Just how many humiliating defeats must the office of the Public Protector still suffer before someone (if she won't) would decide to call it a day? Have anyone ever calculated how much time and money (and expenses in fruitless salaries) the country has lost during the past few years, not to even mention the embarrassment of paying someone exorbitantly to basically fail at her work for quite some time now. Surely it couldn't be that there could be another purpose for losing game, set and match time after time. Did the Public Protector really think that it would be that easy to point out serious wrongdoings if not transgressions by someone as Pravin Gordhan? Perhaps this latest defeat would convince Mkwebane to rather fool about in the pool of much smaller fish than to go for someone of the caliber of Pravin Gordhan. She is clearly not in the same league - not to mention that she has rarely succeeded in filling the boots of her predecessor.

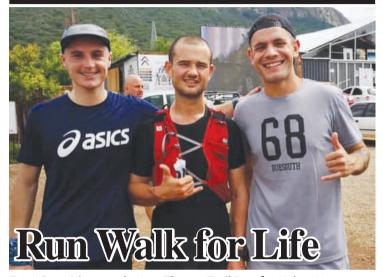
