### No Maths and Science rewrites for matriculants

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - Matric learners can now focus on enjoying their festive season after the Gauteng High Court recently put aside the Basic Education Minister, Angie Motshekga's decision for matric learners to rewrite two leaked exam papers - one for Mathematics and the other for Science. Motshekga made a decision earlier this month to have all the matriculants who sat for Mathematics paper 2 and Physical Science paper 2 to rewrite their exams after answers were leaked. The South African Democratic Teacher's Union (Sadtu), AfriForum and other concerned parties disputed the decision in Court. The judgement then set aside the rewriting of maths paper two and physical science paper two.

## South Africans urged to sign petition on TV licenses

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - As we all know by law, if you have a TV set, you must pay your TV License.

The government is now considering broadening this and asking consumers to pay TV license for streaming services such as Netflix, showmax and others. "The Democratic Alliance (DA) has launched a petition to oppose the government's plans to extend license fees to streaming services such as Netflix, Showmax, and others. In the Draft White Paper on Audio and Audio-visual Content Services Policy Framework: A New Vision for South Africa 2020, the Department of Communications and Digital Technologies proposes broadening the definition of a "broadcasting service" to include online broadcasting services. This means that South Africans will have to cough up more money for watching "broadcasting services", regardless of whether it's on a TV, a computer or a phone. The law currently states that consumers must pay a TV licence fee for viewing "broadcasting services", which includes subscription services

like DSTV. When you buy a TV, regardless of whether you watch SABC content on it or not, you must pay a licence fee for any "broadcasting services." In this sense, "broadcasting service" is limited to content viewed on a TV set.

The DA strongly opposes the license fee on streaming services. This is effectively an underhanded attempt by the ANC to force South Africans to use their hard-earned money to bail out the SABC.

It is ridiculous that the government wants to punish South Africans to use their hard-earned money to sustain an entity which the ANC, through their incessant political interference, destroyed. The DA appreciates the importance of the SABC as a public broadcaster. But the broadcaster must find creative ways to self-sustain and break-even without making South Africans fork out any more money," said the DA in a statement issued recently.

Driver loses control of his vehicle, injuring eight.



## Eight injured in Groot-Marico

This incident happened on the N4, Groot-Marico on Friday (11 December) according to ER24. Information available is that paramedics arrived at 17:45 to find all eight already outside of the vehicle on the side of the road.

Everyone was lucky to have sustained

only minor to moderate injuries. The injured were treated and then transported to Zeerust Hospital according to Ross Campbell, ER24 spokesperson. The Provincial Traffic services as well as the South African Police Service were on the scene for further investigations.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT WATERVAL SMELTER WILL BE APPLYING FOR VARIATION TO THE EXISTING AEL THROUGH BOJANALA DISTRICT MUNICIPALITY (BDM) AS THE LICENSING AUTHORITY

**BACKGROUND:** Anglo American Platinum (AAP) Waterval Smelter is in possession of a valid AEL dated 2 October 2020. The Waterval Smelter operation is located within the north western limb of the Bushveld Complex, with the main objective to process wet concentrate from Amandelbult and Mogalakwena concentrators to produce crushed, slow-cooled, sulphur-deficient nickel-copper matte rich in platinum group metals (PGMs) for despatch and further processing at Rustenburg Base Metals Refiners (RBMR) and Precious Metals Refinery (PMR). The Waterval Smelter is situated just outside the city of Rustenburg in the North West Province of South Africa. The affected properties will include portions of the following:

- Portion J of Waterval 303 JQ

Interested and Affected Parties (I&APs) are invited to comment on the proposed variation by contacting Marietjie Schoeman at 076 860 0503.

The proposed variation is to include a specific condition in the AEL for the process to be followed by AAP Waterval Smelter when undertaking maintenance activities at the smelter which may give rise to exceedances of minimum emissions standards, set for operational plants, during these periods. Under normal operating conditions, the maintenance takes place on an annual basis for 14 days and an extended, once-off extended shutdown of 120 days is being planned for the 3rd quarter of 2021.

AAP will be applying to the BDM to include specific shutdown-related conditions in the AEL through variation which states:

Prior to undertaking the annual 14-day shutdown for maintenance, and the once-off 120-day shutdown in 2021, Waterval Smelter Complex must submit the following to the Bojanala District Municipality:

- Assessment undertaken to identify potential air quality impacts during the shutdown
- Details of potential exceedances of AEL limits
- Possible impacts of these exceedances on ambient air quality
- Details of mitigation measures that will be implemented during shutdowns to minimise the exceedances and impacts
- Proof that notice of the shutdown has been provided to interested and affected parties (IAPs), and details of any comments submitted by the I&APs

The Bojanala District Municipality will acknowledge, in writing, the notification of the shutdown.

Waterval Smelter Complex can implement the planned 120-day shutdown and annual 14-day shutdowns for maintenance purposes, provided that it:

- provides the detail above to the Bojanala District Municipality, at least 14 days before the commencing thereof;
- notifies interested and affected parties (IAPs) of these shutdowns before the commencement thereof. The notice must provide details on where interested and affected parties can gain access to and comment on the information submitted to the Bojanala District Municipality as per bullet points above; and
- the notice should be published in at least one newspaper.

If maintenance shutdowns exceed the planned 14 and 120 days respectively, the Bojanala District Municipality and IAPs must be informed accordingly.

All comments must be received by **28 January 2021** and addressed to Marietjie Schoeman as per contact details below.

# "Please help us help Logan grow into the little boy that he's meant to be"

**RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - "My name is Wilmie Slabbert and I am the mother of Logan Guillaume Slabbert. He will be 1 year old on 27 December 2020. We are from Windhoek Namibia, however Logan was born in Cape Town and his grandfather, Mr Gerry Slabbert is currently staying in Rustenburg.**

This is our story: When we found out we were having a little boy, we were ecstatic. However, at our 20 week appointment our Dr noticed something is wrong with his little heart. After a second and third opinion it was decided I should head to Cape Town to see a specialist. At 24 weeks pregnant our little man was diagnosed with Tetralogy of Fallot - Tetralogy of Fallot is a combination of four congenital abnormalities. The four defects include a ventricular septal defect (VSD), pulmonary valve stenosis, a misplaced aorta and a thickened right ventricular wall (right ventricular hypertrophy). This was the biggest shock of our lives leaving us devastated. It was then decided I should give birth in Cape Town at Christian Barnard Memorial. Our little boy was born on 27 December 2019 at Christian Barnard Memorial in Cape Town via emergency c-section at 38 weeks and extremely small at 2.4kgs. However at birth it was not only his little heart that was an emergency, the doctors noticed numerous physical medical problems that could not have been seen on any scans. He struggled to breath and had to be incubated. He had an anal malformation meaning he could not poop. At 1 day old they had to give him his first operation, a Colostomy, a bag on his stomach where his poop can go. A few weeks later he got the Tracheostomy so that the intubation tube could be removed. This is the little tube you can see in his throat. Not too long after this he received his first heart operation, the actual and primary reason that we were there. A Blalock shunt was inserted. After all this our little hero was still growing each and every day. He was so strong and resilient, even after all the doubts that the Doctors had. He was on a ventilator for a while and then finally was able to breath on his own and go on just oxygen. After almost 3 months in the PICU in Cape Town we could finally come home on 10 March 2020. All these operations were however just temporary fixes until he is big enough to have the actual corrective surgeries. He is still on oxygen due to his heart condition and his lungs that are still a bit weak but looking past all this he is the happiest little boy ever. We are returning to Cape Town January 2021 for follow up corrective operations like his heart which is open heart surgery and colostomy reversal. We are still paying off medical bills from the first hospital stay and surgeries and due the fact that the hospital and doctors are all above medical aid tariffs leaving us with enormous co-payments. Logan is also still on a lot of medications that are also extremely expensive. And then also with our new journey around the corner again and new medical bills on top of the existing ones. We will do anything for our little boy, please help us help Logan grow into the little boy that he is meant to be".

## AfriForum se Kostertak dien strafregtelike klagte in teen munisipale bestuurder

Dit volg nadat AfriForum opgemerk het dat rou riool vanaf 'n rioolaanleg in die Kosterdam gepomp word. Dié besoedeling is die gevolg van 'n nuwe rioolaanleg, wat aan die buitewyke van die dorp gebou is, wat nie doeltreffend funksioneer nie en dus die oppervlak in die gebied met rou riool besoedel.

Daarom het ons geen ander uitweg as om hierdie strafregtelike klagte weens sy nalatigheid teen die munisipale bestuurder in te dien nie," sê Petrus Coetzee, AfriForum se distrikskoördineerder vir Marico.

## Latest Covid-19 amended regulations

**RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - Following the President's latest address on Covid-19 amended regulations, South Africans will have to grid their teeth somewhat longer not only avoid infection, but probably also prosecution.**

As from midnight on 14 December 2020, the following additional regulations will be applicable:

# The Garden Route and Sarah Baartman municipalities have been added to the hotspot area list which already included Nelson Mandela Bay municipality;

# Beaches in the Eastern Cape as well as along the Garden Route will be closed from 16 December 2020 to 3 January 2021;

# Beaches in KwaZulu-Natal will be closed on 16, 25 and 26 December as well as 1 to 3 January 2021;

# Beaches that remain open may only be visited between 09:00 and 18:00;

# Retailers may only sell alcohol from Mondays to Thursdays from 10:00 to 18:00 but wine farms may continue to offer tastings over weekends;

# Alcohol may not be consumed in public places except on licensed premises;

# The curfew has been extended to between 23:00 and 04:00;

# Restaurants and bars are to close at 22:00;

# Gatherings are limited to 100 people for indoor events and 250 people for outdoor events;

# The total number of people inside a building may not exceed 50% of the capacity of the building; and

# Cyclists - help them to come home safely

**RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG** - The festive season is here which usually means an increase of the number of cyclists on the road. Cycling is one of the most affordable means of transport and great for exercising and is becoming more and more popular so there are many more cyclists out there especially at this time of the year. Emphasizing that “Cycling is part of the solution” as a mode of transport in South Africa, the PPA “Stay Wider of the Rider” campaign is reminding drivers and cyclists to take preventative steps to avoid collisions. In South Africa, bicycles are considered legal vehicles and are bound to the same laws, and courtesy as motor vehicles.

“The road is a shared space where all road users have rights and responsibilities” explains chairman of the Pedal Power Association, Steve Hayward.

For drivers, the key message is “give cyclists space when passing them or wait until you can do so safely”.

Remembering that your car is a heavy piece of machinery and that cyclists (and pedestrians) are extremely vulnerable motorists can avoid injuring cyclists by practising the following:

- Always be aware of your surroundings and be on the lookout for cyclists;
- When passing a cyclist, please give them at least a one metre berth, but preferably as much room as you would give a car. Cyclists cannot keep too far left as it becomes dangerous and they may need to swerve to avoid hazards in the road. Always anticipate that there may be a pothole, an oily or wet patch, glass or some other obstruction in the cyclist’s path that you cannot see;
- If you are towing a trailer or caravan remember to give extra room when passing a cyclist and don’t cut in too early;
- Don’t drive too closely behind a cyclist – you may not be able to stop in time if they come off their bike or do something abruptly. If the road is narrow and you want to pass, rather slow down and wait until there is enough room;
- Be particularly vigilant if you see there are children riding bikes – they may do something unexpected;
- When making a left turn, remember that there could be a cyclist coming up behind you who is proceeding straight. Double check that there are no cyclists before making the turn;
- If you are turning right and there is a cyclist

approaching you in the opposite lane do not underestimate their speed. A cyclist can ride at up to 40km per hour so rather pause a moment and let the cyclist through safely;

- Avoid “dooring” a cyclist – check behind you before opening your door to exit your car. Also remind your children to do the same;
- Do not park or stop in cycle lanes, it puts cyclists in even more danger when they move around your vehicle;
- Drive slowly in restricted or low visibility conditions - remember that a cyclist could be around the next corner, so in residential areas, on rural roads or those with limited sight distance or low visibility slow down when you are not sure what is on the other side.

“With the spike of COVID cases along the Garden Route and Nelson Mandela Bay as well as areas in the Cape Metro, the Pedal Power Association encourages cyclists - novices and experts alike - to hit the trails and roads practising social distancing and adhering to wearing a mask or buff thus becoming part of the solution not the problem,” says Hayward. “Besides



adhering to the COVID-19 regulations which are mandatory in South Africa under level 1 lockdown regulations, we also wish to appeal to cyclists to wear high visibility clothing and use bike lights at all times,” explains Hayward. “The PPA is very concerned about the high percentage of hit and run accidents caused by intoxicated drivers on the roads in the early hours of the morning, so we appeal to cyclists to be vigilant at all times and even more so when approaching areas which have been identified as accident hot spots,” says Hayward. For cyclists we recommend the following safe cycling tips:

- Be visible: Wear bright clothes so that drivers can see you - anything neon is great during the daytime. It’s best to avoid biking before sunrise and after sunset, but if you do go for a ride after dark, be sure to wear reflective gear and have lights. When turning, be sure to signal to drivers and make eye contact when possible. Cycle in a straight, predictable line so that you don’t take any drivers by surprise.
- Check your bike: Before you head out, check your tyre pressure, lights and brakes to make sure everything is in order. This way there is less of a chance of some sort of malfunction that could jeopardize your safety.
- Ride in groups if possible: More and more cases of muggings and bike jacking are reported to the PPA daily. Try to slot in with a local Whatsapp group for your own safety.
- Be extra vigilant when riding in the early hours of the morning as records show that most fatal incidents happen between 04:00 and 07:00 when drivers head home from a night out.
- Always wear an ID bracelet when you are out cycling. Most of these have an emergency number to call should you need medical attention. It also makes it easier to contact your next of kin should you be out riding alone.
- Do not use your cell phone whilst riding, stop to take a call or make a call in an area safe to do so.
- Report accidents and muggings to the SAPS and the PPA.

- Avoid hotspot areas early in the morning.
- Always stay aware of your surroundings, riding with earphones is illegal and detracts from you being aware of what is happening around you. “While encouraging cycling for recreational and commuting purposes, the safety of all cyclists is our main concern,” says Hayward. “By being proactive and sharing the road responsibly cyclists and drivers can all enjoy the great outdoors during the coming festive season. Courtesy comes free and leaves both parties feeling better. Acknowledge each other on the road and thank courteous behaviour,” Hayward concluded.

## Police Minister visits North West for safer season operations

**RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - For the first time in 800 years, people on Earth will be able to see the “Christmas star” in the night sky.**

This December, South Africans will be able to see the rare “Christmas star” with their naked eyes. The last time the phenomenon was visible from Earth was in 1226 AD, the medieval Kingdom of Mapungubwe was still thriving in the north of South Africa, in Europe the bloody Crusades began and Louis VIII, the Lion, King of France dies at 39.

But what is this “Christmas star”? Although it is called the “Christmas star”, it is not actually a star shining brightly in the night sky. Astronomers refer to the celestial phenomenon as the “Great Conjunction”, an expert astronomer explains. Although the two planets align every 20 years, not all conjunctions are equal. It is said that the last time they appeared this close was in 1623 AD, but they would have appeared very close to the Sun, and so very difficult for people to see. This year, like in 1226 AD, it is not near the Sun, so people can actually witness the Christmas star. By chance, the conjunction also happens to coincide with the summer solstice – the longest day in the southern hemisphere, which occurs on 21 December. The best time to see it, the astronomer advises, is just after sunset. How to spot it: If you look to the west, you’ll see two bright objects, two of the brightest things in the sky. It is already possible to see them, and over the next two weeks they will draw even closer together – although they will never actually overlap. This year, the two planets are so close to Earth that you can see them with the naked eye. But, if you happen to have a decent pair of binoculars or a telescope, it is possible to observe the rings on Saturn and some of the moons that orbit Jupiter.

Make the effort to go out to look at it; the next Great Conjunction will occur only in 2080 again.

# Matric trip turns tragic

“I have set up a team that is going to do the investigations that will take into consideration the question of whether the trip was sanctioned. There are directives that we have sent to schools since the beginning of the pandemic about school trips,” North West Education MEC Mmaphefo Matsemela said on Saturday. Matsemela emphasized that all school trips must be authorized by the head of the department. According to information received, a group of 42 learners, travelling in three minibus taxis, attended a matric farewell function in Brits on Friday. On their way back home, one of the taxi drivers allegedly lost control of the minibus he was driving and the vehicle overturned, claiming the lives of Ikageng Nkosi (18), Tshepiso Moagi (21) and Amogelang Diphoko (20). Eleven others were injured and admitted to a hospital in Brits. Earlier this week it was reported that they were all in stable condition.

Volgens Jeurisen het die SAPD egter ’n saak van intimidasie geregistreer pleks van ’n saak van betreding. Jeurisen het later navraag gedoen en vasgestel dat die betredingsklag nooit geregistreer is nie. Hy het AfriForum gekontak, waarna ’n vergadering op 8 Desember met senior personeel van die Hartbeespoortdam-SAPD gehou is. ’n Klag van betreding is uiteindelik ná afloop van dié vergadering geregistreer.

“Dit is baie belangrik dat die stem van die gemeenskap gehoor word.

Dit skep ’n gevoel dat hulle ’n regmatige plek in die gemeenskap het,” sê Gerhard Faber, AfriForum se veiligheidskoördineerder vir Noordwes.

Jeurisen het AfriForum vir hul ondersteuning bedank, asook die Hartbeespoortdam-SAPD se senior offisiere, wat bereid is om die gemeenskap te dien en te beskerm.



# Celebrated author dies

**RUSTENBURG HERALD - TRURO - John le Carre, the celebrated author famous for his spy novels, has died at the age of 89 after a short illness. Among his 25 books were the best-sellers Tinker Tailor Soldier Spy and The Spy Who Came In From The Cold. Both were adapted for the screen, gaining the writer a wider audience.**

Literary agency Curtis Brown said the author and former spy, real name David Cornwell, died on Saturday evening after a short illness which was not related to Covid-19. A statement shared on behalf of his family said: "It is with great sadness that we must confirm that David Cornwell - John le Carre - passed away from pneumonia last Saturday night after a short battle with the illness. "David is survived by his beloved wife of almost 50 years, Jane, and his sons Nicholas, Timothy, Stephen and Simon. "We all grieve deeply his passing. Our thanks go to the wonderful NHS team at the Royal Cornwall Hospital in Truro for the care and compassion that he was shown throughout his stay. We know they share our sadness." Cornwell, who worked for both the Security Service (MI5) and the Secret Intelligence Service (MI6), wrote a number of international best-selling espionage novels. His best-known works also included The Night Manager and The Constant Gardener. "John le Carre was an undisputed giant of English literature," Jonny Geller, chief executive of the Curtis Brown Group, said in a statement. "He defined the Cold War era and fearlessly spoke truth to power in the decades that followed." Mr Geller added: "I represented David for almost 15 years. I have lost a mentor, an inspiration and most importantly, a friend. We will not see his like again." In a tribute on Twitter, author Stephen King described him as "a literary giant and a humanitarian spirit".

3. You will receive stickers to place on your ID document and driver's license.
4. Discuss your decision with your family so they are aware that you are now an organ donor. Ask your loved ones to respect and honour your decision. It is very important that you make the people around you aware of your wishes.
5. Set up a living will in which you indicate your wishes to donate your organs should you die.

**How much will donation cost?**  
Donation costs absolutely nothing. By our laws, the Hospital and or Tissue Bank will cover all medical expenses from the moment your family gives consent to have your organs/tissue donated. ## Missing woman's body recovered in Phokeng

According to Captain Elsabé Augoustides, police spokesperson in Rustenburg, a family member received a phone call from her boyfriend enquiring about her whereabouts. He indicated that he dropped her off on Thursday morning, 10 December 2020 at about 07:00 at her rented room in Kgale Section, Phokeng. Various phone calls were made to the missing lady, without success. Neighbors confirmed they last saw her on Friday morning, 11 December 2020, when she was on her way to school. A missing person's report was made at Phokeng police station and an intensive search by her relatives, various units of the South African Police Service and community members were unsuccessful in tracing her. On Sunday morning a passer-by made the gruesome discovery of the victim's naked body, her hands and feet were tied together. A murder docket was opened and currently being investigated by Capt Johannes Montsho of the Phokeng Detectives. Anyone with information is requested to phone him on 076 834 3531.

The District Commissioner of Bojanala Platinum Sub-District 2, Major General Arthur Adams, has expressed his shock and utter dismay. The brutal killing of such a young woman is despicable and no stone will be left unturned in the search for her killer(s). He appeals to members of the community to phone the investigating officer if any information about the murder is known. Crimes against women and children are condemned in the strongest terms.

• To hear and decide appeals against the decision of a municipal valuer concerning objections to matters reflected in, or omitted from, the valuation roll of a municipality in the area for which it was established in terms of Section 56 of the Municipal Property Rates Act; and

• To review decisions of a municipal valuer submitted to it in terms of Section 52 of the Municipal Property Rates Act.

Composition

• A chairperson, who must be a person with legal qualifications and sufficient experience in the administration of justice; and

• Not fewer than two and not more than four other members with sufficient knowledge of or experience in the valuation of property, of which at least one must be a professional valuer registered in terms of the Property Valuers Profession Act, 2000 [Act No. 47 of 2000].

Terms of Office

The term of office of members of an Appeal Board is four years, but members are eligible to be re-appointed.

Remuneration

a. Remuneration payable to the chairperson and members of the Valuation Appeal Board will be determined in accordance with the remuneration tariffs approved by the Minister of Finance by the National Treasury circular issued in terms of Treasury Regulation 20.2.2.

b. The remuneration referred to in paragraph (a.) is for an eight hour working day and where more or less hours of service are rendered, a chairperson of an appeal board and of a committee of an appeal board or other member, as the case may be, will be remunerated for such hours of service in proportion to an eight hour working day.

c. Where a chairperson of an appeal board and of a committee of an appeal board or other member, as the case may be, makes use of his or her own vehicle to attend meetings of an appeal board, an allowance will be paid in accordance with the tariffs prescribed from time to time by the national Department of Transport for use of privately owned vehicles.

d. Where a chairperson of an appeal board and of a committee of an appeal board or other member, as the case may be, is not resident in a district municipal area, for which the appeal board has been established, allowances are payable subject to the following limitation:

Air fares:	Economy class
Motor rental:	Category A or B vehicles
Private vehicle:	As provided in paragraph C
Hotel accommodation (bed & breakfast):	Three or four star or equivalent

Disqualification

a) an unrehabilitated insolvent;

b) a person under curatorship;

c) a person declared to be of unsound mind by a court of the Republic;

d) a person who, after 24 April 1994, was convicted of an offence and sentenced to imprisonment without an option of a fine for a period of not less than 12 months, (which disqualification ends five years after the imprisonment has been completed);

e) a person who has been disqualified in terms of applicable legislation from practicing as a valuer or a lawyer; or

f) a person who is in arrears to a municipality for rates or service charges for a period longer than three months.

# Bakwena urges road users to drive with caution

**RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - With a very different festive season taking place this year, Bakwena Platinum Corridor Concessionaire urges motorists to abide by the COVID-19 preventative measures currently in place as well as the rules of the road this festive season.**

As part of our continued commitment to Road Safety and ensuring that the N1N4 route meets the highest international standards, continuous maintenance, rehabilitation and upgrades are necessary. During busy periods, Bakwena will ensure that all lanes at their plazas are open in the peak direction. Maintain a safe following distance of at least three seconds or more between yourself and the vehicle in front of you. This distance should be increased at times of low visibility and when the road is wet. Stick to the speed limit.

Remember to stop and take a break at least every two hours.

Be cautious and do not stop along the side of the road unless you are faced with an emergency. If faced with an emergency while travelling the N1N4 route, the number to dial is 0800 BAKWENA / 0800 2259362, use the information on the blue km board markers to identify your location when requesting assistance or reporting incidents. Invest in an e-tag for a quick, convenient and pleasant tolling experience. Having an e-tag is a fast and convenient method to pay your toll fees. 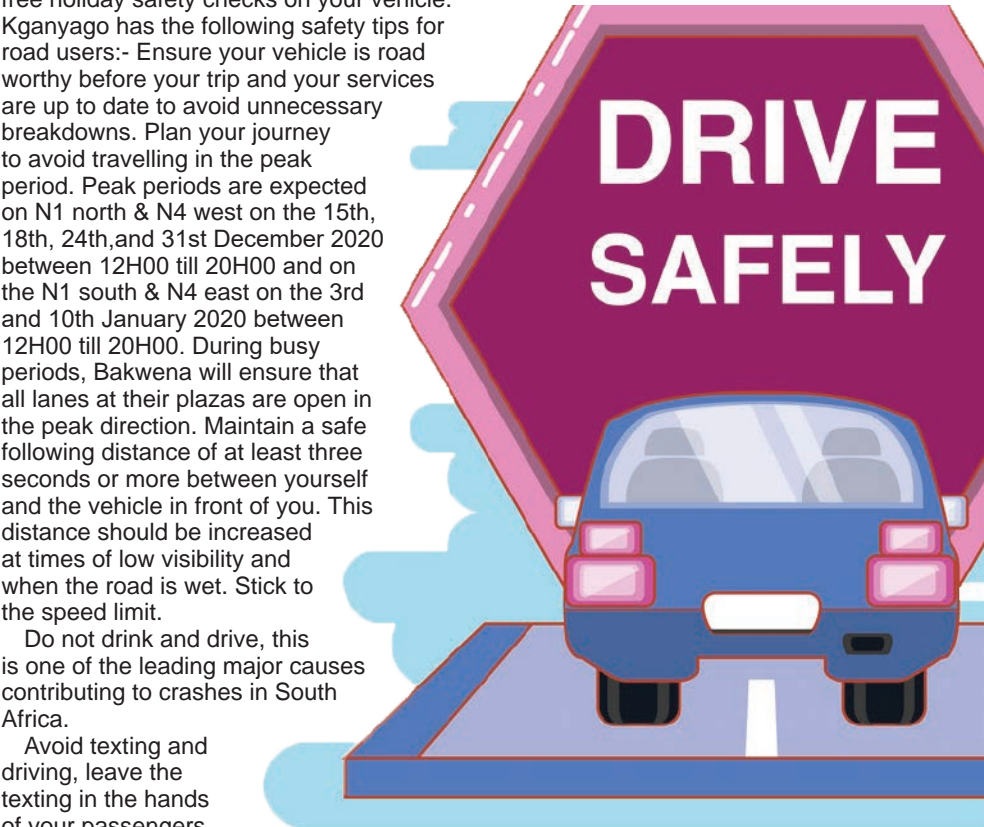

# Top young learners represent North West at crime prevention debate

**RUSTENBURG HERALD- RUSTENBURG – Learners from schools in communities troubled by gangsterism, bullying, violence and substance abuse were selected by their peers to represent North West at the youth crime prevention school debate competition featuring seven (7) provinces.**

The grand finale took place on Saturday (12 December). The competition, dubbed Youth4SaferSouthAfricaDebate, is part of efforts led by Safer South Africa Foundation (SSAF) to intensify crime prevention at schools. This is done in collaboration with the SA Police Service, National Prosecuting Authority, Magistrates, Correctional Services, Department of Basic Education, SA Human Rights Commission and the Banking Association South Africa. The competition involved learners between grades 8 and 11. The learners

were selected to participate in the debate tournament after they performed the best in an essay competition about what they believed could be done about the crime situation at their schools and within their communities, respectively.

The #Youth4SaferSouthAfricaDebate is part of the Criminal Justice Programme (CJP) run by SSAF and offered at schools within crime hotspots. The CJP is a bridge between schools and the criminal justice system departments and seeks to dispel myths learners may hold about criminal justice by exposing participants to facilities such as police stations, courts and correctional facilities through experiential learning. So far, 283 learners have been exposed to the CJP in North West while nationally, 73 schools and about 5000 learners have been reached. "The major benefit of this programme is improved learner behavior, both at school and at home. Diverse topics debated during the training include social aspects such as drug and alcohol abuse, gangsterism, rape, bullying and violence. These problems are prevalent at the selected schools," said General (retired) Riah Phiyega, CEO of Safer South Africa Foundation. Great appreciation is extended to the many donors, supporters and volunteers that made the debate initiative possible.



The five learners who represented North West in the competition were: Sive Nzakane and Katleho Katleho from Vaal Reefs Technical High School, Zoleka Magwayi from New Vision Secondary as well as Angel Dube and Relebohile Chofu from Kanana Secondary School.
