# Biological father rapes daughter, gets life sentence

RUSTENBURG HERALD- RUSTENBURG- A life sentence was secured on 27 January 2020 in the Mogwase Regional Court after the shocking rape of a minor by her biological father.

The child's mother passed away when she was still very young. According to CAptain Elsabé Augoustides, spokesperson for the police in Rustenburg, the child was left in the care of her grandparents in a village near Mogwase. Since April 2011 to September 2013, the father came visiting the child and demanded to take

her to his shanty. There she was raped repeatedly and eventually, as she could not



thought of being sexually abused any further, and out of sheer desperation, she wrote a letter to her principal, indicating that the lady was her "last hope" of ever escaping her dire circumstances.

The principal immediately reported the matter to the SAPS on 17 December 2013 and he was arrested within days. The victim never reported the incidents of rape to her grandparents, as she believed that they would not take her seriously.

The accused was never released on bail and

remanded in custody until he was sentenced. In handing down the sentence, the Magistrate mentioned that children are taught that their parents, especially their fathers, protect the family. He is the one who assist the child when he or she is hurt. "This sentence must serve as a warning to all other fathers to protect and not hurt their

Two investigating officers who persevered under difficult circumstances, W/off Ephraim Raditlhalo and Sergeant Sophie Phutiyagae from Mogwase Family Violence, Child Protection and Sexual Offences are congratulated on a job well done. Major General Adams expressed his dismay at the sheer thought of the trauma that the victim went through.

# AngloAmerican Amplats CEO Chris Griffith to step down

News - financialRUSTENBURG HERALD - After more than seven years at the helm, Anglo American Platinum's CEO Chris Griffith is stepping down.

In a notice to shareholders on Monday (18 February), the mining company said Griffith, who has spent 30 years at the company, will step down on April 16 to pursue "other career opportunities".

His successor is expected to be an internal candidate from within the Anglo American Group. Commenting on Griffith's departure, the chairperson of Amplats, Norman Mbazima, said he made an exceptional contribution to improving safety and aiding the operational and financial turnaround of the business. "The focus on innovation and developing diverse markets for our range of metals, see Anglo American Platinum well positioned to continue growing from its current position of strength," Mbazima said. Griffith said that the time had come for the "next generation of leadership" to take the business forward. The platinum mining company on Monday also released its annual results for the 2019 financial year. The group's EBITA - or earnings before interest, taxes, and amortization - doubled to R30bn. During the period platinum group metals production increased by 1%, driven by record production at its Mogalakwena and Unki mines. Headline earnings per share more than doubled from R28.93 reported in 2018 to R70.87. The group's net cash position is at R17.3bn, up from R14.4bn reported in 2018.

# Rustenburg high-strung on fibre

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - A storm is brewing in Rustenburg with regard to the "installation" of a fibre "cabling" network throughout several Rustenburg extensions for the past few weeks already.

After a promising start to the roll-out of the fibre age in Rustenburg, the process to upgrade Rustenburg to first-world communications technology is hampered by what seems to be communities who are increasingly agitated about the fact that procedures are apparently not followed in terms of the technical side of things as well as increasing complaints that some of the contracting companies involved has not been entirely transparent in terms of its procedural public participation programmes. What was expected to be an exciting and long-awaited development in Rustenburg, turned out to

be a disappointment after it came to light that contracting companies were intend on employing an "above-ground" installation method by means of six meter tall wooden/ tar poles put up at intervals of roughly 30 to 50 metres as support for the fibre cabling network in several Rustenburg extensions. Residents fear that the project could eventually turn out to be exceedingly unsightly with old-world technology to support world-class communications technology - literally in stark contrast to modern times. Several residents have complained that not only are the installations displeasing, but specifically

that contractors have pledged themselves to underground cabling processes as per its Publication Participating Programmes and that per sé, that public participation processes have been flawed.

In addition Rustenburg Herald has been told that surprisingly, "none of the contracting companies has been awarded an official contract to date" which means that everything that has been achieved to date, is nothing short than illegal". A ward councillor told Waldie Volschenk that the Rustenburg Municipality's Directorate Infrastructure was approached by contracting companies and that nothing more than wayleave applications/prescriptions were issued. The understanding is that this was erroneously interpreted as a "go ahead" to continue with the project. "It must be clear that to date, nothing is official, hence several attempts by the Rustenburg Municipality and specifically Ward Councillors to have the entire project halted until all issues have been clarified. It must also be noted that that though probably all Ward Councillors are in favour of fibre technology, we are not that desperate that we would approve of something which is not up to standard", Rustenburg Herald was told. From what could be established at the time of Rustenburg Herald going to print, delegations of all relevant parties were committed to meetings with fellow role players to have the issue resolved within following weeks



#### Important meeting on threat of uncontrolled fires

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - According to 2019 fire reports, approximately 24000 ha of grazing, orchards, fields, natural bush and trees were damaged by wildfires in the Rustenburg Municipal Area, causing loss of assets to landowners, farmers, home owners and to the environment. During September of 2019, several home owners experienced the devastating trauma of losing their homes to wildfires. In one such runaway fire, fanned by high winds, nine homes were destroyed in a matter of minutes.

The Greater Rustenburg Fire Protection Association (GRFPA) is a voluntary association that seeks to unite rural landowners for the purpose of preventing wildfires. The association was registered in 2005 under the Department of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries and now falls under the Department of Environmental Affairs. The GRFPA will be holding its Annual General Meeting on 22 February at 10:00 at the Brauhaus on the R24. All persons who rent or own a property, small holding or farm within the Rustenburg Local municipality are urged to attend. Based on years of gathering statistics, the risk of wildfire (unplanned fire in grass, veld and bush) within our municipality has been classified as "Extreme". The GRFPA provides a platform for concerned people to share ideas on fire prevention, protection and preparedness, and to be informed of the laws with bind all landowners as set out in the National Veld Fire and Forest Act (NVFFA). 

### Bogus 'colleges' closed

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - A clamp down continues on illegal colleges in the city.

During last week the Rustenburg Local Municipality's Directorate for Public Safety led an operation on bogus colleges around the central business district. This was a follow-up on two operations that had already been conducted last year. The operation was in conjunction with officials from the Department of Higher Education and Training. The main objective was to shut down colleges which have not been legally registered to operated including institutions which offer courses for which accreditation has not been issued. A college situated at 15 Oliver Tambo Drive was found to be offering non-accredited courses in Traffic Policing, as well as N1 to N3 courses. Additionally, the building was not equipped with serviced fire fighting equipment. Following the inspection at the college, a fine of R 5000 was issued for non-compliance with fire safety by-laws and the college was closed and will only re-open when full registration of offered courses has been done with the relevant department. Another college located at the corner of Pretorius and Boom Streets was found not to be legally permitted in Rustenburg. The college, however, is registered to operate in Brits, where it has complied with the requirements. Nonaccredited Engineering Courses (N1 to N3) and Business Studies(N4 to N6) are being offered at this college. The college was shut down and will only operate after all proper registration with the Department of Higher Education & Training has been completed. A computer academy, Karabo Computer Academy, which was inspected during last year's operation in Rustenburg and who was closed down, was found to have, illegally, re-opened again. The college was found operating without proper campus registration, as well as offering nonaccredited courses. Karabo Computer Academy is not registered with the Department of Education.

A fine of R 2500.00 was also issued for failing to equip the

# Back to basics - a nutritional overview for the man in the street

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - Bodies and nutrition are complex subjects, but there are certain basics that apply to everyone.

Trying to debug or adjust nutrition without these things being in place is difficult – if not a waste of time – like trying to tune a car when it is only firing on two cylinders.

LV Nutritional Products Pty Ltd 6 steps to good health: Protein (get enough), Vitamins and Minerals (get a full, basic complement), Key Minerals (even after the basic complement as in point 2 is seen to) – vital for smooth muscle function.

These are in two sets of two, in each set one works for muscle contraction and one for muscle relaxation. Most muscle dysfunction can be traced back to deficiencies of these (tremors, cramps, jerky bowels, restless legs, etc): Calcium and Magnesium – probably deficient in a large majority of people, Potassium and Sodium (sodium is usually oversupplied and potassium usually deficient), Fat/Oil Utilisation

(seeing that it is correct), Carbohydrates (most people over-do them. Drop refined ones, see that you get vegetables), Stress - understand and handle as defined nutritionally.

Protein - why and how?

Why? Almost all you see looking at your body is protein. Your digestive enzymes, hormones and immune system are protein. Without enough you cannot digest your food properly, then your body can't build, repair or protect itself, hormones don't function as they should

How? Get at least the equivalent of 6 (and up to 12) eggs daily from the usual sources: meat, fish, eggs, milk, yoghurt, cheese, beans. If you have been lacking or ill, use a supplement like whey protein which digests easily. Rule: quantity first, then adjust quality. If possible: start the day with protein;take your protein in up to 6 small meals daily.

Vitamins and minerals - why and how?

Why? Over several decades, scientists have isolated the nutrients vital to life – mainly vitamins and minerals. Skip any one of them for long enough and it will affect you adversely. For some nutrients, marked, prolonged shortages can cause death. Some deficiencies cause problems rapidly and others more slowly. In supplements, balance is the key.

How?

The difficult way: Eat only preservative-free, fertilizer free food from the very best soils that is "yesterday-fresh" (Do this if you can). A practical way: try to get the freshest, best quality foods within your time and budget. Take a well-balanced multi-vitamin/mineral supplement with adequate dosages. Most commercial supplements are too low to be of practical use. Keep vitamin C very high. 1000 mg daily is rock-bottom for today's toxic city life. Linus Pauling, Double Nobel prize-winner, recommended and took ten times that. We live in a toxic society and Vitamin C is the most important "de-toxer".

Take a natural source of B vitamins. The "B"s are difficult to balance no matter how good a supplement seems. A natural source lessens the chances of artificial shortages caused by imbalances. The two readily available sources are liver and brewer's yeast. The easiest to work with is brewers' yeast. A heaped tablespoon 3 or 4 times a week will get you going in the right direction, but take a calcium/magnesium supplement too, to balance the high phosphorus.

Calcium, Magnesium and Potassium - why and how?

Why? About a third of the body protein, by weight, is connective tissue and its main constituent is collagen, a jelly-like substance that holds the cells together. Calcium is needed for this jelly to set and vitamin C is probably the most important factor in its formation. Both are necessary to firm, disease-resistant tissues.


How? Calcium/magnesium: the only sure way we know of currently, in the modern life-style is by taking a properly formulated, easily absorbable calcium and magnesium supplement. Only a few of the commercial formulas fit this standard. Take potassium after each meal that has added salt (500 – 1000mg would be typical) and take vegetables.

Fats/Oils - why and how?

Why? Oil soluble vitamins (A, D, E and K) are nullified by poor oil utilisation. Vitamin E enables efficient use of available oxygen and protects oils in the body from oxidisation (oxidisation makes oils rancid and thus toxic). Vitamin E Deficiencies will often be seen as shortness of breath. Without quantity and quality of oils Vit E doesn't work well so deficiencies of the other oilsoluble vitamins are very likely. A low/no fat diet can block the oil soluble vitamins as surely as bad oils; and, of course, the essential fatty acids will be missing to that degree.

How? Take the right oils: Cold-pressed vegetable oils including all the essential fatty acids need to be taken. They have different types of molecules which need to work together – several different oils are needed to provide




