It includes physical, sexual, verbal, emotional, and psychological abuse, threats, coercion, and economic or educational deprivation, whether occurring in public or private life.

The stats listed below that appear on the Unicef Website are just a small indication of how serious Gender-Based Violence towards Girls really is:

According to research, up to 120 million girls from every corner of the world will have experienced sexual violence.

On their way to school, in classrooms, at homes, in refugee camps, and on playgrounds – girls experience harassment and violence. Globally, more than 8 out of 10 girls experience street harassment before they turn 17. In the United States, more than one in 10 girls is sexually taunted by the time she is 11. Girls with mental disabilities are especially at risk: in Australia, up to 68% have been the victims of sexual assault.

Pastor prayed before preying on young girls

RUSTENBURG HERALD - PORT ELIZABETH - Shocking evidence was heard at the resumption of the sexual offences trial of the so-called "man of God" - Nigerian Pastor Timothy Omotoso and his two accomplices in the Port Elizaberth High Court on Monday this week.

The state's first witness, Andisiwe Dike gave chilling details of how she was sexually abused by the controversial pastor in his church house in Durban. She is the first witness to take the stand as the trial resumed at the Port Elizabeth High Court on Monday this week.

Omotoso and his two co-accused Lusanda Sulani and Zukiswa Sitho, face 63 main and 34 alternative charges ranging from sexual assault, human trafficking and rape.

The 30-year-old witness detailed three events where she felt unsafe in the hands of what she saw as a 'man of God'.

Dike has described her first one-on-one encounter with Omotoso as scary, shocking and disgusting. She detailed a number of events, where she was shocked by Omotoso's behaviour, with the worst being when Omotoso sent for her to be called to his bedroom one evening.

Dike, who was composed throughout her testimony, told the court that when she went into Omotoso's room, he told her to lock. She says she went inside the semi-dark room and knelt, which was a regular sign of respect in the house.

Dike says this wasn't long after she had moved into the church house, and was still trying to figure things out. Dike alleges that Omotoso looked at her and pat the spot next to him in his bed. Dike alleges that they exchanged a short conversation before Omotoso pushed her to her back, and climbed on top of her.

Dike told the court that the following day, Omotoso sent for her to be called again, saying he needed a foot massage. Dike alleges that during her second encounter with Omotoso, he asked her when she'd be ready for him, to which she responded "anytime".

The witness further alleges that after the first few incidents, she stopped counting as it became a regular occurrence. Dike said that out of approximately 28 girls who lived in the house, only two went to school. She says these were very young girls, as she was amongst the oldest. Omotoso and two co-accused are facing a total of 97 charges between them, including trafficking for sexual purposes, rape, and racketeering. The trial continues.

Dubious Spar employer ordered to pay millions of rands to workers for unlawful deductions, non-compliance with National Minimum Wage (NMW) and overtime

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - The Department of Employment and Labour welcomes the outcome of Commission for Conciliation, Mediation and Arbitration (CCMA) to grant eight Arbitration awards in the department's favour against the eight Spar outlets owned by Mr. Giannacoupolous.

The awards compel the franchisee to comply with compliance orders issued and pay all complainants an amount of R 11 935 478, 00.

The respondent is further ordered to comply with clauses 3.3 to 3.16 of the same compliance order within 14 days upon receipt of the awards. Failure to comply with the awards will result with the respondent having to pay accrued interest in terms of section 75 of Basic Conditions of Employment Act (BCEA).

The decision follows the inspections conducted in May 2019 after the Department's Inspection Enforcement Services (IES) received a series of complaints of alleged gross violations of labour laws which were happening at Spar stores across the

On investigation, all the stores which happened to be violating the labour laws were found to be owned by Mr Giannacoupolous.

Ten stores were affected with nine based in Gauteng and one in the North West. Issues raised in terms of labour business to respect and comply with the laws violations included amongst others:

- Failure by the employer to issue employees with contracts;
- Long working hours without overtime compensation;
- Sunday pay, public holidays and leave not granted according to the law
- The complaints also related to the hiring of illegal foreign nationals; and
- Illegal deductions.

The inspections were conducted at Spar Orchards, Dely Road, Doornport Spar, Montana Spar, Wierda Spar, Silverton Spar, Zambezi Super Spar, Rietfontein Spar, Silverplace Spar and Safari Spar in Rustenburg. These outlets employ 565 workers.

The Department of Employment and Labour Inspector General, Aggy Moiloa, said the Department is delighted that the NMW, which was promulgated in 2019, is bearing much desired fruits. "The relentless work that is carried out by our inspectors is contributing towards making a difference in the lives of vulnerable workforce.

I exhort employers to make it their labour laws of our country".

Over half-a-million Rand collected in traffic fines in Rustenburg

RUSTENBURG HERALD- RUSTENBURG- The Rustenburg Local Municipality's Directorate for Public Safety, has reinforced its zero tolerance stance to motorists in the city, especially those who have been evading the law after being issued with traffic fines.

Learner assaulted by teacher, update

Following the article that was published in the Rustenburg Herald of last week about a learner that was assaulted by a teacher at a well-known school in Rustenburg. The Rustenburg police have confirmed that a case of Assault with intent to do Grievous Bodily Harm was registered with the police in Rustenburg. The docket according to the police has been handed in to the National Director for Public Prosecution for further recommendations. Keep an eye on the Rustenburg Herald for an update on this story. To date there hasn't been a comment from the North West Education Department.

The fines are for a myriad of offences in accordance the National Road Traffic Act 93 of 1996.

More worryingly is the number of drivers who ignore to pay for the traffic fines issues against their names, to the extent that warrants of arrests have been issued.

The operation dubbed "Patela Disuga" has taken many by surprise with the operation being set up on the arterial routes in Rustenburg including roads, which are of secondary use by motorists.

Interestingly the Directorates' officials set up camp any time of the day including early hours of the morning as well as into the evening.

Motorists were taken aback by the level of preparedness including the spot fines that have been settled where the operation is being conducted, against motorists or

vehicles they are using. Outstanding fines were paid through the use of card machines.

In just under two weeks, the operation was able to collect over half-a-million Rand from the numerous fines which had been issued and never paid for vehicles and motorists alike.

As the City is preparing for the fast approaching Easter Period, residents and visitors can expect an intensified presence of traffic police and law enforcement officials on the roads.

The team which is led by part of the senior personnel from the directorate monitor operations and all transactions on the site, to ensure that the law enforcement and traffic officials do their work unhindered and receive cooperation from motorists. Many of the motorists who had to be processed through the various road blocks, were happy to see the Municipality making an effort that all those who had been issued with traffic fines had to pay

them, to ensure that the Municipality is able to function optimally, despite the inconvenience that comes with the delays especially during peak hour traffic in the City. Motorists are advised to visit the Public Safety Office (traffic section) to check if they have outstanding fines to avoid inconvenience on the road or enquire at 014 590 3210.

Marikana turns loss into profit

RUSTENBURG HERALD -RUSTENBURG - Sibanye-Stillwater last week announced that they can report that they have turned a loss of R2.5 billion into a profit of nearly R500 million.

This comes after the precious metals producer had a, what can be described as, an eventful 2019 - which included a damaging gold strike and the acquisition of Lonmin. It is, in part due to Lonmin's former Marikana mine - that Sibanye has reason to celebrate now.

The precious metals producer posted a profit of R432-million in 2019, a nice bounce from a loss of R2.5-billion in 2018, the company said on Wednesday (19 February). That bounce would have been higher were it not for a violent strike at its gold operations by members of the Association of Mineworkers and Construction Union (Amcu), which started in November 2018 and ended in April 2019, but overall, the company had a solid performance over the course of an eventful year, with rising prices underpinning the swing back to profit - a trend that has been lifting overall industry earnings. The average rand gold price the company received rose 21%, which helped to offset the impact of the strike, which pushed the company's bullion production down 21%. Platinum group metal (PGM) prices, notably for palladium and rhodium, have been shooting the lights out on supply concerns. Both metals are key components of the emissionscapping catalysts used in petrol and hybrid engines, and tighter standards are driving demand. Sibanye is well-placed in this regard, with palladium accounting for 42% of its PGM production. "The year in review was a tale of two halves, with the financial performance in H2 2019 in stark contrast to H1 2019, which was significantly impacted by strike action at the SA gold operations and other operational disruptions," the company said in a statement. One surprise was the performance of the Marikana mine - it generated over R1-billion in profit for the last six months of 2019.

"It generated a profit because we are in such a different economic environment," Sibanye CEO Neal Froneman said during the presentation of the results at the JSE.

"The basket price for Marikana when we bought it has gone from R13,000 an ounce to R30,000 an ounce," he added, referring to the price that the combined basket of PGMs, primarily platinum, palladium and rhodium, fetch per ounce. About 30% of Marikana's production is palladium. Lonmin must be spinning in its grave - it succumbed among other things to depressed prices and was finally pronounced dead just as prices were starting to surge. The pay-dirt can be seen in the payback. Froneman said that Marikana would repay its all-share acquisition price in a year – an astonishing return on investment. "Marikana has oneyear payback. It will pay back its purchase price of R4-billion in one year. It's probably the best acquisition we've done in terms of payback period," said Froneman. There was also a restructuring there that saw 1,142 employees retrenched, while 1,700 contractors lost their jobs - fewer cuts than were initially anticipated.

Froneman said during his results presentation that Sibanye are seriously committed to reestablishing their dividend. That could potentially come in August 2020, when the company will report its interim 2020 financials.



Patients on the floor: JST responds

NewsRUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - Social media was recently abuzz about allegations that pregnant patients at the Job Shimankana Tabane Hospital had to lay on the floor.

Rustenburg Herald asked the hospital for an explanation. Tebogo Lekgethwane, departmental spokesperson responded:

"The overcrowding at Job Shimankana Tabane Hospital (JSTH) is as a result of the following issues:

JST Hospital was originally designed for a lesser population hospital and it has over the years evolved into a Regional Hospital and eventually Tertiary Hospital. There is a need for expansion of the Infrastructure to be in line with the population growth and introduction of Tertiary Services. Bojanala population is currently 1 725 000. The hospital has a bed capacity of 396 beds. According to the National norms and standards, a Tertiary Hospital should be between 400-800 beds. There is a need to increase the bed capacity of JST to align it to the National Norms. Although JSTH is gazetted as a Tertiary Hospital, it offers a service package that includes services below its level - like the District and Regional Hospital services which also constrain the ability of JTSH to render optimal tertiary level services. The above prevails due to the lack of a District and Regional Hospital in the area of Rustenburg. The overcrowding is prevalent in the specific disciplines and service areas like Accident and Emergency Unit, Maternity and Critical Care. Although the above prevail, the hospital efficiency indicators are within the norm, for example, Average length of stay of patients is within the normal range of 6-8 days and the bed occupancy rate is 83% for the third quarter of 2019/2020 financial year. The above indicators demonstrate the fact that patients do not sleep on the floor. JSTH collaborates with Fencrest and Peglarae Hospitals to augment services that are constraint for example Critical Care Patients, advanced heart procedures like Cardiac Catheterization Laboratory. The above-mentioned services are rendered at these private facilities at a reduced tariff in accordance with the service Level Agreement between private health care facilities and the State. JSTH also refers to Klerksdorp Tshepong Hospitals Complex and George Mukhari Hospital for tertiary services like Oncology, Ophthalmology, Neurosurgery and MRI. Patients are down referred to District Health Facilities for conditions that require lower level of care. There are future plans to expand and revamp the infrastructure by the construction of 160 bedded Maternity and Obstetric Unit and 22 bedded ICU. These are prioritized and budgeted for and the project is approved for 2020/2021 financial year. There is a current project to refurbish and revamp A&E, Pharmacy and the Theatres to the tune of R30m. The project will be implemented in such a way that will it not compromise provision of quality health care and services within the hospital. The contractors are on



80-year-old in court for rape of minor

The court appearance stems from his apprehension on Saturday (15 February) at about 15:00 in Geluk farming area, on the outskirts of Brits. 2019. The minimum hourly wage and the special wages for some categories of work, will all increase by just about 3.8%, approximately in line with inflation at the moment counting from when the wages were first introduced.

Unions were outraged at a previous recommendation of 5% increases, pointing out that the minimum wages introduced in 2019 were agreed in 2017 and are now much eroded.

The new prescribed minimum wages for domestic workers and farm workers for 2020 are as follows:

The minimum wage in South Africa will increase by roughly 3.8% from 1 March 2020 – roughly in line with annual inflation, but far below the level unions had wanted. The new national minimum wage will be set at R20.76 per hour, employment and labour minister Thulas Nxesi decreed in a notice published last Monday. That is an increase of exactly 3.8% on the previous R20, which came into effect on 1 January 2019.

As with the original minimum wage, certain categories of workers have lower minimum salaries. Because all of those wages are set to the nearest cent without fractions, the increases for those sectors range between 3.77% and 3.818%. In December, the latest month available, annual consumer inflation was at 4%,

This will be the first increase since up from the rate of 3.6% in November. Inflation expectations for 2019 are currently at around 4.5%.

Unions had sought an increase of at least 12.5% in the minimum wage this year on the basis that it has not increased for more than two years. Though the minimum wage was implemented in January 2019, the law that brought it into being was approved in November 2017, the R20-per-hour number was set at the time. The underlying amounts were actually agreed in March 2017, though, three years before the new increases will come into effect. In a joint statement in January, union groups Cosatu, Fedusa, and Nactu described a recommendation of a 5% across-the-board increase by the National Minimum Wage Commission as "shocking and callous".

The WHO used two specific examples to prove its findings.

Hoe lank sal hoop ons dra?

Met 'n demokrasie van nou net meer as 26 jaar waarin dinge grootliks afdraend geloop het, het Suid-Afrikaners die afgelope paar jaar begin gryp na skynbaar enige strooihalm op die horison. Soos die oumense gesê het - die hoop wil maar net nie beskaam nie nê? En dit is 'n goeie ding - as 'n mens eers hoop verloor het, is daar seker nie meer veel wat jou nog kan teleurstel nie... Just how long will hope carry us?

In the history of our democracy of 26 years in which just about everything has gone awry, South Africans have begun to cling to all kinds of things to desperately hang on to hope. Almost anything that will make the ugly truths of present developments disappear, would suffice. At first, in December 2017 there was the election of Cyril Ramaphosa as new President of the ANC and of the country that was hoped to bring about widespread change. Yes, hope was one of the few things we could still afford at the time. The term Ramaphoria incidentally, was a direct result of the excitement following the appointment of the new President and just about everything else that clearly yelled out that change was inevitable. But sadly no, barely anything has changed since the demise of the Zuma era. In fact, as far as unemployment, crime, a struggling economy, a suffering rand, the general decline of our infrastructure and various forms of illdiscipline and lawlessness, things rather seemed to have taken a turn for the worst. Not too long after this, the new hero on the beach and a sparkling beacon of hope turned up in the form of the new Director of the National Prosecuting Authority - Adv Shamila Batohi. So desperate was South Africans for hope and change, that the country's brilliant victory in the 2019 World Cup Rugby tournament momentarily sparked new hope that this time the country was about to unite and to change for the better. Now, in only the second month of the new year the question that remains, is: "Is there anything at all that would bring about change in this country?" One is tempted to say "yes, a new ruling party and a new government of course". Sadly, such a scenerio only calls for even more confusion and distress... 


