

Arno eindig derde in Noordwes maar is tops in wiskunde

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - 'n Slimkop Graad 12-leerder van die Hoërskool Rustenburg spog met die beste akademiese prestasies tydens die afgelope Graad 12-eindeksamen uit alle Rustenburgse hoërskole (kwintiel 4) en spog met sewe onderskeidings met 'n gemiddeld van 91.5%.

Arno Venter het met sy prestasie in wiskunde (95%) boonop eerste in die Noordwes-provincie en algeheel derde in die provinsie geëindig.

Arno se uitslae na die 2019-matriek-eindeksamen was:

Afrikaans: 83%;
Engels: 96%;
Wiskunde: 95%;
Lewensoriëntering: 83%;
Inligtingstegnologie: 95%;
Lewenswetenskappe: 86%;
Fisiese Wetenskappe: 94%

Wiskunde en wetenskap, veral fisika, was sy gunstelingvakke op skool. Arno was sy hele hoërskool loopbaan 'n leerder van Hoërskool Rustenburg. "Ek wil graag eendag sukses behaal in my gunsteling-wetenskapveld, naamlik fisika. Deur te presteer op skoolvlak is 'n goeie manier om vaardighede wat eendag van belang sal

wees te ontwikkel, veral as jy na skool in 'n akademiese rigting wil vorder".

Oor sy Alma Mater sê Arno: "Hoërskool Rustenburg se wye verskeidenheid geleenthede wat aangebied word is een van die deurslaggewende eienskappe wat dit onderskei van ander skole. Die prioritisering van akademiese sukses is ook iets waarop deurlopend klem geplaas word by die skool. Die onderwyspersoneel doen baie moeite om die beste punte vir leerders te verseker en gaan gereeld die ekstra myl, hierdie is beslis een van die grootste bydraende faktore tot die prestasie wat ek behaal het".

"Die beste advies wat ek kan gee is om altyd vooruit te beplan hoe jy jou skoolwerk gaan hanteer tydens eksamens asook gewone skooltye. As hierdie werk eers ophoop kan dit prestasie op akademiese gebied verhinder en onnodige stres veroorsaak. Jy moet ook altyd verseker dat jy die werk wat gedurende die skooldag behandel is behoorlik verstaan en later die dag weer nagaan. In sy vrytyd lees hy graag en beskou lees as een van die waardevolste aktiwiteite wat 'n mens in jou ontspanningstyd kan geniet. Verder geniet ek graag rekenaarprogrammering en speel soms saam vriende rekenaarspeletjies. Hy hou ook van Cappuccino, wegneemetes en reekse op TV te kyk."

North West Education amongst the top three in South Africa

Top performers in North West honoured.

RUSTENBURG HERALD- RUSTENBURG- The North West Education department shocked all in sundry by moving from position four to three during the release of the 2019 National Senior Certificate (NCS) results.

The Province registered 33 014 full time and 6 940 part time candidates with a total number of 39 954 candidates who sat for the 2019 examinations in 435 centres.

The province obtained 86.8% with an improvement of 5.3% from the 2018

results wherein the province obtained 81.1%. The North West Education MEC, Mmaphefo Matsemela during the provincial announcement of the National Senior Certificate expressed that they have outdone themselves as a province.

Cashier brutally assaulted by disgruntled customer

RUSTENBURG HERALD- RUSTENBURG - A man in his late 30s was recently arrested and has received bail following an incident where he assaulted a 28-year-old lady who works as a cashier at one of the well known retail store at the Rustenburg Waterfall Mall.

This incident, according to Rustenburg Police Spokesperson, Captain Elsabé Augoustides, took place on Saturday (4 January) at Checkers Hyper, at the Waterfall Mall. The suspect, Kagiso Dibotelo (36) was reportedly not happy from being sent from one cashier to another, he apparently got impatient and punched one of the cashiers,

Nthabiseng Jele (28). She sustained an open wound. A case of assault with intent to do bodily harm (Assault GBH) was registered with the police in Rustenburg.

The suspect was arrested, he has already appeared in Court and was granted bail.

His next appearance will be on 29 January 2020.



House invasion gone wrong in Zinniaville

The suspect who was shot during an alleged house invasion was identified as 41-year-old John Mzamo.

RUSTENBURG HERALD- ZINNIAVILLE- A 41-year-old man was left dead and one was injured and arrested after an attempted house invasion did not go according to plan in Zinniaville, Rustenburg.

The incident took place on Tuesday (7 January) at around 14:00.

According to Captain Elsabé Augoustides two suspects gained access to a house in Zinniaville, where a very well-known couple resides. The suspects then asked the husband to lie down on the floor, threatened to rape the wife and demanded jewellery, money and anything that they could get their hands on. They managed to steal cash, R20 000 in the bedroom and jewellery to the value of R10 000. While this incident transpired, a member of the community noticed a suspicious looking white VW Polo, suspecting that there might be a robbery, he informed other community members.

When the two suspects came out of the premises and were on their way to the getaway vehicle, they started firing shots randomly, a community member retaliated after the suspects shot more than fourteen bullets and shot and wounded one of the suspects. He was declared dead on arrival by the paramedics according to ER 24

spokesperson, Ross Campbell.

The other suspects that were waiting in the car fled the scene and are still at large. One suspect was injured and arrested by the police.

A case of house robbery, two counts of attempted murder, possession of unlicensed firearm and murder was registered with the police in Rustenburg.

Hot wheels at Pronto Panel Beaters - company unscathed in fire



The scorched remains of no less than eight vehicles that were destroyed by spontaneous fire at leading Pronto Panel Beaters in East End Rustenburg on Sunday, 29 December. According to visual evidence the fire was ignited by presumably faulty ignition or wiring in one of the vehicles and took place during the Christmas holiday recess when the company was closed. No one was injured in the incident but the eight vehicles were totally destroyed, a spokesman of Pronto told Rustenburg Herald. Mr Johan Labuschagné of Pronto Panel Beaters said that there was no truth in rumours that the company had burned down in the incident. "Pronto is alive and well and open for business as usual," he invited.





Post Office warns of parcel scam

RUSTENBURG HERALD- RUSTENBURG- For the umpteenth time, the South African Post Office has warned the public to be on the alert of a parcel delivery scam designed to defraud them.

According to a statement issued by the Post Office recently, members of the public receive an emailed letter from a company purporting to be affiliated to 'Speed Messenger Services' using an adaptation of the Post Office's Speed Services logo.

The letter demands payment for import duty on parcels before the parcels can be delivered.

The SA Post Office does not require customers to make any payment before the parcels are released. If VAT or any other fees are payable on a parcel, this is paid at a Post Office counter at the time when the parcel is collected.

The customer will receive a valid receipt for this payment. Where the Post Office has the cell-phone number of the recipient, the customer will receive an SMS requesting him or her to collect the parcel at a specific Post Office branch. The SMS will not request that funds be deposited into an account.

Members of the public that have information regarding this scam, are requested to call the SA Police or the Post Office's Crime buster Hotline on 0800 020 070.

The SA Post Office advises the public to ignore communications of this nature.

Kidnapping and murder suspect arrested in Chaneng

RUSTENBURG HERALD- CHANENG - A 40-year-old suspect appeared in the Bafokeng Magistrates' Court on Tuesday (7 January), for the alleged kidnapping and murder of a 15-year-old girl in Chaneng Village, just outside of Rustenburg.

According to information received from the provincial police spokesperson, Brigadier Sabata Mokgwabone, it is alleged that the suspect was seen leaving a local tavern in Chaneng Village in the company of the victim and her 18-year-old friend on Tuesday (24 December 2019). They left the tavern and were both seen entering the nearby bushes between midnight and 01:00 on New Year's Day. Since then, the victim was never seen.

The victim's parents opened a case of kidnapping on Friday (3 January). At that point, Mokgwabone continues to explain that the suspect was already in detention after being arrested on Wednesday (1

January) though information received from members of the community, for the initial rape allegedly committed on Tuesday (24 December 2019). He appeared in the Bafokeng Magistrates' Court on two separate cases of rape on Friday (3 January). Further investigation into the matter led to the discovery of the 15-year-old victim's decomposed body in the bushes at about 11:00 on Sunday (5 January) at Chaneng Village. The Provincial Commissioner of North West Lieutenant Sello Kwena condemned the incident in the strongest possible terms and said that the police will have no mercy in dealing with those who commit gender based violence.

Rustenburg lekker nat - maar nog reën altyd welkom

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - Inwoners van Rustenburg en groot dele van Noordwes hoop steeds op nog reën om die rug van die versengende droogte van die afgelope nagenoeg vier jaar finaal te breek en opgaardamme in Noordwes op 'n kommvrye vlak te kry.

Hoewelveral Rustenburg sedert die begin van November uitstekende neerslae geniet het, is daar nog etlike damme in ons streek wat nog ver van vol is. Die meeste prominente damme toon egter 'n merkbare stygging in watervlek - sien die stand van damme in ons omgewing elders in hierdie uitgawe.

Mnr Charlie Graham van Geelhout Gardens Kwekery in Kremetartlaan Rustenburg se statistiek van die afgelope maand of wat toon dat Rustenburg vir Novembermaand nie minder nie as 130.5mm gekry het. Dit was die tweede meeste die afgelope 16 jaar (sedert 2003). Vir die vakansiemaand (Desember) het sake selfs nog meer voor die wind verloop met 'n ongelooflike 213 mm wat

by Geelhout Gardens gemeet is. Dit was trouens die meeste en 'n splinternuwe rekord vir Desembermaand oor die afgelope 16 jaar.

In ander areas soos Cashan 4, 5 en 19, Waterfall Mall en die oostelike gedeeltes van Safarituin is daar egter heelwat meer gemeet. Sondagaand byvoorbeeld het daar nagenoeg 40 mm in Cashan 19 gevallen terwyl slegs 4mm by Geelhout Gardens gemeet is. Tans is daar ongeveer ses of sewe opgaardamme in die Bojanalastreek wat op die punt is om oor te loop of wat intussen reeds oor hul keerwalle gebars het. Die meeste neerslae van die afgelope week het saans tussen 11:00 en 02:00 gevallen en het oor die algemeen met swaar weer gepaard gegaan.

Kgetlengrivier Local Municipality's financial challenges explained

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - All is not well at Kgetlengrivier Local Municipality and since recently it relies on municipal grants such as Municipal System Improvement Grant (MSIG) and Equitable Shares (ES) to keep afloat and run financial services.

According to municipal spokesperson, Sannah Magakala the municipality doesn't have enough cash on hand to meet its monthly financial commitments due to poor revenue collection.

"We are experiencing financial difficulties due to non-payment of services and withholding of Equitable Shares by National Treasury. The Municipality admits that "due to the above mentioned challenges, we are unable to pay third parties payments with the exception of medical aids which are paid on time. The municipality is busy negotiating with the National Treasury to release the equitable shares and we will pay all third parties," said the Municipal Manager, Mr Joseph Mogale.

He said the municipality is doing its best to raise revenue and encourage communities to pay municipal accounts in order to enhance revenue. "We have embarked on the campaign known as "Operation Patella" to encourage communities to start paying their accounts." With regard to the provision of protective clothing the municipality has advertised for the appointment of service providers to deliver. The municipality is finalising the appointment of service providers and would like to apologise to workers for the delay in providing protective clothing.

The municipality will continue to render services to its communities and would like to

apologise to workers and community for any inconveniences caused.

Meanwhile, taps and water installations have run dry for at least the past week since municipal workers have embarked upon a strike in protest to the fact that they are levied by the municipality for medical and pension cover but that these levies are not being paid over to the service providers. Simultaneously, electricity supply has been interrupted because municipal workers in turn simply refuse to repair these.

One of the main problems is the fact that people in the community won't pay for services resulting in our inability to pay for operational expenditure. Mr Carel van Heerden, Chairperson of the Kgetlengrivier Ratepayers Association said that the association understands the challenges of the workers, but that a court order has been obtained in meantime to prevent striking workers from intimidating those who wish to work. Van Heerden also indicated that he intends laying charges at the police against the Kgetlengrivier Municipality because of the fact that the medical and pension contributions have been allowed to fall into arrears. In turn, Municipal Manager Joseph Mogale said that the only and critically important solution is that the culture of non-payment be discontinued.



RUSTENBURG HERALD - IKAKELENG- The community of Ikageleng Village, in Dinokana along the N4 is one of the many villages in the province in which poverty and unemployment is a big issue, especially for the youth.

According to information, the main source of income for most households is government social grants. This village has more than 20% child headed homes and it is one of those communities experiencing an increasing epidemic of HIV/Aids.

Despite all these challenges facing the residents, a group of about 10 women and a man came up with an initiative of planting vegetables and selling them to the community as well as local retailers and tuck shops.

With literally no equipment to work with and no official funding, the group decided that even though it is difficult to find formal employment,

the idea of initiating a vegetable garden will be beneficial to them and members of the community. In an exclusive interview with Jabulani Senyatso of the Rustenburg Herald, the Chairperson of the project, Mrs Bathalefeng Flora Motsumi said the project informally on 18 June 2012.

"It was originally a volunteer project to honour the Mandela Day 67 minutes and we started with about nine women, planting two rows of beetroot, five rows of cabbage and two rows of spinach," Motsumi said.

They have recently been offered a small piece of land by Matshidiso Gae's family, who gave them access

to water and electricity as well as a safe environment to continue with their goals. Flora said that the future vision is for them to acquire about 20 hectares of land so that the project can be done on a larger scale and create job opportunities to the members of the community.

What is the reason for crime among the youth?

Almost exactly the same way as corruption and crime virtually became a new phenomenon in South Africa over the past 25 years (yes we know, of course there were exceptions), it is with great concern that the South African community has noted a marked increase in attacks on parents/grandparents by children/youths over the past 10 to 15 years in the country. Even now, quite a few years since the incidents, it is easy to recall the incidents of Don Steenkamp and Henry van Breda wherein their families were virtually wiped out completely. There were in fact an alarming number of these gruesome events than many of us care to remember. It is unthinkable that crimes of this nature took a serious upswing lately, and this in a country that for decades would have been described as traditional, conservative. There are probably only a very few reasons, with two definitely among the main reasons, for aggressive behaviour and attacks on parents, grandparents and guardians by children who without doubt are not ever ready for the world out there.

The role of peer pressure, increasing alcohol use and the availability of so-called hard drugs in the country must be seen as one of the primary reasons for aggressive

behaviour among the youth. Anyone in South Africa today who doesn't know that a variety of hard drugs are available at clubs, on street corners and even at school are surely out of touch with modern day South Africa. Today we also know that the affordability of hard drugs is a much bigger problem than the availability thereof. So the question, who will a teenager/young man or girl turn to when they are in need of cash for some reason or the other? Obviously the parent/guardian is the first and often, only option. It is hard to arrive at any other conclusion than that the addiction to alcohol/drugs often lead to these gruesome attacks. The second reason must simply be the total lack of discipline at school and even some homes. Though the author of this column is quite opposed to corporal punishment, the question remains, how will you enforce discipline since government thought it well to declare corporal punishment illegal a few years ago. Is there any effective system at schools which could prove a better alternative? Unfortunately, not that we know of... The same goes for the abolishing of the death penalty and the exponential increase in violent crimes. Is it not time in South Africa that we wake up and realise that the monster we have been feeding is going to haunt us?

Jeugmisdaad, waar kom dit vandaan?

Net soos misdaad, korupsie en algemene verval in Suid-Afrika oor die afgelope 25 jaar as't ware 'n splinternuwe verskynsel (ons weet, natuurlik was daar uitsonderings) in ons land geword het, is daar oor die afgelope nagenoeg 10 tot 15 jaar met groot ontsteltenis kennis geneem van voorvalle waarin kinders en jongmense toenemend vir aanvalle en moorde op hul ouers en intieme familielede verantwoordelik was. Dit is selfs nou nog, etlike jaar na die voorvalle, nog maklik om die voorvalle van Don Steenkamp en Henry van Breda in herinnering te roep. In werklikheid was daar egter baie meer voorvalle as wat die meeste van ons kan onthou. Dit is ondenkbaar dat voorvalle van hierdie aard skynbaar besig is om 'n toename te toon in 'n land wat vir baie dekades lank as tradisioneel en streng konserwatief bestempel sou word.

Daar is waarskynlik slegs enkele redes waarvan veral twee beslis die hoofoorsake is, vir gewelddadige gedrag en aanvalle op ouers, grootouers, onderwysers en voogde van kinders wat inderwaarheid nog nie eers behoorlik vir die grootmenswêreld gereed is nie. Die rol van groepsdruk, toenemende alkoholmisbruik en die beskikbaarheid van dwelms in 'n veranderende Suid-Afrika moet een van die twee hoofredes vir die verval onder ons jeug wees.

Enigiemand in Suid-Afrika wat vandag nog nie weet dat dwelms in klubs, skole en openbare plesierplekke feitlik vryelik beskikbaar is nie, is ongetwyfeld uit voeling met gebeure en verwikkelinge in die land. Daar is tot nou toe al hoofstukke geskryf en gepreek oor die toename in die

gebruik van alkohol en sogenaamde harde dwelms in Suid-Afrika. Ons weet ook dat die bekostigbaarheid van baie van hierdie dwelms 'n veel groter probleem as die beskikbaarheid daarvan is. Waarheen dus, sou minderjarige, afhanklike jong kinders hulle wend indien hulle vir water rede ook al kontant benodig? Die ouerhuis is tog maar die plek waar alles begin. 'n Mens kom nie maklik tot 'n ander gevolgtrekking as dat die afhanklikheid van drank en dwelms en die koste daarvan tot 'n groot mate vir hierdie tragiese voorvalle verantwoordelik is nie.

Die tweede en waarskynlik hoofrede vir gewelddadige gedrag onder jongmense en skoolkinders, moet eenvoudig die totale gebrek aan dissipline wees.

Ouers en onderwyspersoneel sit al baie jare met die hande in die hare omdat die handhawing van dissipline in skole en ouerhuise 'n probleem geword het sedert lyfstraf of soortgelyke dissiplinêre maatreëls deur die regering onwettig verklaar is. Hoewel die skrywer van hierdie rubriek hoegenaamd nie 'n voorstander van lyfstraf is nie, moet die vraag eenvoudig gevra word: Hoe dissiplineer jy 'n rammetjie uitnek/boelie of ongedissiplineerde kind sonder lyfstraf?

Watter stelsel is daar by skole in plek om dissipline te handhaaf? Sover ons weet is daar betreklik min of geen werkbare oplossing nie. Dieselfde geld die afskaffing van die doodstraf en die eksponensiële toename in misdaad. Moet die Suid-Afrikaanse samelewing nie betyds wakker word en besef watter monster ons besig is om te voer en groot te maak nie?



Vroue op motorfietse vat langpad vir wêreldrekord

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - Marinda Greyling, 'n dame en geesdriftige motorfietsryer van Rustenburg, nie net plaaslik nie, maar ook die enigste in Noordwes Provinse het deelgeneem aan 'n wêreldwye motorfiet-saflos aflos wat WRWR ("Women Riders World Relay") genoem word om mense bewus te maak van hoeveel vrouemotorfietsryers daar is in die wêreld en ook vir die projek "Riding for a Limb" campaign.

Dit is die eerste aflos van sy soort en sal in die "Guinness Book Of Records" opgeteken word. Die aflos is begin deur Haley Bell en het verlede jaar die 27ste Februarie in Skotland begin. Die SA-roete het op 2 Januarie 2020 in Midrand afgeskop en op 9 Januarie 2020 is die aflosstokkie aan Namibië oorhandig in Upington. Vanaf Namibië gaan hy Botswana, Zimbabwe, Mosambiek, Tanzania, Kenya, Oman en laaste UAE toe. Sy was opgewonde, geëer en het hoendervleis gehad toe sy die eerste persoon was wat met haar groep wegtrek vanaf Bikerswarehouse in Midrand met

kameras wat flits, videos wat geneem was, en die res van die 123 motorfiets agterna. Daar was ook 10 internasionale vroue wat saam met SA se vroue kom ry het, vanaf Skotland, Malaysia, Engeland, Kanada, Wallis, VSA, Swede en die UK.

Die roete van SA het oor nege dae gestrek en was 4390km ver. Die dames het oorgeslaap op Clarens, Dolphin Coast, Matatiele, Grahamstown, De Rust, Kaapstad, Calvinia, Upington en Sannieshof. Daar was 193 "guardians" wat die "baton" (aflosstokkie) vir verskeie km's moet dra. Marinda sê dit was 'n belewenis en 'n emosionele gevoel wat sy nie kan beskryf om die "baton" op haar rug te sit wetende dat hy al deur 75 lande en 1000de km op iemand se rug was. Die oudste "guardian" is 67 jaar oud en die jongste 6 jaar. Elke deelnemer aan die aflos moes die "baton" teken. Op dag 4 het hulle 'n reën en haelstorm trotseer en sy het ook 'n noue ontkomming gehad net voor Uggie toe sy op 'n draai vir 'n bees moes rem en die dame agter haar in haar vasry.

Sy kon gelukkig haar motorfiets regop hou sonder om te val en gou was daar hulp met 'n nuwe agterriem en band en kon hulle haar rathetboom effe regbuig sodat sy die aflos kon klaarmaak. Net haar voet was in die slag, maar darem nie so seer dat sy nie verder kon ry nie. Die ander dame se motorfiets is afgeskryf en sy het gelukkig lig daarvan afgekom deur net haar gewrig en pinkie te breek. Sy wil sommer hiermee ook baie dankie sê aan George van Zyl en Rudi van Niekerk vir al hulle hulp en ondersteuning. Hulle is op verskeie dorpe hartlik verwelkom en in Jeffreysbay spesiaal deur die burgermeester toespreek waar hulle ontbyt gehad het en daarna deur die verkeersafdeling deur die dorp begelei was.

Harley Davidson in Tygerberg het ook groot moeite gedoen met eet- en drinkgoed om die groot groep te verwelkom. 

RUSTENBURG HERALD - JOHANNESBURG - Siya Kolisi, among a host of World Cup heroes, will step out onto the FNB Stadium turf for this weekend's Vodacom Super Hero Sunday.

The first match of the double-header takes place at 13:00. Stormers coach John Dobson is fielding nearly all his other World Cup stars, except the injured Pieter-Steph du Toit for the game against the Sharks. The teams will play in their jerseys inspired by the Marvel characters Captain America (Vodacom Bulls), Thor (DHL Stormers), Spider-Man (Emirates Lions) and Black Panther (Cell C Sharks). Pote Human, the Bulls coach, was taken aback by the suggestion that the match might be anything other than a full-bore physical contest.

"This is the Jikskei derby," he jived of the age-old rivalry against the Lions, which resumes at 15:15 next Sunday. World Cup player Warrick Gelant will likely start, although a niggly hamstring injury is likely to keep out Trevor Nyakane, the popular prop. The Lions, meanwhile, will rely on their playmaker Elton Jantjies. New Lions coach Cash van Rooyen is understandably keen to take an early look at how his players shape, particularly as his specialty is conditioning. "It's an opportunity to let the players test their conditioning and to get some contact," he said of the match against the Bulls. He's mindful, too, of the need

to contribute to the day's entertainment and is likely to give his players the freedom to play instinctively. The Sharks are adopting a similar approach, so Makazole Mapimpi and Lukhanyo Am, the World Cup try scorers, will be in the black and white in a back-line stacked with power and athleticism. Coach Sean Everitt is enthusiastic to be playing at FNB Stadium. "It's always exciting to be playing in an international quality stadium and it will be a first for most of the players. We are looking forward to the occasion and the top-class rugby on offer will be a treat for fans." Although match-winner Handre Pollard has moved to France, there will be a familiar man in the No 10 jersey as Morne Steyn makes his return in the light blue. Several other veterans will also turn out next weekend, among them Juandre Kruger and Josh Strauss, both back in South Africa after long stints in Europe. Human expects the World Cup success to put pressure on the SA teams, but he says this status can only help, rather than hinder, SA ambitions. "We are the best in the world and we must play like it."
