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Kleuters mag skool toe sê hof



RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - Regter Fabricius het vandag in die guns van die Solidariteit Beroepsgilde vir Maatskaplike Werkers en die Solidariteit Skoleondersteuningsentrum (SOS) beslis dat private kleuterskole en dagsorgsentrums daarop geregtig is om onmiddellik te mag heropen indien hulle dit veilig kan doen.

Die twee organisasies het die saak teen die departement van maatskaplike ontwikkeling gevoer omdat geen aanduiding van 'n vasgestelde datum gegee is ten opsigte van die heropening van hierdie instansies nie.

Volgens 'n mediaverklaring wat op 5 Junie uitgereik is, het die departement van maatskaplike ontwikkeling aangedui dat die

sektor vir vroeë kinderontwikkeling, wat uit graad R- en jonger leerders bestaan, nie tydens vlak 3-inperking sal heropen nie, maar Regter Fabricius het dit as onregmatig verklaar. "Ons is verheug oor die uitspraak. Dit beteken verligting vir duisende ouers vir wie dit nou weer moontlik gaan wees om hul kinders in die sorg van hul bekwame onderwysers te laat vir die stimulasie en leer wat kinders so broodnodig het," sê Marisa Engelbrecht, sektorhoof van die Solidariteit Beroepsgilde vir Maatskaplike Werkers. "Wat nog meer gerusstellend is, is dat hierdie kinders nou weer in ? veilige omgewing kan wees en dat die kinders wat afhanglik van voedingskemas is, weer met vol magies kan leer en optimaal kan ontwikkel." Die beroepsgilde en die SOS het aangevoer dat die kleuterskole en dagsorgsentrums ter sake ten volle toegerus en voorbereid is om kleuters te ontvang binne die veilige omgewing wat hulle daargestel het en daarom sou daar geen verdere rede wees om kinders te verhoed om skool toe te gaan nie. Regter Fabricius het ook beveel

dat die departement Solidariteit en die SOS se regskoste van verband met hierdie saak moet dra. Die departement het versuim om sy hofstukke in te dien of om enige ander reaksie te toon soos gedurende hofprosesse van hom verwag word. In antwoord hierop het Regter Fabricius sy sterk misnoë teenoor die departement van maatskaplike ontwikkeling oor die hantering van die saak uitgespreek, veral aan die lig daarvan dat dit oor jong en weerlose kinders se beste belang handel. "Volgens die uitspraak is die staat met geen ander keuse gelaat as om die heropening van private kleuterskole en dagsorgsentrums toe te laat nie. Onderwysers kan hul dienste hervat en die tale personeellede wat ook onder hierdie sinnelose stilswye van die departement gely het, kan nou weer daarna uitsien om gesond en veilig te werk. Hierdie oorwinning is nie net ? oorwinning vir private kleuterskole en dagsorgsentrums en hul leerlinge nie; dit is ? oorwinning vir elke Suid-Afrikaner wat wil opstaan teen die onbillikhed van die regering se inperkingsmaatreëls."

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Organisasie gaan afsny van krag beveg

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - Die KDS Saketrust is 'n organisasie wat inwoners se regte beskerm waar munisipalteite in gebreke bly om Eskom te betaal vir krag gelewer.

Aangesien Eskom 'n kennisgewing geplaas het dat hulle vanaf 30 Julie Rustenburg se krag gaan sny met beperkte tye, het inwoners van Rustenburg KDS Trust genader om hulle deur middel van verteenwoordiging by te staan. "Ons het reeds verskeie dringende aansoeke met sukses teen Eskom gebring en ons regspan is tans besig om regsstukke op 'n dringende basis voor te berei om te verhoed dat Eskom die Rustenburg munisipalteit se krag afskakel", het 'n woordvoerder van die KDS Trust aan Rustenburg Herald gesê. Die KDS Saketrust kan intussen by 083 565 6922 geskakel word.

Libraries, museums, theatres, cultural spaces can now re-open

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - The reopening of libraries, museums, theatres, cinemas, galleries and archives has been signed and approved by the Minister of Sports, Arts and Culture, Mr Nathi Mthethwa.

According to Mthethwa, the reopening of these spaces must be done in compliance

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with measures to prevent and combat the spread of COVID-19, as per 27 (2) of the Disaster Management Act 2002 (Act no. 57 of 2002).

"This approval comes after consultation with the Cabinet member responsible for health. Cinemas, theaters and arts and cultural spaces overall may operate, provided that only 50 people or less are allowed, in compliance with health safety protocols," the Department of Sports, Arts and Culture said on Tuesday (7 July).

The Directions include the limitation of operating hours, as per the amended standard operational procedure, the provision of limited service and limited contact, as well as the limitation on the number of people visiting a space at any given time.

Taxman can't just order bank to pay over your tax debt, court rules

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - The High Court in Pretoria recently ruled that taxpayers have a right to receive "sufficient" notice before the SA Revenue Service instructs a bank to collect an outstanding tax debt.

The ruling is a victory for both taxpayer rights and the wider cause of administrative justice. The case involved a company called SIP Project Managers, which saw SARS instruct its bank to pay over an outstanding tax amount.

SARS must now repay the money to SIP - together with interest as well as the costs of litigation - after the court found that the tax service did not provide sufficient notice to the company before it instructed the bank to pay over the outstanding debt. By law, SARS can demand that third parties - typically banks - pay over outstanding tax debt. But the law also requires that SARS must take steps before this is done, including notifying a taxpayer that they have an outstanding tax debt, and that further steps will be taken should the tax debt remain outstanding. A key requirement is that the debt must be outstanding. SIP Project Managers received a letter from SARS that there was a payable debt, which was due at the end of November. The letter was issued before the expiry date for payment specified in the tax assessment.

In court, SARS contended that the letter

notified the taxpayer that it would "appoint" the bank as an "agent" to pay over the outstanding debt.

But the court found that a notice to a bank and other third party "may only be issued after delivery of a final demand for payment which must be delivered at least 10 business days before the issue of the notice."

This is a peremptory requirement before the step can be taken to issue a third party notice for the recovery of an outstanding tax debt".

Accordingly, for SARS to instruct a third party - like a bank - to collect money:

- *There must be a tax debt
- *The due date for payment of the tax debt must have expired;
- *A letter of demand must be delivered to the taxpayer at least 10 days prior to issuing a notice to a third party who holds monies for and on behalf of the taxpayer concerned;

- *The letter of demand delivered to the taxpayer must set out the recovery steps to be taken should the tax debt not be paid; and

- *The letter of demand must also specify the relief mechanisms available to the taxpayer.

"Another important point to note from the judgment is that the letter of demand must be delivered to the taxpayer (via electronic platform or to the last known address of the taxpayer). A notice generated by the eFiling system does not satisfy the requirement of delivery unless such notice is uploaded on to taxpayer's profile, says a tax expert.

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JST Hospital prepares for surge in Covid-19 infections

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - As the number of positive cases in Rustenburg rises, Job Shimankana Tabane Hospital, just like any other hospital in the country, is gearing itself to face the surge in cases of this highly infectious virus.

In a statement issued to the Rustenburg Herald recently, the hospital said just like any other health facility, they are faced with a challenge of the rising number of infections among its staff members.

According to the statement, which was issued on 30 June 2020, the hospital said the total number of patients and staff members that have been tested for COVID-19 are: 203 and 59 tested positive. Of the 137 staff members tested, 53 tested positive, three were admitted and those with mild to moderate symptoms were placed in isolation.

"Only one staff member has passed on. She did test positive, however circumstances around the death made it difficult to attribute the cause of death to COVID-19," the hospital said,

JST hospital has completed a renovation of persons under investigation (PIU), 26 bed ward. The renovations of a 24 bed ward is

currently undergoing renovations.

To date the hospital has received adequate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) donations valued at over R2 million from Sibanye Still Water, Motsepe Foundation, Old Mutual, Imperial Health, Naspers and Tziki Chi Foundation. These donations included masks, sanitizers, gowns and gloves.

"We are currently on a recruitment drive to employ qualified personnel required for the surge and anticipated increase in number of COVID-19 in the area. Although the facility has sufficient number of specialists. The hospital will be strained as staff members are quarantined and isolated as they test positive," the statement concluded.

The hospital recently acquired two tents to screen and test patients before they enter casualty Department to reduce chances of transmission of COVID-19 to staff and patients.

Kegakilwe passed away on Monday (6 July) due to a short but serious COVID-19 related illness according to reports.


He was admitted with COVID-19 pneumonia on Sunday afternoon (5 July) at the Vryburg Private Hospital and was immediately put on oxygen.

Suspect apprehended for young teacher's murder

RUSTENBURG HERALD - MOGWASE- Last week Monday (29 June) the lifeless body of a young teacher, Khumontle Mokgosi (25) was discovered in her rented place in Magong Village, near Mogwase by neighbors and members of the School Governing Body (SGB), who conducted a search after the young teacher failed to report for duty.

Four days later a 40-year-old suspect, Akanyang Rakodi, was arrested in connection to her murder. The arrest was made on Friday (3 July) at Goo-Mokgatle Section in Dinokana Village just outside of Zeerust.

During the arrest, the suspect was found in possession of the deceased's bank card as well as recently bought goods such as clothes, car battery and liquor. Preliminary investigations revealed that Mokgosi's bank card was used to withdraw cash from ATMs in Northam and Zeerust. Furthermore two of the deceased's cell phones were recovered.

Rakodi appeared briefly before the

Mogwase Magistrates' Court on Monday (6 July) for the alleged murder of Mokgosi. He is facing additional charges of theft and possession of suspected stolen goods. He was remanded in custody until his next appearance on 14 July 2020.

The Provincial Commissioner of North West General Sello Kwena applauded the team work of Bojanala District and Zeerust Task Teams as well as Provincial Traffic for working tirelessly to make certain that the alleged perpetrator was brought to book to face the might of the law.

He said further that the arrest will serve as a warning to those who commit crime, including gender based violence, that no stone will be left unturned in ensuring that they account for their deeds.

Klag na drama by aftree-oord

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - Die polisie in die stad ondersoek 'n klag van aanranding nadat die voorsitter van die bestuurskomitee van 'n aftree-oord hier glo 'n inwoner twee maal geklap het.

Volgens Pieter du Preez (76) het die moeilikheid begin nadat die regering aangekondig het dat huis en-tuinwerkers mag terugkeer werk toe, mits al die nodige veilige maatreëls gevolg word. Die voorsitter van die bestuurskomitee het toe blybaar gesê hy gaan nie toelaat dat tuinwerkers, behalwe slegs die oord se eie werkers, die perseel binnekomb nie. "Ek het hom laat weet dat dit ongelukkig nie vir my aanvaarbaar is nie en dat my werker Vrydag sal kom werk. Ek het ook die versekering gegee dat ek sal sorg dat alles nodig gedoen word om seker te maak dat ek aan die land se regulasies betreffende Covid-19 voldoen," vertel Du Preez. Die voorsitter het hom toe glo verwittig dat hy as 'nie-samewerkend' gebrand merk sal word. Toe die werker dus Vrydagoggend (3 Julie) by die oord se ingang opdaag, het Du Preez gegaan om hom persoonlik te begelei. "Die volgende oomblik kom die voorsitter uit sy erf en pyl

reguit op die werker af. Ek het tussenbeide getree en vir hom gesê my werker is my verantwoordelikheid. Hy het afgehak en my teen die kant van my kop geklap en my teen my slaap getref. My knieë het geknak en ek het geväl." Du Preez vertel toe hy oomblikke later in staat was om op te staan, het hy sy skok teenoor die voorsitter uitgespreek. "Ek kan dit doen, en ek sal dit doen," het die man glo vir Du Preez gesê toe dié hom daarop wys dat sy optrede heeltemal aanvaarbaar is. "En voor ek kon keer, toe klap hy my weer sodat ek weer teen die grond was." Die polisie is gekontak en Du Preez moes vir mediese behandeling geneem word. "Ek het steeds 'n suisig in my ore en erghe hoofpyn wat net nie wil wyk nie," het hy in 'n onderhoude met Rustenburg Herald vertel.

Restless Legs

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - RLS (Restless Leg Syndrome) - Most people feel "restless legs" as cramps that is starting in a lessened state of sleep.

The beginning of the cramp wakes them up to a greater or lesser degree. In that half-asleep state they will then adjust their sleeping position and move the leg trying to avoid the cramp, only to have it start to cramp again needing another adjustment; on and on.

If you or someone you love is suffering this agonizing condition, relief could be at hand. Your brain is the central communication system of your body. Think of it as a switchboard. And, just as a switchboard operator answers the phone and directs a call, messages are sent from your brain to specific organs, glands, muscles and limbs. 



Who gets paid and who doesn't?

Rustenburg consumers were alerted beyond imagination when it was announced by means of an Eskom advertisement in Rustenburg Herald (19 June 2020) that the public should brace itself for a series of unplanned (but indeed scheduled) power interruptions in coming weeks. These interruptions according to the advertisement were as a result of the Rustenburg Municipality being in arrears on meeting its financial obligations towards Eskom.

In a statement issued only hours later, the Rustenburg Municipality responded by vehemently denying that it was in arrears according to its own records. Consumers also heard that the Municipality was in fact in close contact with the power utility and that the issues would soon be resolved. In turn Eskom gave Rustenburg Herald that assurance that electricity would not be interrupted if the Rustenburg Municipality could submit a payment agreement that would be acceptable to the Eskom Management.

The question at hand obviously was: Why did the Municipality take the trouble to respond by means of a public statement in

which it was denying all allegations when a simple proof of its payment records would suffice? What does this tell us about the administration of our world class city or is there something else at play here?

The bigger picture surrounding Rustenburg Municipality's alleged arrears however seems not that simple. We understand that there are certain past agreements between Eskom and the Municipality of which the general public are not aware of and which could have a profound effect on the turn out of events. In short thus: No, apparently possible power interruptions are still not out of the question - not by a mile!

If the Rustenburg Municipality declares a new dispute with Eskom regarding its payment obligations (which is quite standard protocol) and it loses the dispute, the Rustenburg community could be in deep water. Now the question remains: What is the point of paying your monthly municipal accounts only to be cut from the national electricity grid by Eskom and would it necessarily be "illegal" to withhold your payment - at least until the issue is resolved?


Lions front-row duo extend contracts
