Minerals Council takes stand

- Rustenburg residents were shocked to learn that government was discussing the possibility of a return to Covid-19 Level 4 lockdown as a result of a hike in infections reputably reported at Rustenburg and Matlosana (Klerksdorp) mining communities recently.

The Minerals Council South Africa would like to take issue with a narrative that appears to be developing in some quarters labelling the mining industry as an "epicentre" of Covid-19. These assertions are not only inaccurate but serve to spread fear amongst mineworkers and the communities in which they reside or come from. It is a mistake to assume that mining is more prone to the spread of the virus than the population as a whole. Many of the cases identified in the mining industry have been identified even though the individuals are asymptomatic or show only mild symptoms. In some of the clusters identified up to 95% of those who tested positive have been asymptomatic and tested only because of effective tracking and tracing systems in place.

Accident claims dad, baby

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - An accident on the N4 near Kroondal took the lives of a young father and a two-month-old baby.

According to capt Elsabé Augoustides, police spokesperson for the Rustenburg police, the accident happened around 18:00 on Sunday (7 June). Klaas Matlala (24), his wife Rosina (31) their children Precious and Kgotsi, their baby Karabo and Klaas' brother, Lottha were travelling on the N4 in their Toyota Yaris when a tyre presumably burst. This caused Klaas to lose control over the vehicle and it capsized and rolled. Klaas and the baby died on the scene, while the rest of the passengers were taken to a local hospital for treatment. Capt Augoustides told Rustenburg Herald that a case of culpable homicide is being investigated.

Rioolgasse eis glo vier

RUSTENBURG HERALD - KOSTER - Vier mans is verlede week in dié dorp dood nadat hul vermoedelik deur giftige gasse in 'n rioolgat oorval is.

Die vier mans - Cornelius "Connie" Cloete (51), Lennox Thabeni (56), Mpho Melatho (25) en Johannes "Oom Chris Yskas" Pretorius (74) - het volgens gemeenskapslede besluit om op eie stoom 'n verstoppe rioolgat in Brookstraat te ontblok. Die gemeenskap kla blybaar al bitter lank oor dié betrokke straat - en oor die situasie befondende riol in die dorp in die algemeen.

"Dit is al 'n jare lange probleem. Maar die munisipaliteit is doof vir die pleidooie van die inwoners en om dié rede het mense desperaat begin raak. En nou het dit noodlottige gevolge gehad." Só sê Carel van Heerden, voorsitter van die Kgetlengrivier Belastingbetalersvereniging. Inwoners het Vrydagmiddag omstreeks 14:00 alarm gemaak dat die vier in die rioolgat af is en nog nie weer uitgekom het nie. Die brandweer is gekontak, maar hulle het glo nie die nodige toerusting gehad vir 'n reddingspoging nie. 'n Gemeenskapslid het toe 'n harnas beskikbaar gestel en 'n inwoner is daarmee, asook 'n suurstogmasker van die brandweer, met 'n tou in die gat af om die vier uit te haal. Toe hy hul kry, was al vier bewusteloos en het bo-op mekaar gelê.

Twee van die mans, Connie Cloete en Lennox Thabeni, was reeds dood toe hul weer die oppervlak bereik en Mpho Melatho en Chris Pretorius is na hospitale afgevoer vir behandeling. Melatho is Vrydagaand in 'n hospitaal in Koster oorlede terwyl Pretorius Sondag in 'n Rustenburgse hospitaal beswyk het. Rustenburg Herald het die Kgetlengriviermunisipaliteit vir kommentaar genader, maar teen druktyd nog geen terugvoer ontvang nie. Die Noordwes Polisie se kapt Aafje Botma het bevestig dat 'n geregtelike ondersoek na die voorval geloods is.

The township, which is a stone throw away from Karlien Park has not been formally electrified and so residents allegedly resorted to connecting electricity illegally.

On Wednesday (3 June), Rustenburg Local Municipality's Public Safety disconnected the illegal connections in the informal settlement and this was followed by a large scale protest from the informal settlers, who burned tyres and threw stones, resulting in many house's windows and some of the properties damaged.

Several transformers in the vicinity were also vandalised Residents of Karlien Park who spoke to the Rustenburg Herald on Thursday (4 June) said they were caught in the crossfire between protestors and law enforcement officials, when protestors started throwing stones into their yards and causing damage to their property.

"My windows are now damaged, who will help me fix them, who will take responsibility for the damages?"

one resident said. When the Rustenburg Herald was at the scene, broken house windows in the neighbourhood could be seen.

Police investigations continue.



Don't sleep on RLM budget - it's going to cost you dearly

RUSTENBURG - The Council of Rustenburg Local Municipality approved a budget on 22 May 2020 for consideration by residents and communities within the area of jurisdiction of the municipality.

Written submissions can be made up to 10h00 on Friday the 12th of June which should, in law, be duly considered by Council. The Rustenburg Herald saw input by Munsolve CC wherein critical concerns were raised on the accuracy of the tabled budget. According to Rootman from Munsolve CC, the errors indicate that the budget is indeed nothing but a mere "draft", whereas Council should have tabled an Annual Budget that they intend implementing. Rootman is inter alia raising concerns about tariff increases that seems not to be accommodated correctly in the tabled budget. Munsolve CC is advocating that RLM, in this time of COVID-19, embrace the limitations placed via social distancing and publish on RLM's Facebook page and website all submissions received. It would enable members from different communities to see the concerns raised by other and enhance the required public participation process. By disclosing the input received, so Rootman argues, transparency, a cornerstone of local democracy, is enhanced. The Rustenburg Herald wants to encourage readers to scrutinize the budget on the RLM website at www.rustenburg.gov.za. For ease of reference, you are reminded that the proposed tariffs were published in the Herald of last week. It can still be viewed on our website from page 19 of last week's issue. We are inundated during the year with complaints about tariffs and service delivery. Now is the time to give your input on the budget and IDP. The deadline for submissions has been set at 10h00 on 12 June 2020. Use your constitutional right to partake in local affairs.

Mantashe must say about diesel crisis

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - Diesel has been in short supply across the country for the last three weeks.

This is despite unequivocal assurances from the Minister of Mineral Resources and Energy, Gwede Mantashe, and senior officials in the Department of Mineral Resources and Energy, that there is no crisis.

Some two weeks ago the Minister stated that the supply shortfall, which arose because a number of refineries shut down production during the lockdown, would be over by the end of May. Fuel wholesalers report that they have been informed by certain refineries that this situation is likely to continue until at least mid-June. A snap poll conducted by Grain SA indicates that roughly 30% of their members are unable to obtain bulk supplies of diesel.

This has huge consequences for South Africa's farmers, many of whom are in the middle of their annual harvest season. Another sector that is significantly affected

is that of long-distance trucking – a vital component in ensuring South Africa's food security. As mines ramp up production, and the economy gradually opens, more demand will be placed on limited diesel stocks, and any shortfall in supply will negatively impact the ability of businesses to restart and recover their operations. Currently the Strategic Fuel Fund, the custodian of South Africa's Strategic Fuel Reserve, has only six useable tanks out of 45, and only two of those are actually used for strategic reserves. The Draft Strategic Stocks policy, which required that fuel wholesalers and refineries hold 14 days of refined reserves, was apparently never enacted or enforced - this means that the country essentially does not have any reserve that is readily accessible at short notice.

Renew vehicle licences at Post Office

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - Motorists and fleet-owners, whose car licenses expired during the lockdown, can skip the long queues at the Traffic Department by renewing them at their local Post Office during level 3.

According to the Post Office's spokesperson, Johan Kruger, the service has resumed at all Post Office branches that offer it. He reminded people to carry their identity document and that both cash and card payments are accepted. However, motorists are advised to avoid the period between 4th and 7th of every month, as branches are usually packed with South African Social Security Agency (SASSA) customers.

New guidelines for handling waste

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - The Rustenburg Local Municipality appeals to the public to be responsible and adhere to the guidelines before placing waste outside for kerbside removal.

The guidelines include the following:

- That all waste items that have been in contact with individuals that are confirmed or suspected cases of COVID-19 (e.g. used tissues, disposable cleaning cloths, gloves, masks, etc.) are disposed of securely within a refuse plastic bag, separate from the rest of the household's refuse.
- When full, this special refuse plastic bag should then be placed in a second black refuse plastic bag (double bag) and tied to prevent any waste from spilling from the bag.
- Double-bagged refuse bags must be stored separately for five (5) days in direct sun, before being placed outside your home for collection by the Municipality. The safest option would be to store bags for an additional week before domestic waste collection is done. This will ensure that the COVID-19 virus is killed.
- In the case of wheelie bin removal service, residents are reminded to have all personal hygiene and sanitary products double bagged (placed within two small plastic bags) before placing waste inside a bin. Examples of personal hygiene and sanitary products are tissues, used gloves and masks, etc.)
- Residents are requested to please sanitize or wash hands with water and soap for 20 seconds before and after handling wheelie bins or black refuse plastic bags. This measure is to protect both the public and the essential refuse removal teams.
- Residents are requested to sanitise wheelie bin handles and wheelie bin covers.
- Residents are requested to refrain from approaching refuse removal personnel. Please keep a distance of 2m at all times.
- The black refuse plastic bags or wheelie bins can be placed out for kerbside removal after the above mentioned steps have been followed.
- Please put your bags and wheelie bins out for collection, as close as possible to the time of arrival of the waste collection services.
- Please secure the bags in order to ensure that your pets do not have access to the bags to prevent them from tearing the bags or spilling the contents.

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - Die Vuurwapen-lensiëringssproses en die amnestieperiode(s) wat in die laaste jaar twee keer deur die minister van polisie, Bheki Cele, aangekondig is, bly maar 'n kontensieuse saak en vuurwapeneienaars wie se lisenies in die laaste ses maande verval het, sit met 'n reuse probleem!

Rustenburg Herald en AgriPulse het sedert einde verlede maand berig dat die amnestieperiode wat laat verlede jaar deur die minister aangekondig is en tot einde Mei 2020 sou geld, waarskynlik verleng sou word in die lig van die massiewe oponthoud weens Covid-19. Minister Cele het enkele dae voor die verstryking van bogenoemde amnestiydperk (1 Desember 2019 tot 31 Mei 2020) aangekondig dat die ministerie tale versoek ontvang het waarin daar gevra is vir die verlenging van die amnestiydperk. Dié versoek isoorweeg en Cele het aangekondig dat hy van plan was om by die parlement aansoek te doen vir 'n tweede verlenging van ses maande om die publiek wat weens Covid-19 prakties gespore gestrand was, te akkommodeer. Ditblyk egter nou dat Cele se aansoek nie deur die parlement goedgekeur is nie omdat daar volgens wetgewing nie 'n amnestieperiode terugwerkend aangekondig kan word nie. Die implikasie is dat GEEN amnestie tans van krag is nie en dat ongelensiëerde vuurwapeneienaars met 'n dilemma sit. Die SAP se portefeuilekomitee het egter 'n aanbeveling gemaak dat daar 'n nuwe amnestiydperk oorweeg word wat van 31 Augustus 2020 tot

31 Januarie 2021 van krag sal wees. Dit moet egter nog deur die parlement goedgekeur word.

Wat die verdere implikasie gaan wees van wapeneienaars wie se lisenies reeds tydens die onlangse amnestieperiode verval het en wat op 'n verlenging van die amnestie gehoop het, weet nutter alleen aangesien die enigste logiese vertolking hiervan

beteken dat dié vuurwapeneienaars "onwettig" in besit van hul wapens is en volgens die aanvanklike klosules vir die volgende ses maande nie van vrywaring teen vervolging indien hulle hierdie wapens sou inhandig al dan nie, gevrywaar kan wees nie. Daar word intussen gehoop op 'n vergunning van die minister en die SAP teen die agtergrond van Covid-19.

It's hands up for unlicensed firearm owners

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - Owners of firearms that have expired earlier or during the last six months of amnesty (1 December 2019 - 31 May 2020) and who have hoped for an extension of the amnesty period due to the interruption of Covid-19 are in for a shock.

In spite of an announcement by the Minister of Police, Bheki Cele only days to 31 May 2020 in which he had indicated that his department would approach Parliament with yet another request for an extension of amnesty, (and expectations that this would be granted for the period 1 June 2020 to 30 November 2020) the request was denied. The implication for firearm owners whose licences have expired during or even well before Covid-19, is that they currently are in fact illegal owners of firearms and arguably, that they cannot be certain of exemption against prosecution when or whether these "illegal" firearms are handed in to the police or not. The reason for the second request by Cele being

denied, was the fact that according to the Portfolio Committee of Police who file the application, a request for an extension of an amnesty period could in terms of law not be granted retrospectively. The Portfolio Committee however continued to announce that it is considering a second amnesty period of 31 August 2020 to 31 January 2021 which still has to be approved by Parliament. What the true implications are for firearm owners who currently are practically nothing but unlicensed, is not known. The firearm fraternity is however holding thumbs for an extraordinary grant or similar "leave" for unlicensed owners to continue unchanged until the expiry of the latest amnesty period.

Property valuation objections still on hold

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - Property owners who were contemplating lodging objections against the recently "tabled" property valuation roll in which many properties are believed to be exorbitantly inflated, seem to have the luxury of postponing their objections for the interim period on their side.

Following numerous complaints with regard to the Valuation Roll and subsequently, an objection with the Municipal Manager by Council in terms of Section 50(4) of the Municipal Property Rates Act (MPRA) Council

resolved to suspend the period for objections pending the outcome of the process to be undertaken by the Municipal Manager.

In a media statement issued by the Rustenburg Municipality recently,

"a key resolution with regard to the formation of a Multi-party Committee with representation from each party in Council and Troika (Executive Mayor, Council Speaker and Single Whip)" was highlighted. An extension of the validity of the current existing valuation roll would be requested from the North West MEC for Local Government in terms of the MPRA, the statement concluded.

is. Vir eienaars van eiendom is 'n billike waardasie van sy eiendom kardinaal, aangesien dit die bedrag is waarvolgens die eienaar se maandelikse munisipale erfbelasting bereken word.

Die munisipale veelparty-komitee sal uit 'naangewese verteenwoordiger van elke politieke party op die Raad

asook die uitvoerende burgemeester, die speaker en die hoofsweep bestaan. In terme van die MPRA (Municipal Property Rates Act) het die plaaslike munisipaliteit nie die bevoegdheid om die munisipale waardasierol te wysig of aan te pas nie. Daar is voorts besluit dat die LUR vir plaaslike regering in Noordwes genader sou word met die versoek dat die bestaande (vorige) waardasierol wat die afgelope vyf jaar van krag was, vir minstens die volgende 12 maande gehandhaaf word ten einde alle rolspelers die geleenthed te gun om oor die pad vorentoe te besin.



In hierdie jongste weergawe van Standpunt wil ons vir 'n wyle afdwaal van Covid-19 en hoe hierdie ingrypende gebeurtenis ons lewens vir 'n baie lang tyd gaan verander. Ons sê ook nie dat daar gepoog moet word om gevangenes deur middel van sinnelose hande-arbeid te rehabiliteer nie of dat hulle met swepe geslaan en soos slawe-arbeiders behandel moet word nie.

Ons sê bloot dat daar ongetwyfeld baie werk na Covid-19 sal wag. Hoekom nie hierdie potensieel-produktiewe arbeidsmag benut om ons land vinniger op die pad na herstel te plaas nie?

Now is not the time for pity

In this latest edition of Viewpoint and just for a moment, we wish to dwell away from Covid-19 and its disastrous effects to our country and its people. Except perhaps for a brief reference to it: In the light of Covid-19 the Department of Correctional Services has announced that a significant number of prisoners who are serving time for less serious crimes would be released on parole much earlier to decrease the chances of infections in SA prisons as a result of the pandemic. Yes, we know that not everyone would approve of the principle. Those who fell victim to crime probably won't while thousands of families who have fathers, mothers, sons and daughters in prison would undeniable approve. This immediately led us to reconsider an issue that has been in discussion time and time again in the past. If we consider the tragic neglect and decline of South African infrastructure over the past two decades, everyone will tell you that our country urgently needs the repair of thousands of kilometers of roads, bridges and the like. Similarly, our country is in desperate need of hospitals, clinics, schools and important

public infrastructure. If we think about the pollution of our rivers, dams and water installations around the country. What about the backlog in the Reconstruction and Development Programme with millions of people still living in informal settlements? What about food production at large in general? No, not for a moment do we propose taking government contracts from responsible and qualified contractors, or taking food production from the hands of the SA farming community. No we also do not propose chastising these people with whips or working them to death in labour camps or similar. What we simply propose, is that this country will be in bad shape and desperate need of services, infrastructure and material after Covid-19. With the Chinese government apparently willing to spend millions in our country, especially after Covid-19, the biggest shortage will without doubt be affordable labour. Are we then wrong to suggest putting thousands of SA prisoners to good use and at the same time equipping them with valuable skills which will stand them in good stead after their release?



INTERRUPTION OF BULK ELECTRICITY SUPPLY TO RUSTENBURG LOCAL MUNICIPALITY.

Eskom hereby notifies all parties who are likely to be materially and adversely affected by its intention to interrupt bulk supply to Rustenburg Local Municipality on 30 July 2020 and continuing indefinitely.

Rustenburg Local Municipality is currently indebted to Eskom in the amount of R 144 939 135.26 (One hundred and forty four million nine hundred and thirty nine thousand one hundred and thirty five rand and twenty six cents). Part of this debt has been outstanding and in escalation since August 2018 ("the electricity debt").

Eskom Holdings SOC Ltd ("Eskom") is under a statutory obligation to generate and supply electricity to the municipalities nationally on a financial sustainable basis.

Rustenburg Local Municipality's breach of its payment obligation to Eskom undermines and placed in jeopardy Eskom's ability to continue the national supply of electricity on a financial sustainable basis.

In terms of both the provisions of the Electricity Regulation Act 4 of 2006 and supply agreements with Rustenburg Local Municipality, Eskom is entitled to disconnect the supply of electricity of defaulting municipalities of which Rustenburg Local Municipality is one, on account of non-payment of electricity debt.

In order to protect the national interest in the sustainability of electricity supply, it has become necessary for Eskom to exercise its right to disconnect the supply of electricity to Rustenburg Local Municipality.

Eskom recognizes that the indefinite disconnection of electricity supply may cause undue hardship to consumers and members of the community, and may adversely affect the delivery of other services.

In the view of this, Eskom is contemplating a regulated interruption of electricity supply as opposed to an outright disconnection. The contemplated regulated interruption will allow members of the community and consumers the opportunity to make alternative arrangements for the scheduled periods of interruption.

The contemplated interruption of electricity supply will result in temporary scheduled disconnection at the following times:


