Mboweni's budget lenient on taxation

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - Finance Minister Tito Mboweni has delivered his annual budget speech in the National Assembly on Thursday, 26 February and to the surprise of most South Africans who are used to bad news by this time, quite a consumer friendly Budget 2020 was proposed by the Minister. Great news for tax payers is that all tax payers will receive tax relief of more than the inflation rate.

Tax rates and scales of individuals and special trusts will be as follows:

Taxable income/tax rate

- * 0 to - R205 900 - 18% of taxable income;
- * R205 901 to R321 600 - R37 062 + 26% of taxable income above R205 900;

- * R321 601 to R445 100 - R67 144 + 31% of taxable income above R321 600;

- * R445 101 to R584 200 - R105 429 + 36% of taxable income above R445 100;

- * R584 201 to R744 800 - R155 505 + 39% of taxable income above R584 200;

- * R744 801 to R1 577 300 - R218 139 + 41% of taxable income above R744 800;

- * R1 577 301 and more - R559 464 + 45% of taxable income above R1 577 300.

All rebates will be slightly increased. The primary rebate for tax payers younger than 65 is R14 948, secondary rebates for tax payers of 65

years and older is R8 199 and tertiary rebates for tax payers of 75 and older will be an additional R 736. This will mean tax thresholds will increase to R83 100 for persons of 65 and younger, R128 650 for persons of 65 and older and R143 850 for tax payers of 75 and older.

Tax on dividends and exemptions on interest

Tax on dividends will remain unchanged at 20% - so will exemptions of R23 800 for tax payers younger than 65 and R34 500 for tax payers of 65 years and older.

Capital Gains Tax (CGT)

Inclusion rates of capital gains will remain 40% for natural persons and 80% to companies and trusts. This means the maximum CGT will be charged as follows:

Natural persons and special trusts: 18%;

Companies: 22.4%;

Other trusts: 36%;

Annual exclusions will remain R40 000 and exclusions in case of death R300 000.

Transfer duties

Relieve will be granted on transfer duties with regard to property obtained by any person, (companies, closed corporations and trusts included). The new rates are as follows:

Assessment rates

Value of property/tax rate

- * 0 - R1000 000 - 0% of property value;

- * R1000 001 to R1 375 000 - 3% of value above R1 000 000 but not more than R1 375 000;

- * R1 375 001 to R1 925 000 - R11 250 plus 6% of value above R1 375 000 but not more than R1 925 000;

- * R1 925 001 to R2 475 000 - R44 250 plus 8% of value above R1 925 000 but not more than R2 475 000;

- * R2 475 001 to R11 000 000 - R88 250% plus 11% of value above R2 475 000 but not more than R11 000 000;

Motor vehicle expenses

The deductible fixed cost expenses are slightly decreased but fuel and running costs are increased to keep up with increased fuel tariffs and maintenance costs. In addition the fuel price was adjusted by 25c per litre.

Trusts

No changes were made to taxation of trusts.

Medical tax rebates

Tax rebates for the first two dependents are increased to R319 and for additional dependents to R215. With the introduction of the proposed National Health Insurance plan these rebates will be discontinued.

Retirement funds

No changes were made to single amount

rates at withdrawals of retirements.

A tax payer will be allowed to deduct contributions to retirement funds up to a maximum of 27.5% of reimbursement for tax purposes of taxable income, whichever is larger (excluding retirement fund contributions and severances). Deductions are limited to R350 000.

The changes in foreign exchange will include the review of retirement funds.

Tax free savings accounts: The maximum annual contributions to tax free savings accounts will increase to R36 000 per annum. The rate of Value Added Tax remains unchanged at 15%.

Customs and levies

All those little pleasures in life will cost you more: Examples are:

- * Spirits (alcohol) - an increase of R2.89 per bottle (750 ml);

- * Beer: 8c per can;

- * Wine: 14c per bottle (750 ml);

- * Cigarettes: 74c for a packet of 20;

- * Fuel levies: 16c per l from 1 April;

- * Road Accident Fund contributions - 9c per l

- * Levies on plastic bags: 13c per bag;

Estate duties and donations

Estate duties will be charged at 20% up to estates of R30 million and R25% on value of estates of more than R30 million. Similarly will taxation of gifts and donations of more than R30 million remain unchanged at R25%. Rebates on estate duties and donations remain unchanged. The difference between the officials interest rate and interest on loans from trusts will be subjected to tax on donations.

Rebates on foreign salaries

As from 1 March 2020, any South African working abroad for more than 183 days per year, will receive exemption from tax on the first R1 250 000 of their foreign salaries. All other forms of income will be excluded.

Fibre roll out halted, or has it?

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - Evotel contractors, responsible for the roll out of fibre technology in Rustenburg and consumers as well as the Rustenburg Municipality are tied in a standoff of which the outcome will have to be settled in the Mahikeng Court following outcries and complaints by numerous consumers on the procedures followed by contractors.

Several consumers backed by the Rustenburg Municipality allege that concerns by the public that proper procedures for the roll out of new age technology in recent weeks did not meet modern standards and at the very least, do not remotely meet expectations that have been created, indeed have merit. The main obstacle behind the standoff between the two entities remains the issue of, as has been called "unsightly" overhead poles and cables to be strung throughout the community.

The make matters worse - there is a clear indication that the Rustenburg community is divided on the issue, with many consumers welcoming the fibre technology by any means and in any way possible, with others objecting to ugly tar poles in intervals of every 30 meters or so along countless Rustenburg roads and street corners. A number of community meetings which have been convened by the contractor, did little to resolve the issue and accusations that the contractor did not follow reasonable protocol in terms of its public participation obligations, continued.

The latest development came on Thursday, when, according to a Councillor of the Rustenburg Municipality, an application for a Court interdict to halt the process, was granted by the Mahikeng High Court. "This renders the entire process followed thus far as illegal, naturally, with the contractor at liberty to oppose the matter". The Rustenburg public was subsequently called upon to report the "illegal" continuation of the fibre roll out to the nearest municipal Councillor, Rustenburg Herald was told. This was vehemently denied by an Evotel spokesperson who told Rustenburg Herald that though the RLM has applied for an interdict, this doesn't mean that it has been granted nor served as yet. As far as the Rustenburg Municipality is concerned, the installation of fibre has been

ordered to cease with immediate effect. In addition, the Rustenburg Municipality maintains that there is (at least from within Council ranks) general consensus that the contractor has very little in terms of official approval with way-leave directives provided by Council being the only official documentation.

But Evotel strongly disagrees: "We can confirm that we received an application for an interdict last week and we have responded with an answering affidavit, Mr Albert Oosthuizen, CEO of Evotel said.

"We have furthermore met with the Municipal Manager on 27 February where we tried to find a resolution with him. At the meeting, we suggested several solutions such as a hybrid aerial/trenched solution, but he then suggested that we meet with the Ward Councillors and find a resolution with them first. The MM and Ward Councillors then had a meeting set for 3 March and Evotel requested permission to attend. However, our request was ignored. We were not invited and thus not present at all. Though there are allegations that we have attended, the attendance register clearly shows otherwise. Due to the lack of communication and opportunities to find resolutions and since we had permission from the municipality in hand, we continued to build, at all times within the ambit of the law and per the way-leaves granted by the Municipality", he continued.

"Though we continued to press for an opportunity to meet, all our requests were ignored. We are of the view that it was not necessary for this matter to go to court, as we have always been and still are open for constructive consultation with the municipality. We still very much hope to find an amicable resolution, but sadly the Rustenburg Municipality informed us that it would rather approach the court", Oosthuizen concluded.

Giannacopoulos Group heads to the Labour Court

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - The Giannacopoulos family group, which owns more than 40 stores in Spar Group Limited, has filed review applications in the Labour Court against the Commission for Conciliation Mediation and Arbitration (CCMA). The Commission recently issued eight arbitration awards of almost R12 million against the group.

The awards were issued on 13 February but the Giannacopoulos group only became aware of this event eleven days later by way of a press release published on the website of the Department of Employment and Labour.

The Commissioner of the CCMA, Segokodi Thoka, is the first respondent in the review application. The CCMA and the Director General of the Department of Employment and Labour are the second and third respondents respectively. In the notice of motion to the court the Giannacopoulos group's attorney, Mary Erlank, calls upon the CCMA to show cause why the awards should not be reviewed and corrected, or set aside.

Christos Giannacopoulos, who owns the eight stores in question, states in an affidavit that various items of correspondence regarding the matter were exchanged between Erlank and the CCMA, the last being a letter confirming in detail that all the requirements had been met. No reply was received.

Giannacopoulos says Commissioner Thoka disregarded current legislation by not referring

the matter to an arbitration hearing, especially as there are massive disputes of fact in the compliance orders.

The Department of Employment and Labour was given until 10:00 on Thursday, 3 March, to indicate whether it agreed to stay the execution of the awards. They did not respond and the Giannacopoulos group will soon launch an urgent application in the Labour Court, the group said in a statement.



Unity is Chamber's 2020 focus

RUSTENBURG HERALD - POTCHEFSTROOM - The NW Chamber of Commerce and Industry (NWCoCI) has, at the Annual General Meeting that was held last week, decided to prioritise unity amongst all business people in the province as the only way to improve growth in the North West Province.

Speaking after the meeting, the new Chairman, Nick Setsetse from Mahikeng Chamber of Commerce and Industry, said that unity amongst all business people is the only way to achieve growth in the economy of the NW Province and by doing so, much needed jobs can be created. "The economy of the North West Province is dominated by mining (more than 30% of the provincial economy) followed by manufacturing with 5%, agriculture with between 2-3% and construction also between 2-3%. On the national scale, only the provincial mining and agriculture industries made significant contributions. Yet, the agro-processing industries, tourism, general manufacturing, mineral beneficiation, renewable energy sources, recycling in a green economy, research and development as well as technology are all part of the 9 economic sectors that can contribute significantly to "job-hunger" provincial communities", Setsetse said. "In this regard a conducive environment, in which small concerns

can do business, needs to be created. We need to grow the economies of townships and small dorpies as the past number of years' economic growth in the province was way below an idealistic 6% target required to start addressing the concerning unemployment".

"But for both the Provincial - and Local government needs to engage successfully with businesses in the Province. They also need to be knowledgeable regarding the state of the economies in the townships and small dorpies in the Province", he said. In this regard the NWCoCI is also in the process of setting up Chambers in all of the 18 Municipalities in the Province. "For this to happen speedily, the Chamber would need help from Government at all levels", he said.

TANS GEEN BEVESTIGDE GEVALLE IN NW NIE

Koronavirus: Feite en fiksie

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - Al doen tientalle gerugte die rondte, is daar nie 'n enkele geval van iemand wat positief getoets is vir die Koronavirus in Rustenburg nie - en ook nie in die hele Noordwes nie.

'n 26-jarige vrou van Vryburg is vroeër die week na die Tshepong Hospitaal in Klerksdorp oorgeplaas vir toetsing, maar die toets was negatief.

Teen Dinsdagoggend (10 Maart) was daar sewe bevestigde gevallen in Suid-Afrika - ses van hulle is in Kwa-Zulu Natal, terwyl een in Gauteng. Al sewe dié mense was deel van 'n toergroep wat aan die begin van Maart van Italië af teruggekeer het. Sedert die eerste geval in KZN bekend gemaak is, het 'n boodskap op whatsapp in Rustenburg versprei dat die virus ook nou hier bevestig is. Dit het tot mini-histeria op sosiale media geleid.

"Dit is tragies dat daar mense is wat so desperaat na aandag soek dat hulle bereid is om vrees te saai," het 'n kundige aan Rustenburg Herald gesê en daarop gewys dat 'n vrou wat verlede week sulke gerugte versprei het nou krimineel aangekla word.

Belangrik om te onthou, is dat dié virus geen doodsvonnis is nie; die oorgrote meerderheid wat dit opdoen, herstel vinnig en volkome. Die groot gevaar is vir mense met verswakte immuunstelsels en ander onderliggende siektes.

Die beste raad wat gesondheidskundiges het, is: hande was, hande was, hande was!

Hier is, behalwe handewas, nog 'n paar wenke om die virus op hok te hou:

- Vermy kontak met mense wat lugweginfeksie het.
- Moenie aan jou neus, oë en mond met ongewaste hande vat nie.
- As jy moet hoes, staan so ver as moontlik weg van ander mense. Bedek jou neus en mond met 'n kledingstuk, of jou gebuigde elmboog of 'n sneesdoekie (wat jy daarna onmiddellik weggooi). Was jou hande direk daarna.
- Moenie in die openbaar spoeg nie.
- Maak oppervlakte en voorwerpe wat baie gebruik word gereeld en deeglik skoon.
- Moenie rou, of halfgaar kos van dierlike oorsprong eet nie. Hanteer rou vleis, melk of dierlike organe met sorg om kruisbesmetting te voorkom. Gebruik verskillende snyborde en messe vir rou vleis en ander voedsel. Was jou hande wanneer jy klaar met rou vleis gewerk het en voor jy dan weer aan ander kos raak.



LAAT TOETS JOUVIRDIE NOVEL KORONAVIRUS INDIEN JY:

- Erge, akute respiratoriese infeksie het, wat met koers - of voorafgaande koers - hoes en longontsteking gepaard gaan.
- As jy enigsins siek voel binne 14 dae nadat jy van 'n oorsese vakansie terugkom - veral Wuhan in China se Hubei provinsie of Italië.
- Indien jy moontlik in kontak was met 'n persoon wat COVID-19 onder lede het.
- Indien jy in kontak was met 'n gesondheidswerker wat blootgestel was aan pasiënte met erge, akute respiratoriese infeksie.



30-year sentence for rapist, robber



Die Rustenburg-gemeenskap is in sy jong bestaan (goed, ons weet dit is die tweede oudste dorp in die ou Zuid-Afrikaanse Republiek) vir die soveelste keer nie net op die agterpote nie, maar skynbaar erg verdeel oor die sogenaamde "roll out" van veseltegnologie wat in die afgelope net meer as 'n maand vir groot ongelukkigheid gesorg het. Few residents of our wonderful city could be unaware of numerous municipal challenges facing Rustenburg.

While the conflict between the contractor and the Rustenburg Municipality and its supporters is mounting, the latest issue clearly provides proof of a deeply divided city and people who are ignorant towards an important issue on home turf. And which is more - why events such as public participating meetings should be regarded as so much more than a nuisance, but an invitation to be part of crucial developments in your city and one of the few opportunities to let yourself be heard - come on - it's in your own interest, attend those meetings!








