

# JST Hospital evolves to accommodate large population, addresses problems

**RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG** - If you have been keeping up to date with the Rustenburg Herald you would have seen many articles and letters of residents and patients complaining about the condition of Job Shimankana Tabane Hospital.

Amongst other complaints that were voiced was the shortage of beds, pregnant women sleeping on the floor and ventilation issues to name a few. The Rustenburg Herald recently met up with Mr Abednigo Phalalo Mvula, the new CEO of Job Shimankana Tabane Hospital, who was appointed to the hospital on 1 April 2019. With less than a year in his post, Mr Mvula and his team have been working around the clock to try and resolve the problems experienced by the hospital and try to address all the complaints voiced out by residents of Rustenburg as well as patients.

"As you know the hospital was built

to cater to a small population, and since the population of Rustenburg has grown drastically, we had to put plans into place to mitigate the problem of capacity," said Mvula.

Patients, especially pregnant women could not be operated on, unless there was an emergency, because the ventilation and cooling system did not function properly. But this will be a thing of the past since the hospital is currently busy replacing the worn-out system with the new one, which has cost the hospital about R38 million.

The hospital has filled 261 posts ranging from admin staffs, who are responsible for

helping with the filing process, cleaners, groundsmen, nurses, doctors and Allied Health Workers.

The maternity ward is also being fixed to accommodate pregnant women and sheets were purchased, linen replaced and those that needed to be fixed were fixed. When it comes to staff members, the CEO said that they meet with the staff members on a quarterly basis and in case of emergencies and staff members are encouraged to wear

name tags at all times. In case of complaints, the hospital has a complaints procedure and the complaints are resolved within 25 days according to Mvula. "We are very much aware of the task that lies ahead of us and we will do just about anything to put the hospital in a good position to cater for the growing population of Rustenburg," Mvula concluded. Keep an eye on the Rustenburg Herald for an update on the developments of the projects at the hospital.

## Cheaper fuel: Cheaper food, debt repayments

RUSTENBURG HERALD – RUSTENBURG - Local economists believe South Africans can look forward to cheaper food, and lower debt payments, if low oil prices stick around.

The price of Brent crude oil dropped by as much as 22% last Monday (9 March) due to a falling out between oil-producing nations amid the global impact of the novel coronavirus. The cause was mainly because Russia refused to cut its oil production in order to artificially support oil prices amid lower demand, which saw Saudi Arabia having to cut its crude oil price significantly. By late the following day the price had recovered somewhat, to around \$36 per barrel.

This was the biggest fall since the day US forces launched airstrikes in Iraq in 1991. The petrol price could likely decline by as much as 78c when it is set by the department of energy in April, despite taxes on fuel increasing by 25c, said Hugo Pienaar, chief economist at the Bureau for Economic Research at Stellenbosch University. According to information, the diesel price is set for a 90c price decline.

The lower oil price will be somewhat offset by a weaker rand, he said. "A cheaper fuel price

will likely leave already under pressure South African consumers with additional spending capacity which may marginally help the retail sector," Pienaar told a financial publication, Business Insider, last week. As most of South Africa's food is transported by road, prices should decline in the longer term. "However, South African retailers are already under pressure from a weak consumer market, and therefore relied on food inflation to increase turnover. And as the fuel price negatively affects food inflation, it will lead to lower food inflation growth." If current oil prices stay low, inflation may fall below the South African Reserve Bank (SARB) forecasts and target, which would help build the case for interest rate cuts, FNB Economist Mathodi Matse said. "However, if the SARB feels that the current price

movements are only transitory, they might just decide to look past them and focus on what they assess to be more fundamental forces that are expected to move oil prices going forward," Matse added. The Reserve Bank's internal calculations have already made provision for 50 basis points worth of cut to this year. A lower interest rate will see South Africans pay less interest on their debt. But, the Reserve Bank last week warned that as the country borrows a lot, lower interest rates might reduce its access to money too. The lower oil prices may also provide embattled power utility Eskom – which heavily relies on diesel generation to avoid loadshedding – with some relief, said Investec chief economist Annabel Bishop. "Much will, however, depend on the performance of the rand for what ultimately transpires on the diesel price front," Bishop told the financial publication.



# Lanxess mine considers its options

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - The unprotected strike of the National Union of Metalworkers of South Africa (Numsa) at the LANXESS mine in Rustenburg continues despite the High Court ordering NUMSA on 10 March to comply with the Labour Court interdict.

The interdict gave NUMSA until 18:00 on Friday (13 March) to convince their members to comply with the court order.

According to the High Court order, two members of NUMSA were allowed to engage the unlawful underground occupiers and read the Labour Court order to all strikers with a view to convince them to vacate the mine.

LANXESS regrets the fact that NUMSA did not follow the High Court order. "It is disappointing that they could not convince their members to abide by the court order and vacate the mine premises".

## Empty houses in Rustenburg North illegally occupied



The Rustenburg Herald recently received this photograph and many others, of houses located along the railway at Rustenburg North. According to residents in this area it is alleged that since the houses have been empty for quite some time now, there is a group of people belonging to a well known political party that have reportedly been occupying these houses without following the proper procedures. The Rustenburg Herald will speak with the relevant stakeholders and will report on this once the information is available.

"As a result, LANXESS has no option but to embark on a disciplinary process against its employees that are on strike. NUMSA has been informed about the disciplinary action," a statement said.

LANXESS condemned the violent events of the weekend, when a group of people forcibly gained access to the mine to supply the underground strikers with homemade food. In order to avoid further violence, LANXESS has agreed that NUMSA will provide strikers with ready-made food from an external caterer.

**RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG** - Sub contractors continuing with the roll out of fibre in numerous Rustenburg extensions have been served with notices by the Rustenburg Municipality on Monday morning in which they were officially "warned" that their operations are regarded as "illegal" by the Rustenburg Municipality and that the municipality will not hesitate to impound contractors' machinery and even vehicles should contractors not stop their operations immediately.

After months, the Rustenburg Municipality still maintains that Evotel (or nobody) has official approval to continue with the roll out of fibre.

Monday's action followed in spite of the fact that the application by the Rustenburg Municipality to the Mahikeng High Court to have the fibre roll out halted by a Court Interdict, would only be considered by the High Court on Tuesday this week. According to fibre hopefuls, this turn out of events clearly suggests that the Municipality's actions on Monday could in itself be "irregular" and most definitely premature since it proved that the Court Interdict was in fact not in place since Thursday/Friday last week and throughout the weekend until at least, very early on Tuesday morning, as the Rustenburg Municipality had maintained all along.

It would be an understatement to say that the fibre fight between the Rustenburg Municipality and Evotel

coincided with a huge load of controversy, confusion and contradictory comments in recent weeks. For example: Was it Evotel or the Rustenburg Municipality who had convened at least two "public meetings" of late. Both parties argue that the meetings were convened by the opposition as it seems.

On Monday this week, Martin Coetzee, DA Councillor for Ward 16 who is regarded a principal driver of the campaign against the methodology of the fibre roll out in the city, told Rustenburg Herald that the most recent meeting held at Bergsig Academy was convened by Evotel and that the contractor, noticing the outcry from the public on the fibre process, had in fact decided to call it a day, packed up their sound equipment and left the meeting. In turn Evotel is on record for stating that the meeting was called by the Rustenburg Municipality who at the same time, denied Evotel an opportunity to address the meeting on issues that could have been resolved much sooner.

**Moments before our going to print on Wednesday morning it was announced that verdict on the issue in the Mahikeng High Court was reserved and postponed until Friday, 20 March 2020.**



# Reserve Bank not withdrawing banknotes, coins


RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - The South African Reserve Bank (SARB) has warned the public that it is not withdrawing banknotes and coins due to the Coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak.

This came amid fake news circulating on social media involving a scam claiming that it is "recalling" money from the public.

"It is believed that criminal elements are visiting the homes of members of the public telling them to hand over banknotes in their possession because the banknotes have been contaminated with the Coronavirus," said the SARB. The central bank said the criminal elements carry fake SARB identification and provide false receipts in

lieu of the banknotes "collected" which they purport can be collected from any of the banks. "The SARB has neither withdrawn any banknotes or coins, nor issued any instruction to hand in banknotes or coins that may be contaminated with the COVID-19 virus," the SARB said in a statement.

The SARB said it will not, under any circumstances, send employees or representatives to collect cash from the public.



## Girlfriend strangled to death

RUSTENBURG HERALD - PHOKENG - A 26-year-old man was expected to appear before the Bafokeng Magistrates' Court on Wednesday, (11 March), in connection with the murder of his 22-year-old girlfriend.

The suspect's court appearance came after he was arrested on Monday morning (9 March) at Tlaseng village in Phokeng, outside Rustenburg. According to provincial police spokesperson, Lt/col Amanda Funani, the suspect saw the victim exiting a tavern, accompanied by another man and an argument ensued. It is alleged that on their way home the suspect strangled the victim with his bare hands. Further allegations states that when the suspect saw that the victim was unconscious, he fled the scene. The victim was declared dead on the scene by personnel from Emergency Rescue Services. The suspect was handed over to the police by Tlaseng Community, after assisting the police in their search shortly after the incident. This however is not the only domestic violence related case that was reported at Phokeng according to Funani.

Earlier on 2 January 2020 in a separate incident, a 37-year-old man was arrested after killing a 15-year-old victim and dumping her body in the bushes. It is alleged that the 15-year-old opened a case of rape against the suspect last year December.

In another unrelated incident, a 43-year-old was arrested in February this year for murdering his 40-year-old girlfriend in Tlaseng village. According to the information received the suspect also strangled his girlfriend to death after he saw her talking to another man. The North West Provincial Commissioner, Lieutenant General Sello Kwna, thanked the community of Tlaseng for their support and assistance in searching for the suspect. He condemned the incident in the strongest possible terms and said the police will work hard in order to ensure successful prosecution.




### Is ons gereed vir Korona?




