Rustenburg “law man” goes on uncontrolled rant at shopping centre

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - A video of a “well-known”, prominent man in Rustenburg who seems to be involved in a serious scuffle with an unknown man at the Tuscany Shopping Centre has spread like wildfire on social media. In the video, the man who is quite well-known in the Rustenburg area, can be seen verbally abusing an “adversary” as being a foreigner who has no rights in the country.

The exact cause of the prolonged rant is unknown but it is believed that the man was reprimanded by a customer at the shopping centre for parking his silver Aston Martin in a inconsiderate way without any respect shown to fellow users of the parking area at the shopping centre. Apparently the man regularly introduces himself as an advocate/lawyer specialising in Labour Law. Witnesses on social media responded that the entire issue could have been easily prevented and that the man dressed in a black suit and pink shirt could have simply apologised and moved his vehicle but instead he chose to verbally attack a fellow customer who has clearly shown admirable restraint and quality of character. The incident has sparked untold comment in the social media fraternity. According to a Rustenburg lawyer the incident was soon after reported to the Human Rights Commission. Keep watching Rustenburg Herald as more information is likely to unfold.





Food Town Hyper in Tlhabane robbed


RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG- On Saturday (22 February) an armed robbery took place at Food Town Hyper in Tlhabane during the day.

According to Sgt Ofentse Mokgadi, police spokesperson in Rustenburg, six suspects armed with pistols held the staff and customers at the shop at gunpoint. Two stood at the doors and the others took money from the cashiers. Through the help of the public, the suspects were traced to Sunrise View. The driver of the getaway vehicle was arrested and was found in possession of an illegal firearm that was robbed in Mpumalanga early this year. Through preliminary investigations, the getaway vehicle was discovered

to have been stolen in Hartbeespoort Dam. The suspect appeared in the Rustenburg Magistrates Court on Monday (24 February) for possession of firearm and stolen motor vehicle. On 26 February he appeared at the Bafokeng Regional Court for business robbery as he was positively linked to the business robbery in Tlhabane.

The police are requesting anyone with information that can lead to the arrest of the other five suspects to contact the investigating officer, D/ Cst Kabelo Sekanka on 073 347 1919.

Rapist gets eight life sentences

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - North West Provincial Commissioner, Lt Genl Sello Kwen, welcomed the sentencing of eight life imprisonments and 25 years, handed down by Bafokeng Magistrate Regional Court in Tlhabane, to Matsile Tidimalo Pasca (35), for multiple rapes committed in 2014.

According to Provincial Police Spokesperson, Lt Col Pelonomi Makau, in the first incident on Sunday (21 March. 2014) at 01:30, two ladies, aged 18 and 19, were hitchhiking to Phokeng. He convinced them to join him on foot as he was going the same direction as them. He further assured them they need not to worry as he was in possession of a firearm. Once on their way he threatened them with that firearm in his possession, took them to a nearby park in Bester, Tlhabane, and raped both of them numerous times at gunpoint. The following day, Monday (22 March, 2014), he repeated the same demeanour with two other ladies, aged 18 and 22 years. In both incidents he also robbed the victims of their personal belongings. Matsile managed to evade arrest, but good investigation done by Capt Mokgatthe Mokgatthe of the Rustenburg FCS, paid off when he was arrested in September 2014. He was not granted bail by Court and was in custody ever since his arrest. On Wednesday (26 February) Matsile was sentenced after being found guilty on 10 counts of rape and two counts of armed robbery with aggravating circumstances. He was sentenced to eight life imprisonment plus 25 years. The sentence will run concurrently.

Speeding car leaves two dead, two in hospital in Rustenburg

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG -Two children were left dead while their mother and sibling are in critical condition in the hospital after they were hit by a speeding car on Sunday afternoon (1 March) at the corner of Heystek and Kerk Street in Rustenburg.

According to Sgt Ofentse Mokgadi, police spokesperson in Rustenburg it is alleged that the mother and her three children aged five, nine and 13-years-old were crossing the intersection when a silver Kia hit them.

The 5-year-old, and the 9-year-old died instantly while the 13-year-old and the mother are in critical condition in hospital.

A case of culpable homicide was registered with the police in Rustenburg.

The driver was arrested and was later released on warning.

Geelhoutpark wéér dae sonder water

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - Inwoners van Geelhoutpark is kwaad nadat hul al vir sowat 'n week byna nie 'n druppel water in hul huise se krane het nie.

"Dit is heeltemal onaanvaarbaar. Bly ons in 'n stad? Of bly ons iewers in die middel van nêrens waar die beskawing nog nie opgedaag het nie? Ons is vir dae sonder water en die Rustenburg Munisipaliteit het geen antwoorde oor hoekom dit nou wéér met ons gebeur nie," het een inwoner aan Rustenburg Herald gesê. Sy voeg by dat

daar bloot gesê word dat die watertoevoer na huise toegedraai is om Geelhoutpark reservoir se watervlak te verhoog. "Maar dit is telkens die verskoning. Hoekom word dit toegelaat dat die reservoir leeg loop?" wil sy weet. Op Dinsdag (3 Maart) het Rustenburg Herald verneem dat daar boonop ook 'n waterpyp gebars het naby Pendoring en

Santolina - dit het ook glo die vlak van die reservoir beïnvloed. Inwoners van Ooseinde het ook sedert die naweek sonder water gesit. Dié was blykbaar as gevolg van 'n voertuig wat 'n brandkraan op die hoek van Zendeling - en Eskomstrate Saterdag nag getref het en 'n massiewe waterlek veroorsaak het. Teen Dinsdagoggend (3 Maart) het raadslid Martha Lerm haar misnoë uitgespreek omdat die munisipaliteit se waterwerkspan blykbaar

Habitual thief taken off the streets

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - In a continued effort to clamp down on property crimes, the Rustenburg Magistrates Court sentenced Boisy Letsholo (29) to four years imprisonment for house breaking and robbery with intent to steal and four counts of house breaking on Wednesday (26 February).

According to Rustenburg Cluster Police Spokesperson, Sgt Ofentse Mokgadi Letsholo was arrested on 20 February 2017. He was granted bail on 1 March 2017 but later evaded his court appearance and was sentenced to one year in prison. after his release he evaded court appearance again in November 2019. And during this time he committed another crime in Protea Park.

Due to the dedication of the Investigating officer Cst Samuel Ntsholeng Matimbe, Letsholo was arrested again and appeared in Court on 26 February 2020, where he was sentenced to four years imprisonment for his crimes.

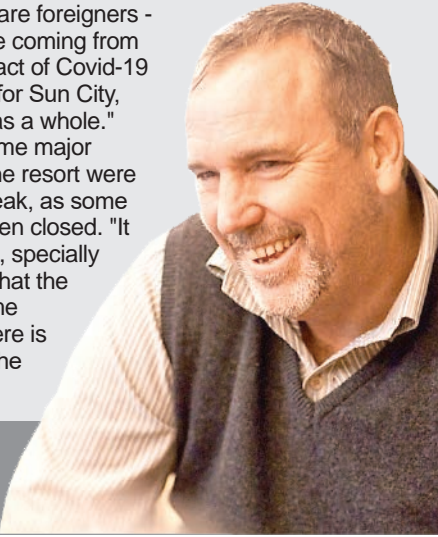


Impact of Covid-19 on tourism

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - The Covid-19 outbreak has had a major impact on global tourism.

Even here, in the Northwest, tourism and manufacturing industries are feeling the pinch. In an interview with CNBC, general manager of Sun City, Brett Hoppé said that a tourist destination like the resort is definitely hurt by less visitors. "Globally, nobody was prepared for the scale and effect of this outbreak," Hoppé said. He added that under normal circumstances, about 32% of Sun City's visitors are foreigners - with a large chunk of these coming from Asian countries. "The impact of Covid-19 is significant. And not just for Sun City, for South African tourism as a whole." Hoppé also added that some major maintenance projects at the resort were also affected by the outbreak, as some factories in China have been closed. "It is a challenge. The upside, specially for domestic travellers, is that the market, for now will become very competitive - and there is benefits for them to reap," he concluded.

Die Suid-Afrikaanse regering se relatief nuwe veldtog teen plastieksakke en plastiese verpakking oor die algemeen is prysenswaardig, maar terselfdertyd 'n skulderkenning dat by verre die oorgrote meerderheid Suid-Afrikaners ongelukkig net nie oor die dissipline, opvoeding en selftrots beskik om rommelstrooiing en omgewingbesoedeling in ons land 'n saak van erns te maak nie.

Ek ken mense (om die waarheid te sê, ek ken sommer baie van hulle) wat meen as jy nou werklik 'n betroubare barometer van iemand se karakter wil hê, moet jy gaan kyk hoe lyk sy motor. Hoewel hierdie vergelyking dalk in baie lande 'n betroubare maatstaf is, weet 'n mens darem nie of dit in ons land altyd so goed werk nie. Ek bedoel, daar is mos maar al te veel mense hier by ons wat in blinknuut, spoggerige en duur motors ry, maar op wie hierdie barometer duidelik nie van toepassing blyk te wees nie. Nee kom ek sê jou, ry so 'n bietjie agter hulle aan, veral as daar eers by die hoenderkoning of burgerplek stilgehou is om kos te koop. Jy sal in baie gevalle nie te veel brandstof hoef uit te ry voordat jy die ruite sien oopgaan en woeps, daar trek die leë koeldrank- (en bierblikkies as jy nie pasop nie) die plastiese, polistireen of kartonverpakking van die eetgoed tot op die sypaadjie, sommer in die straat of waar ook al... So nee, nie veel van 'n betroubare barometer van iemand se karakter nie.

Nee, gaan kyk hoe lyk 'n man se woonplek, sy erf, sy buurt of sommer so "kollektief" soos ons politici deesdae so lief is om te sê - sy omgewing en jy sal weet wie is die mense wat hier woon. 'n Mens hoor en lees dikwels hoe besoekers van die buiteland nie uitgepraat kan raak oor die skoonheid, natuur- en diereprag van ons land nie, maar om met 'n sug af te sluit - "as daar tog net iets aan die skaamtelose rommelstrooiing, besoedeling en traak-my-nie-agtigheid van Suid-Afrikaners oor die algemeen gedoen kon word". En daar moet ons maar ons koppe laat hang - nee, wat ons eie handewerk betref, kan ons nie naastenby dieselfde voortreflikheid as Moeder Natuur en die Vaderhand opeis nie. Geen wonder dat baie van ons primêre riviere, vleilande en skaars waterbronne lankal reeds deur nywerheids- en menslike afval en sommer net ongeërgde besoedeling bederf is nie. Die probleem lê waarskynlik by ons opvoeding. Kinders moet van kleins af geleer word dat Moeder Aarde al is wat ons het en dat elkeen van ons 'n reuse verantwoordelikheid het om deurlopend teen besoedeling en rommelstrooiing te waak. Wat help dit om een of twee keer per jaar in te spring, op te ruim en 'n rivier te probeer rehabiliteer waar die vis en plantlewe lankal die stryd gewonne gegee het en boonop gaan ons maar môre weer voort soos voorheen? Terwyl ons owerhede so geesdriftig is om boetes, tariewe, heffings en hernuwings die gonswoord van die dag te maak, waarom nie daadwerklik optree deur 'n behoorlike boetestelsel vir rommelstrooiing en besoedeling in te stel nie EN dit te polisieer nie?

Pollution, littering our downfall

The South African government's relatively new campaign against plastic bags and packaging in general, is noble and admirable, but at the same time an acknowledgement that by far the most South Africans sadly lack the education, discipline and pride to curb littering and pollution. Desperate appeals on government to recognise the fact that far too many of our people are extremely hesitant to be serious about our environment and the country as a whole, are nothing new. The latest development with regard to the rehabilitation of rivers, dams and scarce water sources are all examples of neglect that has been left unaddressed for far too long.

Rather have a look at where a person lives, look at the yard, at the neighbourhood or "collectively" - the word our politicians love so much lately - the environment. This will tell your more than anything else. One often hears the wonderful comments of foreigners visiting our country complimenting our scenic nature and impressive wildlife. Sadly also, one hears the concerns about the pollution of our environment. These are things that are unheard of in most countries abroad - especially First World countries.

The problem most probably lies with our education. Children should be taught from day one about the importance of caring for our community and the environment. It's of little use to organise a special one day project to rehabilitate rivers, dams, or natural areas just to carry on with ordinary life the following day. How does one rehabilitate dead animals and plants anyway? With local and national authorities being hell bent on speed humps, speed cameras, levies, fees and renewals lately, why not introduce an effective punitive system for transgressors - to date practically everything else has failed, didn't it? There is good money to be made here...

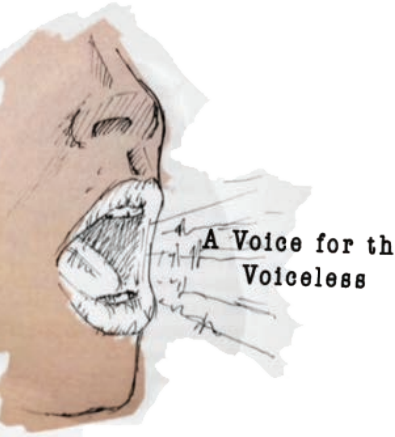

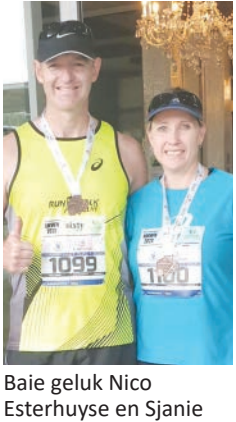

On returning to the field, the South Africans fought back to beat Fiji 29-24 in extra time. In an incredible contest between two of sevens rugby's colossi, Fiji looked set to be cruising to victory after scoring three first-half tries to race to a 19-point lead.

However, as they have demonstrated so often in the past, Neil Powell's side just kept fighting to stay in the contest, running faster, tackling harder. Blitzboks captain Stedman Gans pulled a try back for his team just before half time. Selwyn Davids then had the chance to make it a five-point game when he scored shortly into the second half. However, he missed the conversion and South Africa had it all to do when Fiji veteran Jerry Tuwai reached over to extend their lead to make it a 12-point game with three minutes to go.

Powell decided to turn to his veterans as he brought on Chris Dry off the bench. The forward made an immediate impact as he powered over the line to score. Branco du Preez then came on, replacing Davids after he missed the conversion to Dry's try. The Blitzboks

won possession back from the kick-off and, after Fiji lost a player to a yellow card, Du Preez scored after the hooter to give himself a chance of taking the game into extra time. Despite the fact that the try was wide of the posts, he showed all of his experience to nail the conversion and make it 24-24. It was then that two Blitzbok youngsters combined their skills to win the game for South Africa. Kurt-Lee Arendse carried the ball forward before offloading to 21-year-old Sako Makata, who shrugged off the attentions of a Fiji attacker to score. South Africa, who stunned New Zealand 17-0 in the semi-finals, now trail the Kiwis by just four points on the overall World Sevens Series table.

Sami Valimaki who ironically was outside the top 100 after day one at Al Mouj Golf. A stunning 64 in round three put Valimaki alongside Stone in a six way tie for the lead with 18 holes to play. In difficult, breezy conditions by the coast, both Stone and Valimaki had held the lead on their own during the final day but it was Frenchman Adrien Saddier who set the clubhouse target at 12 under. Stone celebrated wildly as he holed a 20 footer on the last to get to 13 under but there was more drama to come as Valimaki holed from similar range for his own closing gain and a round of 70 to take the contest to extra holes. The duo halved the 18th in pars twice but when Stone sent his second shot crashing into the stand on the third trip and failed to get up and down, a par was enough to hand Valimaki victory. Valimaki had a stunning 2019 on the Pro Golf Tour, winning four times including three consecutive starts at the end of the season. Stone finished sixth at the Challenge Tour Grand Final at Al Mouj Golf in 2015 en route to graduating onto the European Tour and last season at this event he finished in the top 35 despite firing an 80 on Saturday. He finished 103rd on last season's Race to Dubai Rankings Presented by Rolex as he had his first full European Tour season without a win but he is pleased with the work he has been doing despite missing out in Muscat. 'Obviously I'm a little disappointed but I'm really proud with how I played over the last four days,' he said. 'It feels like I'm closer again.'
