'Police stole liquor'?

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - Cases of fraud, housebreaking and theft are being investigated against a number of police officers after an incident at a tavern at Wonderkop, Marikana.

The alleged theft of liquor and tobacco products occurred on 30 April - at the start of the Workers' Day long weekend.

Orshla Lefakane, owner of the LQ Lourah Mantsho Tavern told Rustenburg Herald that her brother was living in the tavern as a way of securing the premises. On 30 April he went out to do some shopping and on his return he saw a vehicle outside the tavern. He also saw people trying to break open the door.

The vehicle had no registration number and her brother immediately thought that the men at the door were thieves. He hid around the corner and called her. She, in turn, called the Marikana Police and then rushed to the tavern. On arrival she was relieved to see police were already on the scene. Her relieve quickly turned to astonishment when she was informed that the people spotted at the door were apparently from Crime Intelligence and that the liquor and tobacco products in the tavern were being confiscated as they were suspected stolen property. "I begged them to let me show them my purchase slips, but no-one wanted to listen. I was told to step aside and shut up, or risk arrest," recounts Lefakane. She says she then asked why she, her husband and her brother were not being arrested if they were suspected of having stolen property in their possession. She was, allegedly, told not to try and tell them how to do their jobs. Police then, again according to Lefakane, started loading crates of liquor into police vehicles. She asked why they were not making an inventory of what they were taking? She was, allegedly, told they know what they are doing.

When the police vehicles left, Lefakane and her husband followed. But at the police station they were prohibited to make notes of the items taken, or to take a photograph of the crates. They were, according to Lefakane threatened that their liquor licence will be taken away if they interfered. "We were told to go and wait in an office to learn when our the court date will be. This was strange for me, as we were not arrested or charged with any crime."

Nobody came to give them any information regarding a court appearance, Lefakane says. The next day they returned to submit purchase slips to prove that the stock was legally theirs and that they bought it before Lockdown. On Monday (4 May) they went to Marikana Police station again after being called told to come and fetch their liquor. Lefakane could not go, because she had no-one to look after her children.

So her husband went on his own. When he arrived at the police station, he immediately called her to inform her that the majority of the stock was now missing. "My husband inquired from the police as to what was happening. He was again threatened that our licence will be revoked if he makes any further accusations."

Northwest Police spokesperson Col Adele Myburg confirmed that cases of fraud, housebreaking and theft was being investigated against the police officers involved.

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Robbery at Kroondal Spar

RUSTENBURG - KROONDAL - The police are investigating a case of business robbery after Kroondal Spar was robbed on Sunday evening (24 May).

According to information received from police spokesperson, Captain Elsabé Augoustides, the suspect fled with an undisclosed amount of cash, Cigarettes as well as designer knives and other valuables. No arrests have been made yet and the police are requesting anyone who might have information that can assist in the investigation to come forward.

Team member at Impala tests positive for Covid-19

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - Management at Rustenburg Impala is confident that the group and its employees are ready and well prepared for any threat from the Covid-19 pandemic since the first case of the disease was detected during a screening at Impala hospital last week.

"Since South Africa was placed on lockdown the Impala team has used the time effectively to strengthen our ability to protect and safeguard employees. We have implemented several health and safety measures and strengthened the capacity of our medical team and facilities and are now more than capable to treat and manage COVID-19 patients", Mark Munroe, Chief Executive of Implats' Rustenburg Operations said. "During the screening process at our hospital on Monday, 18 May, one of our 11 Shaft team members was undergoing his Occupational Medical Clearance where he was screened and tested for COVID-19. The test results have come back as COVID-19 positive and he has been admitted to our isolation facility at the hospital until he fully recovers and is able to return to work. We are in the process of tracing contacts and will conduct further tests where required". Munroe continued. "We are pleased to see that all the procedures and practices we have put into place have helped us as a team to proactively and quickly identify team members who have contracted COVID-19. I urge you all to continue sticking to the rules - that you follow all the precautionary measures to ensure your well-being. Wear a mask at all times, wash your hands regularly and practice social distancing. If at any point you experience a high temperature, dry cough or shortness of breath, please seek medical help immediately", he concluded.

Rustenburg still in the dark on property valuations

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - After weeks of controversy and two urgent meetings by the Rustenburg Municipality on the recently released new Valuation Roll Rustenburg property owners are still in the dark as to the outcome of events.

While Rustenburg property owners were still up in arms on what seems to be grossly inflated property valuations or a terrible mistake, the way forward was unclear on Monday despite the latest meeting on Friday, 22 May, which was concluded with Council's resolution (DA Councillor Pieter Malan's proposal) that the North West MEC for Local Government and Housing would be approached with the request the the existing Valuation Roll (not the controversial roll, but the former) be retained for a period of 12 months until the issue could be resolved to the satisfaction of all parties and roll players. Council also decided that a media release would be issued on at the last Monday/Tuesday this week wherein the status quo would be announced. Meanwhile, property owners were urged to put their objections on hold until the issue was resolved and an official announcement was made by Council. Frans Rootman of Munsolve on the other hand strongly disagreed with the notion that property owners should put their objections on hold based on the fact that he believes that Council does not have the legal authority to set aside the new published general valuation roll. "Council will have to approach the High Court on an urgent basis to review and set the roll aside", Rootman said and recommended that property owners continue to lodge their objections. Council can only approach the MEC to extend the validity of the current roll up to 30 June 2021, as the MEC will not approve extending the valuation roll without the court order. Rootman is also of the opinion that though he totally supports the recommendations submitted by Cllr Pieter Malan, he believes that this was watered down by Council when appointing the Multi-Party Committee, overseeing the position of Council.

Teen arrested for attempted school burglary

RUSTENBURG HERALD - MAKAPANSTAD - On Friday afternoon(22 May), the police, with the assistance of the community and security personnel, arrested a 17-year-old minor, for attempted burglary at a high school in Makapanstad.

According to North West Police Spokesperson, Col. Adèle Myburgh, it is alleged that a security officer was on duty at the school when she heard a strange noise on the roof at approximately 17:30. Upon investigation, she saw three suspicious people on the roof. In no time, the intruders jumped off the roof and fled on foot. With assistance of members of the community, one of the intruders was caught and handed over to the police. The suspect was then processed in terms of the Child Justice Act, 2008 (Act No. 75 of 2008) and released to the care of his parents. Investigations into the matter continues and the police are following up on information about the other two suspects who are also minors.

Transport service centres to open soon

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - Driving Licensing Testing Centres, registering authorities, vehicle testing stations and driving schools will resume their services with effect from 1 June.

Transport Minister Fikile Mbalula said the opening of these services is subject to hygiene, disinfection control, social distancing and sanitizing measures stipulated in the directions. On 20 May, the Minister issued directions related to the commencement of services and extension for the validity period of learner's license, driving license cards, license disks, professional driving permits and registration of motor vehicles. People should not be allowed to enter the premises of these services if they are not wearing a mask that covers the nose and mouth. "All learner's licenses, driving licenses, temporary driver's licenses, motor vehicle license, temporary permits, roadworthy certificates and professional driving permits that expire during the period that commenced from 26 March 2020 are deemed to be valid and their validity period is further extended with 90 days from 1 June 2020," the Minister said.

North West Education ready for reopening of schools

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - The North West Education MEC, Mmaphefo Matsemela declared that the province is ready for the reopening of schools on 1 June 2020.

This announcement follows after a speech by the Minister of the Department of Basic Education, Angie Motshekga who recently declared that schools across the country will reopen on a phase-in approach and will start with Grade 7 and 12.

"When schools reopen, the Grade 7 and 12 are going to have the entire school to themselves. The number of learners per class will now be reduced to 20 and one learner will be allowed to sit per desk, no more two learners per desk. When learners arrive at school, the space will be demarcated for 1.5 meter to deal with social distancing," said MEC Matsemela.

The schools across the country closed on 18 March 2020 to avoid the spread of the Covid-19 virus. To this date schools have been closed for more than two months due to the threat of the Corona Virus which has affected the entire world.

RUSTENBURG HERALD - SONDER WATER - As part of the RLM's leadership oversight visits to various areas within Rustenburg to see the implementation of the service delivery implementation plan, the Executive Mayor of Rustenburg Local Municipality Councilor Mpho Khunou, accompanied by Council Speaker and various MMCs visited Sonder Water, an informal settlement along the R24 ON Wednesday (20 May).

The community, albeit informally established, receives services from the Municipality including water, which was a challenge previously. The community's leadership had an engagement with the RLM's leadership over its service delivery related challenges, which includes the provision of housing. The land on which the community is settled is privately owned, and part of the challenges relating to the roll-out of housing and other infrastructural projects, are as a result of the ownership of the land. The Executive Mayor said the Municipality will do all it can within the confines of the law to assist the community. The Mayor and MMC's were part of a walk-about, which included a graveyard that had been in use since the late 1970's.



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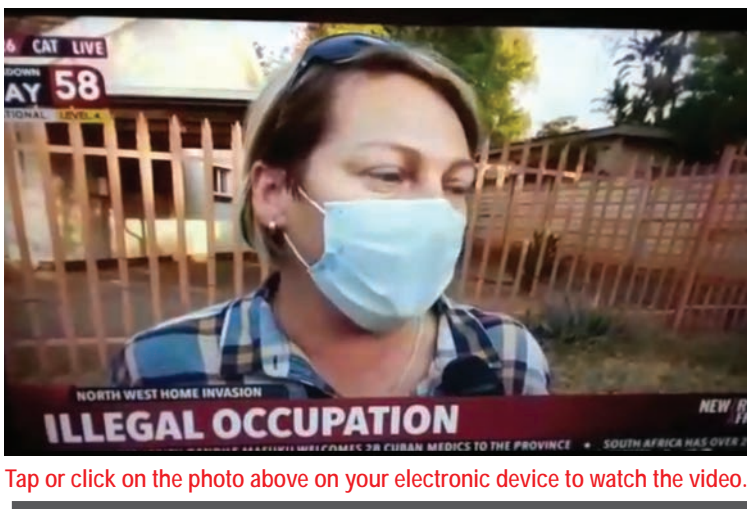
Councillors, municipal workers allegedly fuelling house invasions in Rustenburg

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - In the latest incident that took place in Protea Park regarding alleged house invasions in Rustenburg, it was reported that on Saturday (23 May) a lady who is renting a house was busy putting up curtains when she was called by a man to the gate, who alleged that he was renting the house too.

The man produced a document that he allegedly claimed to be proof of his lease. But it turned out that this was not legit as the lady had a document from the owner of the property that proved that she is the rightful tenant. The question is, since the rightful owner of the property did not give the man the document, then who did?

Reports of people illegally occupying houses belonging to the mines in Rustenburg have been on the rise recently. On Monday (25 May), the Democratic Alliance issued a statement, condemning the incident of house invasions in Rustenburg and urged the mining industry to accelerate their processes in evicting possible house invaders. "The Democratic Alliance (DA) condemns in the strongest terms the illegal invasion and occupation of empty houses in the Rustenburg Local Municipality. To date, more than 75 houses have been invaded since we became aware of the issue in December last year. We have been made aware of the allegations that this illegal activity is being fuelled by ANC and EFF Councillors and possibly municipal employees," DA said.

Lockdown Level 3 - what to expect...

RUSTENBURG HERALD- RUSTENBURG- The president, Cyril Ramaphosa has announced that the country will be moving to alert level 3 from alert level 4 on Monday (1 June). But what does all this mean to us?

Well, the implementation of alert level 3 from the beginning of June will involve the return to operation of most sectors of the economy, subject to observance of strict health protocols and social distancing rules. The opening of the economy and other activities means that more public servants will be called back to work.

Although high risk economic activities will remain prohibited, which include

- * restaurants, bars, taverns - except for delivery or collection of food

- * accommodation

- * domestic air travel - except for business travel, which will be phased in on dates to be announced

- * conferences, events, entertainment and sporting activities

- * personal care services - including hairdressing and beauty services.

People will be able to exercise at any time of the day, provided this is not done in groups and the curfew on the movement of people will be lifted.

Alcohol may be sold for home consumption only under strict conditions, on specified days and for limited hours. Although the sale of tobacco products will remain prohibited, during level 3, due to health risks associated with smoking.

A major announcement came on Tuesday evening (26 May) when the President announced that religious institutions will be allowed to hold gatherings - though this may not exceed 50 people.



RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - Comair – which owns kulula.com and operates British Airways in South Africa – went into business rescue earlier this month, causing some anxiety among the holders of unused tickets.

Last week its business rescue practitioners outlined the options for ticket holders who booked kulula or BA flights for departures between 14 March and 31 October 2020:

If you bought the ticket directly from the airline (your flight ticket number will start with "161"), you have three options -

- * You must make another booking on a Comair-operated flight – and use it by - by 31 October 2021. You will have to pay the difference in rates, fares and/or taxes if needed.

- * You can become a creditor of Comair and try to claim back the value of your unused tickets if the business rescue plan is approved.

* You can give up the booking and the claim – you won't get anything back.

Ticket holders need to make a choice between these options on <https://www.comair.co.za/business-rescue>, by 17 June 2020.

If you don't select an option by 17 June, the value of your booking will remain valid until 31 October 2021. If you booked a ticket via a travel agent or another airline, you have to contact them to directly, the business rescue practitioners said. There is not yet clarity about cancelled airline tickets booked via Vitality on Emirates, Qantas or BA International; or cancelled hotel bookings purchased with Vitality or on kulula.com, on mtbeds or kulula Holidays.

Dodgy hand sanitiser sprayed by stores could cause rashes - even hallucinations

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - Under lockdown, any trip to the shops means loads of hand sanitiser being spritzed on your hands.

However, not all hand sanitisers are created equally - and stores might be relying on dodgy products that could hurt your skin. Some people shared on social media that they have developed rashes and other symptoms after contact with hand sanitisers at store entrances. By law, all business premises must provide hand sanitiser - with at least 70% alcohol content - for use by customers and employees at the entrance to the store. The surge in demand for sanitiser means companies are turning to new manufacturers to provide the products. The industry isn't regulated - and questions are being asked about the ingredients of some of the hand sanitiser aimed for mass use.

A Johannesburg-based manufacturer of medical-grade hand sanitiser said that a number of these new manufacturers are inexperienced. Some products, the

manufacturer says, have no barcodes or contact numbers listed on the packaging, which means you're out of luck if something goes wrong. The key ingredient of safe hand sanitiser is isopropyl - or rubbing alcohol - but some of the hand sanitiser products contain methanol or solvents instead.

You might know methanol better when it's added to alcohol to create methylated spirits - which is what you might be putting on your hands, over, and

over again. Methanol is much cheaper, but very toxic. In fact, a 2018 academic study found that repeated use of methanol-based hand sanitiser caused methanol to be absorbed through the skin, leading to chronic toxicity. This could lead to hallucinations or even death in extreme cases. Skin irritation after use of hand sanitiser doesn't necessarily reflect dodgy ingredients, though.

Rubbing something that is over 60% alcohol - even if it's high-quality alcohol - into your skin is not natural, and skin irritation may occur.



Final year students to return to varsity under level 3

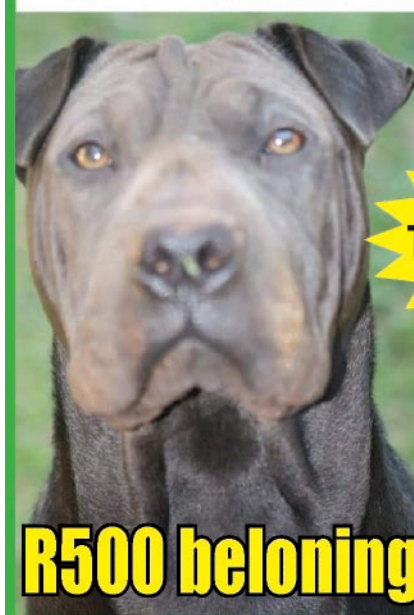
RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - Final year students and those graduating in 2020 may return to campus under level 3 lockdown.

The Minister of Higher Education, Science and Innovation, Dr Blade Nzimande said recently.

Another group of students free to return to university once the country is downgraded from level 4 include final year and postgraduate students who require access to laboratories, technical equipment, data, connectivity and access to the residence and private accommodation.

"Students in all years of study that require clinical training in their programmes provided that the clinical training platforms have sufficient space and can accommodate them while adhering to the safety protocols," he explained.

Your tongue "tells" a story

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - It has become increasingly clear that since the B vitamins occur together in food, no person is deficient in any one B vitamin without being deficient in all of them.

In a general way you can tell how adequate your intake of B vitamins has been by looking at your tongue. It should be moderate in size, an even pink in color, and smooth around the edges without coating or indentations showing where it has rested against your teeth. Interest rate cut by 0,5%

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - With effect from Friday (22 May), the South African Reserve Bank (SARB) has cut the Repurchase (repo) rate by 50 basis points.

SARB Governor Lesetja Kgangago made the announcement on Thursday (21 May) following a Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) meeting. The cut is the third since the advent of COVID-19 in the country in March. In that month, the SARB Monetary Policy Committee cut the repo rate by 100 basis. A second 100 basis points cut was announced in April.

Another huge hike in electricity tariffs

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - Consumers must brace themselves for another hike in electricity tariffs.

In March the National Energy Regulator of SA (Nersa) had approved tariff increases for Eskom.

The increase will be 6.90% for municipalities - and will be implemented on 1 July.

Eskom said recently that, though the low electricity demand during the lockdown gives it an opportunity to maintain its power stations, the lower usage also has negative financial implications.

"While this gives Eskom a much-needed break to carry out much-needed and long overdue maintenance on power stations, it obviously has big financial implications for Eskom and consequences for the consumers of electricity," Eskom spokesperson, Sikonathi Mantshantsha said.

Rustenburg is maar 'n vreemde plekkie wat die irriterende verkeersgewoontes wat padgebruikers betref. Oor die afgelope paar jaar/dekades het soveel slegte/onbedagsame/padvarkagtige gewoontes van Rustenburg se motoriste 'n mens dwars in die bors gestee en dit sou tog soveel aangenamer op ons paaie wees as die meeste van ons motoriste tog net 'n bietjie meer geduld kon beoefen en meer bedagsaam wou optree. (Daar is soveel mense met haastige 4x4-bakkies, spoggerige blink motors en ja, selfs 'n hele paar resieskarre met strepe, nommers en oordadige uitlaatstelsels).

Elk geval - jy ry heel links en heel voor... Mettertyd ry jy jou vas agter 'n baie stadige bus of vragmotor. Agter jou tou 'n ellegange ry motors wat almal in daardie baan van jou verwag om die pad oop te hou. Maar so gou soos jy jou vasloop (teen die bus of lorrie) swaai die een heel agter uit en jaag haastig by die hele tou motors verby tot heel voor - dit is gewoonlik 'n Baie Mooi Wiele (of so-iets) en dit gebeur so vinnig dat jy net eenvoudig nie 'n kans het om agter die lorrie uit te kom en verby te gaan nie. Come on - let's be considerate drivers

Rustenburg is but a strange town with regard to the irritating traffic practices of an alarming number of motorists. Over the past few years/decades, quite a few bad, inconsiderate, straight lousy practices have taken root in our town. Such a pity, traffic conditions on our roads could have been so much more palatable if everyone were prepared to put in a tiny little effort to make things easier for all of us. After all, orderly traffic practices would benefit all of us, right? Municipal property valuations are a joke

I am sure I am one of hundreds if not thousands of readers to fiercely object to the Rustenburg Municipality's rocketing property valuations of late. Rustenburg is without a doubt the only city or town in South Africa where the estimated value of property has risen sharply according to the municipality's evaluators (where do these people come from?) while everyone will tell you that the local property market has in fact declined by between 20% and 30% in recent years.

 - Qt = sum of design capacities of all the waste water treatment works of the Rustenburg Local Municipality in m3/month

Kc = $\frac{COD_i}{COD_t}$

Where: CODi = industry sewage COD
CODt = target COD as published in **Schedule A** in the Bylaws in mg/l
The ratio(Kc) is the larger of 1 or the actual ratio

Kn = $\frac{TKN_i}{TKN_t}$

Where: TKNi = the industry TKN
TKNt = target TKN as published in **Schedule A** in the Bylaws in mg/l
The ratio(Kn) is the larger of 1 or the actual ratio

Kp = $\frac{P_i}{P_t}$

Where: Pi = Phosphate of industry in mg/l
Pt = target Phosphate as published in **Schedule A** in these Bylaws in mg/l
The ratio(Kp) is the larger of 1 or the actual ratio.

- (a) The factor of 0,3 represents the “fixed portion” of the costs. This is independent of the strength (or make-up of the sewage) and also deals with the conveyance costs.
- (b) The above formula is only applicable for the treatment of compliant effluent. If any constituent (heavy metals, any toxic substances etc.) exceeds the approved values, the municipality may introduce any of the following steps:
- i. Refuse to accept the effluent
 - ii. Impose a fine on the industry
 - iii. Insist on pre-treatment by the industry to render the effluent compliant prior to discharge to the municipal system.
- (c) Fines for contravening the allowable limits of constituents in industrial effluents.
- (d) The municipality sells treated sewage effluent to the mines as process water. There is stringent quality criteria associated with this and the mines may refuse to accept sub-standard effluent. In this case the municipality must provide them with potable water at no incremental cost. The one major concern is fats and oils in the effluent as that impact negatively on the mines processes.
- (e) The municipality will thus, in particular, enforce the fat and oil standards rigorously.
- (f) The fines will be implemented as follows:
- i. First written warning. No fine
 - ii. Second contravention R10 000.00 fine regardless of quantity or quality
 - iii. Subsequent contraventions:
 - Spot fines of the larger of R 10 000 or a flow related minimum fine of R5 per m³ or as per written approval
 - Refuse to accept the effluent

If, for whatever reason, the Service rejects an application for any certificate of registration, certificate of fitness or any permit, the applicant must, within 14 days (excluding weekends and public holidays) of the date of rejection, take corrective steps to ensure that the document in question is issued at no additional cost, failing which the applicant must pay the prescribed fees again. 5. (a) The tariff for premises that are liable to registration in respect of paragraph 1(2) or (3), or a combination of them, will be a single fee of R700,00, irrespective of the combination of items: Provided that such combination applies to one premises and is under the same control. (b) If there are different divisions and/or affiliates within a business and/or company situated on the same premises but each division and/or affiliate is managed separately, each division and/or affiliate is liable to registration separately. i. All monies are payable in advance. ii. All fees are also applicable to Council. 6. All relevant application forms are available at the Emergency Services Department (Fire Brigade Services) and must be completed in full and where applicable, signed properly. 7. If certificates and/or spray/transport permits are refused, the applicant must take remedial steps within 14 days in order for the re-inspection to be free of charge and to ensure the issuing of the relevant registration certificate or permit. Failing this, the prescribed tariffs will again be payable in full.
