

**Voman admits to brutal** murder of husband

> Police and **Forensic** team exhuming the body parts from different closed pit toilets.

RUSTENBURG HERALD- LEDIG - On Monday, (23 August), 42-year-old Nancy Majonhi appeared before the Mogwase Magistrates' Court for murder after admitting to brutally killing her husband, Prosper Chipungare in 2015.

The accused was remanded in custody until Thursday (26 August) for further investigation. According to Sergeant Ofentse Mokgadi,

Rustenburg Cluster police spokesperson, it is alleged that the suspect was staying with her her husband (now deceased) at a rented room in Ledig near Sun City in 2015 when they had a fight in which she hit Prosper with a hammer. He lost consciousness.

The accused then continued to assault her husband with a spade before further dissecting the body and threw the parts into three different pit toilets.

After finishing and cleaning her trail, she went to Sun City police and reported that her husband was missing before she went back to Zimbabwe where she confessed to her family and in-laws earlier this month August 2021.

It was then arranged by both families to come to South Africa where she handed herself over to the police.

### Alleged shooting incident in the Rustenburg CBD

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - The Provincial Commissioner of North West, Lieutenant General Sello Kwena has ordered a full investigation into an incident in which a man was fatally wounded while three others escaped with serious injuries, when an unknown gunman fired shots on Thursday afternoon, (19 August) in Rustenburg.

According to Brigadier Sabata Mokgwabone, provincial police spokesperson, reports suggest that people were standing outside at the offices of the Commission for Conciliation, Mediation and Arbitration (CCMA) when an unknown man fired several shots leading to the death of a 40-year-old man. Three other men were seriously injured during the apparent attack. All the injured men were admitted to hospital

for medical treatment. The motive of the incident is yet to be determined and no one has been arrested. According to the data the price of 95 petrol will increase by 7 cents per litre; 93 petrol will increase by 2 cents per litre; diesel (0.05%)

is expected to decrease by 12 cents per litre; while diesel (0.005%) will decrease by 12-cents per litre. Illuminating paraffin will decrease by 7 cents per litre.



### Hoe raak gereelde brandstofverhogings die handelaar?

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - Suid-Afrikaanse verbruikers is na brandstofprys styg - dan verkoop hulle land hom bevind, die vinnigste dadelik 'n reeks skynbaar nimmereindigende stygings in die brandstofprys taamlik ou voorraad teen die nuwe prys wat vuisvoos en letterlik alles moet ingespan word om die gesinsmotor aan die loop te hou.

Maar dink verbruikers soms aan die lot se finansiële begroting. van brandstofhandelaars en die eienaars van vulstasies wie se winsgrense die afgelope klompie jaar ten spyte van gereelde stygings konstant gebly het te midde van die feit dat daar lankal reeds kopgehou moet word om die spreekwoordelike kop bo water te hou? ### Oktoberskoolvakansie of nie?

RUSTENBURG HERALD **RUSTENBURG - Na aanleiding** van die nuus dat daar beplan word om die Oktoberskoolvakansie te skrap, het verskeie skole op ons navrae hieroor reageer.

Die meeste skole was dit eens dat hulle wag op "direktiewe" van die Departement van Onderwys "almal wag in spanning om te hoor wat die besluit van die departement sal wees".

'n Plaaslike hoërskool het laat blyk dat hulle ook op 'n antwoord wag maar indien 'n vakansie wel toegestaan word, 'n verpligte Lenteskool vir die matrikulante in daardie week beplan word.

Laerskole is ook in afwagting op 'n aankondiging van die departement. Daar word verneem dat relevante vakbonde ook in aanmerking geneem moet word voordat 'n besluit geneem kan

Dit is duidelik dat die stof nog lank nie oor die moontlikheid/ wenslikheid van 'n Oktoberskoolvakansie gaan lê het nie.

Die publiek moet R3.84 meer opdok vir 'n liter branstof sedert Januarie. Dit beteken dat indien jy 8km/l brandstof gebruik op jou voertuig jy vir elke 8km 'n addisionele +- R4.00 betaal.

Indien jy as gesin 50km per dag ry, beteken dit 'n addisionele R24 per dag sedert Januarie en ongeveer R750 per maand sedert Januarie.

Oor die algemeen brandstofhandelaars met 'n reuse kontantvloeiprobleem. wanneer ons "wen" is die dag wanneer die

minimaal is want die motoris kom maak sy motor vol om die prysstyging te vermy wat die volgende dag intree. Die handelaar moet dus nou R3.84 meer betaal by aankoopprys met dieselfde winsmarge. Dit maak ekonomiese nie sin nie", sê Mostert.

"Alle sektore in die ekonomie, veral die voedselsektor word deur die styging geraak omdat dit vervoer-intensief is. Daar was slegs 'n \$4 styging in ru-olie die afgelope drie maande. Tans is die prys van ru-olie \$69/vat. Projeksies is dat daar weer 'n styging gaan wees. Dit is ook voor die hand liggend dat gegewe die benarde ekonomiese posisie waarin die

beskikbare kapitaal vir die regering is om die brandstofprys te verhoog".

"Daar is tans 'n magdom verskuilde heffings op brandstof wat geensins sin maak nie. Die heffings van regeringskant is rondom 50% van die brandstofprys. Algemene heffings sluit onder meer in 31% en die Padongelukke fonds - 17%. Na raming kry die regering ongeveer R145 miljard uit brandstof waarvan R94 miljard aan die tesourier gaan."

Gaan die situasie verbeter?

"Persoonlik dink ek daar is geen kans nie. Ons het te lank vergeet ons is deel van Afrika met al sy ideologieë en verwronge politieke oortuigings", sê Mostert.





# Sending money overseas? Beware!

### **Motorists** warned of potential hijackings

RUSTENBURG - The police in RUSTENBURG Rustenburg would like to issue a stern warning to motorists travelling on the Swartruggens road near the new Rustenburg Mall to be extra vigilant to potential hijackers, more especially when driving in the night.

This warning comes after police received reports of several attempted hijacking incidents near the traffic light leading to Olympia Park Stadium. In one reported incident, it is alleged that a driver of a Mercedes Benz was driving in the area when a white Audi swerved in front of his vehicle in an attempt to stop him, the complainant said another vehicle, red Polo stopped next to him, he noticed that the occupants were armed, and seeing that his life was in danger, he drove back in the direction of the CBD. The suspects followed him, however he drove to the police station where he managed to get assistance. The District Commander, Brigadier Joel Pheto instructed the various units of the police to regularly patrol the area, especially at night. Motorists are urged to be extra vigilant.

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - Once upon a time, if you wanted to buy something you needed to physically go to the store which sold said item and exchange cash before you could bring it home.

Today you can purchase virtually anything from virtually anywhere in the world, virtually! Drawers from Denmark, linen from Lithuania, and baskets from Bali. But along with worldwide add-to-cart-opportunities there is also a whole new world of fall-victim-to-fraud-

Most online stores, wherever they are in the world - provided they are legitimate - have secure payment portals and safe ways to pay for your goods. PayPal, for example is a globally trusted payment gateway and has buyer protection in place if products turn out to be not as described or faulty. Transferring funds into overseas accounts however often doesn't come with the same consumer protection. And while it is now relatively easy to make international payments via internet banking, allowing you to reliably and conveniently send money overseas from the comfort of your home computer, you still need to be careful who is receiving your money.

Your first rule should be not to ever send

money to someone you don't know, or who you don't have a business relationship with.

Scammers sometimes encourage people to transfer money for seemingly legitimate means. A legitimate business, charity or company will almost always have a secure online payment portal for you to safely transact without the need to transfer money into their account. So, excuses such as "the website is down at the moment" or "you can access a special deal if you transfer rather than pay via the website" - should let all the red lights flicker. As a general rule just avoid transferring money to unknown or unverified persons who ask for funds. In a number of instances that Rustenburg Herald is aware of, scammers have intercepted emails containing invoices to businesses. The con artists then swop the business's banking details with their own and the send this new, 'adjusted' email on to the client. The trusting client pays into the scammer's account - losing the money and not getting what he paid for.

Here are just a few examples of what scammers might use:

- An emergency situation you haven't confirmed.
- For an online purchase.
- · For anti-virus protection. · For a deposit or payment on a rental
- property.
- To claim lottery or prize winnings.
- To pay taxes.
- For a donation to charity.
- · For a mystery shopping assignment.
- For a job opportunity.
- For a credit card or loan fee.
- To resolve an immigration matter.
- Transferring funds overseas often involves a network of correspondent and intermediary banks. Once funds are transferred, it is often difficult (if at all possible) to cancel or recall transactions, even if you are the victim of fraud. Be alert! Even the most streetwise or businesssavvy person can fall victim to fraud if they let their guard down. When in doubt, rather go 'Old School': go to your bank to verify the banking details and to do the transfer.

# Tavern owner fatally shot

RUSTENBURG HERALD - LETHABONG - The police are investigating a case of murder and attempted murder after a tavern owner was fatally shot and his employee left with serious injuries following a shooting incident that took place in the early hours of Sunday (22 August).

According to information received from sergeant Ofentse Mokgadi, police spokesperson in Rustenburg it is alleged that witnesses heard two gunshots.

When they checked they saw three gunmen running from the direction of the tavern. Police were called to the scene,

and upon arrival they found the tavern owner lying in front of the tavern gate, with aunshot wounds to the neck.

His employee was also found lying several meters from him, with gunshot wounds to the abdomen.

The two were transported to the hospital

however the tavern owner was declared dead on arrival. The tavern owner's Corsa bakkie was left in the middle of the road. It is not clear what the motive of the shooting however nothing was stolen. Police are investigating cases of murder and attempted murder.

No arrests have been made vet but police are requesting anyone who might have information that can lead to the arrests of the three suspects to come forward.

### Unstoppable Caitlin headed for World Championships

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - A young Rustenburg cyclist with loads of talent and perseverance, Caitlin Thompson (17), was selected to represent South Africa at the UCI Road World Championships in Belgium this year. It was however not an easy road with many obstacles and challenges.

Caitlin started out years ago as a runner and has competed in the NWN XC leagues since the age of 8. She obtained NWN colours and represented NWN at SA XC Championships in 2017 and was selected again in 2018. Her running strength has always been her ability to pace herself well for the duration of an event. She has always favoured longer distance events where this pacing skill gives her a significant advantage.

In March 2017, she decided to take up cycling on her first mountain bike, but only started actively riding in August of that year. She also completed her first 94.7 racing by herself in an open seeded batch in a time of 3:19:18 (Age 13). In December 2017, we introduced her to triathlon. She started by competing in the NW Triathlon leagues. Her first NW league race was in January of 2018 and she finished in a time

comparable to the winning time at the 2017 SA Champs. In March 2018 after only being actively in triathlons for +-4 months, she competed at SA Triathlon Champs in Bloemfontein. Her swim was her weakness, which was further impacted when they made the swim wetsuit legal (due to the extremely cold-water conditions). In the end she finished 3rd in her age group, coming back from a 1m44s deficit off the swim.

In June 2018 Caitlin competed in SA Duathlon Champs at Midmar. This was only her 2nd duathlon and she had to compete in very cold and trying conditions. She took the gold to win the SA Duathlon Youth Championship (1/26) that year. Her bike was again the fastest of all the girls and again competing in a category with girls 1 year older than her. In this race, she actually finished 8th overall including the boys (8/56). Her targeting of SA Triathlon and SA of cycling races early in the year, leaving little racing in the later part of 2018. In 2018, she obtained NW colours for Triathlon, Duathlon and Cross Country Running.

After breaking her ankle during the Brauhaus Trail Run in October 2018, Caitlin was sidelined until late December. When she returned to running, she struggled with

biomechanical imbalances and ultimately opted to focus on her cycling which was where her passion lay. We started actively training for SA Road Champs in February 2019.

At SA Champs in KZN in 2019, Caitlin completed in the TT on her standard non-aero Giant TCR road bike with 50mm deep sections

on a flat course that heavily favoured the faster more aero bikes. In the end, she managed a credible 5th and the fastest on a standard bike road bike. The following day she competed in the 60km road race that favoured her climbing ability. She worked most of the day working in a 4-girl breakaway and on the final climb she increased the pace, resulting in sprint for the finish line between herself and Chante Olivier. The finish was not favourable being downhill and she found herself being the lead out for Chante in the end. She however secured the silver medal for her efforts.

Unfortunately, 2020 was a terrible year in many ways and this was no exception for racing, with many national championships cancelled, including SA Junior Road Championships.

In 2021, Caitlin set her sights on the National Road Cycling Championships that was held in Swellendam. She placed all other racing on hold to focus on preparations for the event and subsequently focused on road racing in the hope of selection for the UCI Road World Championships in Belgium. Caitlin put in

a mammoth effort to secure gold and the National Junior Female title in the Individual Time Trial in wet conditions on a hilly route. Two days later she took on the road race which didn't go entirely to plan, leading to her putting in a lot of effort on the front trying to break the group up before the line. Without support she used a little too much energy which counted against her on the final uphill sprint. She however

managed to secure the silver medal in her 1st year as a junior and took home some valuable lessons. Caitlin has been selected to represent South Africa in both the Individual Time Trial and the Road Race at the UCI Road World Championships in Belgium this year. She will also by

the youngest person in the team, being the only 1st year junior. She is now in the final phase of her build up to the event with the only hurdle being that of obtaining a VISA to enter Belgium.



RUSTENBURG HERALD - TLHABANE - According to statistics, in South Africa a girl child misses up to 50 days of school in a year due to the lack of adequate menstrual hygiene support.

While a few individuals and organisations have begun to shed light on the impact of the lack of adequate sanitary protection, this issue continues to affect girl children in many different parts of the country. 



RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - As part of ensuring that those who perpetrate crime are brought to book, police in the north West Province arrested 349 suspects for various offences between Friday (20 August) and Monday (23 August).

According to Captain Aafje Botma, the arrested suspects included three for murder, 10 for assault with the intent to do grievous bodily harm, eight for common assault, two for robbery, seven for malicious damage to property, one for arson, 223 for liquor and drug related crimes, five for being in possession of suspected stolen property, 16 for shoplifting, 17 for theft and 12 for property related crimes. A total of 71 fines were issued, 13 for liquor and nine for traffic related offences. Furthermore, 250 litres of liquor and concoctions were seized.



- Or his or her partner or associate, holds an office in or with, or is employed by, any person, company, organisation or other body, whether corporate or unincorporated, which has an interest contemplated in paragraph (e);
- Is an unrehabilitated insolvent;
- Is of unsound mind, or is subject to an order of a competent court declaring such person to be mentally ill or disordered;
- Has at any time been convicted, whether in the Republic or elsewhere, of theft, fraud, forgery or uttering a forged document, perjury, an offence under this Act or any act providing for the prevention or the criminalisation of corruption, or any office involving dishonesty, and has been sentenced therefor to imprisonment without the option of a fine or to a fine exceeding R500;
- Has at any time been removed from an office of trust on account of misconduct;



Noordwes se vullisterreine in haglike toestand





RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - AfriForum het vanjaar 153 vullisterreine landwyd geoudit as deel van dié organisasie se nasionale projek om die gehalte van vullisterreine in Suid-Afrika te meet. Slegs 2 uit 21 vullisterreine wat in Noordwes geoudit is, het aan nasionale standaarde voldoen. Kragtens toepaslike wetgewing en regulasies, waaronder die Wet op Nasionale Omgewingsbestuur: Vullis 59 van 2008, moet 'n vullisterrein aan bepaalde vereistes voldoen.

Volgens Petrus Coetzee, AfriForum se distrikskoördineerder vir Marico, is die meeste vullisterreine in Noordwes in 'n haglike toestand. "Die meeste vullisterreine is in 'n slegte toestand en dit kan hoofsaaklik toegeskryf word aan die onderskeie munisipaliteite wat versuim om die infrastruktuur en toerusting van die vullisterreine te herstel en te onderhou."

Coetzee sê die algemeenste probleme wat AfriForum tydens die oudit aangetref het, is die afwesigheid van afvalbestuurslisensies en 'n algehele wanbestuur van terreine. "Die meeste van die terreine het ook nie die nodige personeel om dit te bestuur nie en daar is feitlik geen toegangsbeheer nie. Die gebrek aan toegangsbeheer lei daartoe dat mense op die terreine woon."

Munisipale verval is aan die orde van die dag en dit is ooglopend dat veral kleiner munisipaliteite onder grootskaalse wanbestuur gebuk gaan.

AfriForum het in die laaste twee jaar by verskeie geleenthede met Barbara Creecy, minister van Omgewingsake, en haar span vergader. Ses terreine is geïdentifiseer wat die departement in samewerking met AfriForum gaan aanpak om dit weer op standaard te bring. AfriForum gaan ook daarop fokus om saam met munisipaliteite die probleme by sommige van die terreine in die provinsie aan te pak en om druk toe te pas om sekere terreine weer reg te ruk. AfriForum sal die proses deurlopend moniteer om te verseker dat die vullisterreine se standaard genoegsaam verbeter.

Our hosts this week are Chantelle Edwards and Dave de Jager of Hope Hill Rehabilitation Centre.

Our hosts this week need little introduction - Dave and Chantelle share the recipe of a wonderfully flavoured potjie that can be prepared with any cut of beef and fresh or preserved figs.

The pot has a sweet and sour taste with a hint of chilli and is low maintenance during the cooking period. The pot must be made on a slow fire as to avoid the sweet ingredients from sticking to the pot and burning. This recipe

combines an interesting set of ingredients with the traditional cooking method for "potjiekos".

# "Potjiekos"

The juice of 8 squeezed lemons Finely chopped fresh garlic 4 medium sized green chillies

Fresh or dried herbs (Oregano, Rosemary, parsley and thyme);

BBQ spice of your choice

3 chopped onions 3 Kg beef

2 Containers of preserved figs

Half a tin of fig jam/honey

Add to taste the following:

Carrots Green beans Mushrooms Patty pans

Baby marrows Sweet corn (optional)

#### Allow 4 hours cooking time

Mix the fresh herbs and garlic with the juice from the lemons in a container large enough to contain all the meat. Add the meat to the lemon juice mix and marinade for 4 hours. Cook the onions in the potjie until slightly browned or until they lose colour and remove them from the pot. Insert the meat and the lemon juice mix in the potjie. Add the BBQ spice to the mix and stir well. Cook on a low heat for 30 min.

Chop the figs and add them to the potjie at the 30 min mark. Cook the meat for another hour. Add the green beans, potatoes, carrots, mushrooms, onions and a pinch of salt to the potjie and stir slightly. Cook the meat for another hour on low heat. Add the fig jam or honey to the potjie and stir slightly. Add the rest of the veggies to the top section of the potjie. These veggies lay on top of the potjie and will be steamed until soft and will provide another element to the taste of the potjie. Cook the potjie for approximately another hour to ensure the veggies are soft and tender. Do not overcook the vegetables added last, it is important that they retain their own flavour. When the veggies are soft the potjie is done. The potjie can be enjoyed with any side dish or on its own.

# **Local Elections** is Covid-19 a just excuse?

It has been very clear to everyone for quite some time that the governing party's house is not in order and opposing political parties, spokesmen of large organisations and leading companies and analysts are in accord that all those who feel that they have scores to settle with government about the present situation in the country have been preparing to give the ruling party a dressing-down at the Local Government Elections of October 2021. It seems however that for the ruling party in particular, the Covid-19 pandemic has arrived at precisely the right moment to bring to an abrupt halt to any hopes of political chance this time around.

A lot has been said and written about the "fact" that the ANC is supposedly quite frail since the party's recent blunders, particularly the Department of Health's for its scandalous handling of the Covid-19 threat and what has followed since then.

### Elderly man violently attacked, authorities dragging their feet

The Editor

Assaulted with the intention to be killed, saved by SAP. I'm 68-year-old, badly disabled and on a waiting list for double knee replacement surgery, can only get along with the aid of crutches. On 11 July 2021 I was assaulted and tortured with aluminum pipe and pick handle while lying sprawled on the ground for over an hour by an 48-year-old man. He sprayed pepper spray in my face, beaten me about 80 blows from head to feet all the time threatening me repeatedly that today he is going to kill me, but first he wants to beat me to pulp he said all the time and only stopped when police appeared.

I sustained serious injuries to spine, elbow, wrists, hands, knees, lower legs and are still enduring agonizing pain till this day, 44 days later and today the court trial date was set for 6 October, another 44 days from now. I sustained skin beaten off my shin bones, damaged tissue, nerves and ligaments, bones through out my body. I could not walk without crutches and pain killers for 3 years, now it's even much worse. I am agonized that this case has not been investigated at all by the authorities after numerous attempts from my side to get something done.

From three different departments the same response (don't worry). Assault with the intention to kill. don't worry? This all happened during a level 4 lockdown, a cold front with freezing weather and country-wide unrest and violence. I had to evacuate my isolated place of peacefull living next to the Magalies mountains for the past 5 years at great expense. I was a respected Mechanical Engineer that contributed to country and society, now I survive on a government old age disability pension. I think I need legal representation and ask for help please.

### How will the municipality handle the new rates?

I have noticed the adjusted rates advertised in the Rustenburg Herald of August 6, 2021 – we as taxpavers are indeed grateful for this reduction. What is however, somewhat worrisome, is that in the recent Budget, it was announced that the re-evaluation will be phased in over a five year period. My question is: Will the municipality perhaps also, over a five year period phase in the reduced tariff? Or conversely, will the current .0050 cents per R1 per year be increased in phases to reach the original .0076c (previous tariff), or will the current .0050c tariff only be increased by 3% per year without an additional adjustment to achieve the .0076c? Although the tariffs will now be reduced by 35%, the reevaluated (adjusted) valuation of most of the properties were increased by up to 100% or more - which inter alia means that we are in fact now already paying 30% more in Assessment Rates since July 2021.





RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - South Africa's athlete Miné de Klerk has won a silver medal in the women's discus throw while Kyle Rademeyer has won a bronze medal in the men's pole vault at the World Athletics U20 Championships Nairobi on Friday (20 August).

Silver medalist De Klerk also set an African U20 record with 53.50m, coming second to women's discus throw champion Violetta Ignatyeva with a spectacular 57.84m and Alina Nikitsenka of Belarus got bronze with 51.47m. The wins from Rademeyer and De Klerk gave South Africa four medals in total and put the country in second position alongside Ethiopia on the medal table. Double South African champion Benjamin Richardson won South Africa's second medal at the World Athletics U20 World Championships in Nairobi, on Thursday (19 August). South Africa's Mirè Reinstorf set an African U20 record (4.15m) while taking the gold medal in the women's pole vault on day one of the World Athletics U20 Championships in Nairobi. The five-day event, which started on Wednesday and hosted at the Moi International Sports Complex Stadium in Kenya, took place until 22 August, with 54 athletes (29 men and 25 women) from South Africa taking part in the action.

### **SA Relay team wins Gold**

RUSTENBURGHERALD-RUSTENBURG - The national junior men's 4x100m relay team closed out a superb campaign by the South African squad at the World Athletics U20 Championships on Sunday (22 August), breaking the world junior record to win gold on the fifth and final day of competition in Nairobi, Kenya.

The SA quartet of Mihlali Xhotyeni, Sinesipho Dambile, Letlhogonolo Moleyane and Benjamin Richardson, secured victory in the final in 38.51 seconds, shattering the previous global U20 mark of 38.62 which had been set by the USA at the Pan American Championships in Costa Rica in July 2019.

They also obliterated the African record of 39.33 which SA had equaled in the heats the day before. Jamaica took second place in the final in 38.61. Poland took the last spot on the podium in 38.90.



### The Springboks are boss

RUSTENBURG HERALD - GQEBERHA - The Boks registered a 29-10 victory at the Nelson Mandela Bay Stadium on Saturday after opening up their campaign with a 32-12 victory at the same venue the previous week.

While the players were pleased with the results, they agreed there was room for improvement. "It was pretty tough playing against Argentina - they are always hard opponents to face, and they are a physical side," said Malcolm Marx, the Springboks' impactful hooker. "At times we had them under pressure, and there were one or two things that didn't go our way or where we didn't capitalise. We enforced our game plan on them well in the first half, but there is always room to get better," Marx added. Lukhanyo Am also expressed disappointment about the missed opportunities to add to scoreboard pressure during the match.

"There were good opportunities, but with the stop-start nature of the game not capitalising on those chances was our downfall," he said. After missing a full season of international rugby in 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Am was pleased with the trajectory the team was on after clinching the Castle Lager Lions Series by winning two of their three Tests against the British & Irish Lions and registering victories against Georgia and Argentina. "It's been great playing in the green and gold and we managed to build from the Rugby World Cup," said Am. "We are getting to where we want to be, and we are building consistency in the team." Marx, meanwhile, was pleased to start the match after being a key member of the bomb squad in recent years and said: "It is an honour to put on the Bok jersey, even if it is the No 16 jersey. "It was great to start the match. There is a lot of competition in the squad, and the better we prepare, the better we'll be when we play."

The Springboks will remain in Nelson Mandela Bay until a decision is made on where the remaining Castle Lager Rugby Championship fixtures will be played following the announcement on Saturday that the latest outbreaks of COVID-19 in Australia and New Zealand resulted in the tightening of regulations placed on travel and quarantine by various state and national governments. With the Springbok matches in New Zealand against the All Blacks in Auckland and Dunedin cancelled, SA Rugby offered to host the remaining fixtures. A decision on the match venues is set to be made in the next few days.
