

Claims of sexual escapades, corruption at Rustenburg Municipality

RUSTENBURG HERALD RUSTENBURG - The Forum 4 Service Delivery in the North West Province has mandated its Councillors in the Rustenburg Local Municipality to request the Speaker, Ms Shielah Mabale-Huma to urgently convene a special virtual council sitting to discuss two issues which arose from SABC news and the Sowetan newspaper of 29 January 2021.

Allegations have apparently been made by a former employee of the municipality, Ms Sina Makgathla which implies that the Executive Mayor, Mr Mpho Khunou, was interfering or orchestrating testimony in an employee related matter by pressuring her to become a witness in a work-related

dispute against an unnamed employee - a misconduct in terms of the Code of Conduct for Councillors. "More worrying is the statement attributed to the Executive Mayor that Ms Makgathla "signed off on payments for water tankers and blackmailed service providers for payments" which implies

that the Executive Mayor had information of possible corruption on procurement or financial irregularities in water tankering by Ms Makgathla in October of 2020 and knew of the sharing of nude images or disclosing intimate conversations with Ms Makgathla to whoever distributed it." Such concealment of information or the withholding of information from the Rustenburg Local Municipality Council and the South African Police Service is a transgression of Schedule 1 of Municipal Systems Act", the F4SD said. Following the disgrace of alleged sex escapades, the F4SD

wishes the survivors of gender-based violence strength and condolences by sending a warning to the perpetrators of gender-based violence. "The Rustenburg Local Municipality has noted the developments regarding court proceedings which are currently unfolding in which the Executive Mayor Mr Mpho Khunou is involved. The Municipality will respect the court processes and will not comment on the matter which is linked to the Executive Mayor in his personal capacity", the Rustenburg Municipality said in response to an enquiry by Rustenburg Herald.




ATM bombed in Rustenburg North?

The Rustenburg Herald on Tuesday morning (2 February) received this photograph of what appears to be an ATM which has been bombed. It is not clear when the incident took place however the ATM has been identified as the one in Scott Street, Rustenburg North. The police were asked for information but by our time of going to press the information was not yet available.

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - With a decline in new COVID-19 infections, hospital admissions and deaths, Government has decided to ease a number of restrictions under Adjusted level 3.

Addressing the nation on Monday evening (1 February), President Cyril Ramaphosa said the average rate of new infections has been steadily coming down over the last three weeks, indicating that the country has now passed the peak of the second wave. "We are acutely aware that these restrictions have negatively affected businesses and threatened jobs in the hospitality, tourism and related industries. That is why we are determined that such restrictions should not continue any longer than is absolutely necessary to contain the pandemic and minimise the loss of life," President Ramaphosa said. The hours of the curfew will now be from 11pm to 4am. Establishments will need to close by 10pm to allow their customers and staff to return home by curfew. Faith-based gatherings will be permitted, subject to health protocols. Such gatherings may not exceed 50 people for indoor venues and 100 persons for outdoor venues. Where the venue is too small to accommodate these numbers with appropriate social distancing, then no more than 50 percent of the capacity of the venue may be used. Public places such as beaches, dams, rivers, parks and public swimming pools will be reopened subject to health protocols. While restrictions on the sale of alcohol will be eased, the President has called on South Africans to drink responsibly so that the country does not experience a spike in trauma cases or an increase in infections due to reckless behaviour. The sale of alcohol by licensed premises for off-site consumption will be permitted from Mondays to Thursdays, from 10am to 6pm. Duty-free shops, registered wineries, wine farms, micro-breweries and micro-distilleries will be able to sell alcohol for off-site consumption during

their normal licensed operating hours. The sale of alcohol by licensed premises for on-site consumption – such as restaurants and taverns – will be permitted throughout the week from 10am to 10pm. Social gatherings, political events, traditional council meetings and gatherings at sports grounds will not be permitted. Funerals may not be attended by more than 50 people, and there needs to be social distancing, hand sanitising and mask wearing. "It remains compulsory for every person to wear a mask in a public space," President Ramaphosa said.



Bus smashes man's head at Rustenburg Bus Rank

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - A 25-year-old homeless man was killed instantly at the Rustenburg Bus Rank when a bus drove over him while he was sleeping on the pavement at one of the platforms.

According to information received from police spokesperson in Rustenburg, Sergeant Ofentse Mokgadi, the man was sleeping on the pavement, wrapped in a box when a bus which was allegedly attempting to avoid another bus and smashed his head, he died instantly. The police are investigating a case of culpable homicide and a statement was obtained from the driver. No arrest was made. The 25-year-old is known to the police however he cannot be identified at this point.

Suspected stolen items recovered

RUSTENBURG HERALD - MATEBELENG - On Friday (8 January) members from the Marikana Crime Prevention were conducting Visible Crime Prevention Patrols when they received information at around 14:00 about possible stolen goods kept at Matebeleng Township in Kroondal.

The SAPS members searched the premises and found a lot of suspected stolen articles in the informal settlement inside one of the houses. Mostly electronic and technical equipment were seized: Computers, sound systems, digital equipment, flat screen television sets, and other household items, including fans and a pressure cooker. One suspect, 21 year old Fernando Machale was arrested and recently appeared in court on charges of possession

of suspected stolen items. Furthermore, he was linked to three other housebreakings in the Azalea Park vicinity during December last year and January 2021. The suspect remains in custody and has reappeared in court seven days later, on the 15th of January 2021 for a formal bail application. A further court date has been set for the 10th of February 2021 and bail has been denied as the suspect is a foreign national.

This young inventor decided to design a simple alarm system which would assist home owners as well as business owners in the fight against break-ins. Originally from De Brak near Rustenburg, with the help of one





Obituary for Bruno Di Cosmo (17/05/1933 - 24/01/2021)



RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - Bruno Di Cosmo was born in Sora, Italy on 17 May 1933.

He left school at an early age, to do an apprenticeship in auto electrical at a garage in walking distance from the home he shared with his parents, brother and three sisters. Bruno was called to National Service with the Arma Dell'Aeronautica (Italian AirForce) where he continued to learn his trade as an auto-electrician.

In December 1957, Bruno arrived as a 24 year old immigrant in South Africa at Durban Harbour on the Europa, accompanying his eldest sister & nephew, who were to join his brother-in-law in Parys, Free State. He found a job at a workshop in Welkom as a motorcycle mechanic - not his choice, but the only way he was able to obtain a work permit in South Africa.

The Italian community in the Free State was small and close. This is how he met his wife, Lalla Pedretti, also an immigrant from Italy, who had settled and grown up in Parys with her parents, sister and brother. In 1964, on his first trip back to Italy, Bruno called for Lalla's hand in marriage and a few weeks later she joined him there and the wedding took place in Sora, his birth town.

Bruno and Lalla settled in Welkom where their family grew with the birth of their daughter, Paola in 1965 and son, Giovanni

in 1966. Early in 1967, Bruno was offered a job with his father-in-law, Angelo Pedretti, at Rustenburg Granite Quarries. But the rocks, dust and dynamite were not for him. He went back to the starters, alternators and motor oil after just one year.

In 1975, Bruno and Lalla (a hairdresser working at Ingeborg's Hair Salon at the time), were blessed with the birth of their third child, a healthy boy named, Fabio. Bruno was a partner in Electro Diesel at the time, and his hard work, Italian accent and affable nature, garnered many loyal clients and staff. He became known as Oom Bruno to many during those years. In 1983, Bruno left Electro Diesel, to start his own Auto Electrical business, simply called: Bruno's Auto Electrical. Lalla, who had left hairdressing after the birth of Fabio, joined him in the business and learnt, from scratch, how to keep books and run the front shop & staff with her kind and gentle nature. Tannie La was the perfect partner in a business which serviced the cars of individuals, motor companies, mining vehicles and taxi fleets alike. Giovanni joined this thriving business in 1990, upon completing his apprenticeship as a motor mechanic in Johannesburg. Father, mother, son and a staff complement of around 30 worked together to create the business

success it remains today. Bruno handed the reins of the business to Giovanni in 2012, but stayed on to assist his son until 2018 when he and Lalla moved to Cape Town. Bruno retired at age 84, after nearly 70 years of hard work and leadership. He spent his final two and a half years, living a quiet, peaceful life, growing vegetables, teaching his Carer, Steve, to cook and connecting with his Cape Town family and friends. His greatest sadness was living apart from the love of his life, Lalla, who lives in a Care Home, called The Villa, in Vrededorp, Cape Town. Their last visit together was on 24 December 2020, and the love they had for each other was clearly evident in their eyes and body language, across Covid-compliant equipment and distance.

Bruno fell ill in the first week of January and fought a brave fight for 17 days, until he drew his last breath in the early hours of Sunday 24 January and left the world a little darker for all who knew and loved him. He is survived by his beloved wife, Lalla; children Paola, Giovanni and Fabio and their spouses; sisters Rita and Anna; and 5 grandchildren: Daniel, Dario, Lia, Gabriel and Alessio. Bruno's generosity of spirit and zest for life will be remembered and treasured by many for years to come. May his departed soul rest in eternal peace.



Dinsdagoggend is daar sommer reeds in die vroegoggend-nuusbulletins berig dat die verspreiding van Covid-19-gevalle met meer as die helfte gedaal het teenoor die statistiek van die vorige week. Vir baie indien nie die meeste Suid-Afrikaners nie, is hierdie bemoedigende nuus aangesien ons waarskynlik sal moet aanvaar dat die gewone publiek nog 'n hele rukkie sal moet wag voordat die Covid-19 entstof aan die man in die straat beskikbaar gestel sal word. Soos daar berig is sal gesondheidswerkers, hospitaalpersoneel, dokters en verpleegters en almal wat met die behandeling en versorging van besmette en siek pasiënte werk, die eerste wees in die lang toue mense wat gehoop het en staatgemaak het op die entstof om hulle teen die pandemie te beveilig. Met die daling wat die verspreiding van die siekte die afgelope week getoon het, weet

'n mens eintlik nie of jy spyt of bly moet wees dat die entstof presies in hierdie week in die land moes aankom nie. Die daling in verspreiding van die virus en die aankondiging van die president dat maatreëls ietwat verslap gaan word, sal mense hopelik nie tot so 'n mate gerus stel dat ons die veiligheidsmaatreëls sorboord gooi nie.

Nog 'n groot ironie is die belaglike bedrag van R430 miljoen wat die Gautengse Departement van Onderwys in slegs drie maande in die beveiliging van skole bestee het - dit nogal onder die "toesig" van die LUR vir Onderwys in Gauteng, die omstrede Panyaza Lesufi wat nou sal moet bontstaan om te verduidelik hoe op dees aarde so 'n buitensporige besteding in slegs drie maande moontlik kon wees sonder dat selfs hy daarvan geweet of dit goedkeur het. Iets hier klink net eenvoudig nie reg en bilik nie en herinner baie sterk aan die bykans banale vergryping aan korruption deur talle beampies in die departement van gesondheid in 'n tyd toe die verspreidingsyfer van Covid-19 ontstellend hoog was. Daar kan maar net gewonder word of ons die R430 miljoen en die miljoene rande wat vroeër in die sakke van korruptes verdwyn het, ooit weer sal sien. Die hoop beskaam egter...

Covid has seen millions lost in corruption

To thousands of South Africans who were seriously concerned that they could be infected by the feared Covid-19 virus, it should be ironic that the first batch of Covid-19 vaccines arrived in the country on exactly the same day that a significant decline in cases of Covid-19 contamination has been recorded. Since the early morning news bulletins on radio and tv it was reported that Covid-19 infections have declined by more than 50 percent compared to that of the previous week. To many South Africans this is encouraging news since it is generally accepted that the ordinary man in the street will have to wait his turn for a considerable period while the first batch of vaccines is rolled out to health workers, doctors, nurses and all those who are involved in the treatment and care of Covid-19 patients almost every single day. With the arrival of the Covid-19 vaccines at this point in time, it is almost with regret that the vaccines didn't arrive much sooner, or perhaps ever later, since it seems that the steadily rising curve of Covid-19 contamination has been broken. Incidentally, this also coincided with the announcement by the President that once again, some Covid-19 safety regulations have been lifted. We can only hope that

this together with the decline in infections, will not give way to people disregarding the health regulations altogether now that we have reached a certain point in time.

But perhaps it is even more ironic that it had been reported only days earlier, that the Gauteng Education Department has in only three months spent an amount of R430 million on the decontamination of schools in the province - albeit on the watch of the Gauteng MEC for Education - the controversial Panyaza Lesufi. To make matters worse, Lesufi claims not to have been informed on the issue and of the amount spent on these regulations.

This is taken with more than the usual pinch of salt, expenditure of some R400 million in just three months simply seems just too much to have happened without the knowledge of the MEC overseeing the department's affairs. This strongly reminds one of the almost barbaric atrocities with regard to corruption with the roll-out of Covid-19 preventative measures in the country from early last year. The chances of ever seeing a single coin of those monies which without any doubt ended up in the pockets of corrupt "entrepreneurs", are extremely remote, to say the very least.




Rustenburg Cycling Club XCO Trime Trial
