Second hand goods crime put under the spotlight

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - Police in Bojanala District (Rustenburg) successfully launched a crime prevention operation on Wednesday, (10 November), to address crimes involving second hand goods.

Various multi-disciplinary agencies were involved such as Provincial Firearm, Liquor and Second Hand Goods (FLASH), Rapid Rail, K9 (Dog Unit), Crime Intelligence, Mounted Unit, Vehicle Crime Investigating Unit (VCIU), Employee Health and Wellness

(EHW), Transnet, Home Affairs, Telkom CPI, Motor Industry Ombudsman, general Detectives and Communication personnel.

One person was arrested for possession of copper cable and four undocumented citizens were arrested during the operation. Compliance inspections were conducted and fines to the total value of R22 000,00 issued.

Various second hand dealerships, as well as scrap metal dealers and recyclers were visited.

Bojanala Acting District Commissioner, Brigadier Reginah Ntoagae, has expressed her gratitude to all sectors, officers, components and members involved. More of these compliance inspections are on the cards in future. Second Hand dealerships are warned to refrain from buying second hand goods. The police will clamp down methodically to ensure compliance and the eradication of a market for the buying of stolen goods.





Mvianga claimed that the Royal Bafokeng king was not of royal blood and in his claim he alleged that certain family members of the Royal family confirmed his claims.

His stories were since published by the national media early this year where he claimed he was the rightful heir to the throne.

The Royal Bafokeng Nation responded to these allegations on Tuesday (23 November). In a statement issued to the Rustenburg Herald Rre Bashi Makgale, Director of Operations at the office of Kgosi said the Royal Bafokeng nation was aware of these allegations and were in a process

of taking legal action against Mvianga. "I write in response to a letter to the editor from Gladwin Koketso Mvianga published in Rustenburg Herald on 19 November 2021 under the heading, Claim that Bafokeng king is "not of royal blood".

As Director of Operations in the Office of Kgosi, Royal Bafokeng Nation (RBN), I am

authorised by the Royal Family to refute all claims and allegations made by Mr Mvianga in his letter. Further, I wish to advise that legal steps against Mr Mvianga have been initiated by the Royal Family," said Makgale.

Man on Presidential Pardon convicted again

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - On Thursday (18 November) the Rustenburg Magistrate Court sentenced Tshegofatso Maruma (23) to ten years imprisonment after being convicted on a business burglary charge for stealing seven laptops worth R90 000.

According to Rustenburg police spokesperson, Sergeant Ofentse Mokgadi, it is alleged that in 2020 Maruma was caught red handed at one of the brokers offices in Landros Street, upper town after he tried to outrun the security guard. Fortunately with the help of a community member, he was cornered and arrested. During his arrest one of his previous victims who resides around the vicinity managed to identify him and immediately called Detective Constable Morongwa Makhoye who was handling his housebreaking case in 2019.

Upon arrival Makhoye confirmed that indeed Tshegofatso was on presidential pardon after being sentenced to five years imprisonment in 2019 and she was the investigating officer at the time. She was assigned to the docket and immediately commenced with the investigation. Maruma was remanded in custody since 2020 until his sentencing as he contravened his presidential pardon conditions.

Cash-In-Transit heist in Rustenburg

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - North West Police have launched a manhunt for a group of suspects that bombed and robbed a G4S cashvan off an undisclosed amount of money in Rustenburg, near the Rustenburg Civic Centre.

According to information received from police national spokesperson, Colonel Athlenda Mathe, Its alleged that the suspects used a stolen maroon Mercedes Benz to ram into the truck forcing it to come to a standstill. The security guards were then forced out of the cashvan before it was blown up. Shots were fired between the suspects and the escort vehicle but no one sustained inquiries. Suspects are believed to have fled the scene in various vehicles including a white Q7.

"CIT heist scenes can often be dangerous particularly when explosives are used in such robberies. It is for this reason that we warn members of the community that in some instances, it is possible that not all explosives were detonated at the time when the robbery was committed. This therefore poses a risk for the detonator to explode in their presence, thereby posing a risk for the loss of life," said Mathe.

She also said when a robbery is committed, the area now becomes a crime scene and those looting at such crime scenes often contaminate the scene which will constitute a crime of theft as well as defeating the ends of justice.

"We therefore call on all our communities to refrain from entering crime scenes but rather to support the work of the police by assisting members when a crime is committed as opposed to being part of the crime itself," concluded Mathe.

Tlhabane murder suspect sentenced

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - The Provincial Commissioner of North West, Lieutenant General Sello Kwena welcomed the 15 years imprisonment sentence handed down to Itumeleng Daniel Matlapeng (39) by Bafokeng Magistrate Court in Tihabane on Monday, (15 November).

Matlapeng's conviction came after he was apprehended on 13 February 2019 in connection with the murder of 60-year-old Nomvula Lingela. According to information received from Lt/Col Amanda Funani, North West police spokesperson, Tlhabane Police

were conducting patrol duties when they were approached by the victim's son on Tuesday, (5 February 2021), who informed them about his missing mother. The police together with the son conducted a search and discovered the lifeless body of the victim next to Tlhabane stadium in the bushes. The victim's hands were tied with a rope and her clothes and shoes were scattered around the scene. Police's investigations led to arrest of Matlapeng and he was remanded in custody since his arrest until his sentencing. Lieutenant General Kwena congratulated the Tlhabane Detectives for the sterling job that they did in making sure that the accused was sentenced.

Upon their arrival they found three unknown suspects loading four cellphone battery towers on a white Isuzu single cab bakkie with false registration. The suspects saw the police and fled the scene and left the batteries together with the vehicle they used at the scene. They managed to evade arrest. An intensive investigation was then launched and earlier this month (November), 25-year-old Nqobile Nkomo was arrested in Yeoville, Johannesburg after he identified himself as the driver of the recovered vehicle. He has since appeared before Mogwase Magistrates Court on Thursday (18 November) and was denied bail. His case was postponed to Tuesday (30 November) and transferred to Mogwase Regional Court.



Roles reversed as Rustenburg Municipality announces new leaders

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - A full day's session of seven hours almost wasn't long enough to finalise the inauguration of the Rustenburg Municipality's 90 new Councillors and the election of the city's new Speaker and Executive Mayor on Monday.

Not much surprises here however, as both the public stand which on several occasions top candidates came from the ranks of the ANC. In fact, the former Speaker of the RLM, Cllr Sheila Mabale-Huma who has served in this capacity for almost ages one is tempted to say, was elected as Executive Mayor amidst loud chanting and celebrations from

threatened to disrupt the formalities in the Civic Centre Banquet Hall, which served as Council Chambers for the auspicious occasion to accommodate the public.

Mabale-Huma rushed to a swift victory however with 47 votes against the 16 of Cllr



Pieter Malan of the DA and 27 of Cllr Papi Rangwaga of the Tsopang Civic Movement. The election of Council's new Speaker however took considerably longer to satisfy the house as at least two parties including the EFF objected against the format of the ballot, which saw the entire process being repeated.

Eventually, ANC candidate Cllr Koketso Mogomotsi secured 49 votes against the EFF's Cllr Sharon Letlape's 24 votes and the 17 votes of Cllr Luan Snyders of the DA to be the first male Speaker of the Rustenburg Municipality in almost a decade.


Though the Rustenburg Municipality was one of three hung municipalities after it has failed to win an outright majority in the recent elections, the party secured control of Council by forming a coalition with the AIC. Arona and another independent candidate, the mainstream media reported well ahead of the inauguration on Monday morning.

Mabule-Huma is expected to announce the Mayoral Committee on Friday this week.

During her acceptance speech Mabalu-Huma touched on a extremely tender and perhaps long overdue issue when she said it was clear that the Rustenburg Municipality plans to meet with residents of the city - a city that has undeniably suffered a great deal in its recent history as a result of appalling service delivery by the municipality.

Perhaps one of the first major challenges facing the new Executive Mayor would be finding an amicable solution to the almost two year old issue of what became known as a totally unrealistic and unreasonable Municipal Valuation Roll which saw property owners' assessment rates soaring.



Woman behind bars for child kidnapping

Load-shedding can disrupt cell signals

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - Sitting without electricity is bad enough. Not having cell phone coverage during load-shedding just makes things worse.

But why is load-shedding leaving you without cell signal?

Battery theft at base stations, combined with insufficient charging times due to frequent load-shedding sessions can cause mobile network towers to lose power, resulting in little or no cellular connectivity.

This causes frustration amongst residents who still wish to communicate when their fixed-line connections go down due to power cuts. While mobile towers draw power from the electricity grid, all mobile network operators have contingencies for when their cellular base stations lose power.

These include the installation of battery backups at mobile towers, but several

factors impact their ability to provide a reliable power source through power cuts.

Factors such as equipment theft at base stations and an inability for batteries to recharge to full capacity if the time between load-shedding sessions is too short can cause towers to lose power.

Battery back-up systems generally take 12-18 hours to recharge, while batteries have a capacity of about 6-12 hours, depending on the site category.

The theft of batteries at base stations has compounded the effects of load-shedding on mobile towers.

"The impact is far more significant due to theft and vandalism at MTN base stations, with over 800 batteries having been stolen between June and September this year," a spokesperson for MTN told My Broadband.

A spokesperson from Telkom also indicated that batteries are unable to recharge during frequent load-shedding, adding that it is more pronounced at sites with lead-acid batteries which take longer to charge. Load-shedding also impacts the cooling system at Telkom's network towers.

"Load-shedding compromises our cooling system, which results in higher ambient temperatures inside our equipment cabinet, high temperatures compromise the life of batteries," the spokesperson said.

A Vodacom spokesperson also indicated that mobile networks suffer during load-shedding.

Vaccine grocery vouchers extended to over 50s

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - The Department of Health has extended the offer of R100 grocery vouchers to people in their 50s who receive their first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine from 18 November 2021.

This comes after the department announced that during November, R100 vouchers, redeemable at the Shoprite group of food retailers, would be offered to people aged 60 and older. However, the department's Vaccination Demand Task Team Lead, Dr David Harrison, said the uptake of the coupons has been poor, with only 8 135 redeemed to date. "We have also not seen a significant uptick in vaccinations among the over 60s," Harrison said. For older people in particular, Harrison said vaccination may determine whether families spend

their festive season visiting relatives in hospital or even attending funerals. "We are only two weeks in and it may be that the message takes time to filter down to everyone. However, we don't have the luxury of time with the fourth wave approaching and must adapt our strategy quickly if it doesn't seem to be having the desired effect," he stressed. The data shows that almost two-thirds of people over 60 years have been vaccinated. "For this reason, the department plans to test the expansion of the offer to people in their 50s as well."

Flu cases in South Africa on the rise

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - South Africa has recorded a steady increase in the number of influenza cases from 23 August, with a sharp growth in the week starting 1 November 2021. According to the data released the total number of influenza cases detected by the syndromic sentinel surveillance programmes conducted by the National Institute for Communicable Diseases (NICD) has jumped from 68 to 226 during this period.

This includes influenza-like illness (ILI) and hospitalised cases of pneumonia. The statement released on Wednesday (17 November) said both the NICD and private laboratories have received reports of clusters of influenza cases in schools and workplaces. The public health institute said influenza A (H3N2), influenza A (H1N1) pdm09 and influenza B are seasonal influenza virus strains that are common in human populations. Meanwhile, influenza A (H1N1) pdm09, also known as "swine flu" has been one of the circulating seasonal

influenza strains following its emergence in 2009. However, according to the institute, the word "swine flu" should not be used as it causes unnecessary panic.

"The clinical course of infection with this influenza strain and clinical management is similar to that of other influenza strains," the NICD explained. To date, the most commonly detected subtype and lineage are influenza B Victoria (87/226, 38.5%) followed by influenza A (H1N1) pdm09 (53/226, 23.5%) and influenza A (H3N2) (24/226, 10.6%).



VAX FACTS: How to save our summer

December is the start of the festive season, which in South Africa is all about hot summer days, beaches, shisanyama Sundays, family gatherings and bush breaks. To avoid another humdrum summer of Covid restrictions, as was the case in 2020, the Department of Health is encouraging all South Africans to get vaccinated against Covid-19 as soon as possible who have had only one Pfizer dose, must go for their second jab as soon as the mandatory 42-day waiting period is over, and those who are yet to get vac

possible.

Once the majority of the population is fully immunised, the risk of exposure and contraction will be limited and the Covid-19 infection rate will be curbed. This will help enable the economy to recover and save those businesses that will not survive another lockdown.

There is no need to pre-book or to wait for an SMS after registering for your vaccine – simply walk into any vaccination site. Don't forget to take along valid identification (ID, birth certificate, foreign passport or asylum/refugee number).

You can even go to a vaccination site if you have not registered, and you will be assisted to register at the site. Be warned, however, that it will take longer than if you had pre-registered.

1. Safe shopping Make Black Friday (November 26) safe this year by vaccinating as soon as possible. It takes two weeks after you are vaccinated for your body to build protection (immunity) against the virus that causes Covid-19.

2. Safe seniors Encourage or help your grandparents and parents get vaccinated, because they are at high risk of severe symptoms and possible death should they contract Covid-19. A free R100 grocery voucher for people aged 60 and older who are getting vaccinated for the first time, is available during the month of November too.

Safe scholars

3. Sare scnoars Assist children aged 12–17 to get vaccinated at any site. No SMS or prebooking is required. Children with an illness that compromises their immunity are at high risk of contracting Covid-19 and should get vaccinated as soon as possible. The 12–17 age group requires only a single dose of Pfizer to qualify for a vaccination certificate.

4. Safe society If 16 million adults are vaccinated by the end of the year, projections are that at least 20 000 lives could be saved. It is now easier for people to access vaccinations wherever they are, with over 3 000 public and private vaccination sites across the country.

Let's get smart about life insurance

What factors affect the cost of your life insurance premium?

The younger you are, the cheaper your premium is.



According to North West provincial police spokesperson, Captain Aafje Botma, the suspects were arrested for offences such as rape, murder, assault with intent to do grievous bodily harm, house robbery, drug related crimes and many others. In addition, and as part of enforcement of legislation in respect of liquor, 187 persons were issued with fines for illegal dealing in liquor and drinking in public. Consequently, 76 illegal liquor outlets were shut down.

Rustenburg cyclist takes on extreme race

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - Richard Roos, a Rustenburg cyclist will be taking on 1000km in 120 hours - a single stage mountain bike race across the middle of SA in the heat of the summer.

Rustenburg

The Munga MTB 2021 is considered one of the toughest mountainbike races on earth. "At the Munga we celebrate what it is to be human. We know the fight. We know what it means to grovel, and grind, and crawl in desperation to the light at the end of the tunnel. We know what it's like to hand on to a thread, but claw and pull it back till it's a tight rope, and walk that thin line, balancing the life and death of dreams, till at last we lean forward, and the momentum of action carries us inexorably towards our destiny!" Alex Harris - Munga Race Director. The Munga runs over a little more than 1000 kilometres. There are 5 race villages where riders can rest, eat and get mechanical assistance. There are also ten waterpoints placed between 60 and 90 kilometres apart. The race is semi-supported meaning that riders will be provided with support from race officials and at race villages but will not be permitted to have support along the route. Everything a rider needs he will find at the waterpoints or race villages, or it must be taken along on his bike.

The Munga mountain bike race begins in Bloemfontein and ends at the Doolhof Wine Estate in Wellington in the Cape Winelands. The route will be predominantly off road. The route will be a GPS route so riders will not have to think about navigation. Cyclists come in all shapes and sizes, and from all walks of life. Some shred, some meander, others camp and then there are those that test the very fibre of human endurance. Richard Roos is one of these cyclists. Roos (41), qualified Sports Science and Personal Trainer tackling the world's toughest mountain bike challenge the Munga from Rustenburg. "What I'm looking forward to from the Munga is the hidden and hostile scenery that few have the privilege to see. I'm looking forward to seeing just how far I can push myself through the darkest areas in myself to the level of breaking point and hitting that bottom then to push myself through that point of ultimate endurance as this will be my longest race. Ultimate endurance Munga. My mind is working through the process, it doesn't get any challenging than this!!!
