

An average South African can have Elon Musk's riches

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - Dreaming of being as rich as Elon Musk? You, with your average South African salary can do it - but there is a catch.

As of last week, electric car executive and space entrepreneur Elon Musk is worth more than \$287 billion - the equivalent of around R4.3 trillion. Musk, now officially the richest man on earth, last week saw a historic leap in his personal fortune when the share price of

Tesla surged on a big order.

Musk's wealth is most easily compared to other people who are really, really, ridiculously wealthy. Musk is now 46% wealthier than the world's second richest man, Amazon founder Jeff Bezos. He is 17% richer than the founders of Google,

Larry Page and Sergey Brin, combined. He is nearly three times wealthier than Facebook's Mark Zuckerberg. He is somewhere between 500 and 600 times richer than the queen of England.

In the context of his birth country South Africa, it is possible to get a grasp on the scale of his wealth by, again, comparing it to that of extremely wealthy people.

South Africa currently has five dollar billionaires:

- * Johann Rupert and his family
- * Nicky Oppenheimer
- * Koos Bekker
- * Patrice Motsepe
- * Michiel le Roux.

If you take all the wealth of these five, and multiply it by 11, you're getting close to the level Musk now inhabits.

But a comparison between Musk's fortune – enough to run the entire country for years – and the lives of ordinary South Africans just gets absurd.

According to the most recent national statistics, the average salary earner in South Africa (excluding agricultural workers) is paid R23,526 per month. If such average earners stops eating – and spending money on anything else too – then they could in theory catch up to him by dint of simple hard work. The catch is that it will only take you 15.2 million years to earn as much as Musk is worth now.

A very sobering fact indeed.

Nine in court for torching royal house

RUSTENBURG HERALD - MORULENG - Nine suspects have appeared before the Mankwe Magistrates' Court in Mogwase after the royal house was torched on Sunday morning (24 October).

Rapheo Makgale (33), Kedibone Mataboge (37), Kerileng Molemi (47), Moses Pete (38), Refentse Matlhola (26), Bareng Segwatlheng (24), Edwin Njoro (40), Ngxacha Qhithi (46) and Keorapetse Letshedi (27) were released on R1000 bail after they appeared in court on charges of arson and malicious damage to property. They were expected to reappear on Thursday (4 November). According to

information received from North West Provincial police spokesperson, Brigadier Sabata Mokwabone, the accused were arrested in connection with an incident in which Chief Ramono Pilane Linchwe's house was allegedly burnt in the early hours of Sunday morning (24 October), in Moruleng near Mogwase outside Rustenburg. It is alleged that a group of people who were travelling in minibuses arrived at the

Chief's residence and forced entry into his premises. The group allegedly smashed windows of a security vehicle that was parked outside the house. Furthermore, the group left the place after allegedly torching the Chief's house which burnt together with a Toyota Hilux vehicle that was parked in the garage. A manhunt was launched and the suspects were apprehended. The Provincial Commissioner, Lieutenant General Sello Kwena lauded the police for their tireless efforts and good investigative work that led to the arrests of the suspects.

Financial aid applications now open

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - Prospective applicants can now apply for their National Student Financial Aid Scheme as applications are now officially open for the 2022 academic year.

Dr Blade Nzimande, Minister of Higher Education said applications would open from Tuesday (2 November) and would remain open until 7 January.

According to him, the majority of prospective students will know their fate almost immediately, while for others it may take up to 48 hours with a few exceptions that will go beyond that.

And with the demand for student funding having increased due to the impact of Covid-19 Nzimande said the funding of university and Technical and Vocational Education and Training (TVET) college students through the National Student Financial Aid Scheme (NSFAS) went up by 107% from R20 billion in 2018 to R42 billion in 2021.

"Dit is goed om te sien dat hierdie skoonmaakspan 'n verskil maak in die dorp.



Voters not led by the nose - it's a clear message!

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - "It should have been expected - they had it coming!" This was but one of dozens of direct, strongly-worded messages following the November 2021 Municipal Elections which to date would easily be remembered for resulting in the worst voter turnout in any election ever in the history of South Africa.

Broken promises of job creation, economic growth, foreign investments that were supposedly building the country's economy, shocking incidents of corruption by government officials, a soft stance on crime and a lack of accountability by high-profile government officials were but some of the reasons why this year's elections saw the biggest majority of voters ever refusing to go out to vote and exercise their constitutional right.

In fact, a staggering number of 13 million South Africans haven't even bothered to register for this year's election, let alone to, on a public holiday, go out to support the political party of their choice. Early counts indicated a loss of voters' support in many traditional ANC strongholds across the country, with the DA and the FF+ gaining substantial confidence from voters.

Polls since the opening of voting stations on Monday morning, indicated that people were fed-up - "we have been led by our noses for too long, it's been enough, we have warned, we have protested we have pleaded but to no avail. "But why haven't you simply voted for another political party?", we asked. "No, that would be false support, we're wanted government to know that we are discontent with the way things have been going for the past few years - they have turned a deaf ear to us and have abandoned us - we are not

going to vote for them again unless things are changing for the better very soon", Rustenburg Herald was told.

"I have no hope of any politician ever restoring the situation in the country, especially in our region" (Rustenburg) another disgruntled voter (who refused to vote) told Waldie Volschenk of Rustenburg Herald. "I feel abandoned and can't identify any party that is truly representing me in my voting district. Why should I vote for another party if I feel let down by the party I have always voted for", we were told. Though it was far too early to make any assumptions or to predict major winners and losers, by the time of our going to print it was clear that the ANC took quite a beating in several districts, notably Johannesburg (and Soweto) where the Action SA Party of Herman Mashaba has done surprisingly well. There is little doubt however, that the ANC would retain the majority across the country and would remain the key players in government. Other parties that have done very well and gained substantial ground, were the DA and the Freedom Front +. The final Election results is expected on Thursday, with the very last results expected on Friday. Meanwhile President Cyril Ramaphosa has gone public with thanking the country's voters for ensuring another victory for the ruling party.

Vaccinate and get grocery voucher

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - in an effort to encourage more and more South Africans to get vaccinated, Health Minister, Dr Joe Phaahla, said adults over the age of 60, who take the vaccine in November, will be rewarded with a R100 grocery voucher after taking the jab.

He said this pilot scheme would be valued at R26 million to benefit 260 000 pensioners.

He explained that the voucher will be texted to the cellphone number senior citizens registered with the Electronic Vaccination Data System (EVDS) and

coupons will be redeemable at Shoprite and Usave stores. "Pensioners will automatically get an invitation to receive their vouchers. However, due to the Protection of Personal Information Act or POPI Act, they will have to opt-in, by dialing "YES" at no cost to the user upon receiving an SMS.

Royal Bafokeng Platinum's shares rise on buyout offer from Implats

RUSTENBURG HERALD – RUSTENBURG - Royal Bafokeng Platinum's share price on the JSE rose by more than 23% on Wednesday morning (27 October) after shareholders were informed that Impala Platinum (Implats) had made a nonbinding indicative proposal to acquire RBPlat.

RBPlat and Implats noted in a joint cautionary announcement to shareholders that the parties had completed a reciprocal due diligence exercise and were progressing a proposed transaction implementation

agreement. Shareholders would be kept informed of developments in this regard, the miners said.

Should the acquisition be concluded, RBPlat, which is led by CEO Steve Phiri, would be delisted from the JSE. RBPlat's share price rose to R117.20

early on Wednesday, compared with Tuesday's close of R94.80. RBPlat's operations include the Bafokeng Rasimone Platinum mine (BRPM), the Styldrift mine, the BRPM Concentrator complex and the Maseve Concentrator plant in Rustenburg.

Ouers bekommerd oor skool

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - "Al wat 'n ouer wil hê, is dat sy kinders veilig moet wees. Maar nou moet ek erken: by dié skool kan ek dit nie met 'n geruste hart sê nie." So sê een van die ouers wat Rustenburg Herald verlede week gekontak het oor 'n instansie wat as 'n privaat tuisskool bedryf word.

Die skool is buite Rustenburg en op 'n kampterrein geleë. "My kind was daar vir Graad een, maar toe verhuis ons na 'n ander dorp. By die nuwe skool - 'n staatskool - was die onderwysers geskok oor hoe agter my kind was. 'n Onafhanklike terapeut het bevind my kind is skaars op Graad R-vlak," vertel nog 'n ouer. Haar storie word beaam deur nog 'n ma wat, toe sy sien daar word bittermin werk in haar kind se skryfboeke gedoen, ook haar kind na 'n arbeidsterapeut toe geneem het. Ook dié terapeut se bevinding was dat die kind 'n baie groot agterstand het tenoor die gemiddelde ander kind van dieselfde ouderdom. Die ouers sê hulle is in die proses om regstappe te neem. Van die beweringe is: Die skool adverteer dat hul die Cambridge-kurrikulum volg, maar dit is glo nie waar nie. Leerkrakte is nie na behore gekwalifiseer nie. Een van die persone wat klas gee, het glo slegs 'n gr 10-kwalifikasie. Nul tot geen onderrig word gegee nie. Vir meer as ses maande het leerders glad

nie in hul boeke gewerk nie. Badkamergeriewe is glo haglik. Die leerders moet die toilette met kampeerdeurs deel. Leerders moet ook baie maal die toilette skoonmaak – al word dit dan ook deur die publiek wat die kampterrein besoek, gebruik. Geen Covid-regulasies word glo by diie skool nagekom nie. Leerders moet handearbeid op die kampterrein verrig – soos om drade te span. Philip se noodkreet

Megan Snyman bly blymoedig, bly glo dat die wonderwerk vir haar man Philip sal gebeur.

Hy is in Desember 2020 gediagnoseer met 'Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia' en moes dadelik met Chemo begin. Hy, sy gesin en familie was verheug toe hy teen 17 Maart reeds in remissie was. Dokters het met behulp van toetse bepaal dat sy sussie vir hom 'n skenker vir stemselle sal kan wees en Philip het met die behandeling begin om hom voor te berei vir 'n stemseloorplanting. Dié is vir 13 Mei 2021 geskeduleer. Philip het sy stemseloorplanting ontvang en alles het goed verloop.

Toe hy na 'n maand ontslaan is, het hy vir veiligheid by sy ouers gaan isooleer - weens Covid-19 en om te verseker Megan en hul dogtjies, Klara nie kieme van die skole af bring nie. Philip moes sekere prosedures volg vir die eerste 100 dae na sy oorplanting om sy liggaam kans te gee om te herstel en die nuwe stemselle te groei. "Alles het só goed verloop en ons was dankbaar vir sy herstel en was opgewonde om weer 'n 'normale' lewe te leef. Hy kon nie wag om te gaan werk en tussen mense te beweeg nie. Die afsondering van familie en vriende het 'n geweldige emosionele en

sielkundige uitwerking op mens se wese, terwyl dit juis in hierdie tyd van kankerbevegting is wat jy die ondersteuning so geweldig nodig het."

Op dag 121 na die oorplanting - dag 21 na die kritieke 100 dae - was Philip vir 'n opvolg afspraak, en het dokter bevinde dat sy bloedtellings abnormal is. Hy is dadelik opgeneem en dokter het gesê hy vermoed sy Leukemieselle is terug. "Boonop het hy ook niversaking gehad," vertel Megan.

Veldslae uit Anglo Boereoorlog met monument gedenk

RUSTENBURG HERALD - GROOT-MARICO - Ter viering van die 120ste herdenking van die Slag van Kleinfontein/Driefontein in Groot-Marico Sondag (24 Oktober 2021) is 'n splintenuwe monument onthul.

Die Slag van Kleinfontein het op 24 Oktober 1901 tydens die Tweede

Vryheidsoorlog 10 km wes van dié dorp in Noordwes plaasgevind. Die Boere het die Britse opmars tydelik gestuit.

Die Britte het 400 man en 'n groot aantal waens verloor terwyl die Boere slegs 60 sterfes gehad het. Daar is 'n gedenkteken opgerig wat die plek aandui waar die slag plaasgevind het. Hierdie veldslag het plaasgevind toe 'n Britse konvooi onder bevel van Luitenant-kolonel Stanley Brenton van Donop deur Boere onder bevel van generals JH de la Rey, JG Celliers en JCG Kemp en LAS Lemmer aangeval is. Kol Von Donop se konvooi het bestaan uit 65 muil- en 35 ossewaens begelei deur meer as 1 000 soldate met vyf kanonne en twee Pom-Poms en het gestrek oor 'n afstand van sowat 3,4 km.

Vroeg dieoggend van 24 Oktober 1901 het die Britte hul kamp, geleë naby die huidige brug oor die Maricorivier, verlaat en weswaarts

getrek op die Rustenburg/Zeerust-pad. Terwyl die konvooi op die pad verby die bos Boekenhoutbosse op Kleinfontein trek word genl. LAS Lemmer se burgers aan die voorpunt van die konvooi gewaar en word daar met die Pom-Pom op hulle losgetrek. Aan Britse kant sneuwel 31 man, drie is aan hulle wonde oorlede en 44 is gewond, terwyl aan Boerekant 17 man sneuwel, vier is aan hul wonde oorlede en is 31 gewond. 'n Monument is in 1938 op dié slagveld opgerig. Gister is daar 'n splintenuwe monument, Bokkraal-monument, ter viering van die 120ste herdenking van die Slag van Kleinfontein/Driefontein by Bokkraal, sowat 33 km van die Hervormde kerk in Groot Marico onthul om die 10 Burgers wat twee dae ná hierdie veldslag op 26 Oktober 1901 dood is, te gedenk. Die nuwe monument is deur Die Erfenisstigting se EBB-komitee op dié dorp onthul.

Die Britse militêre-begraafplaas en ou monument is ook deur hierdie lede en ander besoekers besoek en kranse is daar gelê. Die FAK het ook 'n krans by die nuwe Bokkraal-monument gaan lê en ook die herdenkingsverrigtinge bygewoon. Barry Müller, projekorganiseerder van FAK-Kulturnetwerke in Gauteng en Noordwes, en Mollie Moolman, lid van die FAK-Kulturnetwerk in Rustenburg, het namens hierdie kulturnetwerk 'n krans gelê en Kobie Ströh namens die FAK-Vaaldrifhoek-Kulturnetwerk.

Danie Steyn, lid van die Groot-Marico EBB en ds Stephan Botha van Swartruggens EBB het ook kranse gelê. 'n Spesiale woord van dank aan Peet Coetze wat die dag onvergetlik gemaak het met sy betrokkenheid in die oprigting van die nuwe monument, maar ook sy aanbieding aangaande hierdie skermutseling en die indienstenvorsing wat hy daaroor gedoen het, wat hy ook bekend gestel het in sy nuwe boek. Hierdie is ook die 11de nuwe monument-oprigting waarby hy betrokke is. Die FAK-Kulturnetwerke en Die Erfenisstigting se EBB-komitees vat eersdaags hande om saam Afrikanerferfenis en monumente te beskerm en te bewaar.







{StandpuntViewpoint}* Skokkende stempersentasie kom 'n lang pad

In Suid-Afrika en feitlik regoor die wêreld is dit tradisioneel 'n nie-amptelike "wet" dat inwoners van 18 jaar of ouer 'n verantwoordelikheid van "plig" het om hul grondwetlike reg uit te oefen en tydens elke plaaslike, provinsiale of nasionale verkiesing te gaan stem. Mense voel oraloor baie sterk oor hierdie saak hoewel daar groot verskille tussen pro- en antagonistiese is - argumente kan maklik vir ure of dae voortduur.

In die Republiek van Suid-Afrika het dit nog altyd blyk of die gemiddelde konsensus hierdie standpunt ondersteun en sedert die heel eerste demokratiese verkiesing sedert die RSA op 31 Mei 1961 'n republiek geword het, was dit nooit nodig om geregistreerde kiesers "aan te moedig" om hul grondwetlike reg uit te oefen nie. Selfs nadat die RSA in April 1994 sy heel eerste demokratiese verkiesing gesien het, het die patroon nie verander nie. Tot baie onlangs egter, blyk die jongste statistiek.

Die tradisionele standpunt oor die saak om te gaan stem of nie, lui dat enige stemgergtige burger wat nie sy grondwetlike reg om te stem uitoefen nie, in essensie van sy/haar reg afstand gedoen het om te kla, enigets te eis, of selfs net 'n opinie oor enige grondwetlike of staatkundige aangeleenthede te hê. Die eenvoudige spreekwoord lui: "As jy nie stem nie, kan jy nie kla nie". (Daar is egter 'n nuwe argument wat sedert betreklik onlangs die ronde doen en (baie sinvol) lui: "Ek betaal vir dienste (wat ek in elk geval nie kry nie) - ek stem nie vir dienste nie"). Geen verkiesing tot en met dié van Maandag het ooit so onteenseeglik bewys dat Suid-Afrikaners nie noodwendig meer met die gewaande "belangrikheid" daarvan

om te stem, saamstem nie. Vandeesweek se plaaslike verkiesing, het baie duidelik getoon dat Suid-Afrikaners gefrustreerd is en apaties staan ten opsigte van die land se politieke en staatkundige toekoms.

So vroeg soos Dinsdag reeds het verskeie forums reeds getoon dat 'n uiterst lae stempersentasie van tussen 45 en 48% vanjaar verwag kan word maar dat ons vanjaar vir die eerste keer in die geskiedenis "beslis" 'n laer persentasie as 50% sou sien.

Vir baie ander was dit self meer insiggewend dat steun vir die land se groot politieke party (ANC) vanjaar ook vir die heel eerste keer na minder as 50% sou terugsaak. Die redes vir hierdie verskynsel is die kieserskorps se algehele frustrasie met die regerende party en 'n gevoel van "n gebrek aan verteenwoordiging" onder groot getalle voorheen lojale ondersteuners van die ANC. Ander redes wat vir dié party se swak prestasie aangevoer kon word, is Covid-19 en sy nagevolge, skokkende voorvalle van korruksie in partyledere (selfs tydens van ten spyte van Covid-19), die gebrek aan eenheid in die party en 'n amper totale ineenstoring van dienslewering regoor die land.

Natuurlik was daar ook die gebruikelike beloftes van werkskepping en ekonomiese groei wat nie naastenby materialiseer het nie. Vir die regerende party was die duidelikste teken van kiesersapatie die feit dat nagenoeg 13 miljoen Suid-Afrikaners nie eers die moeite gedoen het om te registreer nie en noodwendig nie kon stem nie. Finale verkiesingsuitslae word teen Donderdag verwag met die heel laatste uitslae wat teen Vrydag beskikbaar sal wees.

Shockingly low voter turnout had it coming

In South Africa and probably all over the world tradition commands that citizens of 18 years and older have a responsibility if not a "duty" to duly exercise their constitutional right to go out and vote during crucial elections. People often have strong but conflicting views on the issue with arguments often continuing until who knows when.

In South Africa in particular, it seems that general consensus would support this view - hence the very high turnout of registered voters during elections, whether local, provincial or national for the past six decades since the country became a Republic on 31 May 1961. Since South Africa's first ever democratic election in April 1994, the pattern rarely ever changed, until now, it seems.

Historic and traditional views hold that if a registered voter or any person of 18 years or older, won't exercise his right to vote, he practically for that matter waives his rights to complain, to demand or even to merely be entitled to an opinion on all matters of political or constitutional nature. "The overstrained saying goes that someone who doesn't vote, simply shouldn't complain".

In the Local Government Elections of 1 November 2021 it became evidently clear that people do not necessarily agree with this view anymore and it seems that voters for some reason or another, have become frustrated or apathetic towards the country's

political well-being or future. By Tuesday this week, polls reported that a very low voters turnout in the region of 45 to 48% could be on the cards to represent the lowest turnout ever in the country's history but "almost definitely" that the voters turnout could drop to below 50% for the very first time. Also and for many perhaps the most significant, that support of the country's biggest political party - the ANC - could drop to beneath 50% - also the lowest ever in any election that has contested.

There is little need to point out that the low voters turnout is the result of people's frustration and a feeling of no representation by any of the parties contesting the election, including the party that has since 1994, enjoyed the support of by far the biggest slice of the electorate. In recent years this has changed substantially however. Reason readily given for the poor turnout include Covid-19, shocking incidents of corruption by members of the ruling party, party infighting, grossly inadequate service delivery across the country and countless promises of job creation and economic growth that have simply not materialised.

For the ruling party, especially, there is a very clear message in the fact that a staggering 13 million eligible voters haven't bothered to register - let alone turning out to vote on Monday. Election results are expected to be finalised by Thursday this week, with the very last results being announced on Friday.

Voting percentage - could this be why?

The Editor

This year my wife and I decided that we would go to "our" polling station rather late on Monday afternoon. It was around 16:00 when we arrived at the station and we were really surprised to see hardly anyone else at our station which was actually expected to be quite busy. Nonetheless, we promptly voted and returned home thinking that most people probably went to vote during the morning. Later during the day on radio and tv news bulletins we were kept up to date on the voting process and all that was expected. It became quite clear pretty soon that the voting percentage was extremely low - possible even lower than it has ever been in South Africa.

On Tuesday morning some forums reported that the percentage could be as low as 45%. An hour or two later as I was on my way to the office, I patiently had to "negotiate" at least two "out of order" traffic lights at very prominent and busy crossings and as I approached the office, I immediately noticed clean drinking water running down the street for miles on end. "That figures", I immediately came to realise... People obviously don't believe the empty promises and blatant lies anymore. Most people have seen and began to realise that change in this country is still very, very far into the distant future. Probably when it's too late anyway...


What Did You Expect?

"Ek vra hulp asseblief!"

"Op 22 Februarie 2019 het ek onverwags my 15-jarige dogter aan die dood afgestaan deur nalatigheid van 'n dokter. Dit was 'n groot skok vir my, my man en 13-jarige seun. Ek was nog altyd 'n gesonde mens, maar in Mei 2019 is ek gediagnoseer met kolonkanker. Dokters het gesê dis van die trauma en skok wat ek ervaar het van my dogter se dood. Ek is in dieselfde maand geopereer en hulle kon al die kanker verwyder, maar ek moes daarna vir 12 voorkomende chemosessies gaan wat elke twee weke uitmekaar was. Ek was baie siek en moes noodgevonge ophou werk. In Januarie 2020 moes ek gaan vir my CT-toetse om te kyk of chemo sy werk doen. Ek het die nuus gekry dat die kanker versprei het na my regterlong. Weer moes ek vir 'n operasie gaan en die kanker is verwyder uit my long. Daarna het hulle my aangeraai om weer vir 12 voorkomende chemosessies te gaan, ook elke twee weke. Ek kon nie glo ek (en my gesin) moes weer deur dit gaan nie, maar met baie gebed het ek daardeer gekom. Ek was weer baie siek met min of meer dieselfde newe-effekte as die vorige sessies. In Oktober 2020 moes ek weer vir CT-toetse gaan en uiteindelik was ek in remissie. Ek kon op "maintenance" chemo gaan soos hulle dit noem. Ek was so dankbaar. Hulle wou egter weer na drie maande toets om te kyk.

Januarie 2021 het aangebreek en dit was tyd om weer te toets. Die toets het gevind dat daar kanker in my linkerlong is en die onkoloog het my meegeedeel dat dit nie verwyder kan word soos in die regterlong se geval nie, omdat dit op 'n ander plek sit en dit te gevarelik is. My moed het in my skoene gesak en ek het geweet wat voorlê.....die onkoloog het aanbeveel dat ek vir ses aggressiewe chemo's moet gaan. Nee, nee, nee.....met hierdie chemo het my hare en wenkbroue ook uitgeval en ek was baie

Lonsurf sal ek vir ses siklusse (ses maande) moet gebruik voordat ek weer vir scans moet gaan. Dit kos R56 885.90 per siklus so my bybetaling is R28 442.95 per siklus - ons kan dit doodeenvoudig nie bekostig nie. Die onkoloog wil so gou as moontlik met die behandeling begin. Waar krap 'n mens R170 657 000 uit? Ek is onseker en benoud vir die pad vorentoe, weet dat Vader voor my uitloop wat ook al gebeur.

Ek glo ook met my hele hart dat Vader in mense se harte sal werk om te help met die koste van hierdie behandeling. Ek is nog nie reg om op te gee en my man sonder 'n vrou te los en my seun sonder 'n ma nie. Hulle sukkel nog om oor die dood van my dogter te kom".



RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - The Vryburg 400, the sixth and penultimate round of the 2021 South African National Cross Country Series (SACCS) that took place this weekend, 29 and 30 October, at Vryburg in the North-West Province, presented teams with all the seasons in 48 hours while they had to handle a slippery and wet as well as a rocky, sandy and tricky track with care.

There were championship titles to be won – or lost – and both the Production and Special Vehicle Categories produced spectacular racing that turned the event into one for the books.

After two days and 400 tough kilometres of racing in the Kalahari, a mere 71 seconds separated the top three teams who are all in the running for the Production Vehicle and FIA Class Championship titles while only four seconds separated the leading two teams. In the end, it was the defending champions, Henk Lategan/ Brett Cummings (Toyota Gazoo Racing SA Hilux) who came out victorious in a time of 04:53:07 after they started the day in fourth place.

The Vryburg 400 was a good testing track for Giniel de Villiers/Dennis Murphy in the Toyota Gazoo Racing Hilux T1+ prototype who are preparing for the upcoming Dakar Rally. They finished just behind Gareth/Dryer, but do not score points towards the championships.

Lance Trethewey/Adriaan Roets (BAT) settled for second place in Class A and third place overall (06:39:12) after being hampered by fuel-pressure issues during the second loop.

Teams now have three weeks to prepare for the seventh and final round of the SACCS, the Toyota Gazoo Racing SA Parys 400 that takes place on 20 November from the Parys Airfield in the Free State.
