DA calls for provincial skills audit

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - This past weekend it was reported that the four District Chief Directors of Operations in the North West Department of Public Works and Roads do not have the necessary skills for their positions.

It is revealed that the Administrator, Molate Moremi, was left fuming when all the Chief Directors failed to provide comprehensive plans to deal with North West roads before this week's planned Ministerial visit to the province.

This revelation comes when this embattled Department of Public Works and Roads, under national administration since 2018, continues to fail in delivering on its mandate.

Throughout North West, many roads are unusable, especially roads connecting rural towns. Potholes are at the order of the day. "This poor state of roads put lives and livelihoods at risk. Not only are people killed in accidents that could have been avoided should the roads be in pristine condition, but those that survive, suffer the financial burden of repairs and replacing tyres. The cost of transporting goods and services

on untravellable roads are exponential, adding to the high cost of living and shortages, suffocating the rural economy, and turning small dorpies into economic wastelands," the spokesperson on Public Works and Roads for Democratic Alliance in the province, Freddy Sonakile commented on Monday (20 June).

Sonakile added that the Department has failed to utilize its Road Maintenance Infrastructure grant for several years, returning it to Treasury with no consequences. There has been no action taken for irregularities conducted previously, despite several Special Investigative Unit (SIU) proclamations into the Department.

"During the budget debates in May this year, the Member of the Executive Council (MEC), Oageng Molapisi, indicated that only 53 kilometres of the presently unpaved road network could be upgraded

in the current financial year. The DA reiterated that there is no appetite to deal with the road infrastructure issues in this province," Sonakile said and added that the party also requested the Department to present a workable solution, capturing its plans to attract the private sector for funding, but the Department ignored the request.

"This latest revelation is a stark indication that any talk of intervention to stop persistent mismanagement in Public Works and other departments in the province will come to nothing if the same unqualified cadres continue to occupy positions they are not qualified for," Sonakile stated.



NUMSA members embark on a strike at Impala

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - More than four thousand members of the National Union of Metalworkers of South Africa (NUMSA) went on an indefinite strike at Impala Platinum mines in Rustenburg rom Monday (20 June).

These are workers who are employed by contract companies Newrak, Reagents Mining Group and Triple M Mining.

"Our members are on an indefinite strike at these companies. They have been provoked into taking this drastic action because they are fed up with being abused by these labour brokers who exploit them by paying them very little and denying them benefits while they reap massive profits. The contractors at Implats are nothing more than modern day slave traders which is why they are working so hard to keep NUMSA out of the workplace. Reagents and Triple M are ignoring a labour court order to do verifications to confirm that NUMSA is the majority union. They are refusing

to engage us on the demands made by members. At the same time, Newrak is frustrating workers by refusing them the right to be represented by the union and they are refusing to allow the union to access the workplace. All these companies fear NUMSA because they know we will not rest until all workers employed by contractors, have the same pay and benefits as permanent staff. We need to remind these backward employers, that workers in South Africa have the constitutional right to join the union of their choice without interference from management," a statement from NUMSA said.

The members on Tuesday (21 June) gathered next to shaft no. 8, Freedom Park, Rustenburg to promote the strike.



R30p/l for fuel? It's coming!

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - Economists are predicting that South Africans must brace themselves for continued petrol price hikes in the coming months as global oil issues continue.

The possibility of R30 per litre of fuel is, indeed, a very real one.

Crude supplies are likely to remain tight amid limited spare capacity among producers, said investment bank UBS in a research note on Wednesday (15 June).

South Africa's local petrol prices have also not been helped by a tumultuous rand, which has slipped in the last week on expectations of further rate hikes in the US and the possibility of a global recession.

"In South Africa, the rand is at risk of further marked weakness as the differential between South African and US interest rates are eroded on the US interest rate hike this month, which would add to fuel price pressures, as rand weakness increases the rand oil and petroleum product prices," is the opinion of a senior economist at a mayor bank.

Consumers should take note that the current fuel price increase forecast is for another R2.00 per litre hike in the price in July - to R26.18 per litre, the highest petrol price South Africa has ever experienced, while the diesel price is set to rise by R1.18/litre, taking it to R24.27/litre, again unprecedented.

Petrol prices in South Africa are around double what they were about two years ago, and unsurprisingly inflation is more than double as food cost inflation has increased substantially.

Adding to the pressure is the end of fuel price interventions announced by the government in March. Fuel prices in July will see R1.50 kept off the general fuel levy. In August, this will be reduced to 75 cents per litre as the other 75 cents are added back.

Missing man sought

At the time of his disappearance, Silomo was wearing black short trousers, a white T-shirt and a pair of brown sneakers. He is tall and skinny and light in complexion, with short hair.

Operation leads to arrest of 92 suspects

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - In an effort to tightening the grip against criminality in the North West province, police operations were conducted and 92 suspects arrested between Thursday (16 June) and Monday (20 June), for different crimes committed in all Districts of the province through Operation Vhuthu Hawe (Your Kindness).

According to Lt/Col Amanda Funani, North West police spokesperson, among the arrests that were made, two suspects were held for drug related crime, 51 for liquor related crimes, 12 for crimes detected as a result of police action like possession of drugs and liquor while two were arrested for possession of

dangerous weapons. In addition, a total of 29 fines were issued for different crimes, ranging from contravening the Liquor Act, Road Traffic Act and Firearms Control Act.

Furthermore, seven undocumented persons were arrested. The operation also led to confiscation of liquor and a variety of drugs.

Convicted serial rapist gets two life terms

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - The Bafokeng Regional Court sitting in Tlhabane has sentenced a 30-year-old serial rapist to two life terms and an additional 28 year imprisonment on Wednesday (15 June).

According to Lt/Col Amanda Funani, North West police spokesperson, the sentences emanated from three separate incidents wherein victims were raped and robbed of their cell phones and clothes. In the first incident, a 15-year-old girl was with her boyfriend and walking to a nearby shop at Pitso Section in Phokeng outside Rustenburg at about 20:00 on Tuesday, 5 January 2021, when approached by the convict. The latter chased and forced the boyfriend to leave by throwing stones at him. The girl was consequently taken to the nearby bushes and raped. On her way back home after escaping, the girl met her boyfriend and her aunt who took her to Phokeng police station to lay charges of rape and common robbery. In the second incident at about 19:00 on Wednesday evening, 13 January 2021, a 22-year-old woman was from her aunt's place at Kotokoto Section, Phokeng and going back to her residential place at Lenatong Section when the convict approached her and volunteered to accompany her as he was also going to the same area. They were walking and about to cross the bridge when the accused grabbed and dragged the woman to the nearby bushes and raped her. He then robbed her of her cell phone and clothes before fleeing from the scene. The matter was reported to the police for investigation. In the third incident which

occurred 30 minutes after the second one at Lemenong Section, the convict met and approached a 14-year-old minor who was on her way home. He wanted to know if she was not afraid of walking alone and ultimately dragged her to the bushes and raped her.

Thereafter, he robbed her of her cell phone and clothes. Subsequent to the incident, the victim ran to Phokeng police station where she reported the incident and also found the 22-year-old woman reporting a rape case and common robbery. Consequently, the police and security officers with assistance of members of the community, searched for the convict at Lenatong Section where he was

found in possession of the victims' clothes. He was arrested and eventually identified by the 15-year-old victim which also he raped on Tuesday, 5 January 2021. The accused was finally sentenced to two life terms for two counts of rape. He was further handed 20 years imprisonment for another rape and four years for each of two counts of common robbery.

Functional NW municipalities “a dream”

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - “Without political will and if the situation remains the same as it is now, the chance of the municipalities becoming functional, is just a dream,” the Chairman of the North West Chamber of Commerce and Industry (NWCoCI), Gideon Ralepeli, said in a statement earlier this week.

Reacting to the report by the Auditor General, Ralepeli, wanted to know what the financial compliment of the staff in municipalities are doing when they have spent millions on consultants during the 2020/21 financial year. “We have suggested that skills audits need to be done in all municipalities. Then we can train the people responsible to start doing the work and taking responsibility for their jobs and what they are supposed to be doing. This is truly an absolute waste of taxpayers' money”, he said. “Some municipalities have contractors doing their monthly accounts, but even then, it is not properly or regularly done - like in the case of Ditsobotla,” he said.

Ralepeli further said that he cannot understand how municipalities can do budgets if they do not even know what their income history is and what they expect will be the income in the future. He added that it is very clear to them as the NWCoCI that that nobody takes any responsibility and the

said that the municipalities in the North West province continue to record disclaimer audit opinions whilst the lack of service delivery and performance deteriorate. Maluleke has blamed this on leadership instability, which she says is continuing to hamper the municipalities and service delivery.

“There seems to be a culture of tolerating lawlessness across municipalities, with a lack of consequences at these municipalities. Municipalities are not preparing to deliver services to communities and that is detrimental to these communities which are supposed to be served,” Maluleke said.

According to the CEO of the NWCoCI, André Coertzen, it is very clear that many municipalities continue to adopt unfunded budgets and spent money which they don't have. “I cannot understand this attitude that they have. It is like a pie in the sky approach. Nothing is concrete,” Coertzen said. “Where have you seen a company doing a budget

without proper historical facts and figures and taking all factors of the current economy into consideration?” he asked. “There is too much political interference in local government affairs by politicians. Also some of the councillors uses the budgets and the tender system as cash cows,” he added.

“Monies in Ditsobotla, for example, are being used for all things else but service delivery, infrastructure or any other important matter”. He also added that after nearly eight months since the local government elections were held and a new council elected, Ditsobotla, one of the most dysfunctional municipalities in the North West, has not had a proper meeting to discuss and plan critical issues. Only motions of no-confidence and hiring and firing was entertained. “Nearly another year wasted by the new council,” he said. Coertzen also said that in the North West, where politicians interfere, huge disciplinary problems exists with people being suspended left, right and centre without following due processes and non-qualified, inexperienced people being appointment as senior managers and as directors.

Don't fall for phone trick

The latest scheme in Rustenburg is a cell phone (in the ready mode with light activated at night) that motorists will notice in the middle of the street or road while driving. Don't be excited and don't even dare to stop to pick up the phone - this is a scam by unscrupulous people to rob you and possibly to steal your car. Rather look around the area and you will probably notice some people and another vehicle parked not too far away from the "lost" cell phone. These people are simply waiting for you to stop to attack you and who knows what will happen to you - especially after hours or late at night. Be extremely vigilant and don't worry about something such as "lost phones" or similar. No phone is worth losing your life or you vehicle for.



Success: 24 arrested for copper cable theft

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - The fight against tampering with, and damaging of, essential infrastructure gained success when a joint operation by security officers, Crime Intelligence and Rustenburg Visible Policing resulted in the arrest of 24 suspects and discovery of approximately two tons of copper cables which were stolen at the Samancor ventilation shaft along the R104 road in the early hours of Monday (20 June).

According to information received from Brig Sabata Mokgwabone, North West police spokesperson, security officers in Rustenburg spotted a silver double cab Nissan Hardbody V8 vehicle turning onto the R104 road in the vicinity of the ventilation shaft near a townhouse complex. Subsequently, a group of men was seen running in the bushes while firing shots in the direction of the security personnel who called for backup from the police. As a result, a number of suspects were arrested in the bushes and in a hole next to the ventilation shaft while copper cables worth R750 000.00 were seized. All the suspects aged between 18 and 45 were expected to appear before the Rustenburg Magistrates' Court on Wednesday (22 June), facing a charge of tampering with essential infrastructure. Investigation into the matter continues.

The North West Provincial Commissioner, Lieutenant General Sello Kwena lauded the private security company's personnel and all South African Police Service (SAPS) members for their collaboration that led to the success.

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - With South Africa experiencing regular load shedding and regular power outages, Rustenburg’s very own inventor, Kagiso Domingos, from Ledig, just outside of Rustenburg has once again taken his innovation to the next level.

He designed an easy to carry case which could come in handy in dealing with the effects of power cuts. This case, according to Domingos has the potential to produce 220 volts of electricity, enough to power up an entire household. What makes this device special is that during the day it converts direct sunlight into electrical energy, with the aid of a small solar panel fitted to the case. The energy gets stored into a 12 volts battery, and with the aid a coil he is able to convert the stored Direct Current (DC) into Alternating Current (AC), which is conducive for common household electrical appliances.

“The fact that this device is in no way connected to the grid, makes it easier to carry and also it can even supply electricity when there is no sunshine or at night because it stores the energy for later use. While people struggle with power cuts, I am able to do basic things like charging my phone, powering my house or watch television,” Domingos said. “I would like to develop my idea on a large scale so once again I am requesting anyone or any organisation that would like to sponsor me to contact me on 078 754 9248,” said Domingos in an interview with Jabulani Senyatso of the Rustenburg Herald.

Reunion Group reaches out to family

Nazi salute at school investigated - ultimately an educational experience

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - The disciplinary hearing of five learners at Hoërskool Rustenburg who were in the news recently after doing a Nazi salute at a karaoke competition at the school, has been finalised.

“The school governing body maintained throughout that the incident was of a very serious nature. In accordance with the school’s code of conduct for learners the learners were found guilty of unbecoming conduct of a serious nature,” says Mr Bernhard Visser, Chairperson of the SGB.

The governing body also met with the South African Jewish Council of Representatives (SAJCR) about the incident. "The Council requested the school to handle the matter in an educational manner rather than simply punishing learners. This is also the approach of the disciplinary committee of the governing body and the decision about disciplinary action was based on this approach." Visser says the learners involved have written an apology to the Jewish community on behalf of the school. "The governing body is of the opinion that ignorance is not an excuse for behaviour like this. It is the duty of everyone involved in the education of our children to make sure that they understand why their behaviour has an impact on other people."

The five learners will furthermore visit the Holocaust and Genocide Centre in Johannesburg during the third term. Members of the Jewish Council will accompany them and provide guidance. They will also provide the learners and the school with material to continue

the awareness actions. "While specific awareness actions are focused on the learners involved in the incident, the governing body is also committed to creating awareness among the rest of the school about the history represented by certain symbols. The learners will therefore have to prepare a presentation and address the school about their visit to and their experience of the centre." The governing body is satisfied that the incident was investigated properly and that the outcome of the disciplinary process befits the serious nature of the incident.

"An incident that could have caused serious damage to the school's reputation has afforded us the opportunity to equip our learners to look at similar incidents with more understanding." Visser says the governing body has great appreciation for the manner in which the South African Jewish Council of Representatives became involved in the matter. "The Jewish community is directly affected. However, the Council immediately offered their assistance with awareness and has emphasised throughout that the matter be handled in a way that promotes learning and understanding." Visser said the SGB is also satisfied that the school's code of conduct for learners as well as the internal disciplinary processes serve the school's ethos of tolerance and inclusion.

Stepfather sentenced for raping underage stepdaughter

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - A 35-year-old stepfather was sentenced to 18 years imprisonment by the Bafokeng Magistrates' Court on Tuesday (14 June), for raping his 10-year-old stepdaughter.

According to information received from Lt/Col Amanda Funani, North West police spokesperson, the court heard that the accused and his wife were at their place in Boitekong on Saturday, 21 December 2019, when he sent the wife to the tavern to buy more alcohol. He then went to the room where the stepdaughter was sleeping and raped her. The minor

informed her mother about the incident upon return from the tavern and the matter was reported to the police leading to the arrest of the stepfather. Lieutenant General Sello Kwena commended the Rustenburg Family Violence, Child Protection and Sexual Offences (FCS) Unit and prosecution for securing lengthy jail terms against the perpetrator.

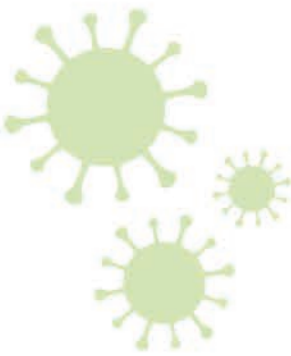



DA: It's about time to lift regulations

RUSTENBURG HERALD – RUSTENBURG - The Democratic Alliance has issued a statement wherein it calls on all the MECs, the Cabinet and President Cyril Ramaphosa to support the Minister of Health, Dr Joe Phaahla's reported recommendations and lift all Covid-19 related health regulations as a matter of urgency.

"We also call on Minister Phaahla to repeal the draft regulations relating to forced vaccinations and forced quarantines that are still up for public comment until 5 August 2022. If the Minister was serious about lifting regulations regarding social distancing and mask wearing it would be nonsensical to bring these other regulations into effect afterwards," said Michele Clarke, the DA's Shadow Minister of Health.

This is after Minister Phaahla allegedly wrote a letter to the MECs in which he notified them of his intention to repeal the current health regulations relating to Covid-19. "The DA has been calling for the lifting of Covid restrictions for months, and while we welcome a decision that would allow South Africa to finally return to normal, the timing of this decision needs to be scrutinized and is rather suspicious," Clarke added.

She said that It can be of no coincidence that this decision has come at a time where Eskom blackouts have started again, the President is dealing with allegations of money laundering at his farm and the delay of the release of the final Zondo report.

"Draconian draft health regulations were gazetted in May to extend permanent control over the South African public. However, the only thing that these rushed regulations achieved was to further burden South African businesses and hamper the economy.

This may never happen again," she concluded.

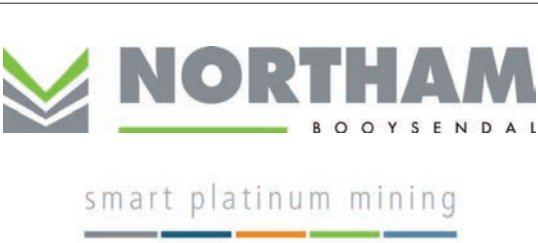

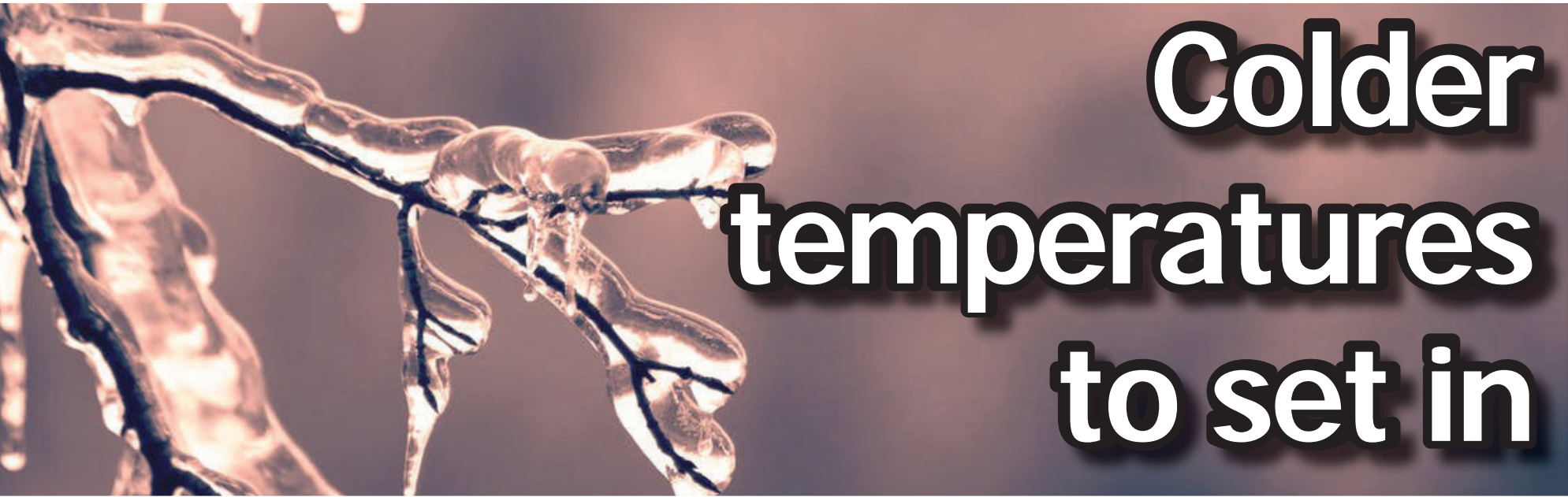

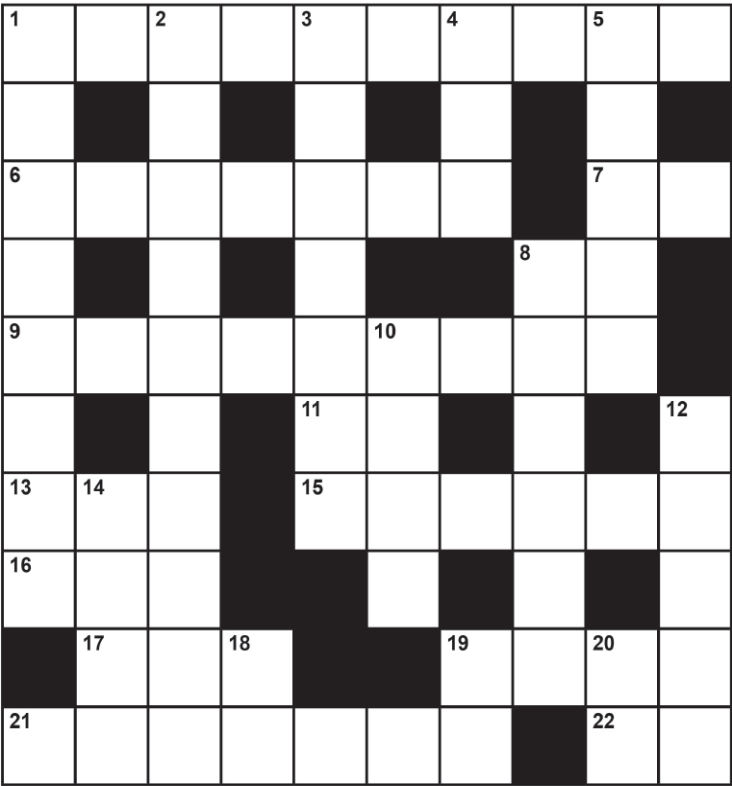

As daar 'n groot hoeveelheid naartjies is, moet jy maar die pot met heelwat water vul en baie geduldig wees. Dit moet maar sterk kook.



Onthou altyd – gelyke hoeveelhede vrugte en suiker en genoeg water om die vrugte met so twee cm te bedek.

Haal daarna die deksel af en kook vir nog 'n uur tot 90 minute. Ons s'n het selfs nog langer geneem omdat ons omtrent agt botteltjies se naartjekwarte gesny het. Kook totdat jou stroop aansienlik verminder het, effentjies "dikkerig" is en stol wanneer jy 'n klein bietjie daarvan in die yskas geplaas het. Verwyder van hitte, laat effens afkoel en bottel terwyl warm.

Ongetemde brandstofprys
'n reuseprobleem

Terwyl daar in baie kringe uiters groot kommer is dat die stad Gqeberha vandeeweeke nog op 'n waterkrisis kan uitloop met krane vir huishoudelike water wat enige dag nou kan leegloop, is daar 'n veel groter krisis wat dag-vir-dag-, maand-vir-maand relatief vinnig besig is om Suid-Afrikaners se lewensstandaard te bedreig en die potensiaal het om die Suid-Afrikaanse ekonomie op sy knieë te dwing. Ja, ons verwys na die brandstofprys wat nou duidelik besig is om met Suid-Afrikaners weg te hardloop en waarvoor daar nie 'n alternatief is nie. Anders as met ons land se watersake en opgaardamme (onthou Kaapstad in 2018) is daar nie ander planne waarmee die regering, provinsiale of plaaslike owerhede vorendag kan kom om die krisis op te los nie. As ons brandstof op 'n dag vir die meeste mense nie meer bekostigbaar is nie, is die skrif aan die muur en gaan die verval van alles waaraan 'n mens kan dink, binne slegs 'n paar dae viervoudig verdubbel indien nie meer nie en gaan dinge vir elke week en elke dag hierna al hoe verder uitmekaar begin val.

Met 'n brandstofprys wat met sy volgende verhoging op 6 Julie met 'n verwagte verdere R2 per liter gaan styg en voortaan gevaarlik naby aan R27 per liter gaan kos, is daar vir derduisende mense in dié land letterlik nie huis te hou nie. Dit raak 'n skrikwekkende scenario wanneer 'n mens begin dink wat gaan gebeur - nee, nie as die pompe begin

leegloop nie - maar wanneer mense brandstof doodeenvoudig nie meer kan bekostig nie. Die eerste ding wat sonder uitsondering op 'n styging in die brandstofprys volg, is 'n styging in prys van alle verbruikersartikels en goedere - wat beteken dat nog 'n verhoging in die brandstofprys 'n sneeubaleffek gaan meebring soos wat nog nie voorheen gesien is nie.

'n Mens wil nie onnodig spoke opjaag nie, maar 'n mens kan nie help om te wonder of die regering die werklike omvang van die dreigende krisis begryp nie. Op die lang termyn, gaan niemand nie, selfs nie eers die heel rykste mense nie - hierdie krisis ontkom nie en kan dit slegs 'n kwessie van tyd wees voordat die ratte van die spreekwoordelike nywerheid tot stilstand knars. Die ineenstorting van SpoorNet dekades gelede en die regering se futiele of halfhartige pogings om die trotste Suid-Afrikaanse spoorvragvervoernetwerk in stand te hou of uit te brei, sal een van baie "mylpale" wees wat betreur gaan word wanneer 'n onbekostigbare brandstofprys die stadium bereik dat dit 'n versmorende effek op die een na die ander Suid-Afrikaanse nywerheid veroorsaak. As daar ooit in die SA-geskiedenis 'n goeie tyd was dat slim mense met visie onmiddellik die koppe bymekaar sit om 'n dreigende brandstofkrisis die hoof te bied, is dit nou - kom ons kyk met watter inisiatiewe die regering vorendag kan kom.

Uncontrolled fuel price
an increasing crisis

While a water crisis is playing out in Gqeberha with domestic and public water installations in danger of running dry within days, South Africans should begin to brace themselves for a threat of unprecedented extent that is growing by the day. This however, could be a crisis that the South African government or communities around the country will find very difficult to contain once it has reached a certain point on the yardstick.

Yes, of course we are referring to the South African fuel price which is slowly but surely, or on the contrary in fact, quite quickly running away with South African consumers. Contrary to the country's water affairs and reservoirs (remember Cape Town in 2018) there is very little that government, provincial or local governments can do about a situation that has the potential to increasingly threaten the livelihood of millions of South Africans with every passing day. With the cost of fuel which will be hovering dangerously close to R27 per liter after the latest increase which is expected on 6 July (apparently by another R2 per liter) millions of commuters and office workers in the country could be in danger of becoming stuck or grounded simply because of fuel becoming unaffordable.

Furthermore, history has shown us that an increase in the fuel prize invariably goes hand in hand with an increase in price of practically each and every commodity or consumer item one can think of. To make matters worse, an unaffordable fuel prize will almost immediately circle out to have a detrimental effect on industries influenced by the fuel prize and will cause a snowball effect that hasn't been seen in this country for a very long time.

It is not our intention to cause panic, but since recently one has to wonder whether our government is fully aware of the plight of millions of South Africans who are depending on daily transport or the cost of transport to make an honest living. On the long run, practically no one in the country, not even the richest people around, will be able to escape the effect of collapsing industries.

It is in times like these that the collapse of SpoorNet a decade or two ago could become regrettable milestones in the history of a failing state and all that goes with it. If ever there were a time for South African visionaries to put their heads together and to devise a workable plan of action, that time has finally dawned upon us. Let us see what government can come up with.

ARCHITECTURAL SERVICES RENDERED IN RESIDENTIAL ESTATES

In the past few years, the Competition Commission and the South African Council for the Architectural Profession (SACAP) have received multiple complaints from residents and registered professionals in the architectural profession against various residential estates countrywide. The complaints allege that Homeowner Associations and/or Body Corporates are setting rules and regulations that allow only Professional Architects ("PrArch") to design plans for residents, thereby preventing all other architectural professionals such as Draughtspersons, Technologists or Senior Technologists from providing architectural services in those residential estates. These rules and regulations disregard the fact that persons registered with SACAP under these professional categories are qualified and competent to undertake designs and prepare plans in terms of the Architectural Profession Act No. 44 of 2000 and as prescribed by the Identification of Work policy ("IDoW"). The rules and regulations by Homeowner Associations and/or Body Corporates have the potential effect of substantially limiting competition in the market in possible contravention of sections 8(c) and 5(1) of the Competition Act. No. 89 of 1998, as amended.

The Competition Commission and the SACAP have, in February 2022, issued a joint circular on **"The Anti-Competitive Effects of Rules and Regulations by Homeowner Associations and/or Body Corporates on Architectural Services Rendered in Residential Estates"**.

Why the Competition Commission and SACAP have issued a Circular:

The purpose of the circular is to promote estate and body corporate rules that are fair and that enable service providers across the various categories of registration to compete and participate in the market for architectural services, for the benefit of consumers. In the circular, the Competition Commission and SACAP advise Homeowner Associations and/or Body Corporates to:

- (i) comply with the provisions of the Competition Act and to refrain from engaging in conduct that has the effect of significantly preventing or lessening competition in the market;
- (ii) ensure that their rules and regulations comply with the provisions of the Competition Act and encourage equitable and fair competition;

- (iii) apply SACAP's IDoW policy as is prescribed;
- (iv) ensure that they follow a competitive and inclusive process if they wish to select a pool of Architectural Professionals to provide architectural services in the residential estates; and
- (v) limit the duration of the contractual period of Architectural Professionals appointed on their panels.

This circular applies to Homeowner Associations and/or Body Corporates of all residential estates within the Republic of South Africa. The Commission will not hesitate to prosecute those that engage in practices that contravene the Competition Act. Homeowner Associations and/or Body Corporates are therefore required to ensure compliance with this circular and that their rules and regulations do not infringe any of the provisions of the Competition Act.

Teen die einde was daar net twee spanne oor - en albei was van Suid-Afrika.

Die eerste URC-eindstryd is die afgelope naweek beslis. Die Bulle uit die noorde en die Stormers uit die suide het mekaar die stryd in Kaapstad aangesê en, alhoewel één van die spanne moes wen, was die troos dat dit ten minste 'n Suid-Afrikaanse vertoonkas sou wees waarin die trofee sal pryk.

Daarna was dit asof die tuisspan meer op hul hoede was en nie soos gewoonlik die bal wyd gespeel het nie. Hulle het eerder die Bulle voor aangevat en gehoop dat daar foute sal wees om uit te buit. 'n Groot gedeelte van die eerste helfte het ook bestaan uit skop vir gebiedsvoordeel, maar die Bulle se Kurt-Lee Arendse het telkens die Stormers se planne in die wiele gery met sy behendigheid onder die hoë bal.

Alhoewel dit gelyk het asof die Bulle so effens die oorhand gehad het, het hul egter ook leemtes gehad en kon net nie daarin slaag om hul stempel op die wedstryd af te druk nie.

Die Stormers het egter hul nie-so-geheime wapen, Deon Fourie, geaktiveer en dié man - wat in sy 100ste wedstryd

vir die Streeptruie gespeel het - het sy hart deur en deur uitgespeel. Dis dan ook as gevolg van sy harde werk wat hulle kort voor rustyd 'n strafskop verdien het nadat 'n losgemaak skeefgeloop het.

Manie Libbock se skop was oor en die tuisspan het eindelijk drie punte op die telbord gehad.

Na rustyd het die Bulle hul voorsprong vergroot nadat loskakel Chris Smith met 'n strafskop geslaag het. Smith het weer met 'n strafskop geslaag om die Bulle met slegs twee punte agter te laat loop, maar toe kom Libbock en wys daar loop ys in sy are! Met enkele minute op die horlosie oor het hy 'n skepskop sekuur oor die dwarslat gestuur om die telling 18-13 te maak.

Arendse het in die doodsnikke probeer om vir die Bulle 'n wen te bewerkstellig, maar die poging het as gevolg van gebrek aan ondersteuning skipbreuk gely.

Na afloop van die wedstryd was daar - soos te wagte - kritiek teenoor die skeidsregter, maar dit verander nie aan die feit dat die URC-trofee sy staan by die Stormers gekry het nie.
