SANRAL in row over construction contracts

RUSTENBURG HERALD - CAPE TOWN - The Chairman of the South African benefit alongside the well-established National Roads Agency SOC Limited (SANRAL), Mr Themba Mhambi, says court action by major construction companies will not deter SANRAL from pursuing transformation of the sector.

Speaking at an event outside Cape Town on Friday night, the SANRAL Chairman said South Africa's biggest construction companies had long benefited from multibillion rand tenders and it was time for them to share with small- and mediumsized industry players.

Mr Mhambi says SANRAL, contrary to media reports, does not want to destroy the major construction companies but will support and strengthen them while also pushing them to transform. "We are going to damage SANRAL if we destrov the big construction companies we have in South Africa, like WBHO, Murray and Roberts, Haw and Inglis (H&I), and so on. If we destroy them, we will be destroying SANRAL and South Africa," said Mr Mhambi. "Therefore, don't believe all the lies that are told that we want to kill these construction companies.

We don't want to do that. We want to support them, we want to strengthen them to get more business but there is one condition and that condition is that they must understand that South Africa belongs to all who live in it, black and white," said Mr Mhambi. Mr Mhambi stressed that it is time for black South Africans - Africans, Indians and Coloureds - who had previously been excluded from benefiting from massive infrastructure projects to

industry players.

'Those people who have in the past been excluded from benefiting from road construction, bridge building, pavements, manufacturing of guard rails, the production of asphalt – those who have been excluded from benefiting from all those things – must now benefit as well.

That is the condition. And that condition does not come from anywhere other than the Constitution of SA.

Mr Mhambi's remarks come after some of the country's biggest construction companies sought court interdicts against SANRAL to stop new construction tenders from being issued using the roads agency's new Preferential Procurement Policy (PPP), which requires big companies to share significant portions of the work with smaller players.

"When these millionaire and billionaire companies say to us 'we are going to take you to court SANRAL because you are depriving us of the millions and billions that we are making alone'

I understand them, because you can't be a millionaire or billionaire by sharing. They are going to resist sharing.

Latest Operation Shanela successes

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - Operation Shanela remains steadfast in stabilising crime in the province.

multi-disciplinary high operations conducted between 21 and 24 September 2023, with emphasis on the reduction of contact crimes and property related crimes in hotspot areas.

Actions executed over the weekend culminated in the arrest of 664 suspects for different offences.

The arrested suspects amongst others, included 9 for rape, 89 for assault with the intent to do grievous bodily harm (GBH), 53 for assault common, 17 for robbery aggravating, 23 for driving under the influence of alcohol drugs, 8 for illegal dealing in liquor, for burglaries at business premises, 22 for possession of drugs and 16 for dealing in

During the operations and execution of various actions, 4 372 persons and 2 049 vehicles were searched. The operation also led to the inspection of 116 licensed liquor premises, 20 second-hand goods dealers and fourteen

recyclers /scrapyards. Furthermore, 8 unlicensed liquor premises were closed, while 35 suspected undocumented foreign nationals were taken in for processing by Immigration Officials.

The following items were confiscated during the operations: Liquor, Various drugs (Crystal Meth, Mandrax and Nyaope)

Four cell phones, 11 firearms.

In one of the operations conducted in Bojanala Platinum Sub-District 1(Brits), police in Mooinooi arrested two suspect September for the possession imitation firearm, different types of cigarettes and three cellphones.

The police cannot rule out the possibility of linking the pair with business robberies in Brits and Mooinooi.

The two suspects are expected to appear in the Brits Magistrates' Court soon on a charge of business robbery.

10 suspected multi-criminals arrested

RUSTENBURG HERALD - TLHABANE - Ten men suspected of multiple crimes were arrested at Yizo-Yizo, Tlhabane last week.

The group were arrested during an operation by a multidisciplinary team comprising of Rustenburg Crime Intelligence, Thabane Visible Policing, District Crime Combating Unit, Bafokeng Reaction Force and and private security. The ten are suspected of being part of a criminal group terrorizing the community of Yizo-Yizo.

Four of the 10 were arrested on charges of the possession of drugs, while six others were nabbed for robbery with a weapon other than firearm, business robbery, attempted murder, theft out of / from motor vehicle, possession of suspected stolen property, as well as burglary business and residential.

All the suspects appeared before the Bafokeng Magistrates' Court in Tlhabane on Friday, 22 September. Six of them were remanded in custody and are expected to reappear before the court between 26 and 28 September again.

Cases of dealing drugs against four accused, were provisionally withdrawn pending forensic laboratory results.

The investigation into the allegations against the suspects continues.

Peermont pledges R500 Million investment into Rustenburg hotel development

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - Gaming and Hospitality industry leaders Peermont pledged to invest R500 million into the rehabilitatin of the North West Province at the investor dinner held on 15 September at Sun City.

Phase 1 of the basic refurbishment work to reinstate the hotel is currently underway. Peermont has also applied to relocate the Mmabatho Palms gaming licence to Rustenburg where the R500 million investment will go towards setting up a new hotel casino resort which would greatly benefit the Platinum Province and ensure the long term sustainability of the Mmabatho Palms, which, without support from the Rustenburg project, is

licence to Rustenburg as there is a lot of potential for growth and creating employment,' says Peermont Chief Executive Officer, Nigel Atherton. 'And by pledging R500 million to this project we demonstrate our dedication to the long-term sustainability the historic Mmabatho Palms and growing the hospitality and gaming industry in the North West Province.'







Erfenisdag moet dalk heroorweeg word

Having so many teams gives more players the opportunity to play competitive netball. In 2022, teams from the school finished first or second in several provincial leagues.

The President of the Netball South Africa, Cecilia Molokwane, expresses the importance of the tournament and the positive impact it plays for netball in South Africa.

Netball South Africa Vice President and tournament director Mami Diale said Hoërskool Rustenburg was an ideal venue for the national championships. Tickets for the games will be available at the venue – R20 for adults and R10 for children. Selected matches will be broadcast live on SuperSport Variety 4/Channel 209 (2-7 October).
