After more than two months and 20 days, workers on Tuesday morning of this week began the long-awaited process of resealing of the asphalt road surface in Arend Avenue since the notorious Arend Avenue Sewerage Disaster brought traffic to a standstill and frustrated residents to the brink of despair following a sewerage burst on 26 January 2023. Road closure to finalise this final phase of the project, might be scheduled for Saturday, 22 April, if necessary, Rustenburg Herald was told. For the residents of upmarket Rockcliff Estate the wait to have access to Cuckoo Avenue (top photo) from an eastern direction, has been considerably longer since a cloud burst have washed away various causeways and small bridges in Rustenburg on Friday, 9 December 2022. We must state that, whereas for RLM 29.5% of the allocated amount was spent at 31 December 2022, by 31 March 2023 expenditure stood at 62% of the total allocation.

As regards to the Neighbourhood Development Partnership Grant (NDPG), non-performance does not result from inability to spend, but rather from the improper allocation by National Treasury

The RLM can confirm that a total of R65 itself. In this instance, whereas the municipality requested a total of R30.3 million for the widening of Marikana Road (D1325) in Central Business District, National Treasury only made a commitment of R2 million. With a R28.3 million shortfall, the municipality could not proceed with project implementation.

THEFT: Man to apply for bail **RUSTENBURG**

R9 MILLION

RUSTENBURG - The Rustenburg Magistrates' Court adjourned the case against Evan Mutale (44), to 19 April for a formal bail application and for his case to be transferred to the Specialised Commercial Crimes Court.

Mutale is facing 21 charges of fraud and three alternative charges of money laundering.

His court appearance comes after his arrest by the SAPS' Provincial Commercial Crime Unit on 12 April. He was charged with stealing over R5 million from Jaira Constructions and Projects, where Mutale was employed as an accountant, responsible for managing accounts, payroll, and loading

It is alleged that between September 2019 and November 2020, Mutale fraudulently transferred money into an account belonging to an individual who has no links to the company but is known to him. These transactions were allegedly done under the pretense of paying a service provider for services rendered to the company. In the process, he deceived his supervisor to make final authorisations for money to be transferred into his accomplice's bank account.

Investigations revealed that some of this money was later transferred to his bank account, as such constituted for the state to charge him with money laundering. Police are not ruling out the possibility of making more arrests. Mutale will remain in police custody until the next court appearance and the state intends to oppose his bail application.

The Director of Public Prosecutions in the North West, Dr. Rachel Makhari, as well as the North West Provincial Commissioner, Lieutenant General Sello Kwena, expressed their gratitude for the productive collaboration between the prosecution team led by Adv Bongani Chauke and Brigadier Pharasa Ncube from the SAPS.






FOOD SECURITY














Rustenburg dalk binnekort 'n "metro" - meer geld vir raadslede?

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - Die Munisipale Afbakeningsraad (Municipal aangeneem het nie en dat die dorp op die oog af Demarcation Board - MDB) in die Noordwes-provinsie is wyd gekritiseer oor sy planne om verskeie onderpresterende munisipaliteite in dele van Noordwes by die groter Rustenburgse Munisipaliteit in te lvf.

Voortploeterende munisipaliteite SOOS Kgetlengrivier (Koster, Derby en Swartruggens) asook dele van Madibeng (Brits, Hartbeespoort en Mooinooi) is onder dié wat vir inlywing by die RLM bestem is in 'n stap wat in amptelike terme daarop gemik is om beter munisipale dienslewering te bewerkstellig.

Die Afbakeningsraad het sy voorneme met behulp van 'n kennisgewing in die Daily Sun ('n publikasie wat kwalik enigiemand in Rustenburg gereeld onder oë kry) van 8 Maart 2023 bekend gemaak. Die sperdatum vir besware is boonop onbillik kort naamlik 27 April 2023 (boonop 'n vakansiedag - Vryheidsdag). Vir inwoners van die Kgetlengrivier- en Madibeng-munisipaliteite is dit geen geheim nie dat hul gemeenskappe die afgelope minstens 10 jaar al knaend in die nuus is oor die gebrek in munisipale dienste en/of die ineenstorting van noodsaaklike infrastruktuur.

In die meeste van hierdie gevalle, veral in Kgetlengrivier - het dit weke of selfs maande geduur voordat dienste hervat kon word en infrastruktuur herstel is. Of hierdie tekortkominge voortaan onder die vaandel van die RLM gaan verbeter, is sterk te betwyfel.

inwoners van die Rustenburgse Munisipaliteit is daar betreklik min om na uit te sien. Inwoners kan nie opgewonde wees oor die feit dat dit hoofsaaklik bankrot munisipaliteite is wat nou deel van Rustenburg Munisipaliteit se verantwoordelikhede gaan word nie, terwyl Rustenburgse inwoners jare lank al kla oor verslegtende munisipale dienste. Talle inwoners is van mening dat dienslewering in Rustenburg nog nooit voorheen sulke skokkende afmetings

op die randjie van bankrotskap huiwer. Daar is boonop talle kwessies van beweerde korrupsie wat na jare steeds onaangespreek bly - onder meer die sogenaamde "Yellow Fleet" debakel waarvan ondersoeke nou al gevaarlik naby aan vyf jaar sloer.

Die veelgeroemde Rustenburg Rapid Transport projek staan egter kop en skouers uit as 'n projek wat 'n hopelose mislukking was maar wat miljarde rand gekos het en waarvoor daar 'n skrale kans is vir 'n behoorlike ondersoek en onafhanklike oudits. Dan is die grootste enkele vraagstuk in die geledere van die Rustenburgse Munisipaliteit die feit dat 'n kultuur van wanbetaling in verskeie van sy informele woonbuurte vir jare al heers met 'n agterstand wat tot dusver al tot naby die R4 milhard aangegroei het. "Die waarheid agter die stap is dat die ANC hoop om weer 'n volstrekte meerderheid in die munisipale raad van die RLM te bewerkstellig veral in die lig van aanstaande jaar se nasionale verkiesing en natuurlik, die volgende rondte munisipale verkiesings. Vir raadslede van die RLM is daar egter bewese voordeel - 'n vergrote munisipale gebied bring uiteraard voordele soos 'n verhoogde salarispakket aan raadslede, het De Wet Nel van die VF Plus en lid van die Provinsiale Wetgewer gesê. "Hierdie word natuurlik as 'n rede gesien hoekom geen ander politieke party behalwe die VF Plus teen die voorgenome inlywing beswaar gemaak het nie. "Die VF Plus is hard agter die skerms aan die werk om seker te maak dat hierdie onderduimse planne nie deurgevoer word nie. Baie mense het reeds beswaar gemaak en beswaarvorms word op daaglikse basis by ons kantore afgehaal.

N4 murder: reward offered

RUSTENBURG HERALD RUSTENBURG - The family of a young dad shot and killed on the N4 last year is offering R100 000 as a reward for valuable information.

Juandré Kidson was killed by highway robbers on 7 May 2022.

"Please, if you have any information about the shooting that killed my brother, come forward," Marco Kidson of Rustenburg is pleading with the community.

The Kidson family is desperate for answers after Juandré's death a year ago..

Juandré, his wife Johanette and their one-year-old baby daughter, Annabelle was travelling home from Rustenburg to Brits on that Saturday night.

Near the R512 Randburg off-ramp, around 21:00, their Hyundai Santa Fe hit rocks that were placed across the road and a tyre was punctured. Juandré drove on, but had no other option than to pull off the road to change the tyre. While he was busy, three men approached him.

"My brother told the men that they can take everything they had with them. He pleaded with them not to hurt them. And then they shot him in the head," Marco said.

The robbers then shot Johanette in the shoulder while she was trying to shield her baby and prevent the men from grabbing the child out of her arms.

Police killer sentenced to life imprisonment

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - Thabo Motaung (40) was sentenced to life imprisonment when he appeared before the Rustenburg Regional Court on Monday (17 April).

Motaung was arrested on 30 November

The accused was involved in a business robbery that took place in Marikana where he and others robbed a shop.

Whilst members of Marikana Crime Prevention were following up on leads regarding the incident of business robbery that had occurred a few days earlier, they spotted the accused and others at an informal settlement in Marikana. When they approached the group, they were met with gunshots. A shootout ensued resulting in the fatal killing of a police officer and the subsequent arrest of the shooter. A Norinco 9mm firearm and ammunition was seized for further investigation.

The matter was taken over by Directorate for Priority Crime Investigation and the accused made his first appearance in court where he was remanded in custody until his conviction.

Motaung was sentenced to life imprisonment for murder, seven years imprisonment for unlawful possession of a firearm, five years imprisonment for unlawful possession of ammunition, two vears imprisonment for discharging a firearm and twelve months imprisonment for being an illegal immigrant.

Rustenburgers om die bos gelei

Die planne van die Munisipale Afbakeningsraad van Noordwes om verskeie "kleiner" munisipaliteite in die provinsie by groter munisipaliteite ingelyf te kry, kan van meet af as niks anders as onderduims beskryf word nie. Dié gevolgtrekking kan ook nie as ongevraagd of onregverdig bestempel word nie, gegewe die wyse waarop die Afbakeningsraad gepoog het om Rustenburgse inwoners 'n rat voor die oë te draai deur sy strategie só beplan het dat mense wat eerstehands deur die inlywing van kleiner dorpies geraak en sekerlik negatief geaffekteer sou gaan word, eers so laat as moontlik van die Raad se planne bewus sou kon word.

Vir diegene wat nou nog nie die kloutjie by die oor kon bring nie, die volgende: In 'n kennisgewing in die Daily Sun (Johannesburg) - 'n publikasie wat sekerlik nie eers 0.3% van Rustenburg se koerantlesers ooit onder oë kry nie, het die Munisipale Afbakeningsraad van Noordwes (MDB) op 8 Maart 2023 kennis gegee van sy planne om kleiner, meestal onderpresterende munisipaliteite in Noordwes, soos Kgetlengrivier (Koster, Derby en Swartruggens) asook sekere munisipaliteite in Madibeng (Brits, Hartbeespoort en sekere areas van Mooinooi) by die Rustenburgse Munisipaliteit in te lyf.

Hoewel die presiese rede vir die plan nêrens pertinent genoem word nie, maak die Raad skynbaar staat op inwoners se naïwe aanname dat die stap oorweeg word om beter dienslewering by genoemde klein munisipaliteite te bewerkstellig. Die eintlike rede vir die stap blyk egter daarop gemik te wees ten einde die ANC in die Rustenburgse Munisipaliteit weer 'n volstrekte meerderheid te gee - iets wat die ANC die laaste jaar of twee reeds nie sonder die steun van kleiner faksiepartye kon vermag nie. Maar dit is nie hier waar dit ophou nie.

Vir 'n groter-wordende munisipaliteit, soos Rustenburg in so 'n geval, sou sy 'n groter, bykans "metrostatus" vir al sy raadslede 'n beduidende verhoging in salarispakket beteken. 'n Mens hoef dus nie te wonder hoekom bykans geen politieke party benewens die VF Plus teen so 'n voorstel beswaar gemaak het nie. (Sien berig hieroor elders in hierdie uitgawe).

Rustenburgers met hul vingers op die pols van ook maar nie veel meer as 'n onderpresterende dorpie nie - sal egter nouliks dwaas genoeg wees om te reken dat dié stap vir Rustenburg hoegenaamd enige voordeel sal bring, benewens die feit dat die snytjies van die koek veel dunner gaan word omdat soveel meer mense nou skielik by die feestafel gaan aansit. Enige vermoede dat die Afbakeningsraad onderduims was met sy planne word eenvoudig beaam deur die feit dat 'n hopeloos-onbillike, veels te kort tydperk vir besware afgekondig is - boonop met die laaste dag op 27 April - 'n openbare vakansiedag (Vryheidsdag) vir die mense wat dalk vergeet het soos wat die konkelaars heimlik gehoop het. En om te dink hoe maklik dit vir enige party wat inderdaad sy sout werd was, sou wees om sy greep op die goue septer te behou.

Seker maar dié dat daar nie nou tyd of geld is om Rustenburg in stand te hou nie - die uitmekaarvallende ANC moet sekerlik tog eerste gered word?

Rate payers deceived by MDB

From the very outset the plans of the Municipal Demarcation Board in North West (MDB) to incorporate several small, under performing municipalities with other independent municipalities, can be described as nothing else but underhandedness. In addition this assumption can in no way be disregarded as unjustified or unasked for, given the fact that the MDB clearly attempted to throw dust into the eyes of Rustenburg residents by keeping them in the dark for as long as possible.

For people who have perhaps missed this ploy of the MDB, the following might be interesting: In a notice in the Daily Sun of 8 March 2023, - a Johannesburg publication which is hardly read by more than 0.3% of Rustenburg residents, the MDB in North West has announced its plans to incorporate small, under performing municipalities such as Kgetlengrivier (Koster, Derby and Swartruggens) and Madibeng (Brits, Hartbeespoort and certain areas of Mooinooi) with the Rustenburg Local Municipality. With no particular reasons given for the proposal. the MDB may hope that Rustenburg rate payers will assume that the move has been aimed at better service delivery in these municipalities, not to mention Rustenburg. Much closer to the truth however, is the fact that the ANC in the Rustenburg Municipality clearly hopes to regain a outright majority in the RLM - a feat it has

achieved only with the help of smaller faction parties in recent times.

But more importantly however, the unsaid truth is that a promotion in status and bigger "metro" will of course mean considerably higher salaries for all Councillors of the Rustenburg Municipality. Should anyone then wonder why not a single political party but the VF Plus has dared to oppose the proposed move? (See article in Rustenburg Herald elsewhere in this edition). Rustenburg rate payers surely would not be fooled into thinking that the incorporation of a number of smaller, insignificant municipalities with Rustenburg would bring anything meaningful to the RLM. It is only logical that the slices of (still) the same cake would now only be much thinner and smaller, since so many new faces will now also be seated at the table.

Any suspicion that the MDB was underhanded in its approach to the issue, is clearly confirmed by the hopelessly short, unreasonable period allowed for objections with the deadline already on 27 April 2023 - a public holiday (Freedom Day) and a day which most South Africans would hopefully forget, the conspirators might have bargained.

To think how easy it could have been for any party worth its salt to cling to a majority in Council by doing what it is supposed to be doing - nothing more, nothing less!

Mentoring certification is now mandatory for mining engineers

BUT THIS IS NOT A BAD THING

RUSTENBURG - As of January 2023, the Mine Engineer's Certificate of Competency requires a mentor to possess certification from an accredited institution, and proof that at least five engineers in training are being mentored, in addition to other requirements.

However, while this may be viewed as another hurdle in achieving certification, it can be hugely beneficial, not just for engineers themselves but for mines as well. Embracing this new requirement as a positive can make all the difference in shifting mindsets and can help mining engineers further their careers and mines to improve efficiency, productivity, and safety in the long-term.

Meeting with resistance

While mentorship has now become one of the criteria for competency certification, many engineers remain reluctant to pursue mentorship skills. Reasons for this include a lack of time for additional responsibilities like mentoring, as well as a lack of incentive or reward for pursuing these goals. There is also a lack of training to contend with, as mining engineers may not have received formal mentoring training, leaving them feeling ill-equipped to take on the role. This shift represents a change in the way things have always been done, so resistance to this change as well as fear of making mistakes or giving bad advice could hold them back.

Addressing these challenges requires mining organisations to get on board with incentives and recognition for mentors, as well as training and support for mentoring skills development.

The goal should be to create a culture that values mentoring and encourages engineers to take on the role of a mentor. This will not only aid in achieving the requirements for certification, but will also create an environment that encourages learning and development, which will benefit both the organisation and its employees.

Why mentoring skills are important

Mentoring is a critical element in effective skills transfer, helping the next generation of mining professionals to benefit from the knowledge and experience that exists within the organisation. This helps mines to develop a pipeline of talent to improve business continuity. It also assists with enhancing job performance all around, as mentoring can identify areas for improvement and then goals can be set and plans developed to achieve these

goals. Effective mentors are empowered to provide guidance and support to help engineers overcome challenges, learn new skills, and achieve their full potential. But these skills can also help mining engineers themselves by developing leadership skills, including communication, listening and problem-solving, which are essential management skills and important for job progression. Having effective skills in these areas can enhance job satisfaction and enhance both personal and professional growth.

Mentoring can expose mining engineers to different perspectives and ways of thinking, which can broaden their horizons and enhance their creativity and innovation, ultimately benefiting their careers as well as the productivity of the mines. These skills also help build professional networks and relationships that can provide valuable insights, advice, and opportunities for career advancement.

Accredited providers can simplify training processes

Having the right skills around mentoring can help mining engineers become more effective, resulting in satisfied employees, but the fact remains that a certificate of competency is now also a requirement for the Mine Engineer Certificate of Competency. This must also be awarded by an accredited provider.

In die 200m het hy 'n tyd van 1:56.66 aangeteken - wat hom tans die vyfde beste swemmer ter wêreld oor dié afstand in hierdie item maak.
