SA women miners join hands to advocate for gender equality in the mining industry

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - The mining industry has long been needed convenience for women particularly recognised as a male-dominated field with women historically underrepresented in various roles.

However, as we move towards a more inclusive and equitable society it is crucial to recognise the importance of empowering women in the mining industry and creating an enabling environment that motivates and encourages their success.

This was the core focus of an "International Day of Women in Mining" on 15 June when Glencore Ferroallovs hosted a Women in Mining (WIM) conference under the theme "We work for our success". The event's mission was to commemorate women and the vital role they play in the mining industry while advocating for gender equality. This event was a resounding success.

Representatives from Department of Mineral Resources and Energy (DMRE), Minerals Council South Africa, Mine Health and Safety Council, Glencore representatives from different operations including senior management, as well as legendary actress and businesswoman Sophie Ndaba were in attendance. The event focused on engaging in thought-provoking discourse that highlighted the need to prioritise women's safety and well-being within the mining industry. The conversations unpacked the

gender-based violence. To further bring these issues to light, the Minerals Council's Deputy Safety & Sustainable Development Department Manager, Lerato Tsele, highlighted the Mine

challenges faced by women in mining such

as, suitable PPE, the safety of women on the

mines, mental health, as well as the threat of

Health and Safety Act, which is currently under amendment. The amendments will include guidelines that will make it mandatory for all mining organisations to comply with the Code of Good Practice with regards to making available differently designed PPE to accommodate the different body-types of women in mining.

"The mining industry currently employs 72 500 female mine workers, a great improvement from where it comes from. Despite this, there is still a long way to go. There is a huge focus and efforts to ensure gender equality in the workplace. Technology is utilised to assist with the heavy-load tasks in the workplace, which will ultimately improve safety and health," said Tsele.

In May 2022, Glencore launched its WiM Forum, which is made up of committees from each of its nine operations. The commitees are mandated to come up with solutions for women's safety and advocate for gender

"We exist because of the women in our organisation. Our purpose is to create inclusive spaces to ensure we unlock the immense potential that women bring into the mining industry. This is only the beginning. and we look forward to witnessing the incredible journey of each and every woman playing their part to help revolutionise the industry for future women miners," said Molelekeng.

Senior Health and Safety Inspector of Mines, Omphemetse Phefo from the Department of Mineral Resources and Energy (DMRE), made it clear that her mandate is to ensure zero harm in the industry. She stated the importance of equipping and empowering women with the necessary resources to ensure that they are safe at all times regardless of their environment.

Sophie Ndaba encouraged the women to make use of the opportunities at their disposal and empower others.

"I am inspired everyday by women who work for their success, for there is no one who can do that for you besides yourself.

Be encouraged and surround yourself with people whom you can learn from for they can help you grow. Grab on to knowledge and let it build and guide you on your way to the top," concluded Ndaba.

The conference is set to be held annually as a key platform to track the progress of the WiM Forum's mission and to fast-track inclusion safety for women in Glencore Ferroalloys

SARS warns of new scam targeting taxpayers

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - The South Africa Revenue Service (SARS) has warned South Africans to be wary of a new scam targeting taxpayers.

According to the taxman, the new scam bank account details which the criminals criminals posing as authorities from the South African Police Services (SAPS) financial crimes unit. The email is titled 'Internal Communication' from a fake Department of International Relations and Cooperation (DIRCO) email domain.

It asks the email recipient to click on a fraudulent link to verify their identity. SARS has urged taxpayers not to click on any links and delete the email. SARS frequently reports on and updates its comprehensive list of over 300 scams trying to exploit the tax authority's name.

The latest scam forms part of the exhaustive list of phishing scams targeting vulnerable taxpayers. Under this specific type of scam, members of the public are randomly emailed with false 'spoofed' emails made to look as if these emails were sent from SARS but are actually fraudulent. Their primary goal is to obtain sensitive personal information from a victim for monetary gain. "These emails contain links to false forms and fake websites made to look like the "real entering personal information such as

doing the rounds comes as an email from then extract and use fraudulently," SARS

SARS has further provided the following advice as to what to keep an eye out for: Do not open or respond to emails

from unknown sources. Beware of emails that ask for personal, tax, banking and eFiling details (login credentials, passwords, pins, credit/debit

card information, etc.). * SARS will never request your banking details in any communication that you receive via post, email, or SMS. However, for the purpose of telephonic engagement and authentication purposes, SARS will verify your personal details. Importantly, SARS will not send you any hyperlinks to other websites - even those of banks.

Beware of false SMSs. SARS does not send *.htm or *.html attachments.

SARS will never ask for your credit card details.

Contact your local SARS office with your SARS number ready if you have any doubts about the authenticity of thing", but intending to fool people into documents or messages that you have

Salted caramel "churros"

Ingredients:

1 cup all-purpose flour 113 g baking Margarine/butter

1 cup of water (250 ml)

Pinch of salt

2 tsp sugar

3 eggs

Oil for frying

For dusting - 80 ml sugar and 2 ml cinnamon

Place water, butter, sugar and a pinch of salt into a medium size sauce pan. Bring to boil. Add the flour and mix vigorously until well blended (the dough will come together in a minute or two).

Remove from the stove and let it cool a bit. Once it has cooled, add the eggs (otherwise the eggs will be cooked) and work it into the dough. Try to do this as fast as possible - at the beginning it might look like the churro dough doesn't want to bind but take your time - it will.

Pour the oil into a large frying pan/pot and heat it up. Fill a piping bag fitted with a star piping tip with half of the dough (it is easier to handle). Check if the oil is ready for frying by dropping a tiny piece of the dough in the oil. If the dough turns nicely brown you are ready to pipe the churros in.

Pipe the dough directly into the hot oil (choose any length you like) and cut with a fork or kitchen scissors. Do not pipe too many churros in as they need a little space for frying. It will take only about 2 minutes for them to turn into a lovely golden colour which means they are ready. They should turn to gold evenly and gradually - if you note that

they are not turning gold evenly, reduce the temperature. Remove churros from oil and place on a paper towel to drain of excess oil. When they are still warm, roll each of them in sugar mixed with ground cinnamon mixture. You can either serve the churros with thick hot chocolate and/ or a salted caramel sauce which you prepare as follows:

Salted caramel sauce:

1 cup sugar

6 tablespoons butter, diced

½ cup double cream

Tsp salt

In a medium-size saucepan over medium heat, melt the sugar. Stir constantly with a rubber spatula, scrapping the sides as you go. Once the sugar melts and turns golden brown, add the butter until melted. Pour in double cream and bring to a simmer without increasing the heat. Simmer for 90 seconds. Remove from heat and stir in salt. Pour mixture into small mug and pour over churros before

Groot name vir klein dorpie teen die berghange

Vandeesweek en wel eerskomende Saterdag, 1 Julie, skop een van die grootste jaarlikse sportgebeurtenisse in die wêreld van fietsry in Bilbao. Spanie af wanneer die wiele vir die 110de keer in die geskiedenis van die Tour de France begin draai. Vir mense wat nie noodwendig vreeslik belang by die TDF het nie, is dit dalk nuus dat die wêreldbekende fietsryer Louis Meintjes wat vanjaar vir die sesde keer aan die TDF deelneem, 'n voormalige Rustenburger is wat in 2010 aan Bergsig Akademie matrikuleer

Benewens die feit dat Rustenburg die wêreld se grootste produsent van platina is en die tweede oudste dorp in die voormalige "ou" Transvaal is, het die dorpie oor baie jare heen 'n klompie inwoners opgelewer wat inderdaad wêreldgeskiedenis gemaak het of andersins internasionaal beroemd geword het. Onder die heel eerstes was die trekkerleiers Andries Pretorius en Hendrik Potgieter wat na afloop van die Groot Trek in Rustenburg afgesaal en uitgespan het, wat hier na jare van wrywing tussen die twee uiteindelik versoen is en hier "rus" gevind het en waaraan Rustenburg volgens oorlewering sy naam te danke het. Rustenburg is in 1853 as 'n dorp geproklameer.

Hierna was die groot nuusmakers of internasionaal bekendes in Rustenburg Paul Kruger - vyfde president van die Zuid-Afrikaansche Republiek en eienaar van nie minder nie as vier plase in die Rustenburgomgewing. Die eerste hiervan die bekende Boekenhoutfontein tussen Phokeng en Boshoek, die plaas Waterkloof op die R24 skuins

oorkant die Rustenburgse Excalibur-kasteel op die gronde van die Paul Kruger Gastehuis oos van Rustenburg. Die twee oorblywende plase was Baviaanskrans en Rietvlei, twee plase wat gekombineer en as natuurreservaat aan die staat geskenk is met die uitdruklike voorbehoud dat die grond nooit vir ontwikkeling gebruik mag word nie - sedertdien die gewilde Kgaswane Natuurreservaat aan die suidelike hange van die Magaliesberg.

Hierna was daar 'n taamlik indrukwekkende lys van Rustenburgers wat op uiteenlopende geskiedenis gemaak het of internasionaal bekend geword het. Baie hiervan natuurlik sportmanne en -vroue: Ons lig 'n paar hiervan uit:

Bettie Cilliers-Barnard - kunstenaar en moeder van aktrise Jana Cilliers; Bill McGill waterverfskilder; Johan Botha - een van die gewildste operatenore ooit; Koos du Plessis Afrikaanse liedjieskrywer en sanger; Pik Botha - wêreldbekende politikus en Suid-Afrikaanse Minister van Buitelandse Sake; John Cranko - Suid-Afrikaanse balletdanser en -choreograaf van die Koninklike en Stuttgartse Balletgeselskap; Frik du Preez - rugbyspeler van die Eeu; André Stander - berugte bankrower en misdadiger; Jan Eloff - SA Mynboukommissaris na wie Eloffstraat in Johannesburg vernoem is, Drickus Hattingh (rugbyspeler), die tennisspeler Danie Visser en die spiesgooier Sunet Viljoen wat verskeie medaljes tydens meer as een Olimpiese Spele verower het. Hierbenewens het Rustenburg ook minstens drie wenners van die jaarlikse Comrades Marathon opgelewer.

Big names for small town at foothills of Magaliesberg

This week, Saturday, 1 July, will see the wheels rolling into motion for the 110th edition of the internationally acclaimed Tour de France bicycle race in France and a number of European countries, such as Spain - the home country of well-known South African cyclist, Louis Meintjes. Among those with little interest in the world of cycling it might be news that Meintjes is a former Rustenburg boy who matriculated at Bergsig Academy in 2010 and whose professional cycling career kicked off barely three years later. In addition to the fact that Rustenburg is the world's biggest platinum producer with the world's largest platinum refinery on its doorstep, Rustenburg is also the second oldest town in the former "old" Transvaal. Through the ages the small town at the foothills of the Magaliesburg had also "produced" quite an impressive list of people who became famous internationally or who have made world history during their

Among the very first were the Voortrekker leaders Andries Pretorius and Hendrik Potgieter who settled in Rustenburg towards the end of the Great Trek, who reconciled at the grounds of the latter Dutch Reformed Church in Prinsloo Street after years of animosity between the two leaders, who found "rest" here in the shade of the Magalies and Cashan mountains and from whence the name "Rustenburg" is derived.

The next famous person was Pres Paul Kruger - the fifth President of the fomer ZAR (South African Republic) and the owner of no less than four farms in the Rustenburg region. Among these were the well-known Boekenhoutfontein at Boshoek, the well-known President Kruger Guest House across the Excalibur castle on the R24 with the last two - Bayiaanskrans and Rietvlei, two farms which were combined and donated to the state as a nature reserve on the condition that the land may never be sold or utilised for development - hence the Kgaswane Nature Reserve in the southern foothills of the Magaliesberg.

'North West is in a dire state' - Chamber of Commerce

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - "The North West province is in a dire state and we need urgent intervention by provincial - and national - government," Gideon Ralepeli, chairman of the North West Chamber of Commerce said in a statement over the weekend.

This comes after prominent business people from the North West province met in Matlosana on Wednesday last week to discuss the general state of the province. Unfortunately, the premier, Mr Bushy Maape, could not attend after being hospitalized.

"The general feeling was that if the government does not act decisively more businesses will close and relocate to other provinces and even into Africa. This will be bad for the North West where we already have one of the highest unemployment in the country. We are of the opinion that interference by politicians in the running of municipalities is creating most of the problems.

"According to business people the arrogance of some of the municipal officials towards the people paying their salaries is just not acceptable", he said.

Speaking for the farming community, Benedict Modise from NWK, said that they are spending millions of rand to fix roads so that the farmers and farming community can get their products to silos in the province. "We are doing this ourselves with no help from the provincial government. The costs are escalating each year and have become part of our yearly budget", he said.

Mthokozisi Sibisi, Business Unit Leader of as Auditor General in North West, said that most of the municipalities are bankrupt and need urgent intervention.

Prof Ronnie Lotriet from the NWU Business School said that urgent skills audits need to be done and training should then take place. "It is important that the people in the decisionmaking positions should have the necessary tools to run successful local governments", he said. The most relevant problems identified by the meeting were dysfunctional municipalities, illegal foreigners taking over the informal economy, crime, the collapse of the health services, local companies not getting contracts or tenders within the province and a lack of cooperation between business and government at all levels.

The EXCO of the Chamber also met

with an advisor of the Deputy President in Potchefstroom on Friday and is hoping to get some results out of that meeting. "We will send a report to the advisor regarding the problems and possible solutions with the undertaking that follow-up meetings will be held soon. If the government is serious about solving the problems, they need to come to the party soon," André Coertzen, CEO of the Chamber, said.
