

Phone hacked? Tell-tale signs

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - A prominent Android smartphone manufacturer has highlighted five signs that could indicate your smartphone has been infected with malware.

"Android mobile devices are pretty secure, provided you follow common-sense precautions such as using strong passwords for all of your accounts, downloading apps only from Google Play or official phone manufacturer app stores, and not clicking on suspect website links you receive by email or instant messaging," a spokesperson for the company said.

Still, it's possible for you to accidentally download some malware on your device or give your account details to a persuasive scammer. Cybercriminals are clever and persistent, and it's not always easy to keep up with their latest tricks. And once they've breached your phone, they might quietly steal your personal data, hijack your social media accounts, or use your phone to mine cryptocurrencies."

The company highlighted the following signs that could indicate that your phone has been hacked or that there is malware installed:

- Your battery life is suddenly worse than it used to be. Some malware and fraudulent apps constantly run in the background on your phone, draining its battery.
- Your phone is running hot and uses more data than usual. This may also indicate malware or spy apps running in the background.
- Performance has become degraded. Another sign that there is a malicious app on your phone is that performance has become worse. For example, it takes longer to load websites and apps are freezing, crashing, or running slowly. This is another sign that a malicious app is stealing resources on your device.
- Strange things are happening on your online accounts. If a cybercriminal has access to your info, they might try logging into your apps like social media or online banking. You might be breached if you are getting emails and texts for password resets or notifications that someone is logging in from an unfamiliar location.
- Mystery apps, texts and calls. If you start seeing apps you haven't downloaded, calls you haven't made, and texts and emails you didn't send in your history, that's

If you suspect that your device has been compromised, the following steps are suggested:

Disconnect your phone from the Internet.

Immediately disconnect from the Internet to prevent malware from sending more data from your device or the hacker from controlling your phone.

Remove any suspicious apps.

Check your phone for any suspicious apps that you may have unknowingly installed. Uninstall them immediately.

Install a reputable antivirus app.

Use a good antivirus app to scan for any malware or viruses that may be present on your device.

Change your passwords.

Change the passwords for all your accounts, including your email, social media, and banking accounts, to prevent the hacker from accessing them.

Perform a factory reset.

If nothing else works, consider factory resetting your phone to remove any malicious software and start fresh.

Objection against incorporation of small municipalities a runaway success

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG - "We are elated, the results speak for themselves and we are confident that rate payers in the affected areas have made it abundantly clear that the proposed amalgamation of several small municipalities in the Bojanala District Municipality to that of the Rustenburg Local Municipality is rejected and unwanted", says De Wet Nel, Deputy Leader of the FF Plus in the North West Province and Member of the Provincial Legislator on Tuesday this week.

People from the Bojanala have responded in great numbers to The FF Plus' call to object to the plans of the Speaker of the Rustenburg Municipality, Cllr K Mogomotsi, to centralise and amalgamate said municipalities in the Bojanala District Municipality to indeed, a rather under performing Rustenburg Municipality in the near future

As reported last week, a number of under performing municipalities in the Bojanala, notable Kgetlengrivier (Koster, Swartruggens and Derby), Madibeng (Hartbeespoort, Brits and certain areas of Mooinooi) as well as Moses Kotane (Ledig and Sun City) were considered to be incorporated with the Municipal Council of the Rustenburg Municipality following a proposal by the Speaker of the RLM, albeit allegedly without the necessary mandate by the Rustenburg Council to do so. Earlier the FF Plus' De Wet Nel told Rustenburg Herald that the FF Plus was the only party in the Rustenburg Council (31 March 2023) to object to the proposal when it called for a division of the house in terms of votes on the issue. A request that was eventually denied because the matter wasn't discussed in Council any further. "We have nonetheless succeeded in garnering surprising support from our affected communities which clearly shows that people in the district wish to rather maintain the "Status Quo". The FF Plus' call for people to object to the move managed no less than 4 592 letters of objection from people within the Bojanala. This of course excludes another possibly 1 000 or 2 000 emails sent to the offices of the Municipal Demarcation Board over the weekend after negotiations between the MDB and the North West FF Plus, that physical objections would be allowed until 12:00 on Friday, 28 April and in case of objections per email, until 24:00 on Saturday, 29 April. This was in response to the fact that the last day set aside for physical objections, was Thursday, 27 April, which of course was a public holiday (Freedom Day). It was not much of a surprise that rate payers from the Rustenburg Municipality were not the only ones who were desperately opposed to the amalgamation. Nel told Rustenburg Herald that of the just over 4 500, 1 600 were from residents of Kgetlengrivier, some 700 from Madibeng, 1 400 from the Rustenburg area and just over 700 from Groot Marico, Sannieshof and Delareyville. What we know from this is that the Municipal Demarcation Board has to consider the input from people within the district. After this a number of public meetings will be held whereafter the final outcome of the matter will be announced between November 2023 and January 2024.

Help trace next of kin

According to him, he was never married, but he does have children. Mr Isak recalls his siblings as 'Mokobiwa' and 'Magageng'. He does not recall much of the information about his life back in Lichtenburg.

An appeal is therefore made to communities at large to assist the hospital in reuniting Mr Isak with his family members.

Njuza was attacked on 8 May by two men at the back of a tavern in Tlhabane. He succumbed to his injuries.

Koketso 'Kok's' Mogomotsi and Dacamfy Comfort Rakhudu was arrested in connection with Njuza's death shortly after the incident. The duo have made a number of court appearances and will be back in the dock on 11 May when their trial will presumably start.

Bangladeshi nationals jailed for kidnapping

RUSTENBURG HERALD - RUSTENBURG The Mogwase High Court imposed lengthy jail sentences on two Bangladeshi nationals, two South Africans and a Mozambican for robbery and kidnapping a businessman in 2019.

Narul Asfar, a Bangladeshi national was robbed and kidnapped on 9 July 2019 at Tlhatlaganyane village near Sun City.

It is alleged that on that day the suspects were driving a VW Polo with Gauteng registration plates. After Asfar was robbed and kidnapped, the businessman was handed to accomplices traveling in a BMW 5 series.

At that time the police had already received a lookout for a blue VW Polo and stopped the vehicle as soon as it was spotted.

Koketso Elton Modisadife (28), Lucky Majoba Mogale (27), Anton Abdul (36, Mozambican) and Jewel Rana (27, Bangladesh) were arrested, but the businessman was still missing. A firearm, cash and some of the items believed to be taken from the businessman's shop were found inside the vehicle.

On the same day the BMW 5 series with the victim inside, was stopped by unsuspecting traffic officers on the R24, Magaliesburg road for contravention of a road traffic act.

While being stopped and about to be offered a fine, the victim managed to free himself and kicked open the vehicle's door and alerted the officers about his situation.

Snyman Mohoje (56, RSA), Hayatunnobi Shaun (35) and Arif Howlader (26) - all Bangladeshi - were arrested and a firearm was found in the vehicle. One suspect managed to elude the arrest and fled on foot.

The suspects have been in custody since their arrest after their numerous bail applications were successfully opposed.

Two suspects -Jewel Rana and Snyman Mahoje - died in 2019 and 2021 due to illness while in custody. The other five were sentenced on 26 April 2023.

The sentences handed down were:

Koketso Modisadife: Count 1- Robbery years aggravating circumstances; 15 imprisonment, count 2 - Kidnapping 10 years imprisonment,

Lucky Majoba Mogale: Robbery aggravating circumstances; 15 years imprisonment

Antony Abdul: Count 1 Robbery aggravating circumstances; 15 years imprisonment, Kidnapping 10 years imprisonment, illegal immigration 6 months imprisonment

Hayatonobi Shaman: Kidnapping 10 years imprisonment, illegal immigrant six months imprisonment.

Arif Howlader: Kidnapping; 10 years imprisonment, illegal immigrant; six months imprisonment.

The sentences are to run concurrently.







She has been behind Annual Children's Athletics which took place at Olympia Park Stadium recently.


The event was held in support of Early Childhood Development Centres (ECDCs).

Somme maak dalk nie deel van dié proses

Die nuus in Rustenburg draai reeds die afgelope paar weke rondom die kwessie van die moontlike inlywing van klein, onderpresterende munisipaliteite soos Kgetlengrivier, Madibeng en Moses Kotane by die ja, inderdaad onderpresterende Rustenburgse Munisipaliteit en die gevegte en binnegevegte oor die moontlikheid van so 'n stap. Verder hoor of sien of lees 'n mens maar min van die hele proses maar veral nie hoekom dit dan nou op hierdie tydstip en datum so op die vooraand van 'n nasionale verkiesing nodig geword het dat die Rustenburgse Munisipaliteit nou skielik die pad na 'n "metro" (metropolitaanse munisipaliteit) moet loop nie.

In die "gange van gerugte" egter, hoor 'n mens dat daar vir Raadslede wat so gelukkig sou wees om in hierdie metro te dien, groot voordeel is van uiteraard 'n aansienlik verhoogde salarispakket en dat hierdie die rede is hoekom daar relatief min teenstand uit partygelede (behalwe die VF Plus) teen die moontlikheid van so 'n stap sou kom. 'n Ander verduideliking is dat so 'n stap vir die ANC in die RLM groot voordeel inhou deurdat dit die party vir die eerste keer in 'n taamlike lang tyd in staat sal stel om weer 'n volstrekte meerderheid in die RLM te geniet en 'n mens moet vra of daar nog mense is wat teen hierdie tyd nog nie weet nie dat die ANC die belange van die ANC bo dié van Suid-Afrika en Suid-Afrikaners stel. Op sy heel beste is die min "goeie" nuus dat elk van die klein dorpies se leierskap darem "plaaslik" is en as't ware net voor sy eie agterdeur hoef te vee. Eensklaps egter word die vier klein dorpies skielik een groot dorp, met 'n gesamentlike leierskap verteenwoordigend van al vier die dorpies. Die probleem nou egter, is dat slegs die mees sentrale of die grootste van die vier klein dorpies nou nog "plaaslik" is, trouens, die bedieningsarea is nou net vier keer so groot (en so ver) soos voorheen. En onthou dan: Die grootste van die vier dorpies wat nou moet "baas" speel, kon voorheen beswaarlik die mas opkom om net voor sy eie agterdeur te vee maar sal nou moet uithaal om te sorg dat al vier die dorpies "beter" bedien word. 'n Mens hoef egter net na die oorsake en gevolge van verstedeliking oor die afgelope 25 jaar in Suid-Afrika te kyk om te sien waartoe hierdie dorpies inderdaad gedoem is. Dit geld ook die baasspeel-dorpie wat nou meer en groter verantwoordelikhede gaan hê terwyl hy dié verantwoordelikhede te midde van moeiliker omstandighede sal moet handhaaf. Ek sien swarigheid...

Doing the maths probably not part of amalgamation process

For the past few weeks already people have been talking about the possible amalgamation of a number of small under performing municipalities such as Kgetlengrivier, Madibeng and Moses Kotane with that of yes, indeed under performing Rustenburg Local Municipality. One however seldom hears why such a move would be deemed necessary and why it was essential that Rustenburg and those four unfortunate municipalities were earmarked to take to the road towards becoming a "metro" (metropolitan municipality). Rumours have it however, that fortunate Councillors to ultimately serve in the Metro, could bargain on considerably bigger salaries. In addition to this, rumours have it that the amalgamation of the four municipalities would enable the ANC component in the RIM to once again enjoy an outright majority in Council. Apparently it has been quite some time since the Rustenburg ANC in Council were in a position to achieve this. There are probably very few people in the country who don't know that the ANC regards the ANC as more important than South Africa or South Africans.

Just consider the following: There are four small towns - each of which no less than 50 km from each other. Each of the small towns has been struggling for ages to keep its head above water, to maintain municipal services, to maintain roads and infrastructure, to keep potholes at bay, to fight decline and to keep rolling out services such

as water, electricity, refuse removal and sewerage services. None of the four towns however, have been very successful at achieving the goals above with at least three of the small towns constantly engaged in court battles surrounding service delivery issues. These they periodically lose from time to time for weeks or months at a time until they could get their house in order to regain its leadership role. Perhaps the only good news around the small little struggling municipalities is the fact that they were at least "local" and only had to sweep at its own back doors.

All of a sudden however, the four municipalities are amalgamated into one big municipality representing all four small towns. Literally overnight virtually none of the four towns can still be called "local" while the most central and biggest of the four, neither has the money, expertise, experience nor the will to oversee service at all four of the towns. Furthermore, in the past it could hardly manage acceptable service and maintenance levels at its own little back door - let alone all four of them combined. In addition the service area has doubled to four times its former size, while it is also much further, more expensive and much more difficult to logistically take care of its new responsibilities. One simply has to look at the phenomenon of urbanisation in South Africa over the past 25 years to see where it would be going - indeed, dark times ahead...




