SAPS Management pays tribute to NW CPF Chairperson

BRITS POS – BRITS - The National Commissioner of the South African Police Service (SAPS), Gen Fannie Masemola has, on behalf of management paid tribute to the North West province's Community Police Forum Chairperson (CPF), Dixon Ngamlane.

Ngamlane and his wife died in a car accident in Fochville, Gauteng recently.

Ngamlane was a crime fighting patriot, a passionate and astute fighter who championed for resources needed to assist community policing structures to assist the work of the police.

He was a member of the Community Police Forum (CPF) board for the past 23 years having served as the Mahikeng Cluster CPF Chairperson, and later as the Provincial CPF board Chairperson, a role he held until his passing.

The Ngamlane couple were buried on Saturday in their hometown of Mahikeng in the North West province.

Gen Masemola and the Provincial Commissioner of North West, Lt Gen

Sello Kwenia, the CPF Chairpersons of various provinces and community patrollers were in attendance.

General Masemola described Ngamlane as a dedicated and humble volunteer.

Frans Kgasago, the CPF chairperson of Limpopo spoke on behalf of CPF members and community in blue patrollers across the country.

"Dixon was firm and selfless. We need more people in our communities to assist the police to fight crime. Police cannot fight crime alone, communities need to come on board and play an active role in sharing information", said Mr Frans Kgasago, CPF chairperson of Limpopo.



DEAD PANGOLINS

Four suspects appear in Brits Magistrates' Court

BRITS POS – BRITS - Four suspects made an appearance before the Brits Magistrates' Court on Friday, 7 July, for possession of an endangered species (pangolins).

The suspects' court appearance emanated from their arrest during a Crime Intelligence driven operation on Tuesday, 4 July.

Brits Trio Task Team members operationalised information received about four men who were seen selling two dead pangolins. The police reacted swiftly and the four suspects in possession of pangolins were cornered in the vicinity of Die Hoërskool Wagpos in Brits. The pangolins were found inside plastic bags and the suspects were all arrested. They were charged with possession of endangered species which is in contravention of the National Environmental Management: Biodiversity Act, (NEMBA), 2004 (Act No. 10 of 2004).

The four; Morewell Mpofu (34), Simon Gwenzi (26), Phineas Mchuma (46) and Taurai Zhou (35) were remanded in custody for further investigation. They will appear again before the same court on Friday, 14 July. Investigation into the matter continues.

Another suspect linked to theft of rhino horns nabbed in Brits

BRITS POS – BRITS - Lindani Mthombeni (32) appeared in the Mahikeng Magistrates’ Court on Friday, facing a business burglary charge.

The accused is linked to the alleged theft of 51 rhino horns at the North West Parks Board two weeks ago.

Hawks’ Serious Organised Crime Investigation unit assisted by the Rustenburg Public Order Policing, Tactical Operations Management Section, Tracker Connect and Insurance Crime Bureau arrested the suspect on Wednesday in Brits.

The team followed up on information after the suspect was allegedly spotted in Brits driving in a Range Rover Evoque, which is suspected to have been used in the commission of the crime. He was traced to Brits where he was arrested and charged with business burglary.

Mthombeni along with Elias Manganda, who was arrested earlier for alleged theft of rhino horns, appeared in court today and their matter was postponed to Thursday, 13 July 2023 for bail application. The duo was remanded in custody.

Operation Shanela nets 310 suspects over the weekend

BRITS POS – BRITS - With more boots on the ground to sweep away criminality through Operation Shanela, various actions executed over the weekend culminated in the arrest of 340 suspects for different offences.

This included four for rape, 74 for assault with intent to do grievous bodily harm (GBH) and assault common, 19 for robbery aggravating, 40 for driving under the influence of alcohol, 12 for illegal dealing in liquor, seven for burglaries at residential and business premises, 13 for possession of drugs and four for dealing in drugs.

During the operations and execution of various actions, 1 344 persons and 1 056 vehicles were searched. The operation also led to inspection of 118 licensed liquor premises, 86 second-hand goods dealers and 15 recyclers/scrapyards. Seven unlicensed liquor premises were closed, while 39 suspected undocumented foreign nationals were taken in for processing by Immigration Officials.

The confiscated items are liquor, various drugs (crystal meth, mandrax and nyaope), five cellphones and three vehicles.

The Provincial Police Commissioner, Lieutenant General Sello Kwen, thanked the members for the commitment they have displayed since the inception of the operation, which has so far netted more than 1 800 suspects.

ESKOM

Private sector technical teams began work at four troubled coal stations

BRITS POS – BRITS - Electricity Minister Dr Kgosientsho Ramokgopa initially indicated that the teams would officially begin work at Matla, Kriel, Majuba and Kendal power stations on 5 June, but the terms of reference were not finalised in time and the deployment will begin as soon as it has.

The teams have been given specific targets for the recovery of each plant’s energy availability factor (EAF).

At **Matla**, which could produce up to 3 450 MW, an 11% EAF improvement is being targeted through actions focused specifically on improving coal quality.

The target at the 2 850 MW **Kriel** station is a 25% EAF improvement but addressing 700 MW of partial load losses relating to the poor condition of the cooling towers.

At **Majuba**, which could produce up to 3 822 MW, a 12% EAF improvement is being targeted through addressing the 1 200 MW of partial load loss associated with its bag filters, while another 25% improvement is being targeted at the 3 840 MW **Kendal** station,

which has problems ranging from ash handling through to its air heaters.

Some of the individual experts, Ramokgopa reports, have worked for Eskom previously, while others have been drawn in from other private companies and “come highly recommended”.

“These are people who have raised their hands and we are very happy with their credentials,” he adds, noting that they have also been deployed to certain stations based on their specialist knowledge of the technical problem that requires fixing.

Through the Generation Recovery Plan, Eskom is aiming to increase its fleet-wide EAF to 65% by the end of March 2024, despite having fallen short of the 60% target set for the end of

March this year.

By that date, the EAF was 56% and it has since deteriorated further to 52% during the period to the middle of May.

Ramokgopa also reports that the private sector is providing technical support in a bid to further optimise the diesel logistics supply chain to the **Ankerlig** open-cycle gas turbine (OCGT) power station, in the Western Cape, which is supplied by road tanker.

Ahead of winter, Eskom indicated that it planned to increase the load factor of the OCGT plants to above 20% to help reduce the intensity of loadshedding during the high-demand months of June, July and August.

Through tariff increases and the debt relief package, Eskom has R30-billion available for diesel, R20-billion of which would be spent to operate its own OCGT plants at Ankerlig and Gourikwa, with another R10-billion available to buy electricity from the private OCGT plants.

While **Gourikwa** is supplied through a pipeline, for Ankerlig to operate at such high load factors requires on ongoing delivery by hundreds of trucks daily, with on-site storage for 17-million litres and off-site storage of 40-million litres also imposing logistical limitations.

“[Eskom] has been finding it difficult to accommodate these additional trucks, so we have sent in some experts, who are very knowledgeable about logistics, to outline what might be possible,” Ramokgopa says.

Should the supply chain be relieved to the point where the OCGT plants could operate at even higher load factors, and doing so would help reduce loadshedding, the Minister said additional funding beyond the R30-billion earmarked might be necessary.

“If we continue burning diesel at the current rate, that R30-billion might not be sufficient,” he said, while stressing that modelling still had to be completed before he could provide a possible monetary value.

“If it is more, where will [the money] come from? “It can come from one of two places: it could come from a future tariff increase, or it can come directly from the fiscus,” he said, adding that the affordability argument would be based on the cost of burning additional diesel relative to the economic cost of higher stages of loadshedding.

The technical support, he confirmed, is being funded through the RMF, which was launched by Business for South Africa in March in response to a request from President Cyril Ramaphosa for the business to help capacitate the National Energy Crisis Committee (Necom).

RMF funding is also being used to support Necom in establishing an Energy One-Stop Shop, to facilitate the accelerated processing of the approvals, permits and licences required for new generation to be added to the grid.



Hail damage brings together producers and retailers to decrease food waste

BRITS POS – BRITS - After a decade of little hail damage in the fruit producing areas of Ceres and Langkloof in the Western Cape, the same cannot be said for the past year.

Hail hit the apple orchards multiple times affecting all apple varieties over the last twelve months, most notably in November 2022 and again in February this year.

Because of this, Du Toit and Good Hope Fruit have partnered on a campaign with Pick n Pay to promote the merits of cosmetically blemished produce. This Hail to Heroes campaign was born from a need to decrease food waste and ensure consistency of apple supplies in Pick n Pay stores.

Nutritious and delicious

Apples have the ability to repair themselves after suffering superficial indentation caused by the impact of a hard piece of ice. According to Jaco Jordaan, Technical Manager at Good Hope Fruit, hail generally only causes cosmetic damage. “The fruit quality and taste of these apples remain perfectly intact, with the exact same nutritional value and delicious taste as those that are not damaged,” he says. “While our human scars do not define us, the natural scars from hail do not define what lies beneath the skin of the fruit. The wonderful eating experience remains intact – nutritious and delicious, just the same as our wholesome spirits as humans,” says Linde du Toit, Head of Technical at Dutoit.

Don’t judge an apple by its cover

The challenge is that when consumers buy fresh produce, they tend to buy with their eyes. An incorrect perception exists that only perfect looking fruit will be delicious and nutritious. The truth when it comes to hail damaged fruit is that, although there might be a blemish or slight bruising on the skin, the inside of the apple is unaffected. Unlike fruit that is rotten or mouldy, hail damaged produce has prominent scar tissue which means the fruit has been able to heal itself. Consumers are used to buying fresh produce based on how it looks. This campaign is a unique opportunity to educate and inform consumers and change this perception over the long term.

Mitigating risks and supporting farmers

Given the increasing electricity, cooling and packing costs, the Fruit industry cannot afford further losses, especially when these hail damaged apples are crunchy, juicy and full of flavour. Keeping the supply and the price of apples consistent is helping to mitigate the already overwhelming challenges faced by the

Farming community while also reducing food waste. Hail to Heroes also creates jobs up and down the supply chain, positively impacts the economy and uplifts the local communities. “We saw an opportunity to partner with Pick n Pay on this campaign and get this perfectly good fruit to market while minimising the risk of job and volume losses,” says Johan Du Toit, Business Manager SADC at Good Hope Fruit and Karien Bassett, Business Manager at

Du Toit Agri. While unique to South Africa, this campaign mimics similar sentiment taking place globally. Various campaigns have been launched in Europe to market ‘ugly’ fruit and vegetables, with a focus on the fact that the nutritional value remains the same, even if the carrot is skew. This has further reduced the need to process and dump fresh produce.

Hail to Heroes – don’t judge an apple by its appearance

“Without partners involved namely Du Toit Agri, Good Hope Fruit, and Pick n Pay, this campaign would not be possible and most of the produce would lead to losses,” says Johan and Karien. “This is an innovative partnership within the agricultural and retail sectors. We have to help each other as much as possible for the greater good of the producers, labour force and consumers”.

Getting to the core of food wastage

“Following hail events, thorough assessments are carried out to determine the most optimal outcome for the orchard. With early damage such as what was experienced over the last year, we are still able to hand thin each and every tree to remove the worst affected fruit and give the remaining fruit the best chance to reach their full nutritional potential,” Linde says.

“Hail damaged fruit in no way implies less dedication to the handling and marketing of the fruit. In fact, perhaps even more care is taken to ensure the longevity of fruit,” he says.

With climate change expected to increase the severity and frequency of hail in the Western Cape, Hail to Heroes encourages consumers to look beyond the external appearance and give these hail damaged apples a chance. “Hail to Heroes not only honours the fruit that braved the storm and reached the retailer’s shelves, but also the farmers and farm workers who have continued to nurture the fruit. Thank you to another hero, Pick ‘n Pay, for stepping up to sell unique looking apples that are perfectly nutritious and delicious,” continues Linde. Let’s show our love for the fruit that braved the storm, and Hail

to the Heroes that feed our nation by looking out for specific Hail to Hero stickers attached to selected bags of apples in Pick n Pay stores. 

BRITS POS – BRITS - After being in a car accident there are numerous actions, you absolutely must take, like making sure everyone is safe, taking photos, and staying put until the police arrive.

But there are also several things that could have wide-reaching and unintended consequences which you preferably shouldn't do. Naked Insurance breaks down the dos and don'ts you should be aware of just in case you are ever involved in a car crash, be it your own fault or someone else's.

Don't
Following an accident, especially where someone was injured or property was seriously damaged, it's important not to leave the scene until the authorities have arrived. Also, do not move your vehicle unless you are told to do so by the police or if it poses a safety hazard to other people on the road.

If someone was seriously hurt during the ordeal, refrain from moving them as this could put them at even more risk; and call an ambulance or emergency services with haste.

"Get an ambulance on scene as soon as possible. Your insurer's emergency roadside assist can help with that and should be available 24/7," said Naked.

Do
The "single most important" thing you can do after being in an accident is to remain calm as it could "literally save lives," according to Naked. After the dust has settled, rationally evaluate the situation to see if someone is injured, if an offence has been committed, or if a state vehicle or property has been damaged. In any of these scenarios, you are obligated to call the police and stay on site until they arrive and dismiss you. Provided there are no injuries or damage to

property, the next step is to check if your car is still driveable, and more importantly, if it'll get you back home or to the nearest police station safely. "Sometimes the answer is obvious, but if you aren't entirely sure, rather play it safe and contact your insurer's towing services," said Naked. If a tow truck must be called, you may find that numerous drivers arrive within minutes which can be intimidating to deal with.

One thing to remember that is of vital importance: "Don't make use of the first service provider that appears on the scene, even if they claim to be from your insurer," said Naked.

Your car isn't going anywhere, so take a few extra minutes to call your insurer's emergency hotline and ask for towing assistance and how to identify the truck it's sending.

Once this is all out of the way, it's time to start taking as many photos as possible of the accident scene, especially if someone else was involved. This includes number plates, license disks, street names, and any other landmarks close by. Ask all other drivers involved for photos of their driver's licence, too. Also, pay attention to any CCTV cameras in the area which may have recorded the incident.

"Your memory of the incident may become a bit fuzzy once the initial shock wears off, but your phone will remember important details weeks after the incident," said Naked. Of equal importance, take down the names and contact details of the other parties and any and all witnesses, which will assist if you feel the crash, wasn't your fault.

Information to collect from other parties involved including witnesses
