Reason for water issues in Rustenburg

BONUS - RUSTENBURG - Residents in an around Rustenburg have been struggling with water for the past few days, some have been experiencing low to no water supply.

The Rustenburg Local Municipality recently issued a statement stating the reasons why Rustenburg residents are struggling with water. "The Rustenburg Local Municipality hereby informs residents that one of the City's water providers- Magalies Water has informed the Municipality as well as other bulk consumers of high demand of water demand on the system. All of our residents in Geelhout, Tlhabane, Tlhabane West and Greater Boitekong with

exception to town areas (CBD, Cashan and neighbouring areas) who are supplied by a different water service provider will experience low water pressure to no access to water," the municipality said. "As a result, the command reservoirs from which the Municipality draws its water supply are currently experiencing extremely low water levels," the statement concluded. Residents are once again urged to use water sparingly so as not to prolong the water rationing.

Roads rehabilitation

will have to wait much longer before they drive there since the two roads were closed for a rehabilitation project which started on 19 October 2020 and was supposed to end on 19 November 2020.

According to the latest information received from the Municipality, the deadline to the rehabilitation had to be intersection (Lebone Street and Dr. Moroka) which was to end on Friday (19 November), an extension on the completion of the abovementioned intersection will continue until Friday (11 December)," a statement from the municipality said. Residents and all motorists were urged to be patient and the municipality apologised for the inconvenience on their part.
