# Ten suspects arrested over unlicensed firearm and ammunition

BONUS- RUSTENBURG - Ten suspects were arrested by the Mooinooi Detectives and the Brits Tactical Response Team (TRT) for possession of unlicensed firearms and ammunition, possession of suspected stolen property and possession of housebreaking implements.

The arrest, according to Brigadier Sabata Mokgwabone, North West police spokesperson, comes after police received a tip-off about suspicious armed men who were spotted at a certain house in Matamong informal settlement in Mooinooi. It is alleged that the accused whose ages range from 23 and 34 were found at their rented place where two shacks were searched. During the search, police found three unlicensed 9mm pistols and a rifle, 38 rounds of ammunition, suspected stolen goods such as cell phones, a pair of takkies, computer monitor and various

tools. Preliminary investigations suggested that one of the firearms was reported stolen in Tsakane, Gauteng Province. The suspects appeared appeared briefly before the Brits Magistrates' Court on 30 October and were remanded in custody until Monday (9 November).

## Child grabs: False reports can get you into trouble

BONUS -RUSTENBURG - With still about 60 days left of Annus Horribilis, also known as 2020, motorists will at least have a little bit of a reprieve when they stop at the petrol pumps.

It is expected that the petrol price will drop at midnight Tuesday (3 November) for all grades of petrol. The prediction is:

Petrol 95: decrease of 17 cents per litre Petrol 93: decrease of 14 cents per litre Diesel 0.05%: decrease of 20 cents per litre

Unfortunately there is some bad news for people relying on illuminating paraffin; the price will increase by 5 cents per litre.

BONUS - RUSTENBURG - In September a video of a man trying to kidnap a child from a Johannesburg restaurant caused quite a stir.

And, all of a sudden reports of similar alleged incidences made its way to social media.

Some people even claimed that more than a million children were trafficked in South Africa per year. This is very far from the truth. "Data available shows that the figure can be estimated at around 2000 children yearly. The global amount is approximately 1.2 million," says a report of AfricaCheck. This means that parents and child caregivers must always be on high alert to keep children safe, but panic is unnecessary. Here in Rustenburg only ONE case of an attempt to kidnap a child has been registered. Recently a social media post proclaimed that a learner of a high school escaped after being abducted. This claims were investigated by the police, but the parents of the two girls involved declined to lay charges of any sort. "When people

do not want to open a case, we as police can do nothing," Capt Elsabé Augoustides said in reaction. She warned people to not make claims about alleged crimes unless there is a case opened with the police. "Identifying underaged victims, as well as suspects is unlawful. In fact, identifying any suspect is unlawful, unless they have appeared in court," she added. Experts also warn about the danger of children or parents making unfounded claims about attempts of kidnapping. Police warn that fake news often has hidden agendas, and spreading it only serves to continue misinformation. "Such misinformation is reckless, irresponsible and unacceptable. We condemn any posts or voice notes aimed at causing alarm and unnecessary fear. Spreading false news or information is an offence and people can be prosecuted," Capt Augoustides said.



# Production vehicle Cross Country Championship produced nail-biting battles, well-deserved titles and close standings in challenging 2020 season

BONUS - RUSTENBURG - The 2020 South African National Cross Country Series (SACCS) season was a season like no other and will long be remembered for the disruption and challenges caused by the global pandemic, COVID-19, but it will also be remembered for the championship battles that had everyone on the edge of their seats until the end.

With motorsport activities in South Africa that came to a screeching halt in March only to be continued five months later in August, the season had to be shortened and was made up of five rounds which also excluded the popular and historic Toyota 1000 Desert Race, the only marathon event on the SACCS calendar, that usually takes place over three days and almost a thousand kilometres in Botswana. In the end, it was Henk Lategan and Brett Cummings (Toyota Gazoo Racing SA Hilux) who defended their overall and FIA Class championship titles successfully to be crowned the 2020 champions after winning four of the five rounds of the season. In the Overall Production Vehicle Drivers' Championship, Lategan's team-mate, Giniel de Villiers (91 points), who started and completed the season with

his Spanish navigator, Alex Haro, made use of the navigating skills of Juan Möhr in between, finished 52 points behind the winner in second place with Chris Visser (Total Excellium Toyota Hilux) in third trailing De Villiers by eight points. Toyota claimed the Manufacturers Championship with a total of 498 points. Ford (198 points) is second while Nissan and Century Racing accumulated the same amount of points (63). Renault finished with 28 points and Mercedes-Benz with 23.

If the 2020 season is anything to go by, competitors, sponsors, supporters and enthusiasts can already look forward to the action that will start in the first quarter of 2021.
