BONUS - RUSTENBURG – Social media platforms were abuzz this past weekend when a video, showing an on duty police officer in Wolmaransstad drunk and unable to stand on his feet, went viral.

This video was captured by members of the community on Saturday (28 November). It shows a drunk constable, in full uniform, struggling to stand steady on his feet to inspect the state of the motor vehicle and check what appears to be a scratch. The damage was apparently caused by a collision of the state vehicle with a fence at Extension 10, Tsweleng Location in Wolmaransstad. The Constable was the driver at the time.

He was arrested and released on a bail of R500. We was expected to appear again in Court on Monday (30 November).

Provincial Commissioner of North West, Lieutenant General Sello Kwenya expressed his disapproval of the member's conduct. He said that all SAPS members are obliged to conduct themselves in a professional manner at all times and adhere to the code of conduct, including using available resources responsibly and take into account the needs of the community. The Queen Mother, Mmemogolo as she was affectionately known, played a pivotal role in the Bafokeng Nation to become the model traditional community that it is today.



Her Royal Majesty - Dr Semane Molotlegi of the Royal Bafokeng who has passed away on Saturday.

The Queen Mother was the founder of the Bafokeng Women's Club and also the patron/founder of the Thuto Thebe Educational Fund that is focused on education and community development advocacy in memory of both her husband, Kgosi Edward Lebone, and her firstborn son Kgosi Mollwane Lebone II.

She is survived by her four children, Kgosi Leruo Molotlegi - the present King of the Royal Bafokeng Nation, Prince Bothata Molotlegi, Princess Motswana Molotlegi and Princess Tirelo Molotlegi as well as her grandchildren. Further details and arrangements will be communicated in due course, the Royal family said on Monday.

Motorists urged to be vigilant

BONUS - RUSTENBURG - Motorists travelling in the North West, especially in the Bojanala Platinum district are urged to exercise caution when stopping next to the road or when ordered to stop by other motorists as they could be potential hijackers.

This warning comes after a few incidents in which vehicles were recently hijacked by unknown suspects, were reported. On Monday (16 November), at about 21:15 in Tlhabane, a 40-year-old victim allegedly stopped to pick up a person in Mokgethi Street. He parked in front of a gate and climbed out of the vehicle. He was allegedly pointed with a firearm and instructed to get back inside his Blue VW Polo. He managed to escape by running away and two suspects drove off with his Polo.

In an unrelated incident on Wednesday (18 November), a 44-year-old victim was allegedly travelling on the N4 road at

canopy of his Nissan bakkie before fleeing from the scene. The victim managed to break the rear window of his bakkie in order to escape and contacted the police on his cellular phone.

Motorists are requested to exercise caution when stopped by unknown persons and report such incidents to the nearest police station. Never offer a lift to a hitch-hiker and do not stop next to the road except for an emergency. People stopping to relieve themselves have also fallen victim of this crime.

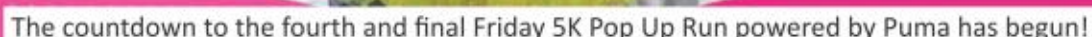
