Dam spectacular!

Buffelspoort Dam burst its banks for the first time this year just over a week ago after exceedingly good rains feeding the Sterkstroom River in recent weeks. It's no secret that Buffelspoort is one of the most beautiful and impressive reservoirs this side of the Crocodile River on account of its crystal clear water and lush surrounding landscape in the pristine Buffelspoort Valley Conservancy. Buffelspoort is some 40 km north east of Rustenburg. The dam wall was completed in 1937 and the reservoir has a capacity of 10 250 cubic meters. Extension for provisional tax filing season deadline

BONUS - RUSTENBURG - The South African Revenue Service (SARS) has extended the filing season deadline for provisional taxpayers from 29 January to 15 February.

In a statement, the revenue collector said the decision was based on the unprecedented health challenge of COVID-19.

"In line with SARS' communication on steps taken to prevent the spread of COVID-19 and protect both the taxpayers and SARS staff, taxpayers are encouraged to use eFiling or the SARS MobiApp," SARS said on Thursday (28 January).

In the statement, SARS Commissioner Edward Kieswetter said the decision to extend the filing season was taken with due consideration of the traumatic effects being experienced by taxpayers who have lost loved ones, as well as businesses who have lost staff, during the devastating second wave of COVID-19.

The Commissioner urged taxpayers who received auto-assessment notices last year but who have not yet accepted the auto-assessments, or edited and filed a return in response to the notice, to make use of this opportunity to do so.

Kieswetter, however, urged taxpayers to comply with their legal obligations by 15 February 2021, as it is vital that all taxpayers remain compliant.

SASSA cards valid even beyond March

BONUS - RUSTENBURG - The South African Social Security Agency (SASSA) has assured social grant beneficiaries that SASSA cards will not stop working on 31 March 2021.

This comes after social media misinformation and claims that SASSA-SAPO [South African Post office] cards will expire on 31 March 2021. SASSA has refuted the claims.

"These claims are not true.

The cards will have to be replaced, as indicated by the South African Reserve Bank report, but there is no set date by which this must be done," SASSA said in a statement.

The agency said the information on card replacements will be made public in due course.

SASSA reiterated that clients have the right to choose their payment method, and "there is nothing that forces clients, who are currently being paid through the South Africa Post Office, to change to bank accounts".

"They will still be paid using the current SASSA-SAPO card beyond April 2021."

BONUS - KOSTER – One person was declared dead when a light aircraft crashed on a farm outside of Koster on Thursday morning (4 February).

According to information received from provincial police spokesperson, Captain Aafje Botma, the light aircraft allegedly crashed on a farm near a dam in Koster at approximately 10:00. It was reported that farm workers alerted the farmer about the incident. The farmer ultimately informed the police who upon arrival at the scene, found only one person who was burned beyond recognition in the light aircraft.

The man has been identified as 67-year-old Leon Leuvenink. According to the latest information received Leuvenink, described as a seasoned pilot, was allegedly flying to Windhoek, Namibia when the incident happened. He is survived by his wife, Ina Leuvenink and his sons, Emile and Eben. According to Kabelo Ledwaba of South African Civil Aviation investigations into the incident are currently underway.

Lion attack in Pilanesberg leaves ranger dead

BONUS - PILANESBERG - A tragedy played out in the Pilanesberg National Park early on Saturday morning when a member of the Pilanesberg's Rhino Anti Poaching unit was killed when he was attacked by a lion while he and two of his colleagues were on border patrol duty towards the eastern boundary of the resort.

Kobus Marais was a popular member of the Pilanesberg's K9 unit. His dog was not by his side during the lion attack. Marais was fatally injured by a large lion male which was subsequently shot by fellow members of the patrol.

The incident took place at approximately 06:30 on Saturday morning and Marais was declared dead on the scene moments later. The incident is being investigated and arrangements have been made for the counselling of the staff involved as well as other colleagues of the resort. The attack - as far as could be established - was the first of its kind in the resort and took place during an early morning foot patrol in the east of the park. The Pilanesberg Board had expressed its sincerest condolences to Marais' wife and his family as well as friends and colleagues.

Beware of recruitment scam, Correctional Services

BONUS- RUSTENBURG - The Department of Correctional Services has recently urged the public not to fall prey to fake recruitment scams bearing its name and logo.

This warning comes after the department noted an increase in circulation of such scams on various social media sites in recent months. The scams, according to a statement issued by the department, include bogus advertisements for Correctional Services learnerships, calling on applicants to apply through certain web-based platforms.

"The public is therefore cautioned not to fall prey to such scams and further called upon to report such illegal activities to law enforcement agencies," said the department.

The fake adverts further indicate a monthly stipend over a period of 12 months and requires applicants to make payments in order to be able to have access to such opportunities.

Those who have already fallen prey to such scams have been requested to register their full names, identity numbers, residential addresses, contact details as well as details of the persons and/institutions to whom such applications were submitted via the email: Enquiry.Complaints@dcs.gov.za.
