END OF AN ERA: Passing of FW de Klerk

BONUS - RUSTENBURG - Former President Frederik Willem de Klerk passed away on 11 November 2021 in Fresnaye, Cape Town.

De Klerk is often described as the last President of the former non-democratic South Africa and will be best remembered for pioneering the way towards a fully democratic RSA which culminated in the first democratic election of the Republic of South Africa on 27 April 1994.

Frederik Willem de Klerk was born in Johannesburg, Transvaal (now Gauteng) on 18 March 1936. He grew up in a political family, with both his father and grandfather serving high office. His father, Jan de Klerk, was a Cabinet Minister and the President of the South African Senate. His brother is Dr Willem (Wimpie) de Klerk, a political analyst and one of the founders of the Democratic Party.

De Klerk graduated in 1958 from Potchefstroom University with BA and LL.B degrees (the latter cum laude). In 1969 he married Marike Willemse, with whom he had two sons and a daughter. In December 1989, De Klerk met with the imprisoned leader of the African National Congress (ANC), Nelson Mandela. On 2 February 1990, he lifted the ban on the ANC, the South African Communist Party (SACP) and the Pan Africanist Congress (PAC). Mandela was released soon after. In 1993 Nelson Mandela and De Klerk were awarded the Nobel Peace Prize for their efforts at reform in South Africa. After the 1994 elections, De Klerk was appointed the Second Vice President in President Mandela's cabinet. He retired from politics in 1997.

Karoo National Park - BirdLife Rustenburg

BONUS - RUSTENBURG - The Karoo National Park is extremely important for Namib-Karoo biome-restricted assemblage species and it supports a host of other arid-zone specials and threatened species.

A total of 231 species has been recorded so far in the park during SABAP2. Some of the special birds that can be found here include Ludwig's Bustard, Karoo Korhaan, Spike-heeled Lark, Karoo Lark, Grey-backed Sparrow-lark, Tractrac Chat, Karoo Chat, Karoo Eremomela and Rufous-eared Warbler. BirdLife Rustenburg's yearly outing was to this fascinating park and most members could add birds to their life list. The meeting will take place on Monday, 15 November 2021, at Methodist Church on the corner of Brink and Schuurman Streets. The meeting starts at 18:30 and members and non-members are welcome - non-members pay R30 per person.

All normal Covid-protocols will be observed - please wear a mask and sanitise on arrival. Farewell to Mr Adventure

BONUS - RUSTENBURG - The world renowned Zambian-born South African writer, Wilbur Smith has passed away over the weekend.

Wilbur Smith was an icon, larger than life, beloved by his fans who collected his books and passed his work down through generations - fathers to sons and mothers to daughters. His knowledge of Africa, and his imagination knew no limits. His work ethic and his powerful, elegant writing style made him known to millions.

"I have lucked into things continuously. I have done things which have seemed appalling at the time, disastrous even, but out of them have come another story or a deeper knowledge of human character and the ability to express myself better on paper, write books which people enjoy reading. Along the way, I have lived a life that I could never have imagined," Smith wrote in his autobiography, On Leopard Rock.

The master storyteller died on Saturday (13 November) at the age of 88 at his house in Cape Town.

Suspect accused of murdering husband dies in hospital

BONUS - RUSTENBURG - Nancy Majonhi (42), the woman accused of killing her husband and dismembering his body with a spade before dumping the parts in three different pit toilets in Ledig, has died.

According to information received Majonhi died in hospital on Saturday morning (13 November).

After she confessed to the murder of her husband, she was arrested and was remanded in custody. A bail hearing was set, but she could not attend due to ill health. Her condition was as a result of a hunger strike she embarked on. After she was admitted to hospital, she reportedly refused to take her prescribed medicine. Battles will continue at TGRSA (Toyota Gazoo Racing South Africa) Parys 400

BONUS - RUSTENBURG - The war for the championship titles in the Special Vehicle Category of the South African National Cross Country Series (SACCS) might have been won, but the battles for podium positions and the final standings will continue at the TGRSA Parys 400, the seventh and final round of the 2021 season that takes place on Saturday 20 November.

The Overall as well as Class A and Class G champions have secured their titles and will have no pressure, but the rest of the field will go to Parys with the aim to finish the season on the podium or to better their overall and class championship standings. Victories, podium results and race finishes will be the name of the game and Parys will serve as the chosen battlefield. Lance Trethewey and Adriaan Roets (King Price Xtreme BAT) are the 2021 Overall Special Vehicle Drivers' and Navigators' Champions as well as the Class A champions with nothing to lose, however, they enter new territory, and have upgraded to the Production Vehicle Category where they will compete with a Century Racing CR6 in the FIA Class. The pair were victorious at five of the six previous events with their team-mates, Boela Botes/Jay Pretorius (Porter) claiming the victory at the recent Vryburg 400.

Botes/Pretorius are now second in the Class A championship and another victory will be a perfect way to round off their season. The main race starts at 09:30 and will consist of a 175 kilometre loop teams will need to complete twice to receive the chequered flag. All the action will take place from the Parys Airfield where the Race Headquarters, Designated Service Park (DSP) and Start/Finish will be situated. Spectators are unfortunately still not allowed in the DSP area. The race can be followed on the RallySafe App that is available for download from the iStore and Google Play Store.
