



What to do in a mall robberv

BONUS - RUSTENBURG - As we approach the busy retail festive season, the risk of mall robberies unfortunately increases.

Knowing what to do in the event of security expert says the golden rule if you ever are caught in the middle of a heist is to stay calm. Customers always need to remain vigilant and should always be on the lookout for any suspicious activities and be aware of the people around them.

Fidelity Services Group provides the following useful advice:

If you are in the store that is being robbed:

- Co-operate with robbers for your own safety. Listen to their instructions closely and follow their instructions
- Try and keep as calm as possible. Everyone reacts in a different way but try and breathe deeply until help arrives
- Do not use your cell phone whilst the robbery is in process, this could agitate the assailants
- · Immediately try and find a sheltered spot and keep low on the ground
- · Take note of the assailants to pass information on to the authorities i.e. what they were wearing, any distinctive clothes, markings, jewellery etc. Try and remember with the post-traumatic stress following what they look like i.e. height, weight, etc. such robberies," concludes the expert.

- · Ensure your children are always kept a mall robbery could save your life. A close to you. Do not let children wander off while you are shopping
 - · Do not shop with large amounts of cash or valuables

If you are not in the store being robbed:

- · Speak with the store personnel to firstly close the roller shutter doors. This is also standard operating procedures in many malls and move to the back of the store, out of sight
- · Try and find a store closest to you and secure yourself as described above
- · Do not try and exit via the standard entry and exit points as these are the same points the robbers will be using. Many malls now have standard operating procedures to lock down the mall.

Bartmann says crime is becoming more sophisticated, with inside information playing an increasingly prominent role.

"Whether you were in the store being robbed, or just witnessed the incident in the Centre, you should seek counselling, regardless of how you might feel. It often takes some time to experience and deal

1. How is unemployment defined?

The narrow or strict definition of unemployment includes those who are unemployed and have taken active steps to look for work. The broad or expanded definition of unemployment includes discouraged job seekers

Statistics South Africa (Stats SA) publishes regular statistics on employment in South Africa. The Quarterly Labour Force Survey (QLFS) for April to June 2021 estimated a strict unemployment rate of 34.4%. The broad



4. What is the youth unemployment rate?

In South Africa, 'youth' is defined as people between the ages of 15-34. Earlier this year, Stats SA said that the 'burden of unemployment is concentrated among the youth' and that the youth unemployment rate is high rrespective of education level

The latest data shows that the unemployment rate for youths aged 15-24 was 52.3% and among those aged 25-34 it was 28.9%. The expanded rate for those aged 15-24 was 73.4% and among youths aged 25-34 if
