Primary School in Luka allegedly torched down

BONUS - RUSTENBURG -The community of Luka Village, just outside Rustenburg woke up to the shocking news that their school, called Ramotse Primary School had burnt down at midnight on Saturday (12 February).

The cause of fire is still unknown but the school community suspects that it was criminal activities. The fire destroyed a computer lab with 40 computers, photocopiers, printers, Mathematics lab (1 projector, one screen, manipulative cupboard, interactive board and 18 tables), National School Nutrition Programme storage (food for learners) and Learner Teaching Supply Material (Stationery and textbooks) and a block of toilets for the girls and boys. The MEC for Education, Mmaphefo Matsemela condemned in strongest terms the alleged burning of the school.

“I take this moment to condemn in its strongest terms the alleged burning of Ramotse Primary school. Such incidents are clearly targeted at delaying the provisioning of education to an African child. These incidents are aimed at destroying the right to education enshrined by the South African Constitution. We wish the full might of the law to find those responsible and send them to jail where they belong”, said MEC Matsemela. The school has opened a case of arson with the local police station.

Three arrested for robbery

BONUS -RUSTENBURG - Three men were allegedly arrested on Saturday morning after an incident at an internet cafe/casino in the vicinity of Heystek Street and Beyers Naude Avenue. According to information received, the three men, one of them brandishing a firearm, entered the premises earlier that morning.

It could not be established whether the men wanted to rob the business or the patrons. The attempted robbery was apparently foiled and the three suspects arrested. According to people on scene, a police vehicle that attended to the crime was then involved in an accident with another vehicle. Due to this accident, traffic around the scene was disrupted for some time. Police has not yet confirmed the incident or the information officially.

Increase to the National Minimum Wage

BONUS - RUSTENBURG - With effect from Tuesday (1 March), the National Minimum Wage (NMW) for each ordinary hour worked will increase from R21.69 to R23.19 for the year 2022.

The Minister of Employment and Labour Thulas Nxesi said the announcement was in terms of Section 6 (5) of the NMW Act, No 9 of 2018, to amend the NMW contained in Schedule 1 and Schedule 2 of the National Minimum Wage Act published under Government Notice No. 44136.

As in previous years, the adjustment provides exceptions for several worker groups which include farmworkers as they are entitled to a minimum wage of R23.19 per hour and domestic workers are entitled to a minimum wage of R23.19. Workers employed on an expanded public works programme are entitled to a minimum wage of R12.75 per hour while workers who have concluded learnership agreements contemplated in section 17 of the Skills Development Act, 1998 (Act No 97 of 1998), are entitled to allowances contained in schedule 2. “It is illegal and unfair labour practice for an employer to unilaterally change working hours or other employment conditions in order to implement the NMW. The NMW is the amount payable for ordinary hours of work and excludes payment of allowances (such as transportation, tools, food, or lodging), payments in kind (board or lodging), tips, bonuses, and gifts,” the Minister said.
