

Attempted murder suspect to re-appear in court

BONUS - RUSTENBURG - Mpho William "Seun" Modirapula (24), was expected to make a second appearance in the Rustenburg Magistrates' Court on Monday (13 June) for attempted murder.

The accused was arrested on Sunday (5 June), in Mokolokwe Village, Bethanie, outside of Rustenburg.

He was arrested for the attempted murder of a 42-year-old woman in Lekgalong Village in the policing precinct of Marikana.

According to information received from Brigadier Sabata Mokgwabone, North West police spokesperson, it is alleged that the accused forcefully gained entrance into the woman's residence in the early hours of Thursday (2 June), then hit her with a spade. The severely injured woman managed to fight back and the accused ran away. The incident was ultimately reported to the police leading to the arrest of the accused three days later. He was remanded in custody upon first appearance on Tuesday (7 June).

Preliminary investigations revealed that the accused has two pending rape cases allegedly committed in December 2017 and December 2021 in Mooinooi and Pretoria respectively. Investigation into the matter continues.



Beware of latest scam:

Post Office

BONUS - RUSTENBURG - The South African Post Office (Sapo) has warned customers about a new scam designed to mislead members of the public to pay money into a fraudulent account and share details of their credit card.

"The emails and SMS messages appear to originate from the post office when in fact they have no connection with the post office," Sapo said on Friday.

Clicking on the link in the message leads the user to a payment page where they are asked to deposit money into an account to 'release' a package. In several instances a form is included asking for the card number and the CVV number on the back.

"The combination of the card number and CVV number are required for online purchases. If you share these details with the scammer, they may be able to use your account to its credit limit," the post office said.

The post office has advised customers to note the following characteristics on emails and messages to confirm if the communication sent is legitimate. The post office never asks for import duties or clearance fees in advance. If there are customs fees payable on a parcel from abroad, the client pays the fees when they collect the parcel from the post office counter or when delivered by a post office driver. Any information about postal crimes, can be reported to the post office's toll-free crime buster hotline on 0800 020 070.

This is the plea of Bridget Masango, Democratic Alliance Shadow Minister of Social Development.

Masango said that the Department of Social Development and the South African Social Security Agency (SASSA) have to communicate properly and effectively with beneficiaries of the Social Relief of Distress (SRD) grant.

The recipients haven't been paid for two months. She added that she is of opinion that beneficiaries must also receive back pay for the months they did not receive their grants.

"It seems that the Minister of Social Development, Lindiwe Zulu, and the SASSA CEO, Busisiwe Memela-Khambula, truly have no empathy for the poorest of the poor in South Africa. Children are literally starving – 1009 children have died due to malnutrition in the past year. And those numbers only indicate the children who were hospitalised. How many more children have starved? How many adults are currently starving without any hope of providing food for their families?" Masango said in a statement.

She added that, while the R350 grant is too little, it means the world for South Africa's poorest and most vulnerable. "DSD and SASSA must stop playing with people's lives. It is time SRD grant beneficiaries received a definite date of payment. Without the grant many people won't have access to sufficient food and water as mandated by Section 27(1)(b) of the Constitution. All South Africans deserve to live with dignity," Masango concluded.
