Another fuel price increase on the table for March 2023

BONUS - RUSTENBURG - It appears that South African motorists may need to bite down even harder as a dramatic increase in the price of petrol is expected for March 2023 while Diesel may only see a slight blip in price.

Based on the current market trends the expectation at the moment is that the inland price of Petrol 93 will increase by R1,26, while Petrol 95 might increase by R1,20.

This increase would see the inland price of petrol per litre rocket to R22,64 (93) and R22,88 (95). Coastal prices of petrol 93 and 95 may increase to R21,99 and R22,23 per litre respectively. As for Diesel, expectations allude to an increase of 37 cents per litre, resulting in the inland cost of a litre of Diesel increasing from R21,32 to R21,69. Coastal prices of Diesel are expected to increase from R20,67 to R21,04.

The Department of Energy made a point of highlighting the volatile nature of the fuel price and stated that these estimates may vary greatly come to the end of the month. Factors contributing to the tumultuous opening in three months range from the volatile nature of the oil price, which currently sits at \$87 a barrel but experts speculate that this may increase significantly in the future. Rand's poor health has also contributed to the under-recovery experienced in 2023, followed by a strengthening of foreign currencies and a winning in confidence from investors towards domestic governance.

Paraffin may also see a drastic increase as data suggests that the inland cost price could soar from R15,84 to R16,25 while coastal prices may only increase by roughly 30 to 40 cents. Early speculation for February suggested a decrease, unfortunately, an increase was ultimately a reality for the motorists of South Africa in march 2023.

With less than two weeks till month end, current market trends may set the increase in stone.

Stage 6 load shedding is 'heartbreaking'

BONUS - RUSTENBURG - The past weekend, Eskom announced that stage 6 load shedding will be implemented. According to the electricity provider, stage 6 will remain until further notice due to the breaking down of more generating units at several power stations.

The level of the power cuts was meant to have been reduced to stage 4 on Monday morning after Eskom implemented stage 6 from 8pm on Sunday night.

But the utility has been battling to keep up with the high number of system failures that have tripped a further eight units on Sunday.

Eskom Spokesperson Sikonathi Mantshantsha said that six units had suffered breakdowns and were taken offline for repairs.

"Further, two generating units at the Lethabo power station were shut down due to coal constraints as the new Vaal mine that is supplying the station has been unable to deliver the expected amount of coal during the past week because of the heavy rains."

Eskom said that changes to the current level of power cuts may be announced at a moment's notice due to the severe pressure on the power grid.

"We are without electricity for more than 10 hours per day. Businesses were struggling; but now many of them will simply have to give up. It's heartbreaking," wrote one commentator on Twitter.

Another stated: "South Africa is

Jansen wrote: "Ja Mr President here we are again at Stage 6 but why would you and your cabinet care? You are covered. I promise you, we are voting you lot out of power (sic) once and for all. No damn it, nobody signed up for this crappy life under your mismanagement."

In Rustenburg, the municipality has indicated that they will stick to stage 4, limiting power outages to six hours a day.

New RAF 1 FORM

A new RAF 1 Form (Claim Form) has been implemented which outlines the minimum information that must be provided by a claimant when lodging a claim, in order to ensure that claims are registered and processed in a timely manner by the Road Accident Fund (RAF).



EFFECTIVE DATE 04 JULY 2022

Going forward only the new Claim Form must be used and the RAF will object to the validity of all claims that are submitted on, or after, 4 July 2022 on the old RAF 1 Third Party Claim Form.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT THE NEW RAF 1 FORM:

- Claimants are only required to complete those sections of the Claim Form that relate to the specific type of claim lodged, which makes completion of the Claim Form simpler;
- The Claim Form lists all of the documents that a claimant must lodge with the Claim Form, for each type of benefit claimed, to enable the speedier processing of claims by the RAF; and
- The Claim Form was amended to assist the RAF to obtain sufficient information about the motor vehicle accident (MVA) to ensure that, at the time of lodgment, the RAF is in possession of the necessary information to enable it to investigate the MVA and to assess its liability within 120 days of lodgment.

Operation Restoration plumes feathers in Ward 17

Brother, sister missing

A search and extensive police investigation were conducted around Rustenburg and surrounding areas, but the duo could not be found.

Prominent businessman killed

BONUS - RUSTENBURG - Police here are investigating a shooting incident in which a man was killed.

According to Rustenburg Police Spokesperson, Sgt Ofentse Mokgadi, the 42-year-old man, was shot multiple times by two unknown suspects. "The incident occurred at a shopping complex at the corner of Nelson Mandela Drive and Klopper Street. The suspects were dressed in work suits," Sgt Mokgadi said.

The motive for the murder of Neo "Makhanda" Mbatha, a well-known businessman, is unknown and the police are appealing to the members of the community who might have witnessed the incident, or have any information to please contact the investigating officer, Detective Sergeant Keoarapetse Ramokgadi on 082 772 8941.

In an unrelated incident, a 48-year-old man was fatally shot multiple times by unknown suspects driving a white Toyota Quantum. The man was in his Ford Ranger bakkie when he was attacked in Freedom Park.

The motive for the killing is still unknown and no one has been arrested.




