

Municipal workers down tools as result of labour dispute while millions of litres of precious water go to waste

BONUS - RUSTENBURG - A wonderful sports weekend with many highlights was spoilt for hundreds of consumers in various extensions throughout town over the weekend.

A burst pipe in Beyers Naudé has seen millions of litres of water going to waste since Friday morning while another pipe burst in Helen Joseph Avenue led to dozens of homes running dry. In Leeurik Avenue a boundary wall has collapsed as a result of a water spillage and losses were to such extent that at some stage Boschdal reservoir was in danger of running out of water. Several extension of Safari Gardens were without water for hours on end over the weekend while practically no work teams from the Rustenburg Municipality or their superiors were available to assist consumers or to respond to urgent enquiries by consumers. According to reports by Councillors of the

Rustenburg Municipality, a labour dispute was the main reason for the unattended water problems and shortage of essential equipment such as TLBs in areas where pipes have burst. Of course his also led to the unavailability of teams from the municipality's water unit. Councillors of various Wards - amongst these Cllr Gert du Plessis of the DA - was told that workers would address the city's latest wide-spread water crises as soon as a labour dispute had been resolved. To make matters worse neither the Executive Mayor, the Acting Municipal Manager, the Director Technical Services and Infrastructure were not available to respond to telephonic enquiries, Rustenburg Herald was told.



Nangosuth Nangosuth Buthelezi passes away at 95

BONUS RUSTENBURG - The founder and traditional Prime minister to the Zulu Royal family Prince Mangosuthu Buthelezi has died at the age of 95 years on Saturday morning.

The family announced Buthelezi's death in a statement released early on Saturday morning.

"In this devastating moment, we thank God Almighty for His faithfulness and grace, knowing with certainty that uMntwana has been embraced by His Lord."

He quietly and painlessly stepped into eternity in the early hours of this morning," read the statement. Buthelezi was described as a 'towering and significant historical figure' in the country's history. The family said it will engage with Zulu King Misuzulu kaZwelithini, President Cyril Ramaphosa, the Buthelezi family and the leadership of the IFP as the necessary funeral arrangements are made. Further details in this regard will be announced in due course. "We thank the nation for the immense support that has been shown towards our family in the past few weeks, and give thanks for the prayers that will surely sustain us now. "May South Africa's beloved servant rest in peace," read the statement."







BirdLife Rustenburg - Waders

BONUS - RUSTENBURG - Waders, or shore birds, are a fascinating group of birds that are usually, but not exclusively, found near water.

They can be found from literally sea-level – such as Sanderlings and White-fronted Plovers - right up to altitudes over 5000m.

These birds are also celebrated for their unbelievable migrations which can cover huge distances in a matter of days, and sometimes over vast expanses of ocean. Waders are under severe pressure all around the world as the increase in human population results in a loss of habitat and issues such as pollution and global warming.


There are some interesting wader-hotspots around Rustenburg - Rockwall Dam, Kroondal Dam and then Finfoot Lodge and Pilanesberg National Park. A surprising amount of different waders can be spotted at these locations during the summer months such as Threebanded, Kittlitz's and White-fronted Plovers, Little Stints, African Jacana, Black-winged Stilts and many more.
