Lentswe, Jouberton - A retired teacher who ended her career at Vuselela college passed away at Life Annron Hospital on Tuesday 21 July at around 11:45.

The former Khuma Primary School teacher, Betty Phehello King-Wageng (77) matriculated at Kelebogile ABET Centre according to her family.

She studied her Lower Primary Teachers course at Bethel Training Teachers College, Diploma in Education at SACTE and her High Education Diploma at North West University.

Her two grieving daughters, Dimakatso Wageng (47) and Kedibone Wageng (50) said she started teaching in Bloemhof, then came to Jouberton's Boitumelo Primary,

Khuma Primary and retired at Diphetogo Primary.

Around 2012 she started as a supervisor at Vuselela FET College.

Her daughters said: "We lost a mother, a mentor, motivator, freedom fighter and are saddened by her death. She was a God fearing woman as she served the Roman Catholic Church as a President of Catholic Women's League (CWL) under Klerksdorp Diocese."

She is survived by her four daughters (Dimakatso, Kedibone, Keodutse Mnguni and Kefilwe Maak-galemele), 9 grandchildren, 4 great grandchildren and

her sister.

Her funeral service will be held at home X1183 Mangesi Street Jouberton from 08:00 on Tuesday 28 July.

Illegal cigarette bust at border

Lentswe, Zeerust - Million rands worth of illegal cigarettes were confiscated at the Kopfontein border post.

A 48-year-old suspect was expected to appear in the Zeerust Magistrates' Court on Wednesday 22 July for smuggling in illicit cigarettes.

According to Brig Sabata Mokgwabone, police spokesperson, the suspect was apprehended on 20 July at approximately 23:40.

"According to reports, the suspect was entering the country from Zambia via Botswana when his truck with Gauteng registration number plates was stopped for a search. During the

search by police, 152 master boxes of cigarettes with an estimated value of R4 256 725 were found.

"Preliminary investigation revealed that the suspect is due to appear for a similar offence in court in Lephalale, Limpopo in August this year."

The Provincial Commissioner of North West, Lieutenant General Sello Kwena, commended the members for their vigilance which resulted in the success.

The Directorate for Priority Crime Investigation (DPCI) is investigating.

Long queues at post office due to grant payments

Lentswe, Klerksdorp - Long queues at the Klerksdorp post office at City Mall are caused by people who arrive in the hope of getting their Special Covid grant.

SASSA (the South African Social Security Agency) appealed to beneficiaries to only go to a post office when they received a message on their cellphones indicating that their grant is ready for collection. Throughout the week, Special Covid-19 SRD grant beneficiaries formed long queues at some Post Offices and not observing social distancing. "This is a huge concern to us," Nthabiseng Mosieleng, SASSA NW spokesperson, said.

"In trying to control the queues SASSA and role players; banks, merchants and SAPO agreed to use payment staggered SMS messages system asking beneficiaries to collect their grant when it is ready for collection. The system makes it possible to ensure that a manageable number of people go to SAPO branches and it also makes sure only beneficiaries whose funds have actually been paid into Postbank visit the branch."

Necessary Covid-19 precautionary regulations of using sanitizer dispensers at the doors and wearing of masks should be adhered to in order to reduce the spread of Covid-19.

'Coffin man' walks Khuma streets

Lentswe, Khuma - On Tuesday 14 July, the community of this kasi, was shocked to see a man walking on the streets with a white coffin on his shoulder.

The video that was shared on social media, shows the man walking down Mokgethi Road, passing near Khuma Stadium and approaching Mosala Street.

On the video, you hear a voice of a woman asking the man if he built the coffin on his own, but another voice said it looks like the coffin was dug up by the way it looks. Somewhere on the street, the man meets a group of boys who run away when they see him carrying

the coffin.

In another video, a number of people have gathered asking what is inside the coffin. The police also make an appearance.

Speaking to the North West police spokesperson Capt Afjee Botma she said no case was opened.

"We can confirm that there was an incident of a man with a coffin, but there's no case opened against him, because this guy was mentally ill and he got this broken coffin from an abandoned mortuary around Khuma. There was only a dustbin with rubbish in this coffin. Apparently they took him back to Tshepong Hospital. As I said allegedly he is mentally ill," Captain Botma said.



Reduction of isolation period

Lentswe, Klerksdorp - The Minister of Health has announced that the isolation period for persons who have tested positive for Covid-19 has been reduced from 14 to 10 days.

This means that the sick leave burden on employers, in respect of employees who have tested positive, has been reduced accordingly, the employers' organisation union Neasa said.

Employees who have tested positive and displayed no symptoms may return to work 10 days after confirmation of a positive test. Employees with mild symp-

toms may return 10 days after the date of symptom onset and employees with severe symptoms may return 10 days after clinical stability has been achieved.

There is no requirement for employees who have tested positive to be tested again before returning to work but a simple confirmation by a doctor that he/she is fit to work will suffice.

Although the amendment has not been gazetted yet, the Minister of Health indicated that these amended protocols will be implemented with immediate effect.

Expired license disks still valid

Lentswe, Klerksdorp - The Department of Transport announced the validity period for car licenses that expired during lockdown has been extended to the end of November.

South Africans should expect further extensions for car license renewals, however, as the department may not be able to work through its backlog this year.

"The extension to the end of November is a great start, and we certainly welcome this move by the Department of Transport. It's the correct decision and indicates that the department is aware of the problems

motorists are facing," the Automobile Association of South Africa said.

"However, we still believe this does not provide enough time to deal with the backlogs and we will continue with our petition which seeks extension until at least the end of January next year."

While the validity of licenses has been extended yet again, South Africans can currently visit licensing centres to renew their license.

The main Post Office in Klerksdorp, situated at City Mall in the CBD, also offers this service.

Case withdrawn against Matlosana MM

Lentswe, Klerksdorp - The criminal case against the City of Matlosana's Municipal Manager (MM) was withdrawn in the Klerksdorp Regional Court last week.

Tsietsi Roger Solomon Nkhumise appeared in court on Friday 17 July to hear that charges relating to contravening the Municipal Finance Manage-

ment Act (MFMA) against him, were withdrawn.

According to North West Hawks spokesperson Capt Tlangelani Rikhotso this is only a formality. "The matter was provisionally withdrawn pending finalisation of certain administrative issues."

The court case stemmed from allegations that Nkhumise deviated from the official procurement processes when appointing a service provider for a tender

of more than R8 million for the supply and delivery of paraffin for indigent communities.

Papers filed with the North West High Court by Lawrence Mabunda in June, ask that Nkhumise's permanent appointment as MM is unlawful, irregular and in conflict with the rule of law and should be set aside. A date for this application to be heard still needs to be set.

Burials for killed police officers

Lentswe, Wolmaransstad - The two police officers who died in an accident last week will be buried this week.

The Wolmaransstad police are investigating a case of culpable homicide after the vehicle in which two police officials and a civilian were travelling, collided head-on with a truck.

According to the North West police spokesperson Brig Sabata Mokgwabone, the accident happened along the R540 (Leeudoringstad-Wolmaransstad) road at approximately 10:35 on Wednesday 15 July.

Brig Mokgwabone confirmed that the victims, Sgt Thys Kgaratsi and Sgt Daniel Sethibe are stationed at Public Order Police unit.

Sgt Sethibe will be buried in Ikageng on Friday 24 July, while Sgt Kgaratsi will be buried on Saturday 25 July in Tswelelang.

Efforts to get more info about the third victim who was also involved in the crash were fruitless.

"This house will definitely change my life even though I'm still unemployed. In this shack, I've been staying in the coldness of winter, there was always water inside during the rainy days, but now my life was changed by these good Samaritans sent by God," he said with a smile on his face.

Khumalo said he was sent from pillar to post by the municipality.

Khumalo is staying with his wife, Meisie Mokoena (49).

Former ANC ward Councillor Mbulelo Makhaza said: "The reason why these RDP houses are still incomplete is that our then Tlokwe municipality, now JB Marks local municipality told us that the provincial Human Settlement had a backlog as funds were misused. I was one of those 14 ward councillors who complained about maladministration, corruption and fraud. That was the time the ANC decided to fire us as councillors and then DA took

over the municipality at that time."

Makhaza is now the ANC ward committee member of ward 16 and also a ward secretary.

One of the founders of the Maono Foundation Shimmy Mochobo said: "We saw it important as the newly established Foundation to assist our people and that Mr Khumalo must be honoured as an old man with a complete and dignified shelter. We are intended to continue and help others. And thanks to sponsors which helped to sponsor us to fulfill this dream of a house to be completed."

No new vacancies at this NW department

Lentswe, Klerksdorp - The NWDepartment of Community Safety and Transport warns that there are fake positions advertised in the name of the Department.

The Department said that the last advertised positions were four months ago, in March.

In that advertisement it was stated that 17 April 2020 is the closing date for the applications' submission but as a result of

Covid-19 enforced lockdown, the deadline was extended to 29 May 2020.

Chief Director for Corporate Services Sizile Mpolokeng warns potential candidates that the Department has not advertised any positions posts since then and with that deadline.

"We are, therefore, advising potential candidates to ignore these fake advertised posts. It is for that

reason that the Department's Human Resource Management will not accept any employment applications with a closing date of 17 July 2020," warned Mpolokeng.

Any future positions shall be advertised as per normal channels including the Department's website, government emails, through print and onlinemedia platforms as well as on official Departmental social media pages.

Eskom to distribute free basic electricity

Lentswe, Klerksdorp - Eskom's North West Operating Unit said it is working with municipalities to ensure that indigent households receive free basic electricity allocated by the government.

North West Eskom Khaya Mnyandu said: "We encourage customers who qualify for Free Basic Electricity (FBE), who have registered with municipalities as indigents, but are not currently collecting their FBE, to collect their tokens from the nearest Eskom vending outlet where they buy their electricity.

"Qualifying households, in terms of the government's policy the unemployed, low earning, the destitute and the elderly, are encouraged to approach their municipalities to register as indigents. Once registered with the municipality, the customers' details are sent to Eskom to be loaded on the Eskom system where they get credited with free electricity tokens."

Mnyandu said customers on municipalities' indigent household registers have the right to collect a minimum 50 kilowatt-hour (kWh) of free basic electricity every month, which can also be higher, depending on the municipality.

"We are concerned that a large number of indigent households do not exercise their right to FBE, either because they are unaware of the benefit, or because they have not registered with the municipality," he concluded.
