The 45 hopefuls arrived in Johannesburg for the training camp on, January 03 and have undergone extensive training supervised by South African soccer legends Phil Masinga and Neil Tovey as well as four other top coaches.

Lehlohonolo Marumo born in Orlando West Johannesburg has been playing in the local SAB league here in Mahikeng when he was selected for the team. The young star has been studying and living in Mahikeng where his soccer career started at Living Faith Prep School, then Mmabatho High school and subsequently Sol Plaatje Secondary School where he completed his schooling.

I started playing for 15 Masters, then moved on to Western Tigers FC, then promoted to Mafikeng Rocks and later changed to Blydeville FC" said Marumo. Marumo also spent a year in Brazil at the OleAcademy in Riberao Preto ( in the then Themba Gwabeni squad)while he was still at Mafikeng Rocks. He was selected at the SAB trails held at Montshioa stadium late in 2013 and represented the province in Stellenboch, Cape Town where he made it to the last 45 that went to camp.

He was selected together with Gerald Gaona Modisane, a centre -half from Motswedi, Lehurutshe (Zeerust) identified by Mpho Nkontlha, his caretaker agent in 2011 at the Mothupi Tournament held at Lehurutshe stadium. According to Nkontlha the boy had exceptional talent and when he moved to Pretoria in 2012, to further his studies he was snapped by Arcadia Shepherds. The boys have been placed at Premier Soccer League PSL teams which they could not reveal at the time of the interviews.
