


## So bek moet jêm kry

# Measures taken to curb illegal mining

Klerksdorp Midweek, Klerksdorp - Safer South Africa Foundation (SSAF) and Harmony Gold have joined hands with communities near the mining company's operations in Gauteng, Free State and North West provinces to address rising levels of criminality including the scourge of illegal mining.

SSAF's crime prevention initiative and

Justice Programme (CJP) will be rolled out in Khutsong (Gauteng), North West Province's townships of Jouberton and Kanana as well as Virginia and Viljoenskroon in the Free State.

"The health and safety of our employees is our number one value, both at work and within the communities in which they dwell.

We believe through this partnership, we will contribute positively towards crime prevention in the affected areas," explains Mashego Mashego, Executive Director for Corporate Affairs and Stakeholder Relations for Harmony.

SSAF CEO, retired General Riah Phiyega, says the communities were facing high levels of violent crime fuelled by gangsterism, substance abuse and unemployment. "Of major concern, is that this criminality has spilled over into schools. So, we will enrol both learners and out-of-schoolers whose ages range between 18 and 35 to help them tackle the problems," she says.

She added that the North West Province sessions have been completed. The programme is currently being rolled out in the Free State in Virginia High School. Gauteng will follow thereafter.

The CJP empowers communities to take ownership of preventing and fighting crime in conjunction with the various arms of the criminal justice system such as the South African Police Service, the National Prosecuting Authority, Correctional Services and the South African Human Rights Commission.

The aim is to enrol more than 500 people in the CJP together with Harmony. "We realised for our programme to have further reach and therefore an even deeper impact, learners can work together with their older peers to sustain this collaborative crime-

prevention initiative with Harmony Gold," adds Phiyega.

The CJP is an effective crime-prevention programme that bridges the gap between communities and the criminal justice system. It is a platform for youths to have face-to-face interactions with law-enforcement practitioners to improve relationships and foster trust and confidence of communities in the criminal justice system.

Furthermore, the CJP promotes constitutionalism and human rights by improving the understanding of individuals' rights and obligations as well as helping the youth realise that crime does not pay.

In collaboration with Banking Association South Africa, the CJP also includes a financial literacy module.

The youth are taught financial savviness and how to break the poverty cycle without resorting to criminality.

To date, over 20 000 learners have participated in the programme nationwide and its reach keeps growing as organisations such as Harmony partner with SSAF to expand its reach even further.

This partnership with Harmony will be complemented by community dialogues over crime prevention in Khutsong. The dialogues are a platform to share information and concerns about crime in their area and find practical solutions together with relevant authorities.





## Sticky Pork rasher cubes

**Ingredients**

- ~ 900 g pork rashers - outer skin removed and cut into 25mm cubes
- ~ salt and black pepper - to taste
- ~ 15 ml Chinese five-spice powder
- ~ 60 ml cooking oil
- ~ 100 ml sugar
- ~ 100 ml boiling water
- ~ 45 ml Chinese BBQ sauce
- ~ bunch spring onions - finely chopped
- ~ 30 ml sesame seeds - pan roasted
- ~ 2-3 cup steamed rice - to serve
- ~ coleslaw - to serve

**Method:**

- ~ Season the pork rasher cubes with the salt, pepper and Chinese five-spice.
- ~ Heat the oil in a wok or heavy-bottomed pan and fry the pork cubes in batches until cooked and crispy on the outside. Keep the batches of fried pork cubes warm while you fry the rest.
- ~ When all the pork cubes are fried and removed from the pan, add the sugar and water to the pan, stirring. Do not let it boil until all the sugar has dissolved.
- ~ Bring the sugar and water to the boil and continue simmering until it turns the colour of honey.
- ~ Add the Chinese BBQ sauce and pork cubes to the sauce and stir-fry until the pork cubes are coated and glossy.
- ~ Sprinkle with spring onions and sesame seeds and serve with the rice and coleslaw.

**Klerksdorp** - Is jy ook jaloers op almal wat die 2023 Rugby Wêreldbeker in Frankryk gaan kyk terwyl jy soos kiepie by die huis moet sit?

Dan het kykNET wonderlike nuus vir jou. Vanes-Mari du Toit en Hamilton Wessels gaan wéér die Bokke al die pad Wêreldbeker toe volg en vir jou 'n onvergeetlike rugbyreis gee in hul nuwe reeks, *In Frans, ja!*, wat op 9 September om 19:30 op kykNET (DStv-kanaal 144) begin.

In 2019 het Vanes-Mari en Hamilton die Bokke gaan ondersteun in Japan, die fassinerende kultuur leer ken en 'n hele rits merkwaardige mense ontmoet. In Frans, ja! is selfs meer opwindend, want nou het die Bokke die kans om die trofee vir 'n vierde keer huis toe te bring.

Die Wêreldbeker skop af op 8 September. Dit is dus tyd vir Hammie, soos sy vriende hom ken, en Vanes om hulle paspoorte af te stof, hul 15de *booster shot* elk te kry en die pad Frankryk toe te vat om jou op 'n groot Afri-Franse avontuur te neem.

Vanes sê dat Japan fun was, maar Frankryk gaan FUNTASTIC wees: "Ons sien uit om alles te doen, te eet en te sien wat die land van die Hane te bied het."

Dié twee gaan die Bokke vanaf Marseille na Bordeaux volg, waar hulle tussendeur bietjie gaan wynproe en hul hand aan



muurkuns gaan waag. Daarna kyk hulle saam met die oud-Bok Flip van der Merwe in Biarritz die Bokke se wedstryd teen Ierland. Dan is dit tyd vir 'n jolige rugby-bootreis met ander Suid-Afrikaners. En as alles goed afloop, sal Hammie en Vanes hopelik wéér sien hoe die Bokke die Webb Ellis-trofee lig – dié keer in Parys.

Hammie sê as jy gedink het In Japan, ja! was 'n avontuur, dan het kykers geen idee wat voorlê nie, want hy en Vanes gaan die Franse en al die ander lande se rugby-ondersteuners wys hoe word dit by 'n Wêreldbeker gedoen.

"Japan sal nooit weer dieselfde wees nadat ek en Vanes dit met die vorige Wêreldbeker op horings geneem het nie. Die Franse gaan ook nie weet wat hulle getref het nie. Ons beplan om hulle in ongeloof agter te laat en natuurlik met die William Webb Ellis-trofee aan ons sy," sê Hammie uitgelate.

Ons dink Hammie wil eintlik net die Webb Ellis-trofee wat hy "per ongeluk" in Japan gesteel het, wéér vir 'n slag omhoog hou. Ons sal maar moet wag, duime vashou en sien.

Na die Springbokke se wen teen die All Blacks die afgelope naweek loop wêreldbeker-koors hoog.

# Calling on primary schools to help save lives

## Klerksdorp Midweek, Klerksdorp -

Building on the success of its 2022 pilot campaign in the Western and Eastern Cape Provinces, the award-winning health education initiative, FAST Heroes, is gearing up for its 2023 campaign, inviting primary schools to register and help save lives.

Endorsed and supported by the World Stroke Organisation, FAST Heroes has an important mission: to enlist a million young heroes who will play a crucial role in safeguarding their grandparents from the potential impact of a stroke.

Designed for primary school children aged

5 to 9 years, this compelling campaign aims to equip them with the ability to recognise stroke symptoms and understand the urgency of immediate action - to call an ambulance.

Through a 5-week curriculum, facilitated by teachers and involving weekly activities and reinforcement, children learn and internalise the signs of a stroke and the steps to take during a stroke emergency.

The educational

resources within the FAST Heroes program are designed to captivate young minds.

They are interactive, engaging, and fun. Beyond imparting life-saving skills, the program also nurtures values such as empathy and compassion.

"Statistics show that stroke is a serious concern in SA and globally, ranking as the second leading cause of death and the third leading cause of disability worldwide. Unfortunately,

many stroke victims don't receive timely medical care due to a lack of awareness about the key signs. Children hold the power to change this by educating their families," emphasises Prof Naidoo, CEO of the Heart and Stroke Foundation South Africa.

Embracing their inherent passion for learning and sharing, children are encouraged to become health advocates and "superheroes" within their families, particularly with their beloved grandparents. The primary focus is on empowering them to educate their families, particularly their grandparents, about the signs of a stroke and the importance of quickly calling an ambulance.

The campaign introduces children to the three most prevalent stroke symptoms through the engaging analogy of "the evil Clot" striking. Guided by a cast of animated characters including retired superhero grandparents and their grandchildren - Timmy and Tanya, children become adept at identifying the three key signs of a stroke: facial drooping, arm weakness, and speech impairment.

The characters emphasise the importance

of calling an ambulance. This vital process gave rise to the acronym FAST, reflecting the symptoms of a stroke and the urgency of getting prompt medical attention.

During the pilot program in 2022, Nina Ras from Brackenfell Primary School in the Western Cape was a finalist for the Teacher's Award. She received recognition as South Africa's Teacher of the Year for her unwavering dedication to the campaign. With Nina's guidance, over 500 learners participated in the FAST Heroes initiative.

Nina shared her insights about the program: "Being part of the FAST Heroes campaign has been a rewarding experience. Witnessing the enthusiasm and dedication of our young learners as they become agents of change is truly inspiring."

The FAST Heroes campaign was conceptualised by the Department of Education and Social Policy at the University of Macedonia in Europe. The campaign's implementation in South Africa is made possible through the support of the Angels Initiative by Boehringer Ingelheim. The Heart and Stroke Foundation South Africa (HSFSA), a non-profit organisation, is the chosen local partner for this initiative.

Renathe Van Der Merwe, the national coordinator for Fast Heroes, says "With global stroke figures on the rise, recognising stroke symptoms and knowing how to respond are vital life skills.

Children serve as exceptional messengers for disseminating this crucial message to adults around them. I extend a challenge to schools to join forces; together, we can make a transformative difference and save lives, one grandparent at a time!"
