

Life imprisonment for raping ex-girlfriend

STELLALANDER-CHRISTIANA: The Christiana Regional Court sentenced Lesego Andrew Maribe (36), to life imprisonment for raping his ex-girlfriend.

The court further ordered that his name be registered in the sexual offender's register. Maribe's conviction emanates from an incident that occurred on 02 July 2021, wherein he went to his ex-girlfriend's house in Christiana and demanded to be let in while kicking the door. Upon hearing the voice of the accused, the complainant refused to open and rushed to the back of the house to exit and run away. Maribe managed to catch up with her and started assaulting her while dragging her to his place. When they arrived at his place, he repeatedly raped her and only freed her the following day. She went to her aunt to report the matter and later reported the matter to the police. Maribe was arrested and was denied bail by the court. It was also discovered that he had previous convictions of rape and attempted rape. The Director of Public Prosecutions in the North West, Dr Rachel Makhari, lauded the prosecutor, investigating officer and other role players for a collaboration that secured a conviction. She called on communities to advocate against the abuse of women, children and the elderly.

Accused nabbed for contravention of national credit act 34 of 2005

NORTHERN CAPE – A 28-year-old accused, Cornelius Jacobus Jacques Lombard and an entity made a brief appearance before Pampierstad Magistrates' Court on Thursday, 21 September 2023 for contravention of National Credit Act 34 of 2005.

The accused was arrested by the Hawks' Serious Commercial Crime Investigation team and appeared in court on the same day.

Preliminary information indicated that the accused was running his business whilst retaining clients' bank cards, birth certificates, pin codes, proof of residence documentation, SASSA cards and identity documents in order to enforce credit agreement.

Lombard was also charging his clients exorbitant interest rates. A search and seizure disruptive operation was executed at No. 2 Quick Cash Loans, Pampierstad. During that search, documentation, automatic teller machines and a total amount of R10 200 were seized.

Lombard was released on R10 000 bail and the matter was postponed to Monday, 6 November 2023 for further investigation.

Former plant manager sentenced for corruption

STELLALANDER-KATHU: A 54-year-old former plant manager of Sishen Iron Ore Company at Kolomela mine, Johan Breedt was sentenced by Kimberley Specialised Commercial Crime Court on Tuesday, 19 September.

Breedt was arrested in December 2020 by the Hawks' Serious Corruption Investigation team, together with two other sentenced persons, Anthony Meyer, Theunes Burger and Burma Plant Hire. In April 2016, the accused nominated Burma Plant Hire to load and haul final dense medium separation product to the plant production beds. The company was awarded a tender to work at Kolomela mine for the period of July 2016 and July 2017. Between July 2016 and December 2016, the accused demanded monthly payments of R40 000 and gifts from Burma Plant Hire to ensure that company continues to get work at the mine. The accused, through his unlawful activities, benefitted R627 370 in cash and gifts from the company. On 03 July 2023, Breedt pleaded guilty on 12 counts of corruption and 10 counts of money laundering. On Tuesday, 19 September 2023, Breedt was sentenced to three years correctional supervision on all counts of corruption and money laundering and further ordered to pay an amount of R627 320 which he unduly benefitted through his illegal activities. The case against Burma Plant Hire was remanded to 28 November 2023 for trial.

STELLALANDER-VRYBURG: Die burgerregteorganisasie AfriForum het die laaste week 63 koringstroobale aan boere in die Vryburg-omgewing geskenk wat onlangs onder veldbrande deurgeloopt het.

Dié stroobale het altesaam 14 ton geweeg. In Augustus en September het meer as 200 000 hektaar se weiding afgebrand as gevolg van veldbrande. Meer as 60 beeste het in hierdie tydperk doodgebrand. "Baie boere in die omgewing het groot skade gelei weens die brande. Daar is boere wat geen weiding meer vir hulle vee oor het nie en daarom het AfriForum ingespring en voer geskenk om boere in hierdie moeilike tyd te help," verduidelik Jp Nel, AfriForum se distrikskoördineerder vir Stellaland. Hierdie skenkings is moontlik gemaak deur AfriForum se Voer vir 'n Boer-projek. AfriForum se Vryburg-tak het ook water, koeldrank en nie-bederfbare kos vanuit die gemeenskap ingesamel vir die persone wat gehelp het om die brande te bestry. "AfriForum wil graag sy lede bedank wat bydraes gelewer het tot hierdie veldtog en moedig sy lede aan om verdere skenkings te maak om die boere te help. Veldbrande hou 'n groot risiko vir boere én die gemeenskap in, daarom is dit belangrik dat ons mekaar gedurende hierdie tydperk ondersteun," sluit Nel af. 

NAME OF PROPONENT: Wonderstone Limited.

LOCATION AND SIZE: Wonderstone is located outside Ottosdal, approximately 300km west of Johannesburg in the Northwest Province and is located in the Tswaing Local Municipality which forms part of the Ngaka Modiri Molema District Municipality. The current mining operation takes place on Portion 44 of the farm Gestoptefontein 349 IO and is located within the quaternary catchment C31C in the Lower Vaal Water Management Area (WMA). The proposed project will involve an area of approximately 2 000ha of which approximately 30ha will be new activities only. The proposed Wonderstone – Driekuil Mining Right Consolidation Project will take place on the following farm portions:

- Portions 5, 7, 9, 10, 11, remainder of Portion 15 (a portion of Portion 1), 20, 24 (a portion of Portion 5) and 40 (a portion of Portion 41 now known as Portion 44) of the Farm Gestoptefontein 349IO; Remainder of portion 1, 2, 4, 7 (a portion of portion A), and the Remainder of the Farm Driekuil 280IP.
- The expansion to the mining activities will take place on the approved mining areas including:
- Portions 5, 9, remainder of Portion 15 (a portion of Portion 1), 24 (a portion of Portion 5) and 40 (a portion of Portion 41 now known as Portion 44) of the Farm Gestoptefontein 349IO.

PROJECT PROPOSAL: In April 2022, Wonderstone Ltd. ("WST" or "the mine") applied for an extension of their approved Converted Mining Right (398MR) (CMR) area by adding portions of portions of the approved New Order Mining Right (397MR) (NOMR). Certain portions of portions of the approved areas of the NOMR would also have been abandoned. Based on the outcome of the draft Hydrogeological assessment and the Freshwater Ecosystem assessment, substantial changes in the project layout were considered which also resulted in a change in the farm portions considered. In October 2022 and again during July 2023, in terms of Regulation 3(7) of the EIA Regulations (2014), an application was submitted to the DMRE for an extension of the relevant prescribed timeframe for completion of the EIA due to the change in the scope of work. This will allow the project to resubmit the Environmental Application with the changes to the layout. This will also result in the re-initiation of the Environmental Scoping Report and Specialist studies. For the purposes of the new EIA Application, the project will apply for mining of the following mining blocks: Mining of Blocks 1N, 1S, 2S, 3N, 4N. This is undertaken in order to remove the previously planned blocks 2N, 5N and 6N and replacing them with 1S and 2S.

This Consolidated Environmental Authorisation Application Process pertains to the following main aspects –

- The New Project Expansion;
- The Abandonment and Consolidation of certain Mining Rights Areas;
- Upgrade of existing Bridge crossing over the Driekuispruit; and
- The Consolidation and Update of the Current Environmental Management Programmes (EMPr's), including the incorporation of the existing Section 24G Environmental Authorisation.

Silwer randjie vir Springbokke na Ierse nederlaag

STELLALANDER-VRYBURG: Daar is 'n beduidende silwer randjie aan die Springbokke se klein nederlaag teen Ierland Saterdag, 23 September in die Wêreldbeker-rugbytoernooi.

Die Springbokke se nederlaag teen Ierland het hulle blykbaar op 'n pad na die eindstryd geplaas wat dalk 'n sagter roete na die kampioenskapswedstryd kan wees. Natuurlik beteken dit wel dat sou die Springbokke 'n sege beklink oor Tonga in hul laaste poelwedstryd, dat hulle waarskynlik Frankryk in die laaste agt sal teëkom. Dit sou beteken dat die Springbokke net soos in 2019 weer die gashere in die kwarteindronde pak. Hulle moet egter heelwat meer van Frankryk verwag as wat die 'Brave Blossoms' vier jaar gelede aangebied het, selfs al is hulle van die sterspeler Antoine Dupont afgeskei. Terwyl Dupont die toutjies vir Frankryk trek, het hulle 'n baie goeie span met baie wapens om aan te val en 'n puik skrum en stelskop. As die Springbokke Frankryk kan klop om die Rugby Wêreldbeker-halfeindronde vir die sesde keer te haal, sal hulle dan te staan kom vir of die wenner van Groep D (wat tans na Wallis is) of die naaswenner in Groep C. Groep C se naaswenner sal waarskynlik getrek word uit een van Samoa, Argentinië of Japan wat elk een gewen het en een wedstryd verloor het met Engeland wat die groep op 'n galop wen. Jy sal moet dink dat Wallis bevoordeel sal word om bo uit te kom in daardie stryd en na die waarskynlike semi-finaliste lyk. Daarteenoor lyk Ierland gereed vir nog 'n nagmaeting met die All Blacks in 'n stadium van die Wêreldbeker-rugbytoernooi wat hulle nog nooit verby was nie. Sou hulle verby die All Blacks kom, wag 'n ontmoeting met 'n herlewende Engeland in die laaste vier. As die Springbokke hul pad kon kies, sal hulle waarskynlik verkies om teen Frankryk en Wallis te speel om 'n Wêreldbeker-eindstryd te haal eerder as om teen Nieu-Seeland en teenstanders Engeland te veg. Die verlies teen Ierland is nie die einde van die lyn of die einde van die wêreld vir die Springbokke nie.
